DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined fishhook and bait holder, showing my new design;

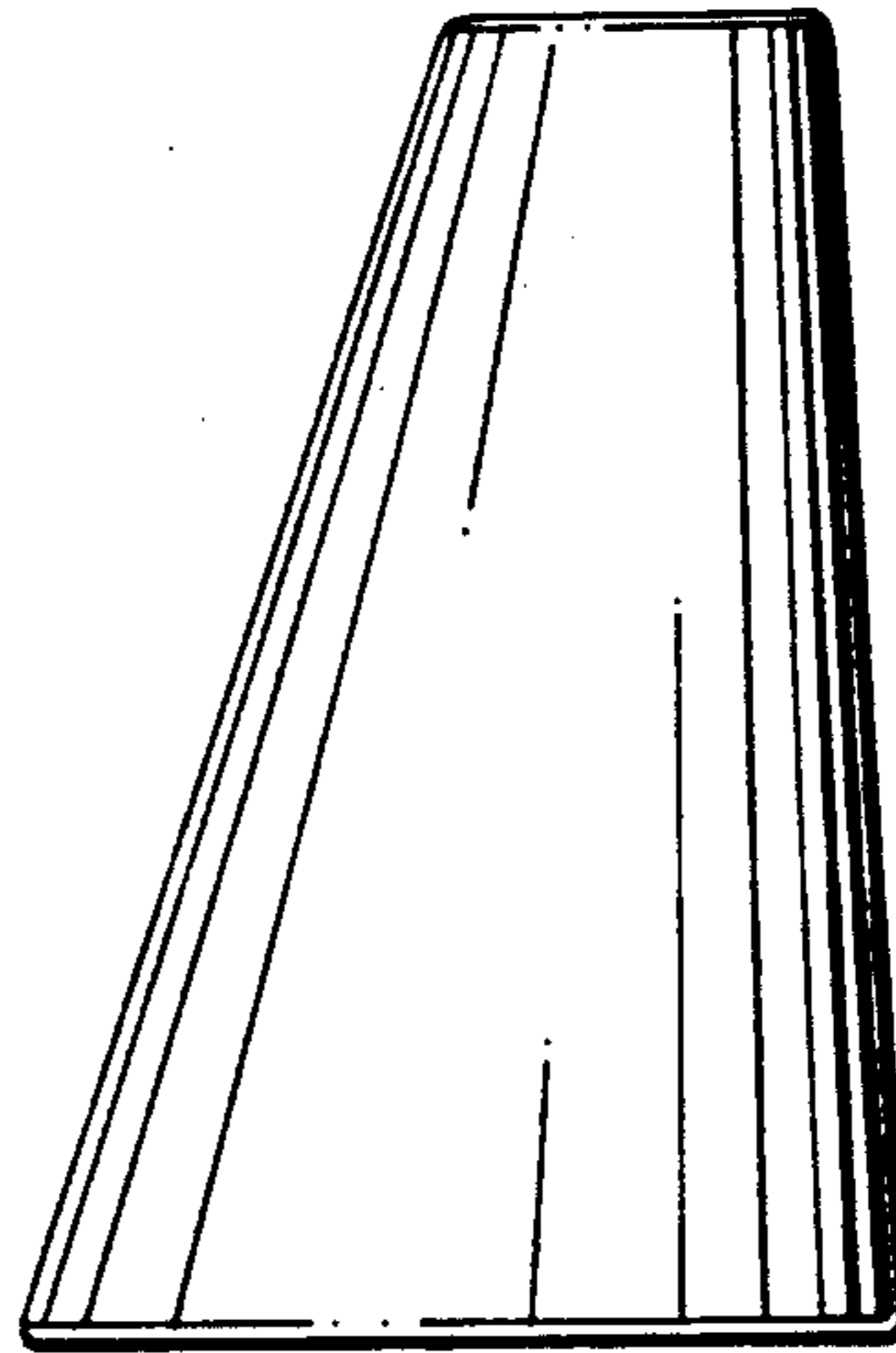

