[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tape player, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right-side perspective view of a tape player, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof, shown with cassette cover in the open position; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof, shown with belt holder removed; FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof.

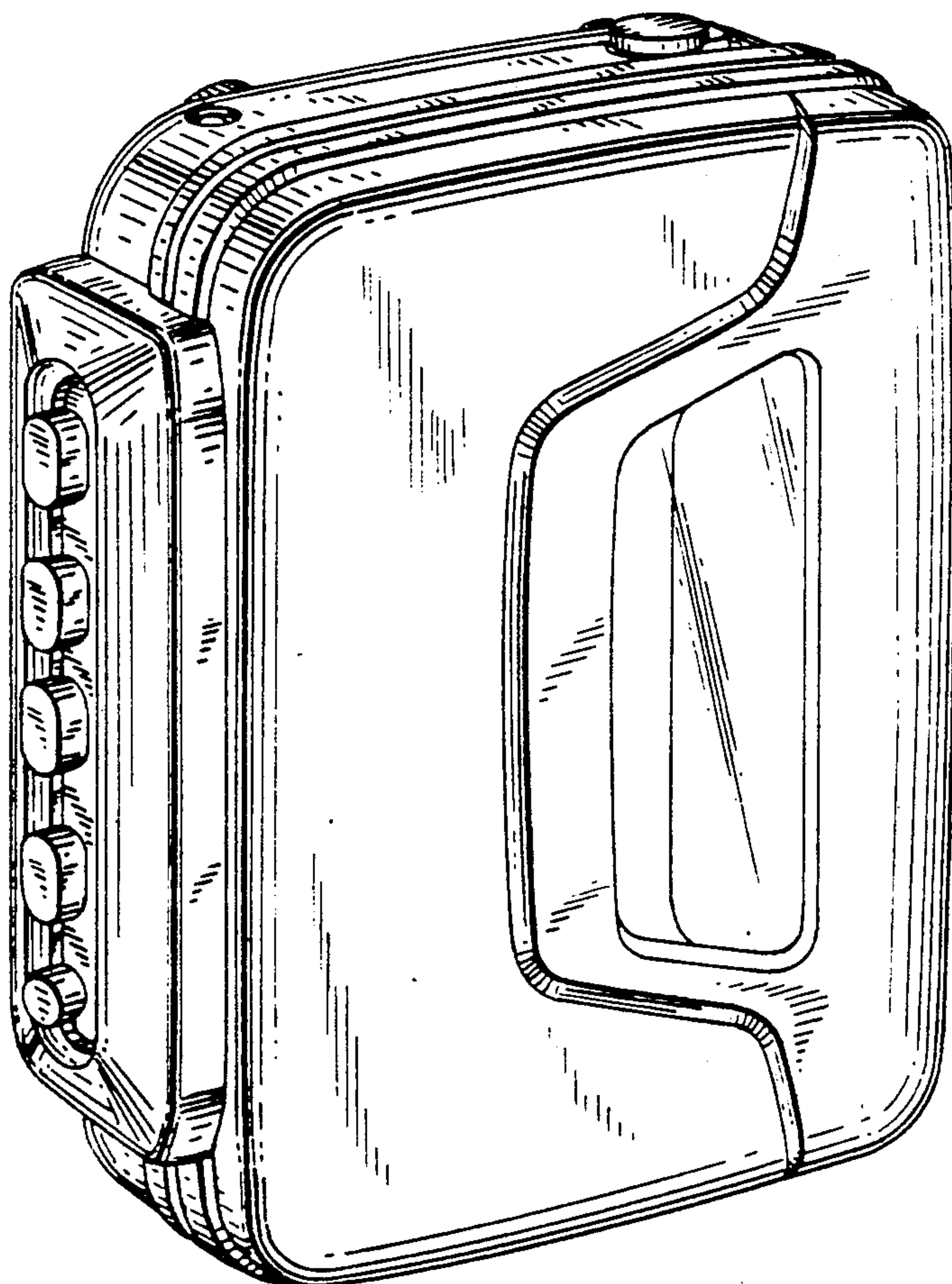
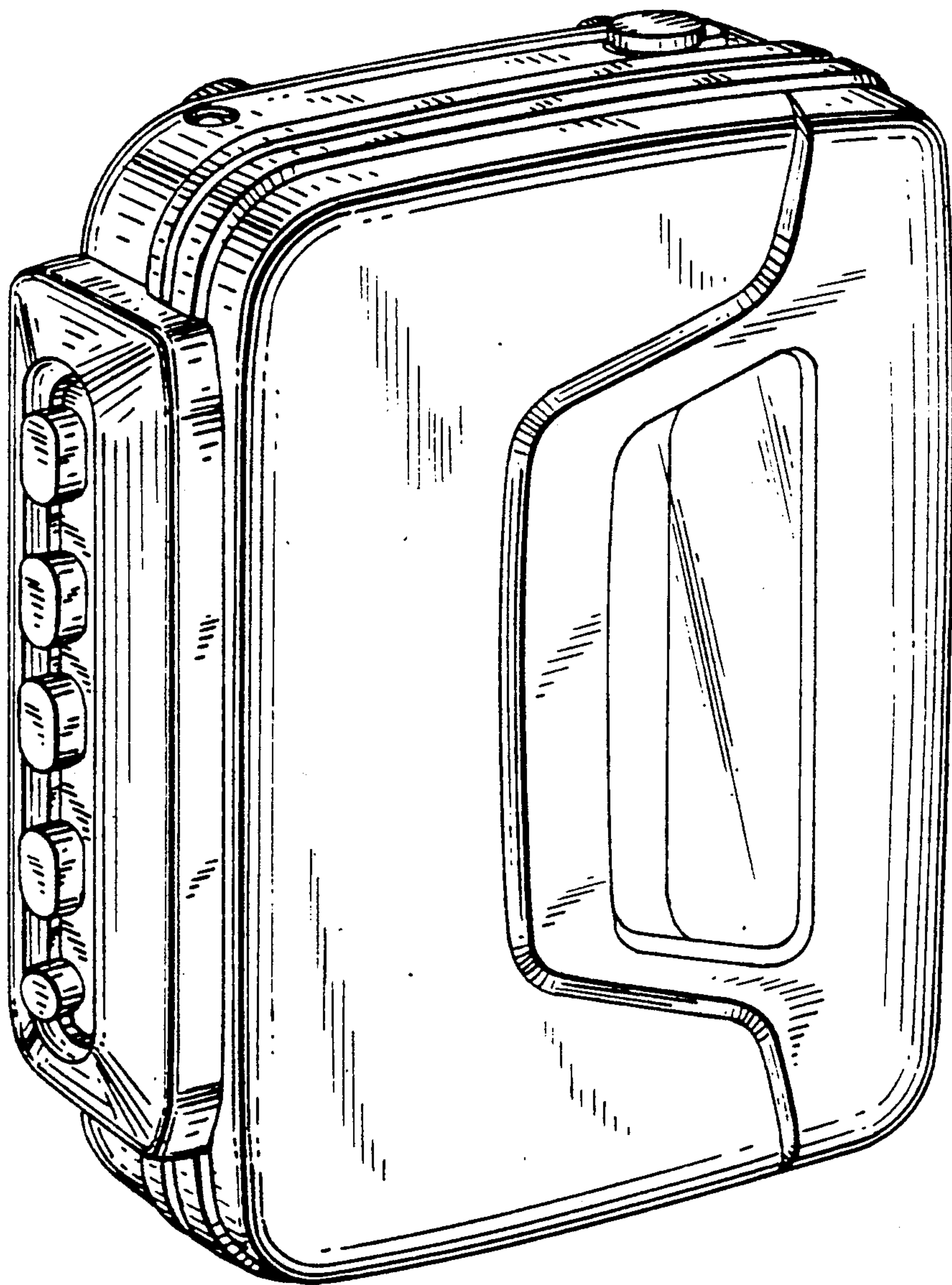

