The ornamental design for a housing for a television monitor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a housing for a television monitor showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

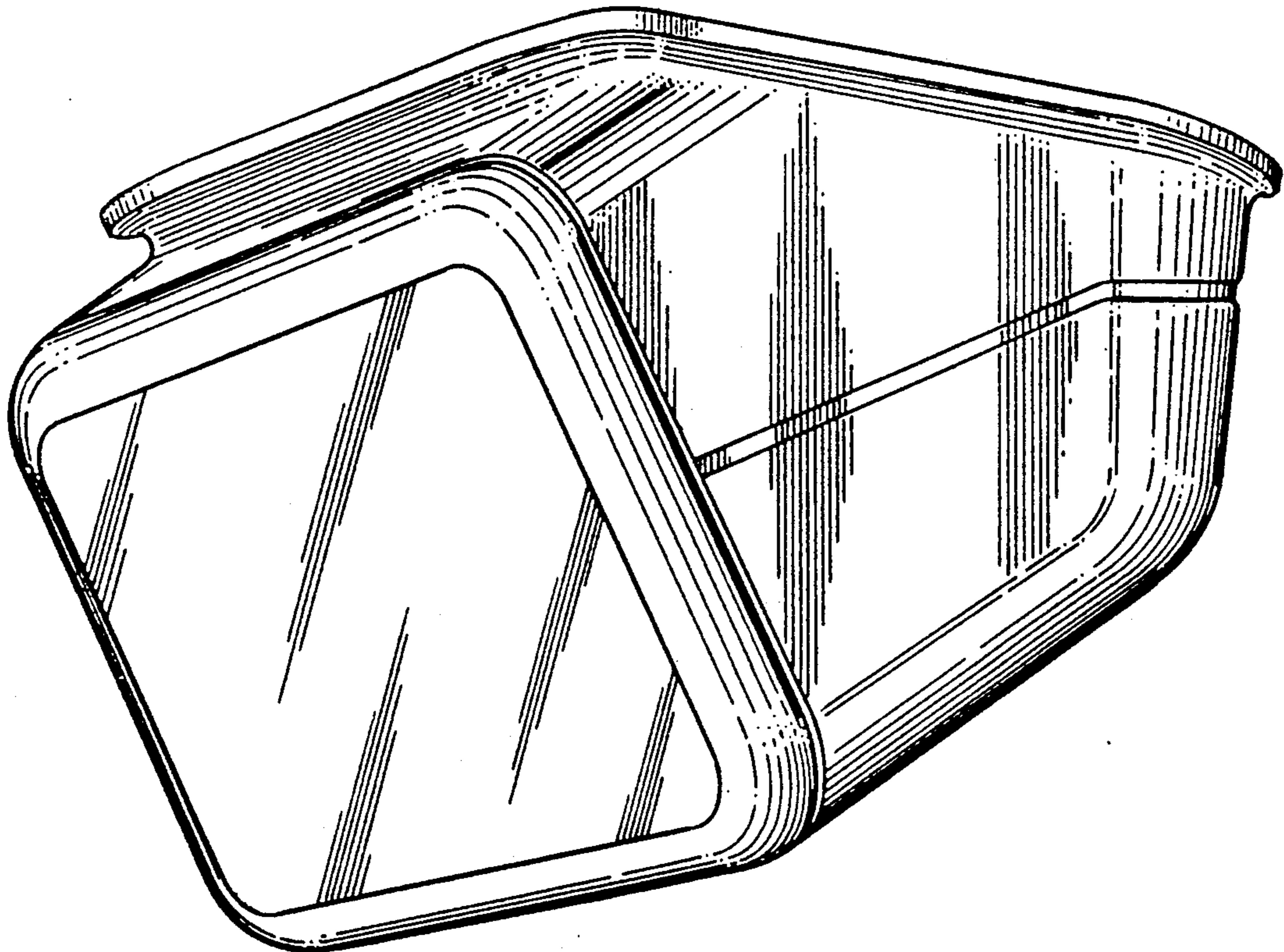

