FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

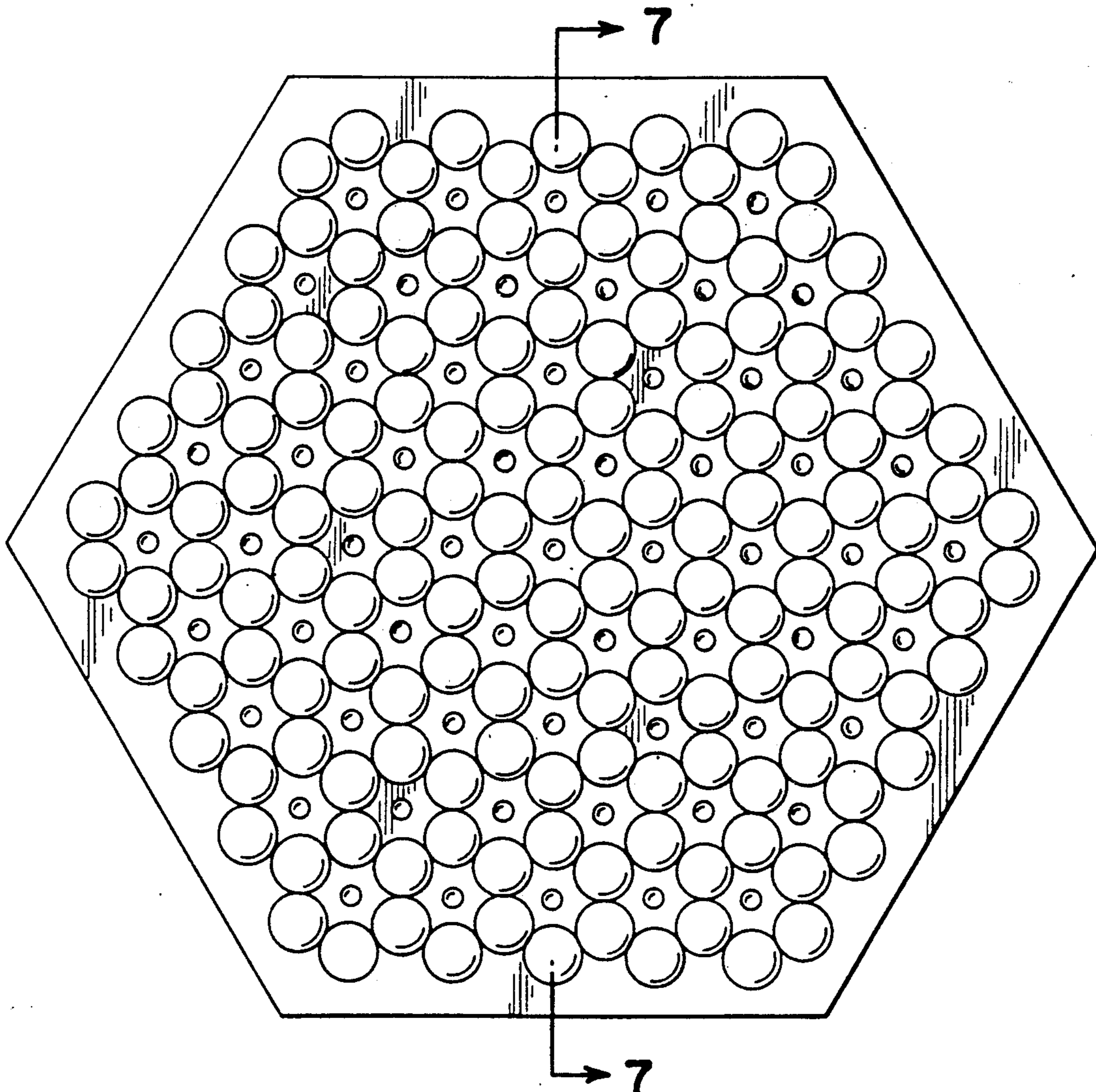
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view thereof, taken along line A—A in FIG. 1.