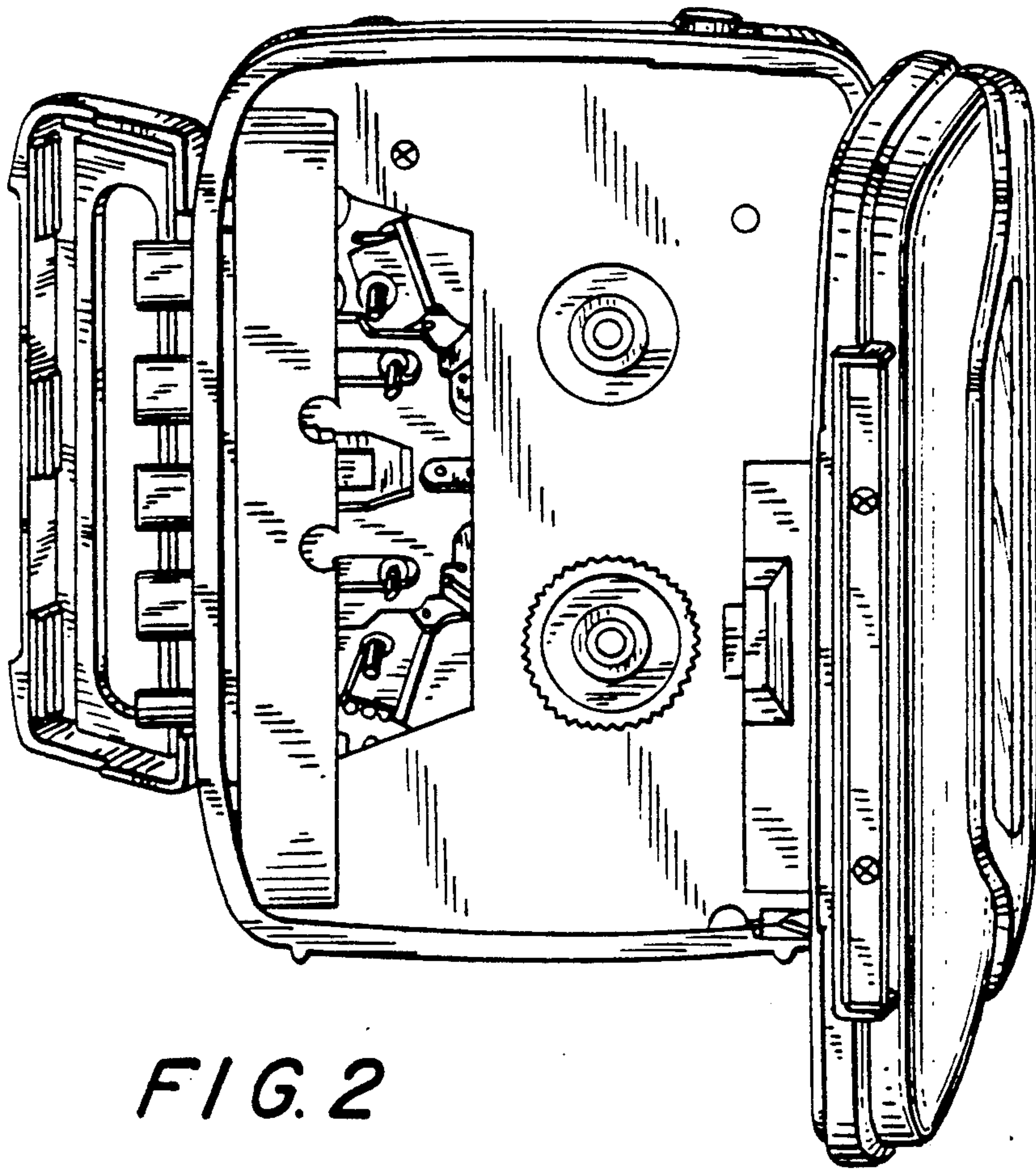

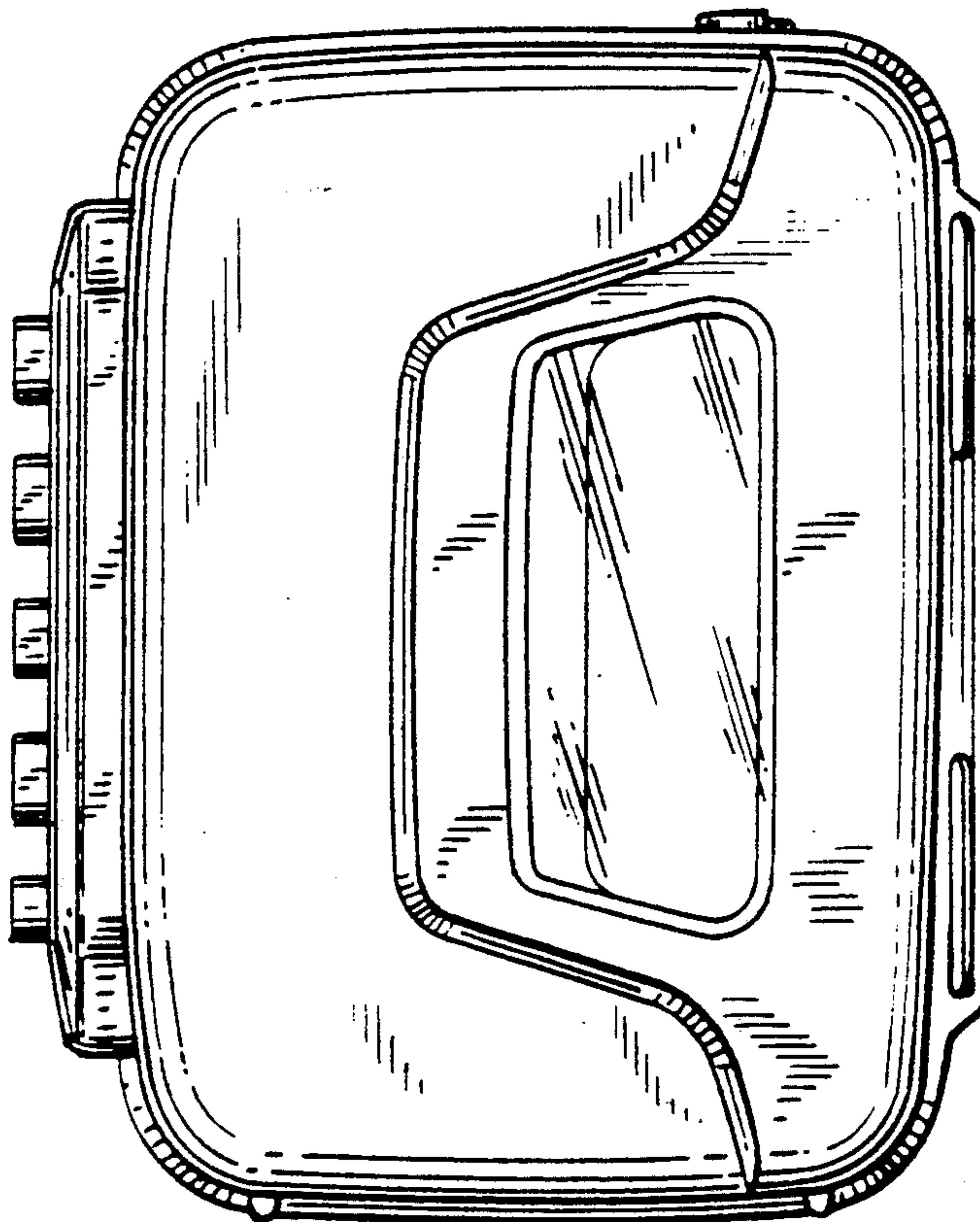

