[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pop-up strobe autofocus camera or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a pop-up strobe autofocus camera or similar article showing my new design with its flash module in the extended position;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

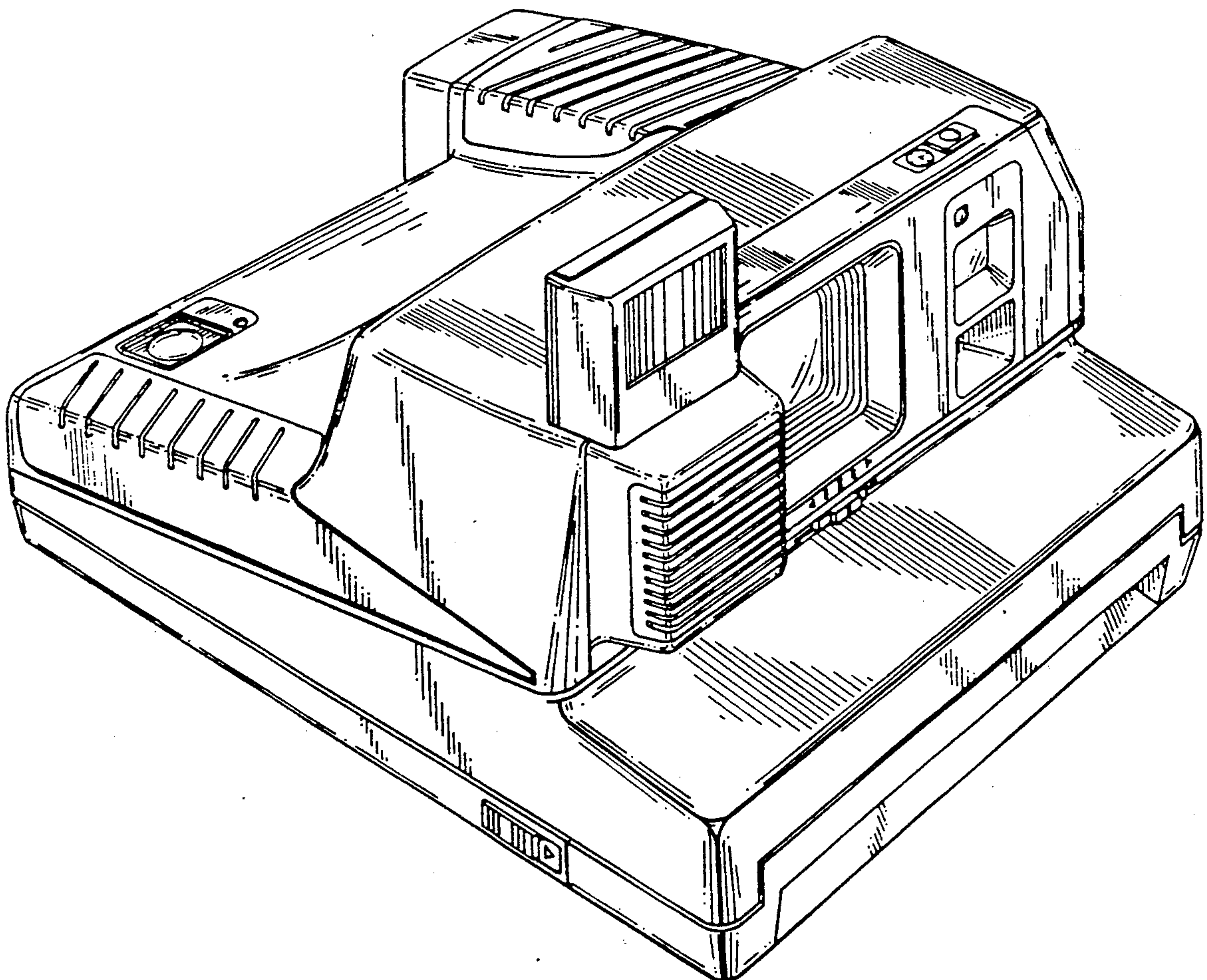
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof with its flash module in the stored position.