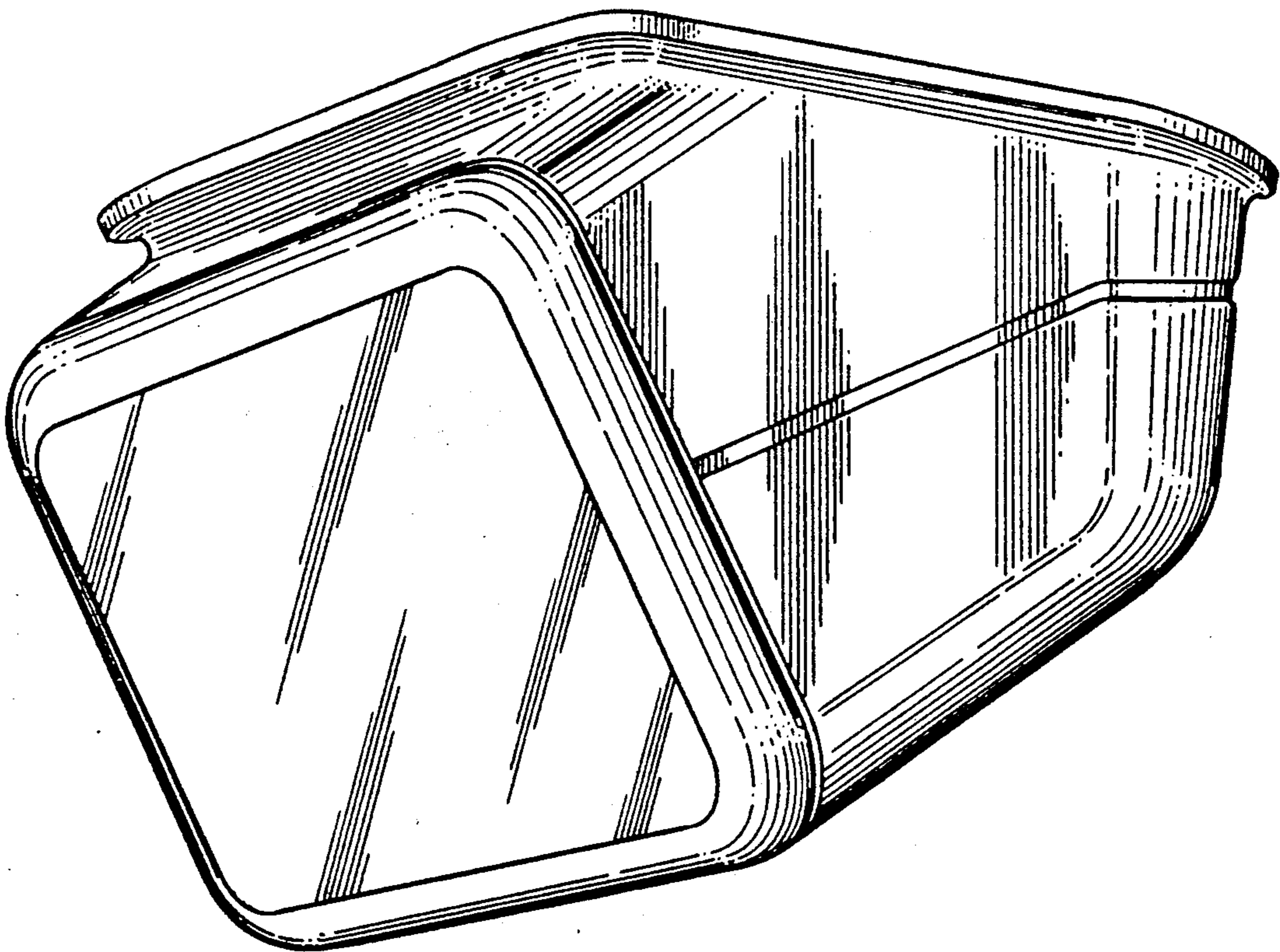