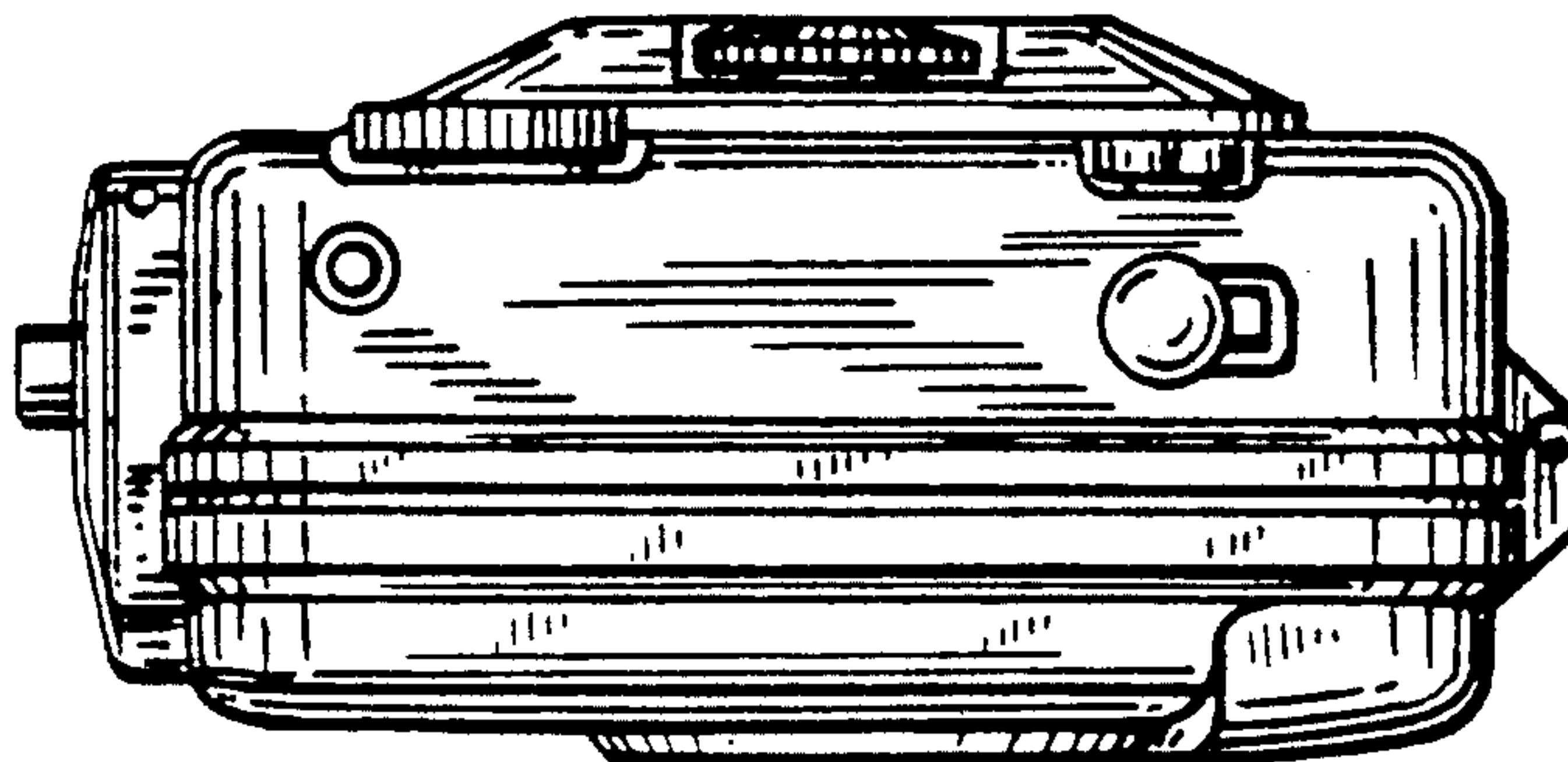

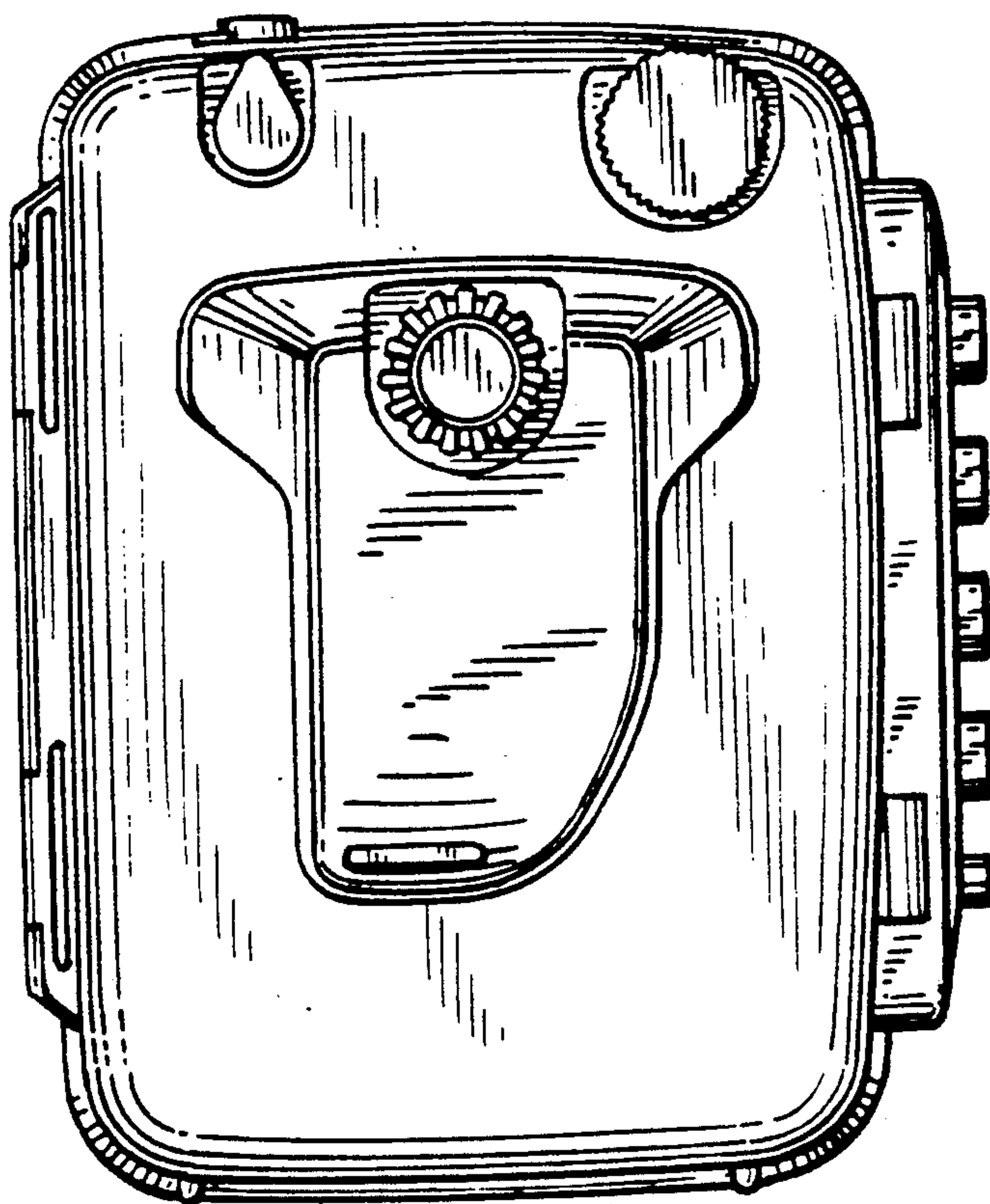

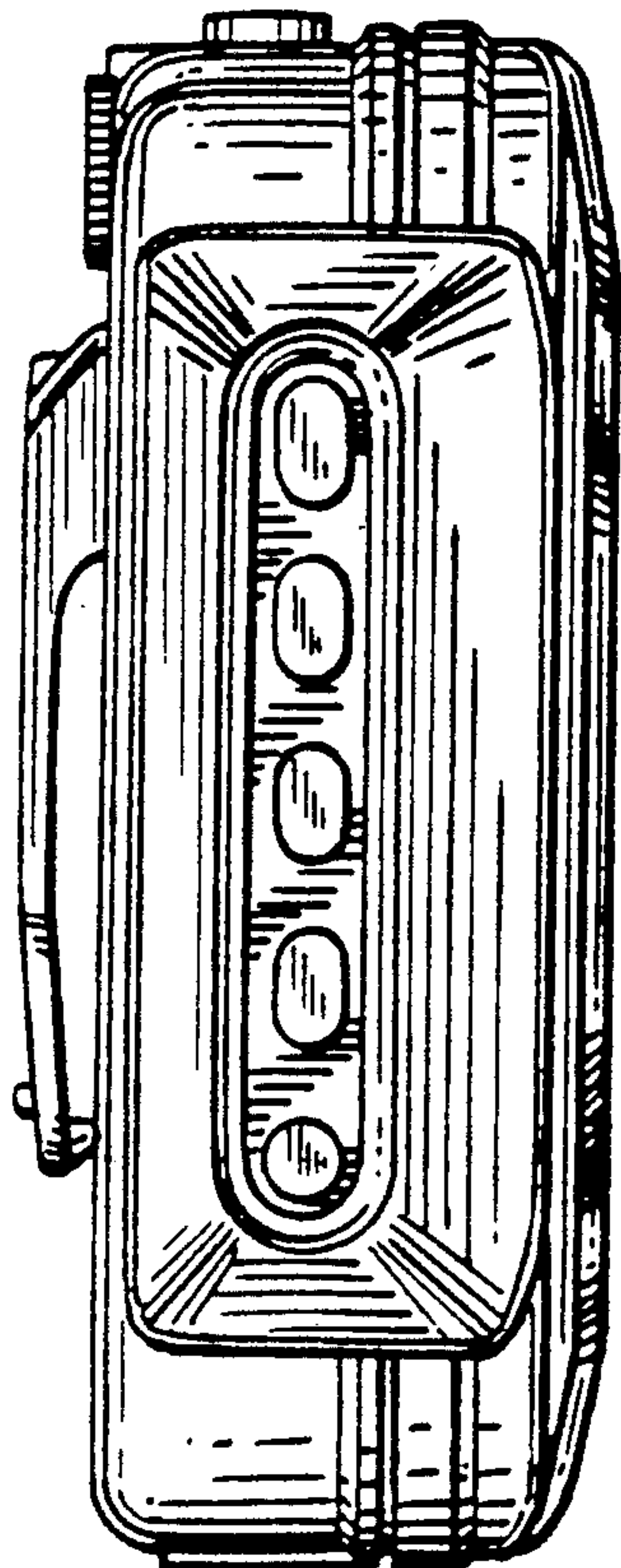