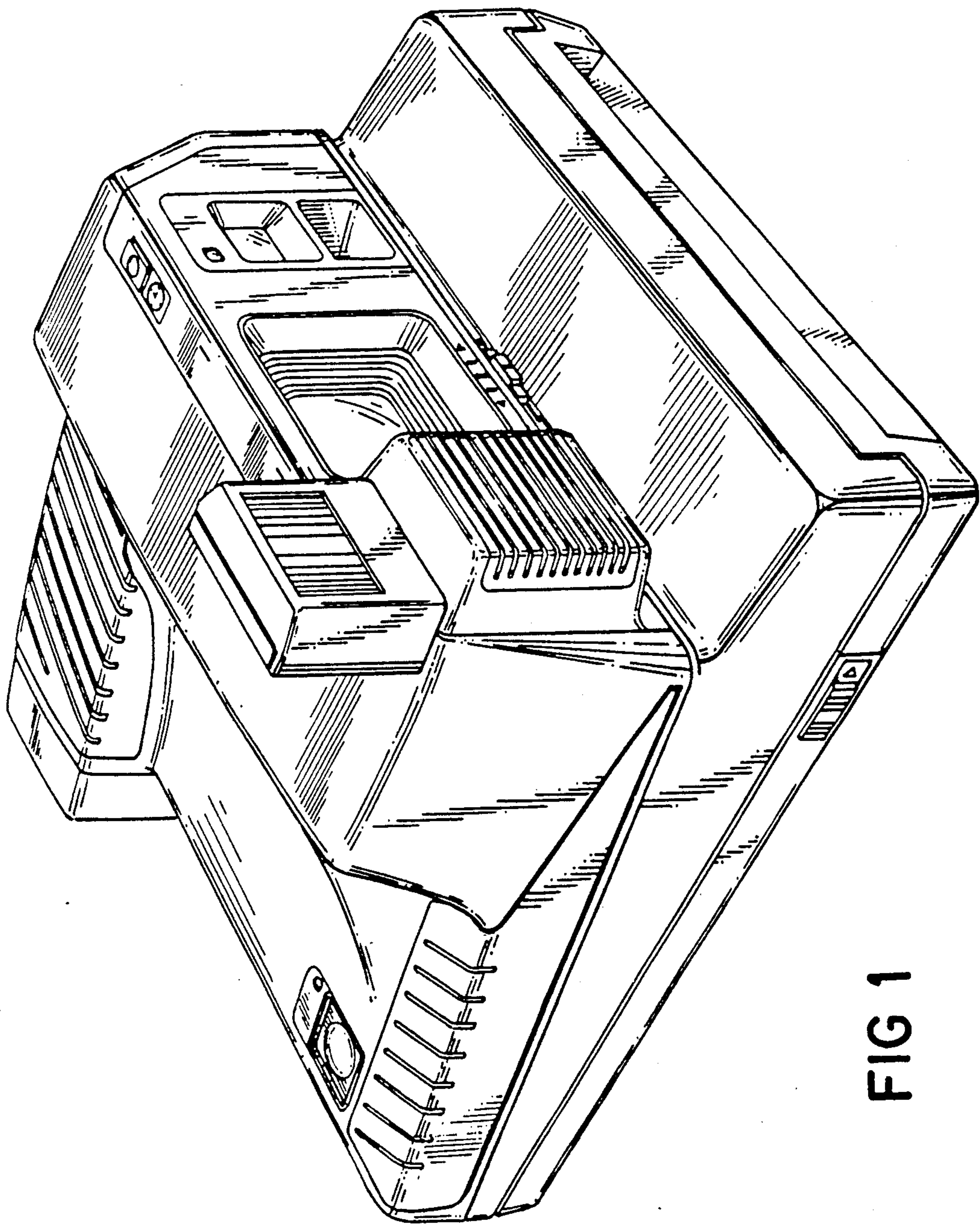