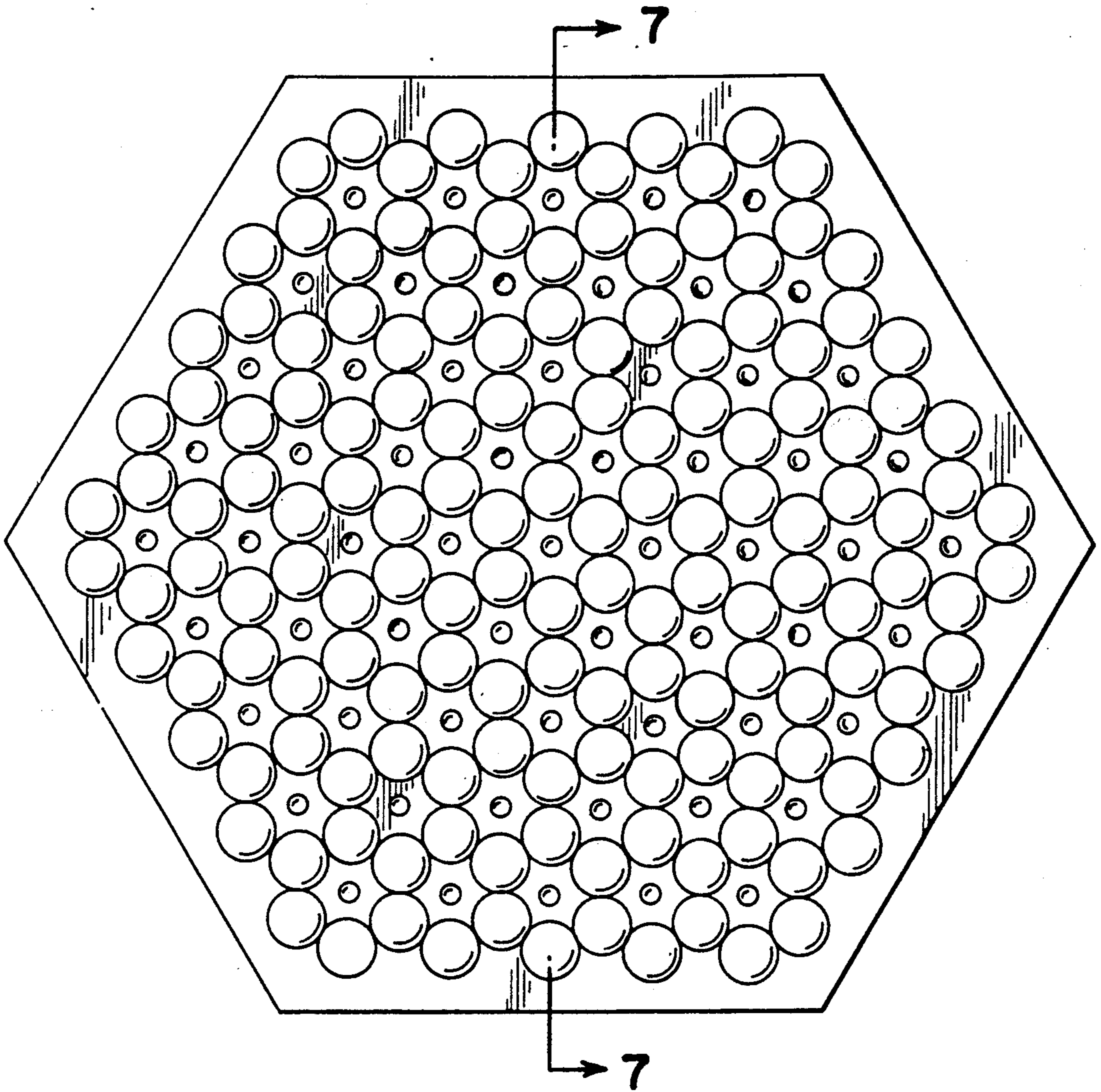