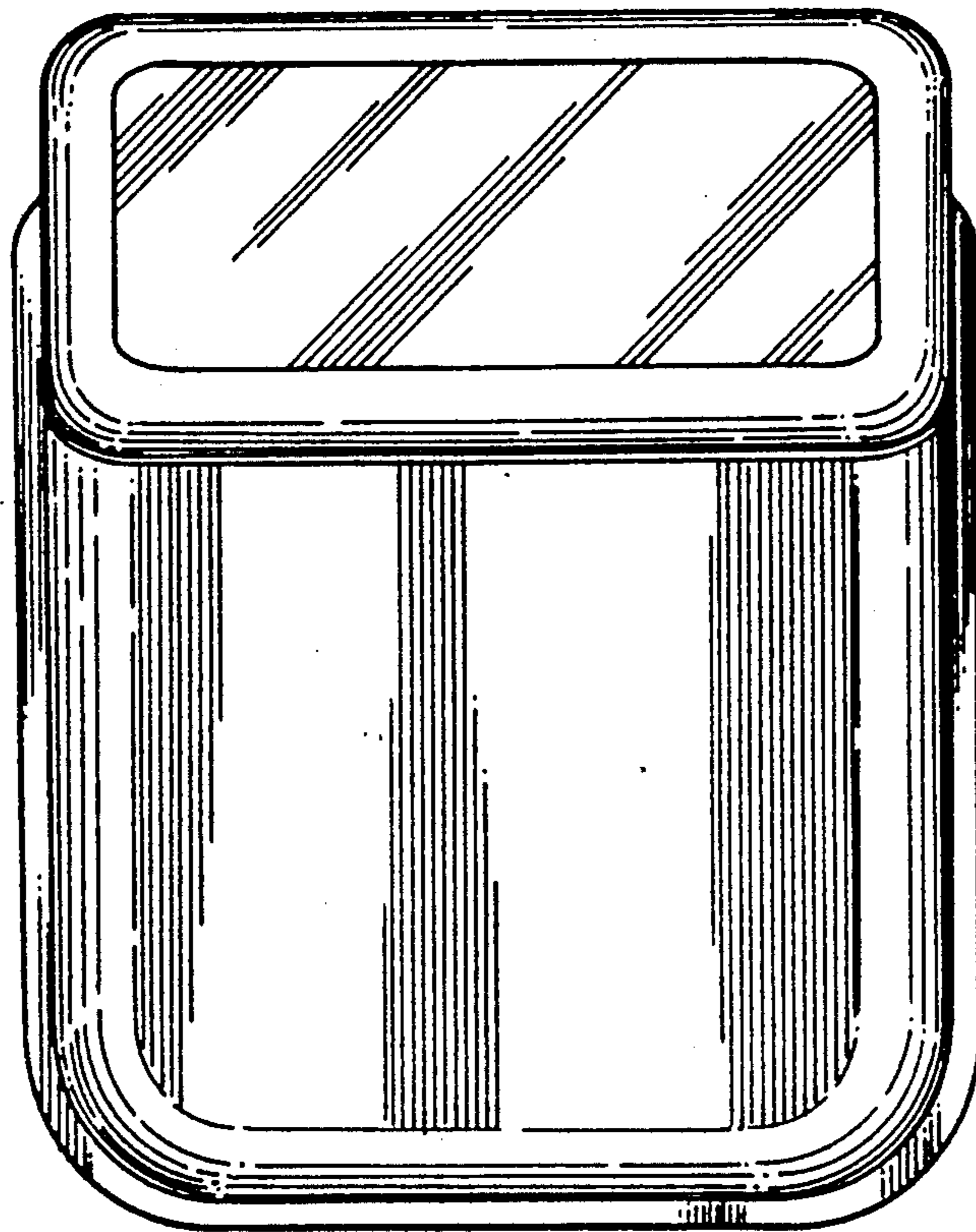
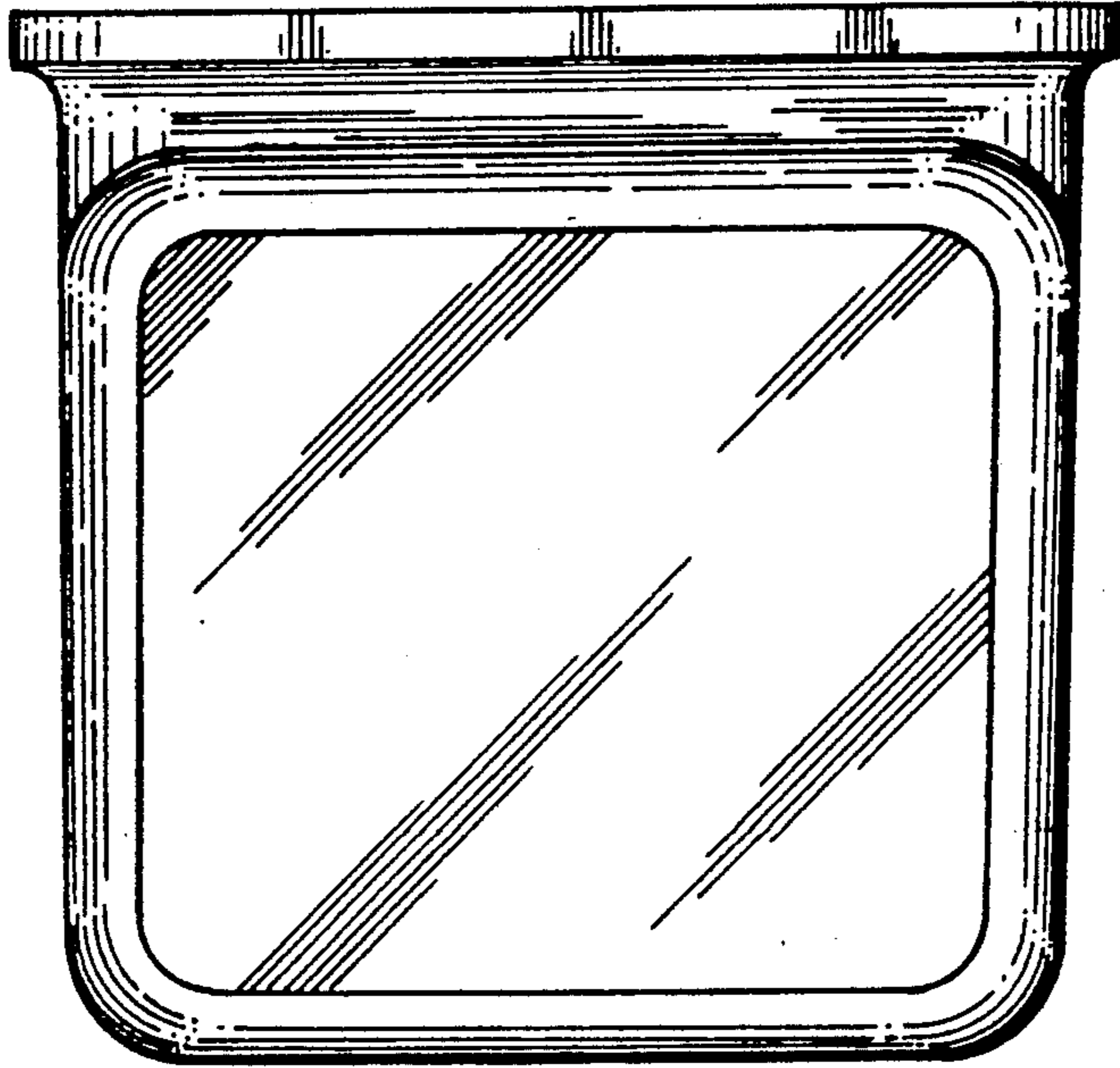