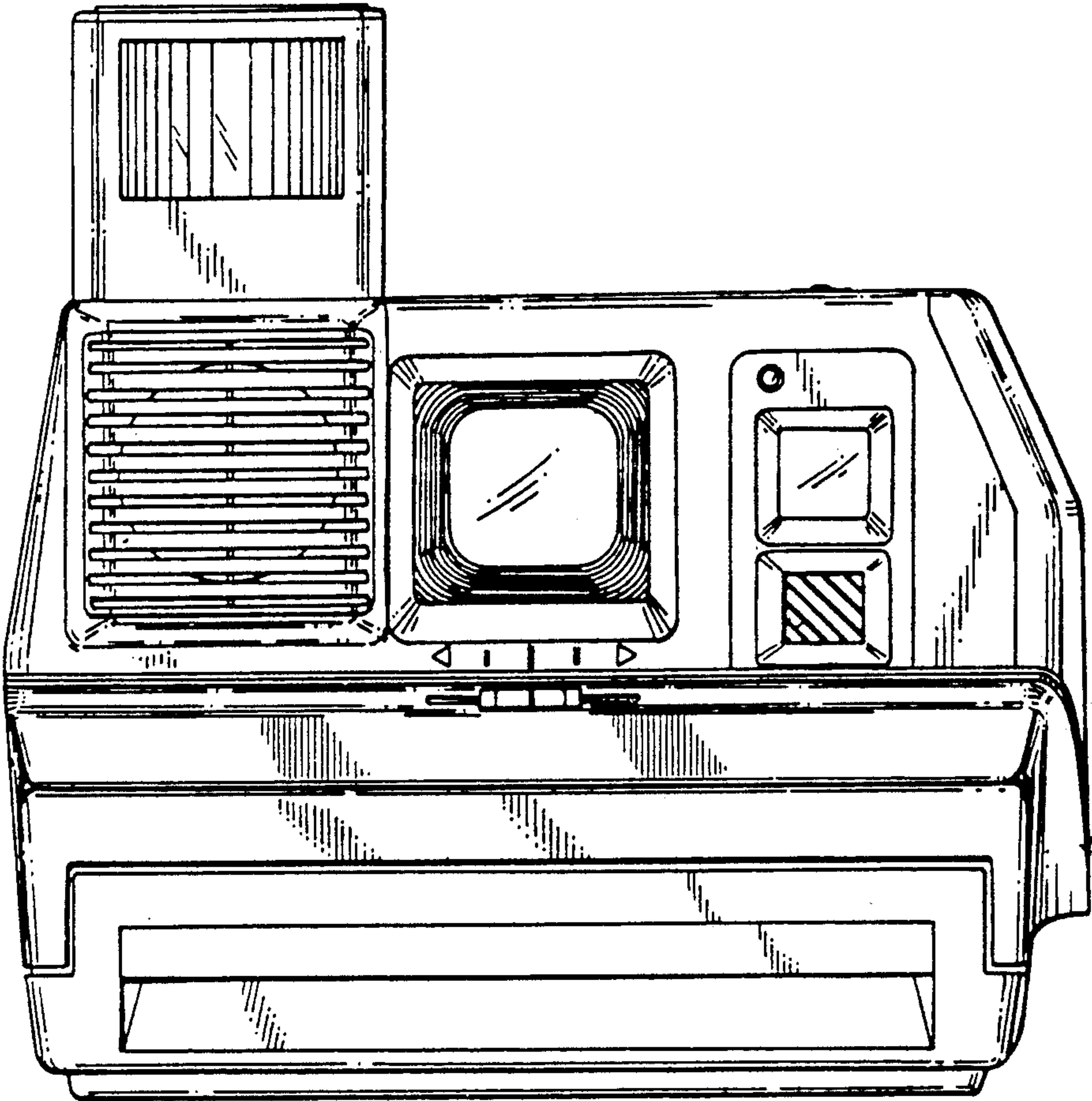