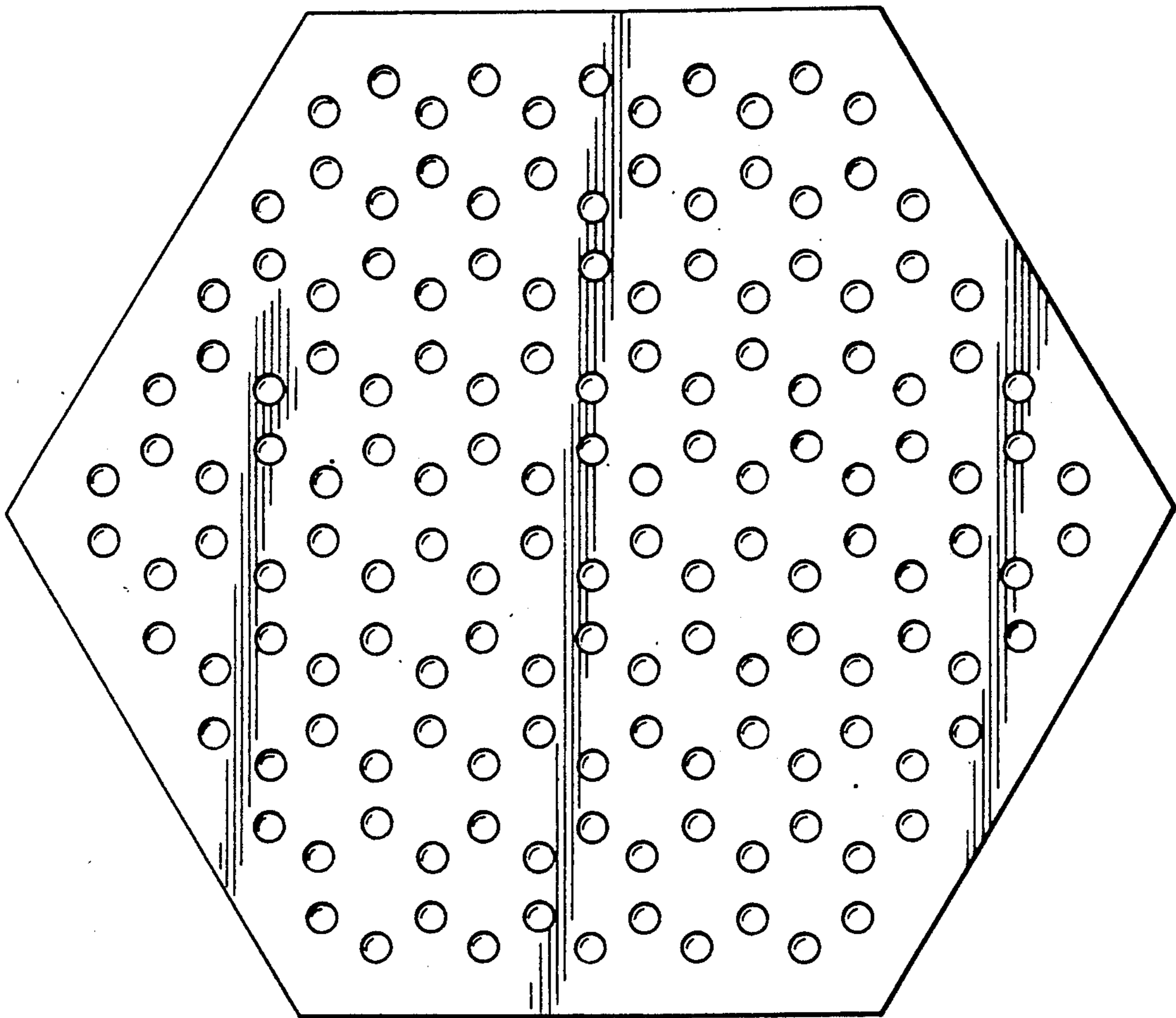
