

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spoiler for the rear deck of an automobile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a spoiler for the rear deck of an automobile showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is an enlarged rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is an enlarged front elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a greatly enlarged fragmentary top plan view of the left end thereof; FIG. 6 is a greatly enlarged left end elevation view thereof; FIG. 7 is a side elevation view of FIG. 5 opposite to that shown in FIG. 6; FIG. 8 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 5; and FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of FIG. 5. The broken line showing of a fragmentary portion of an automobile in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
