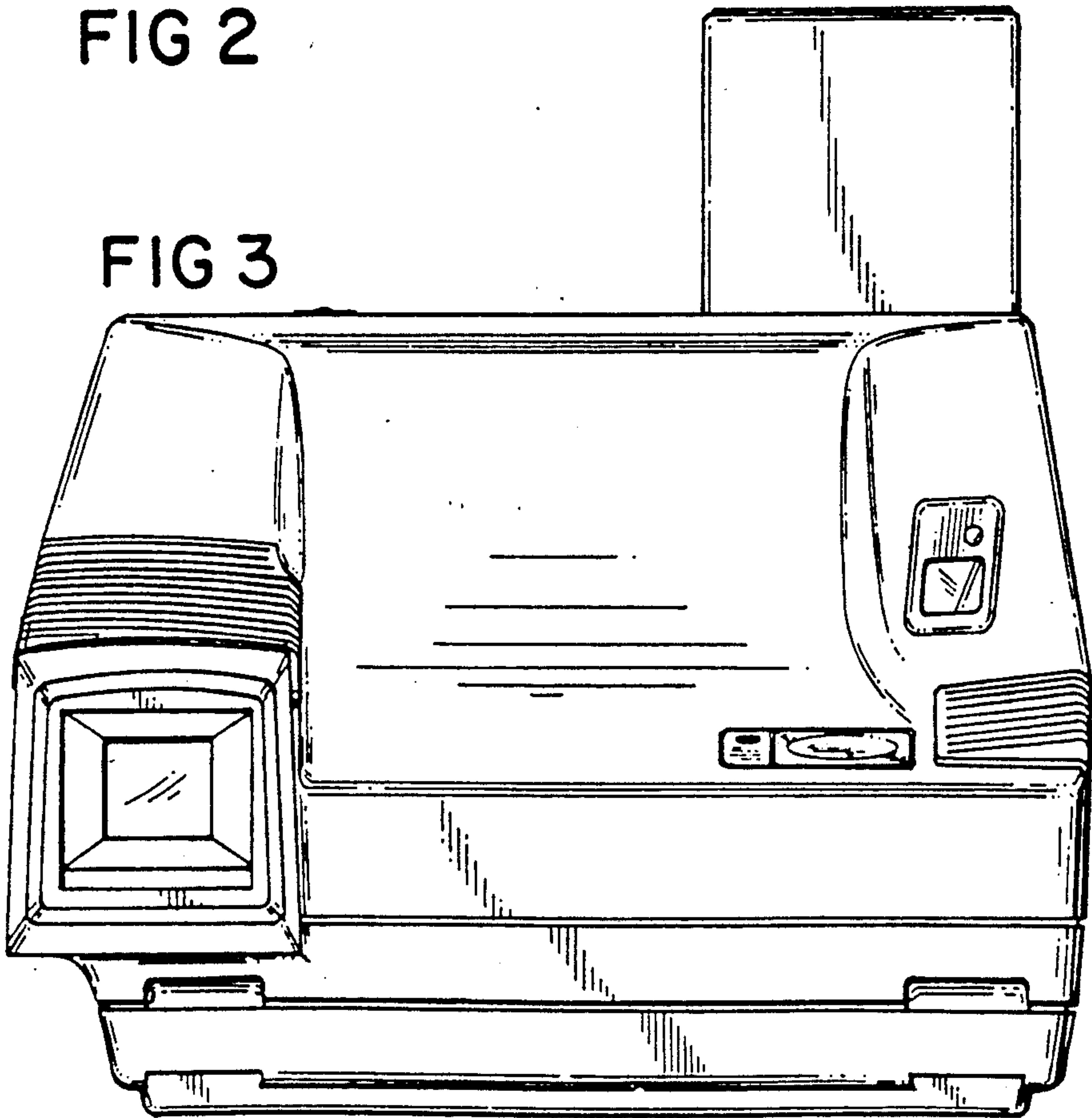