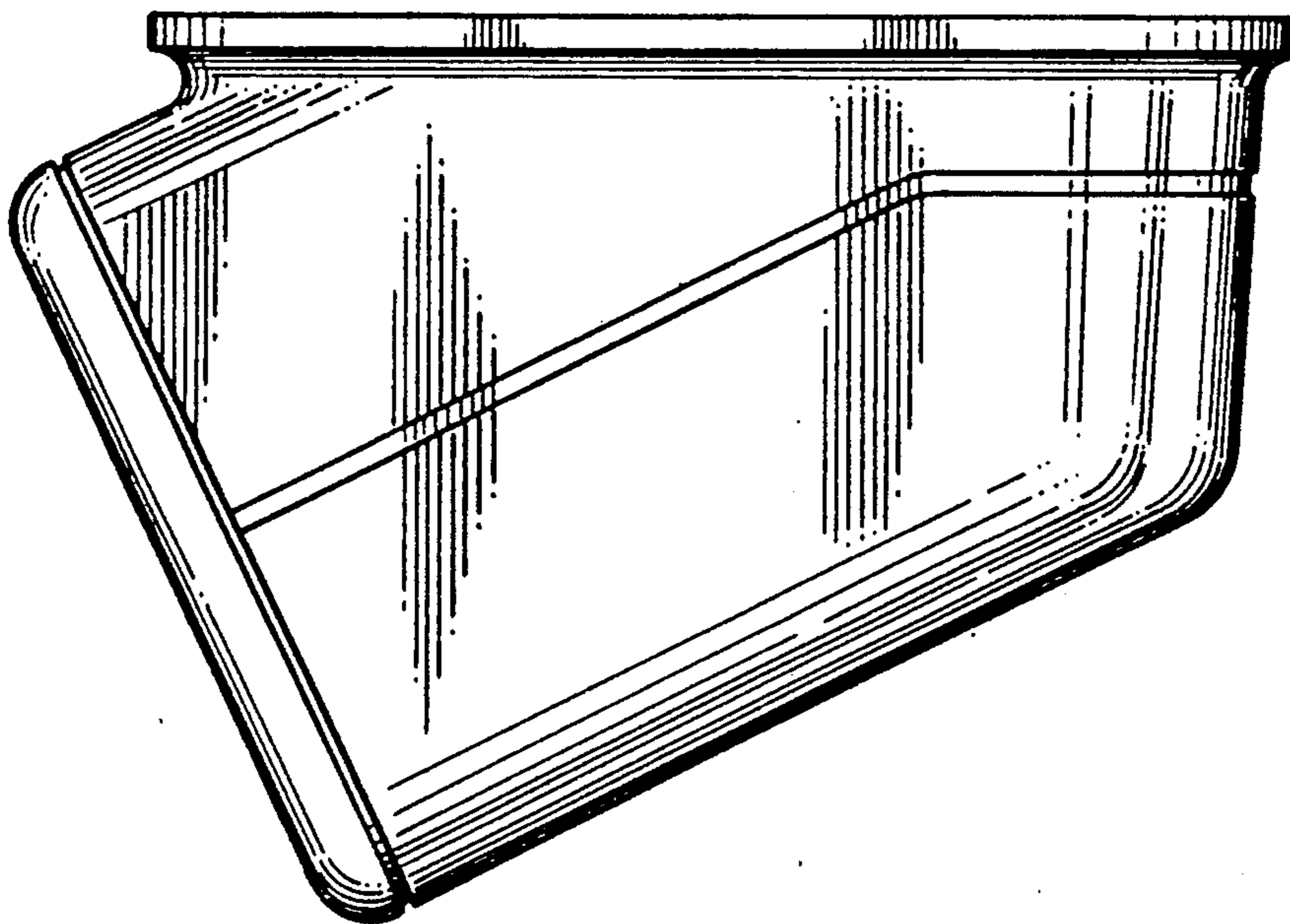
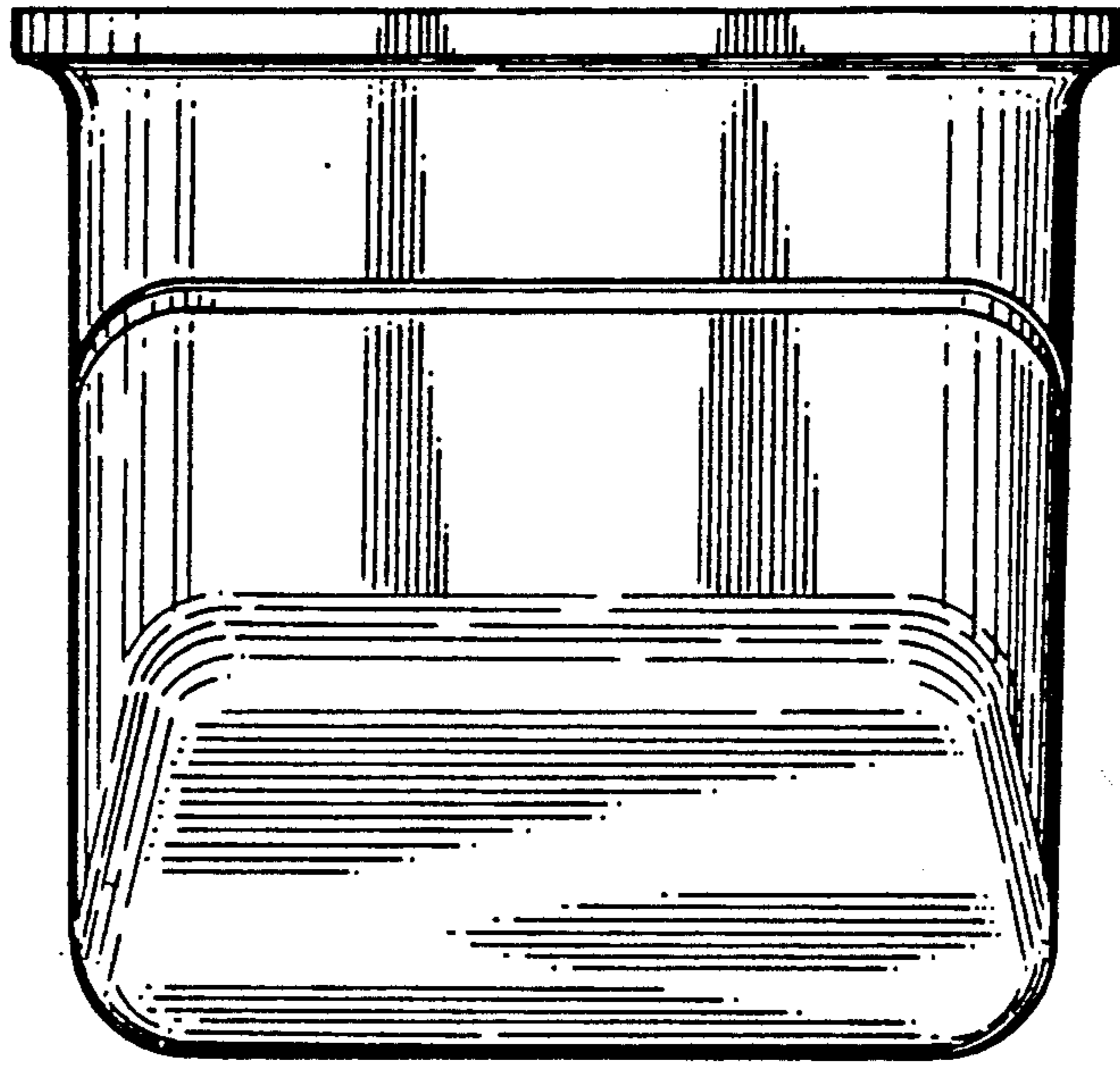