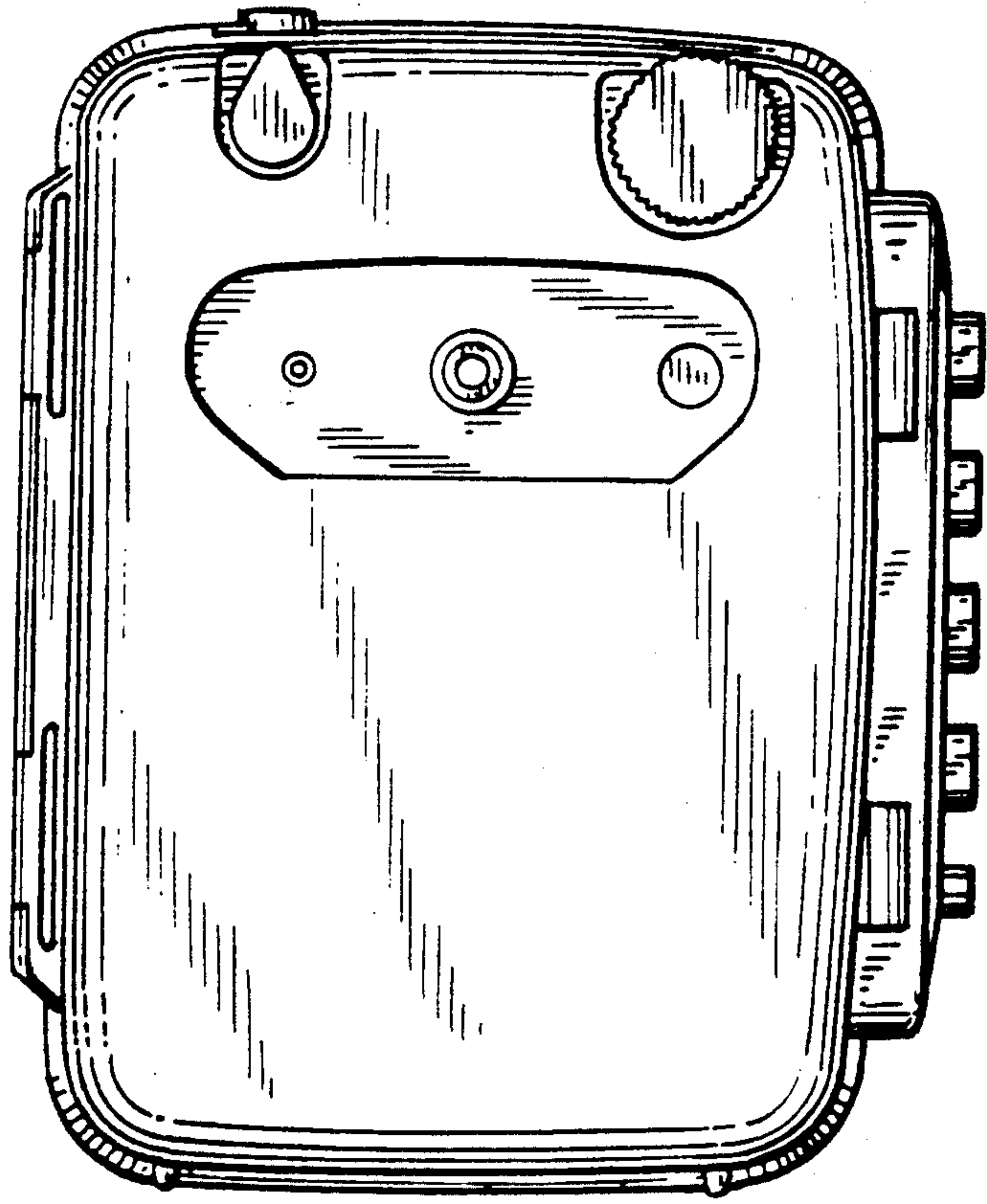

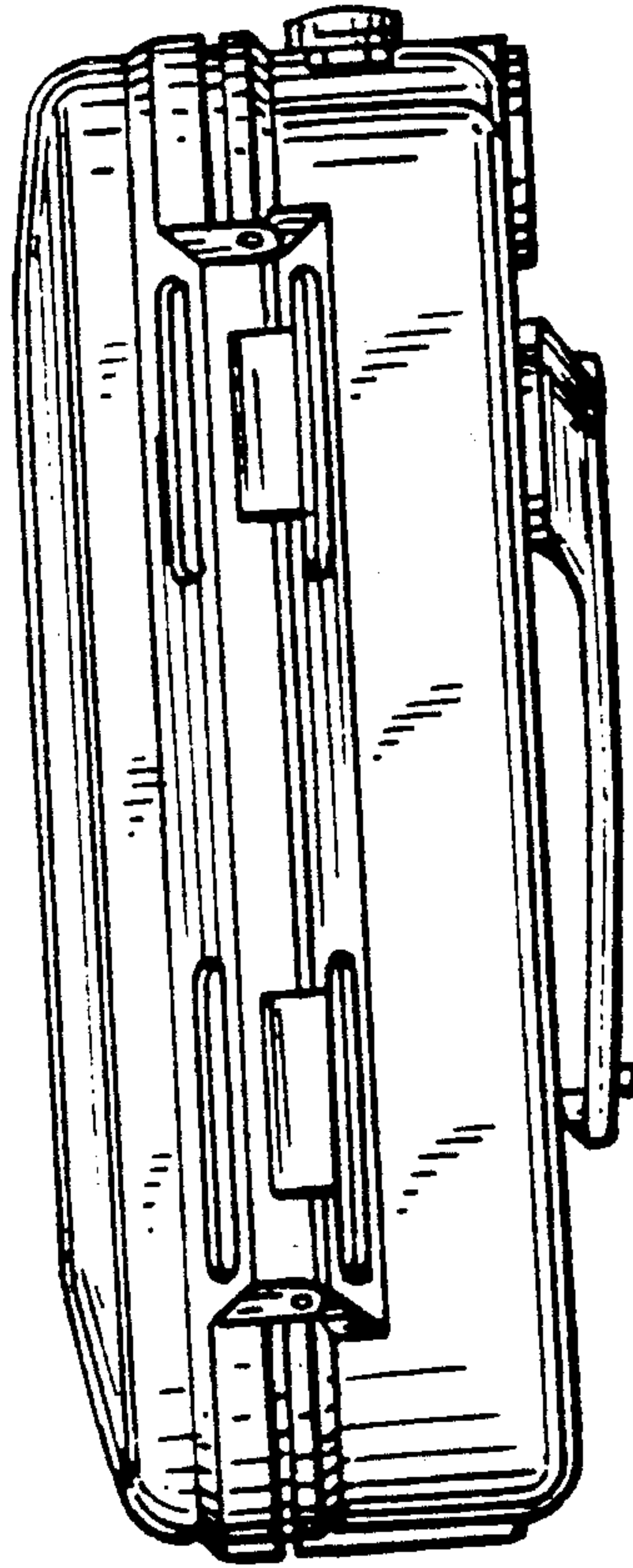