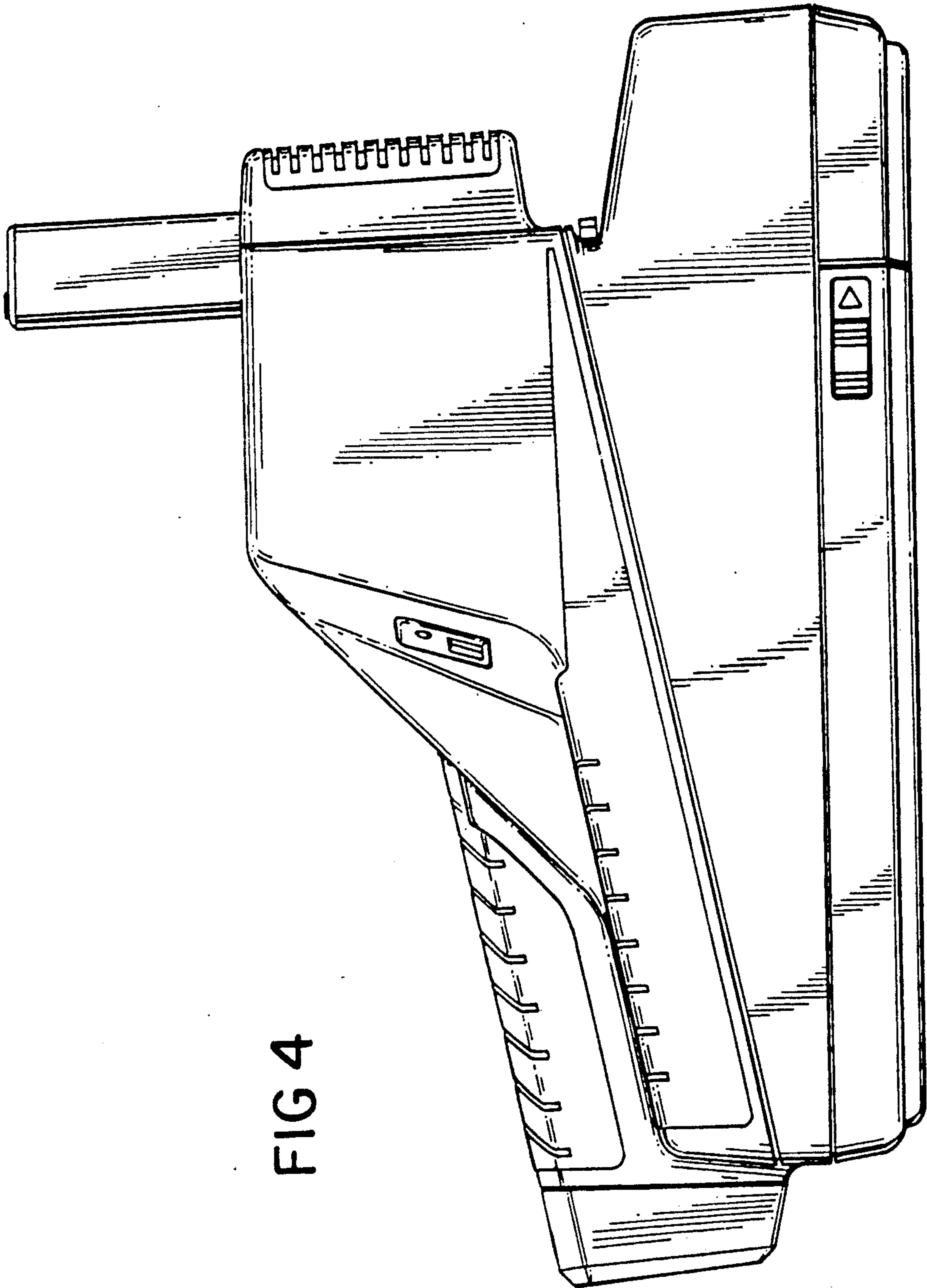

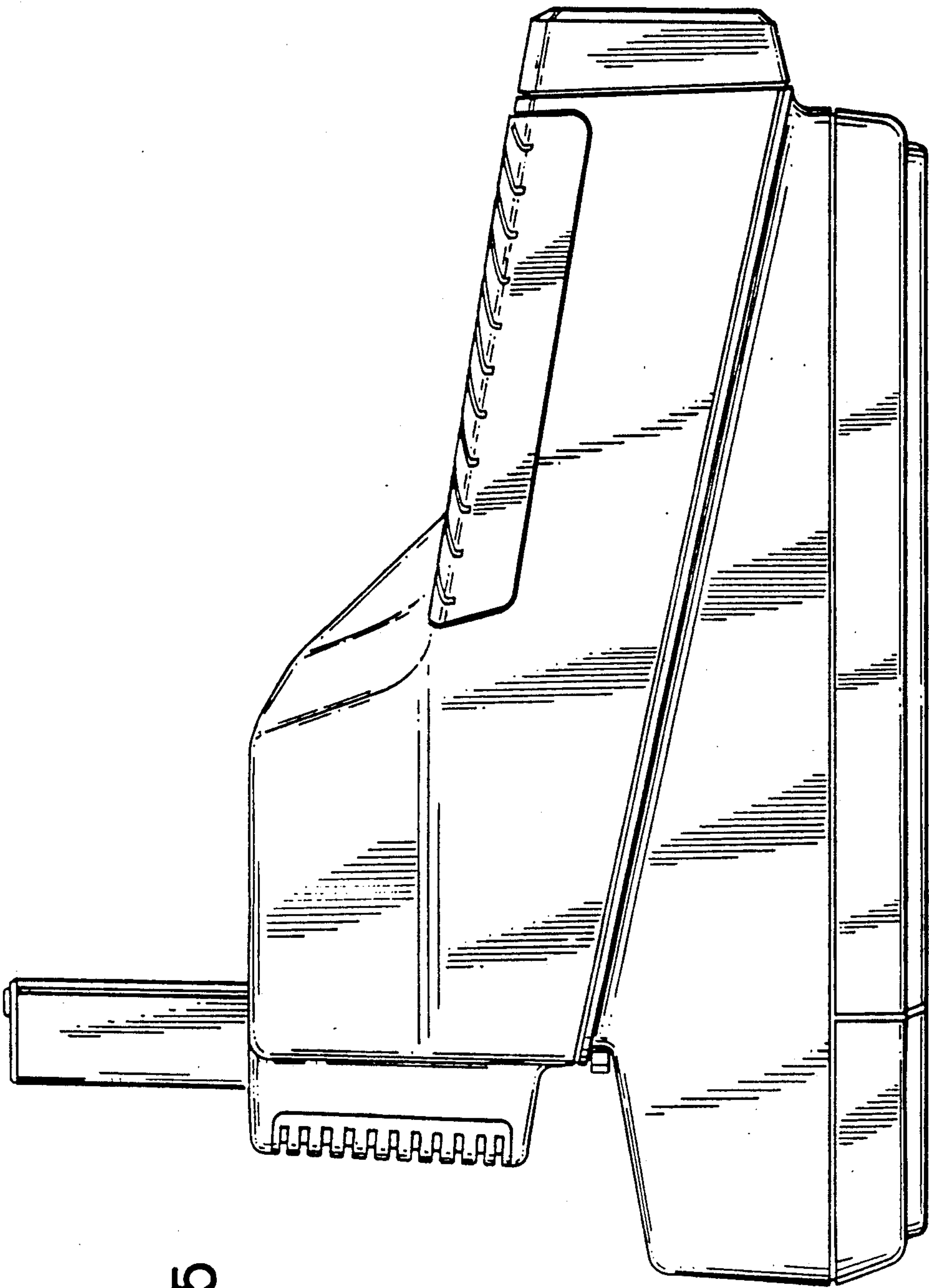

