DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a ring or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is back elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from one side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view taken from the other side of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof.

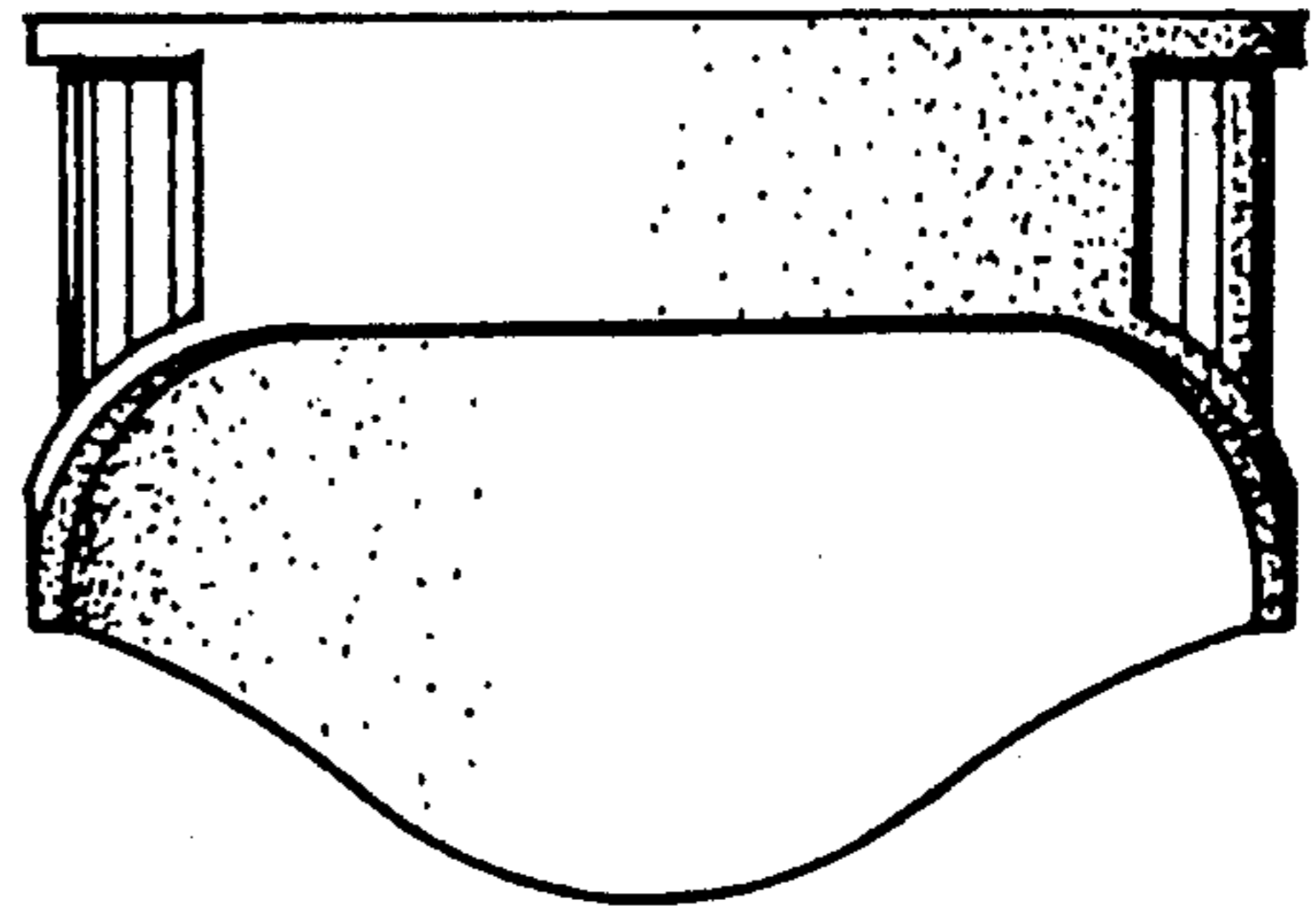

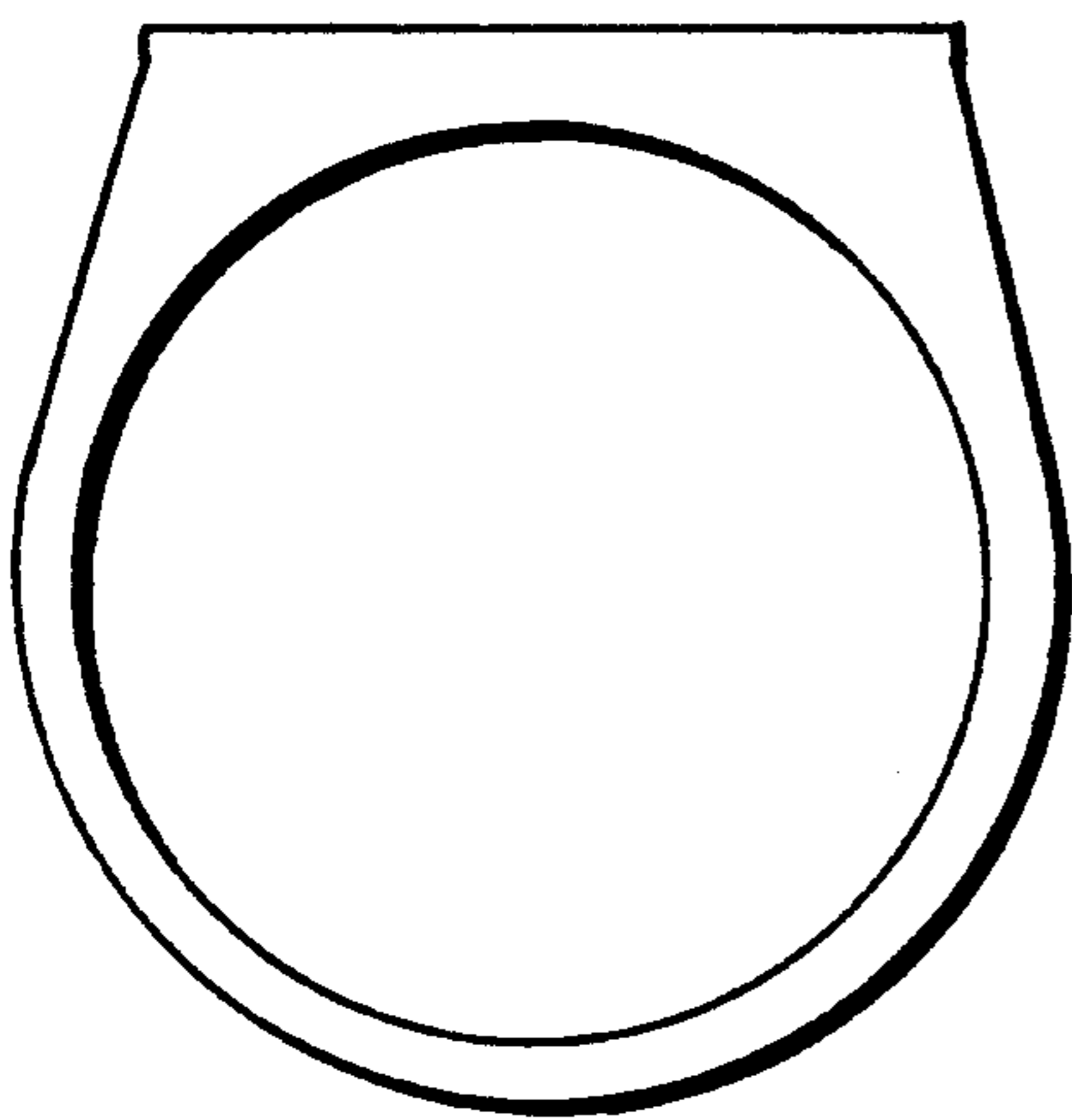