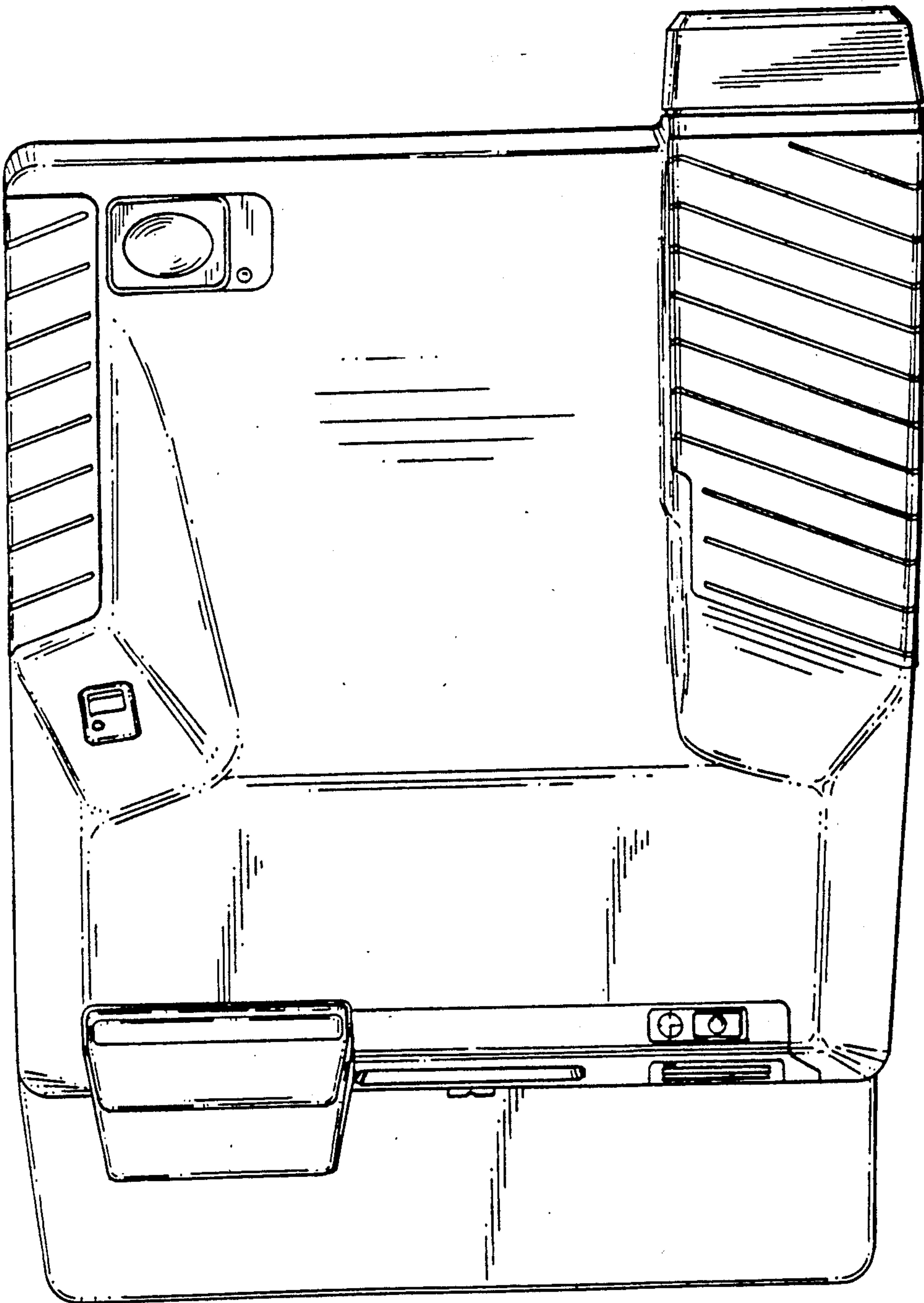

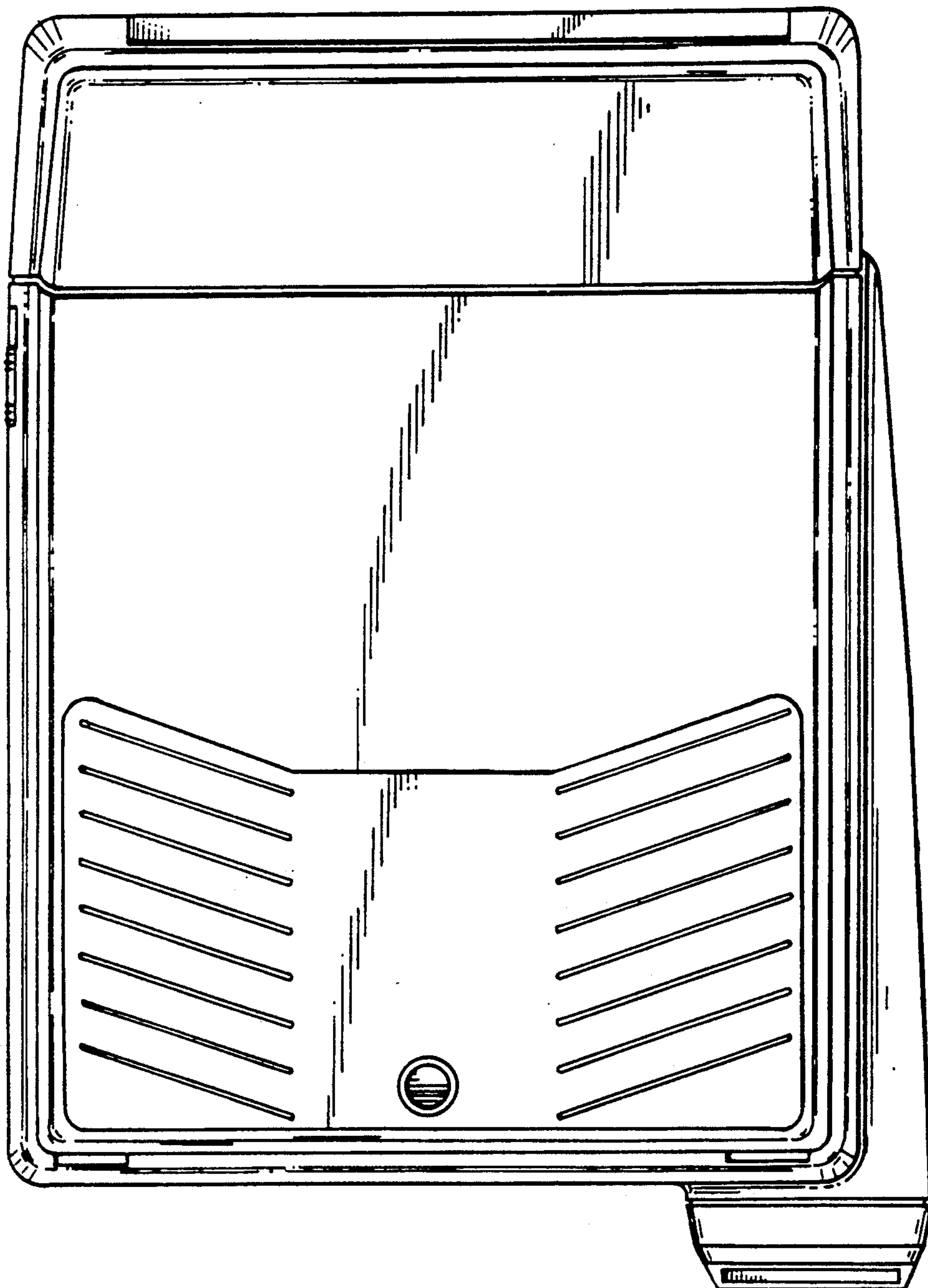