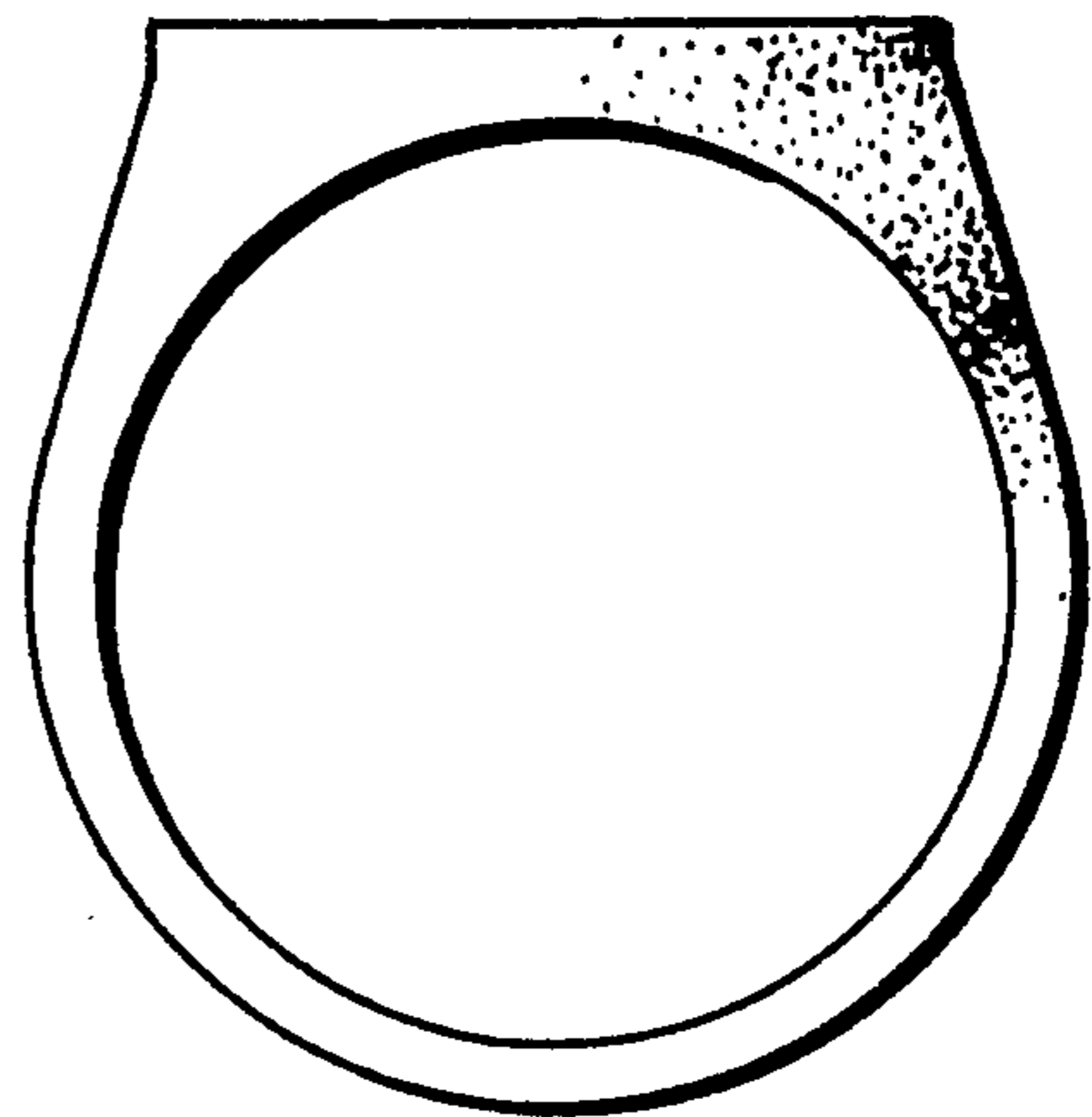

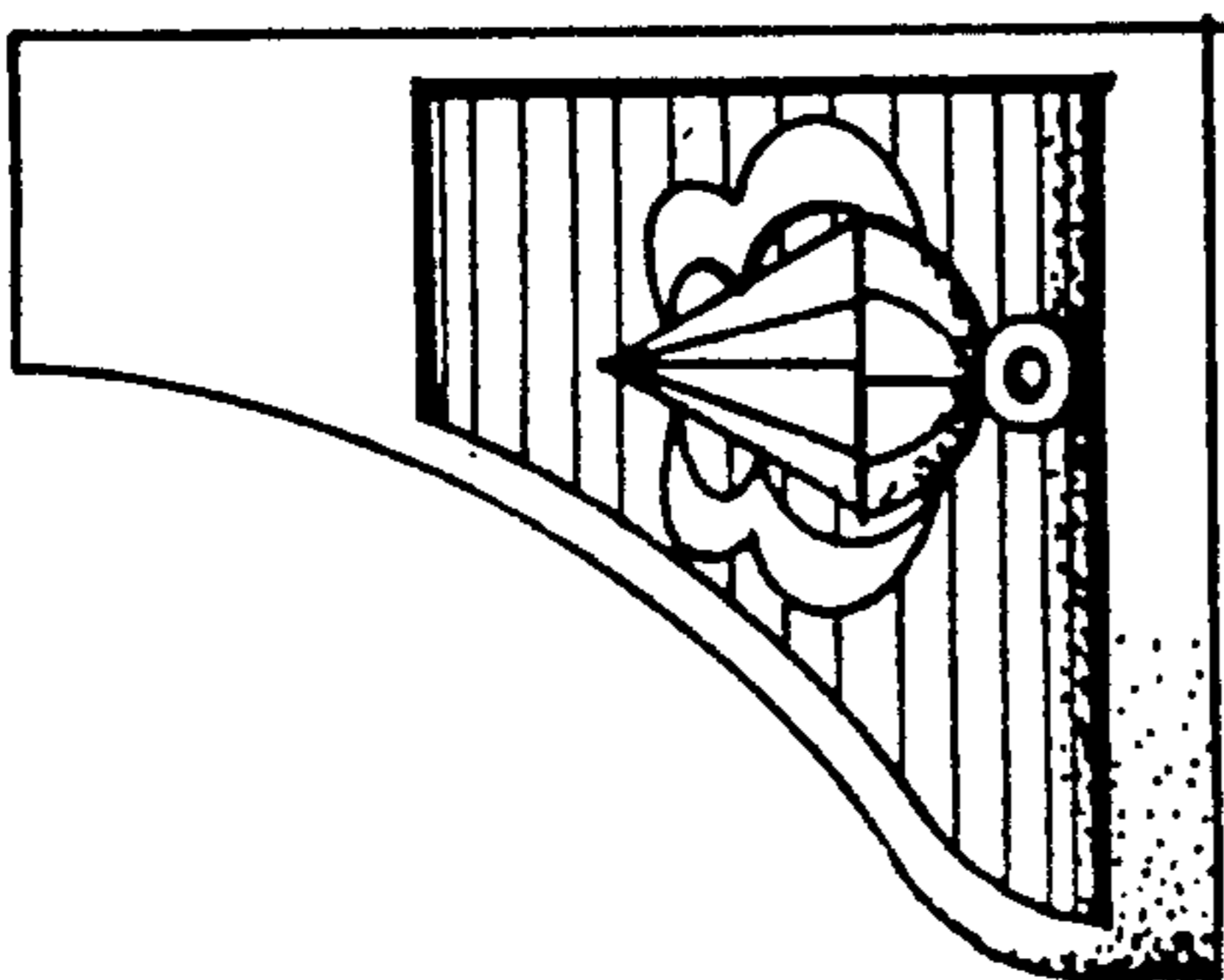

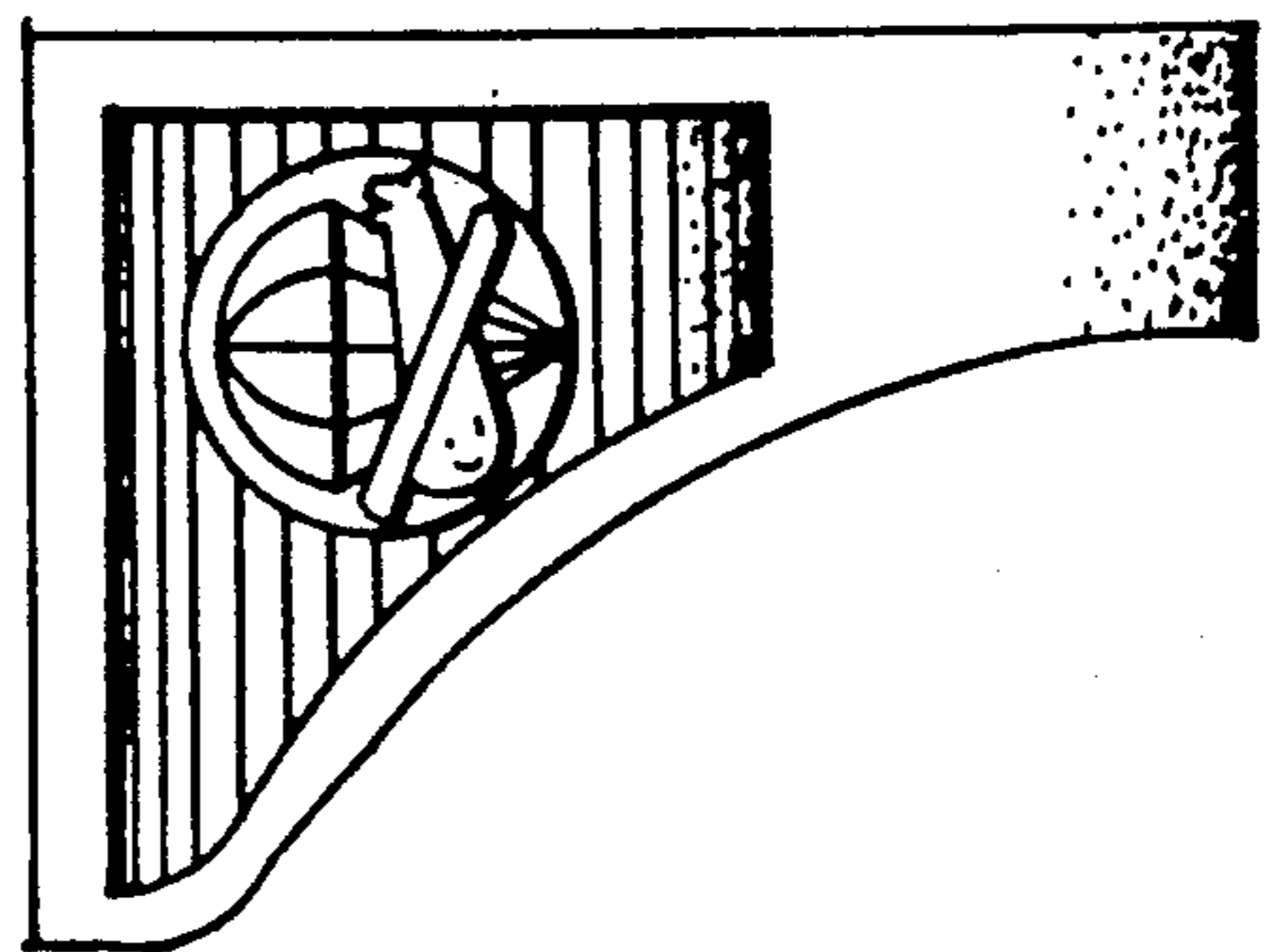