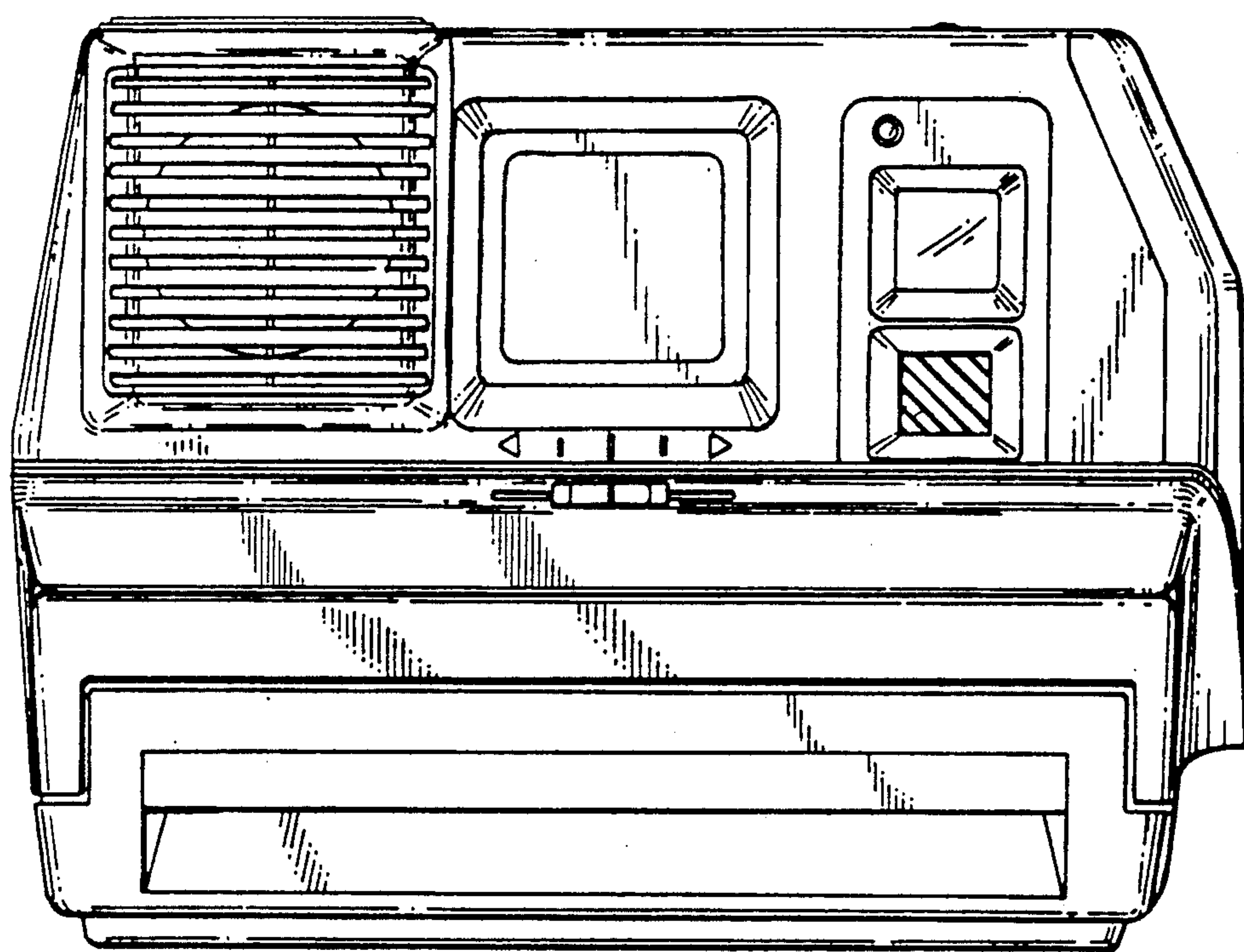