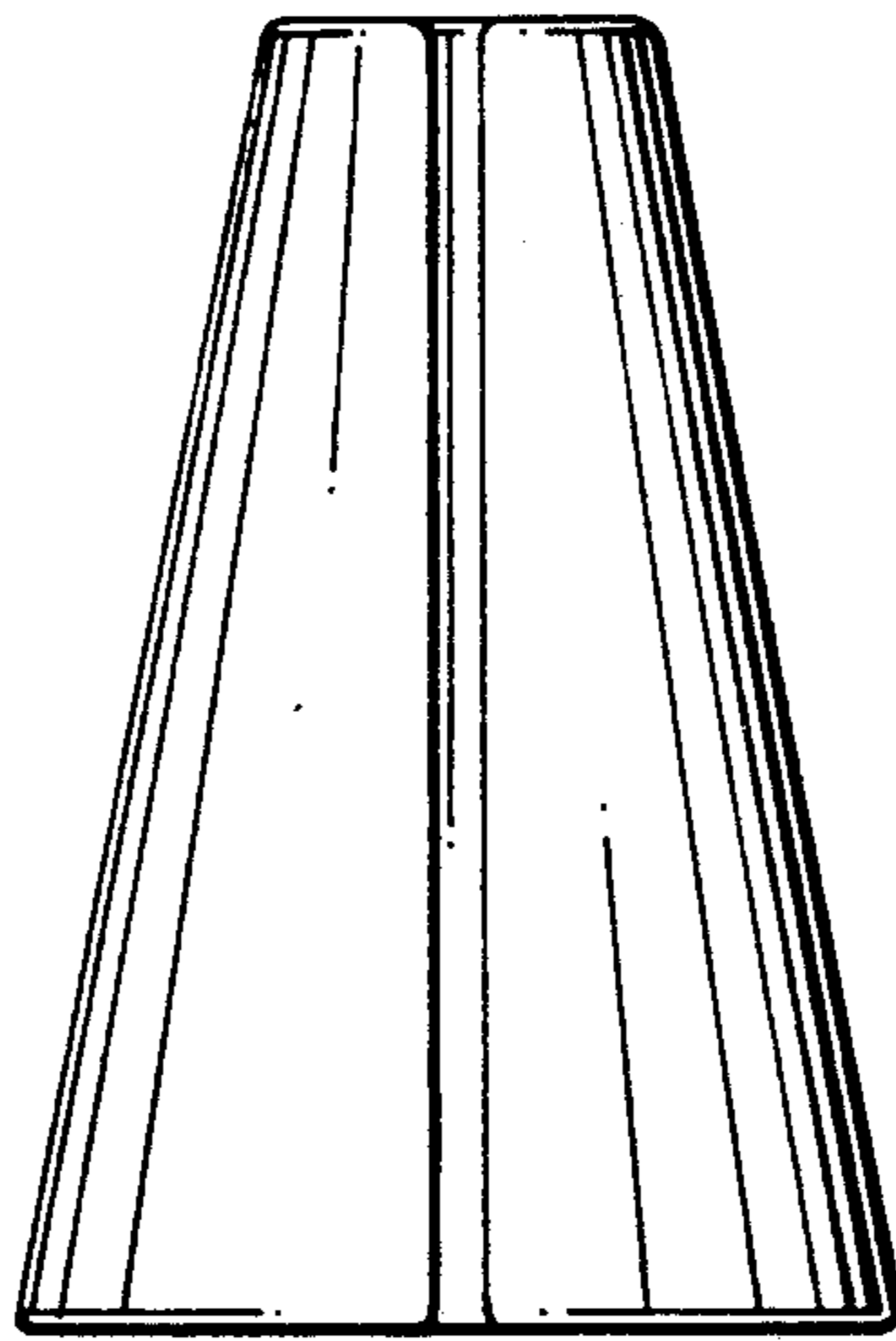

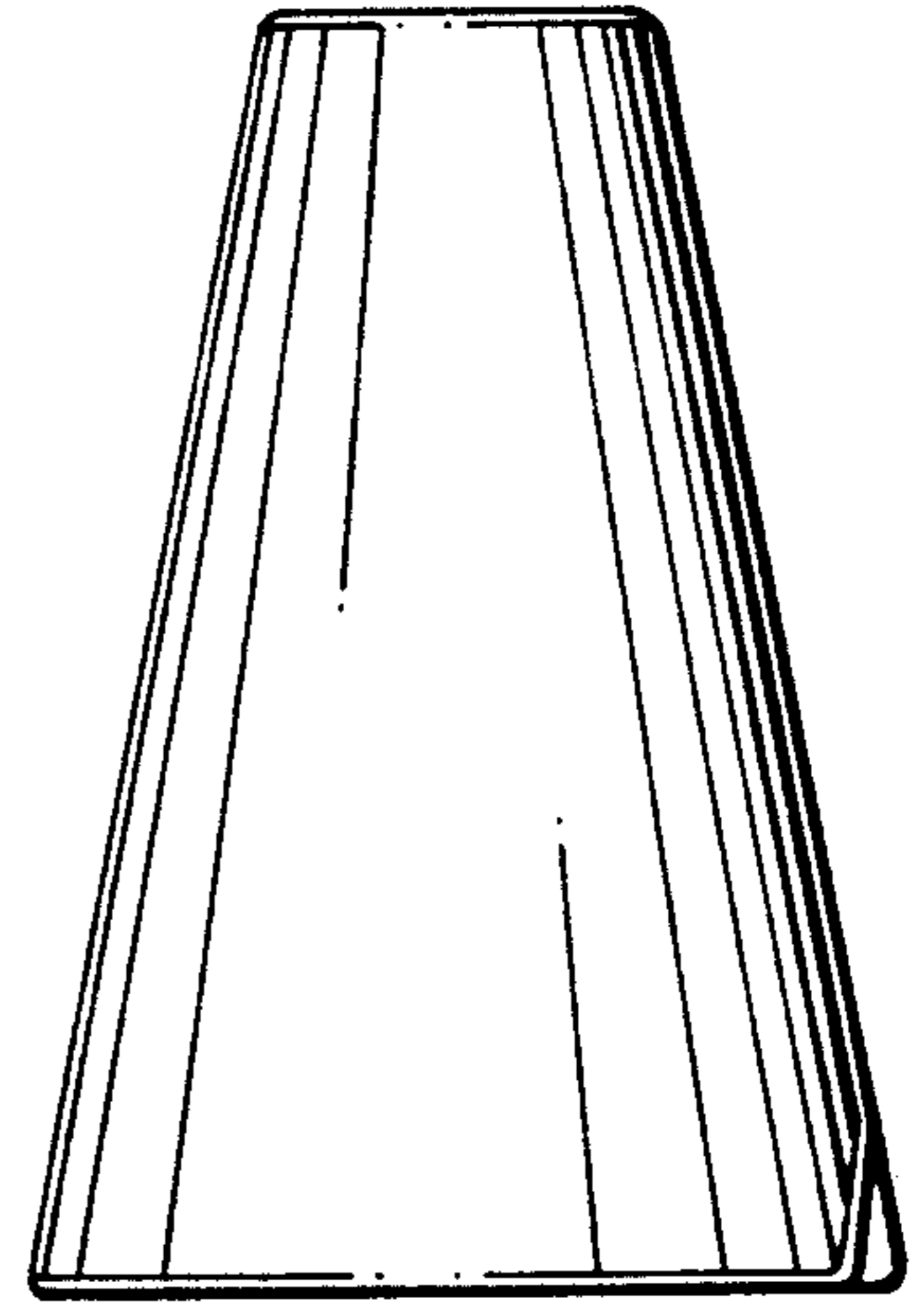

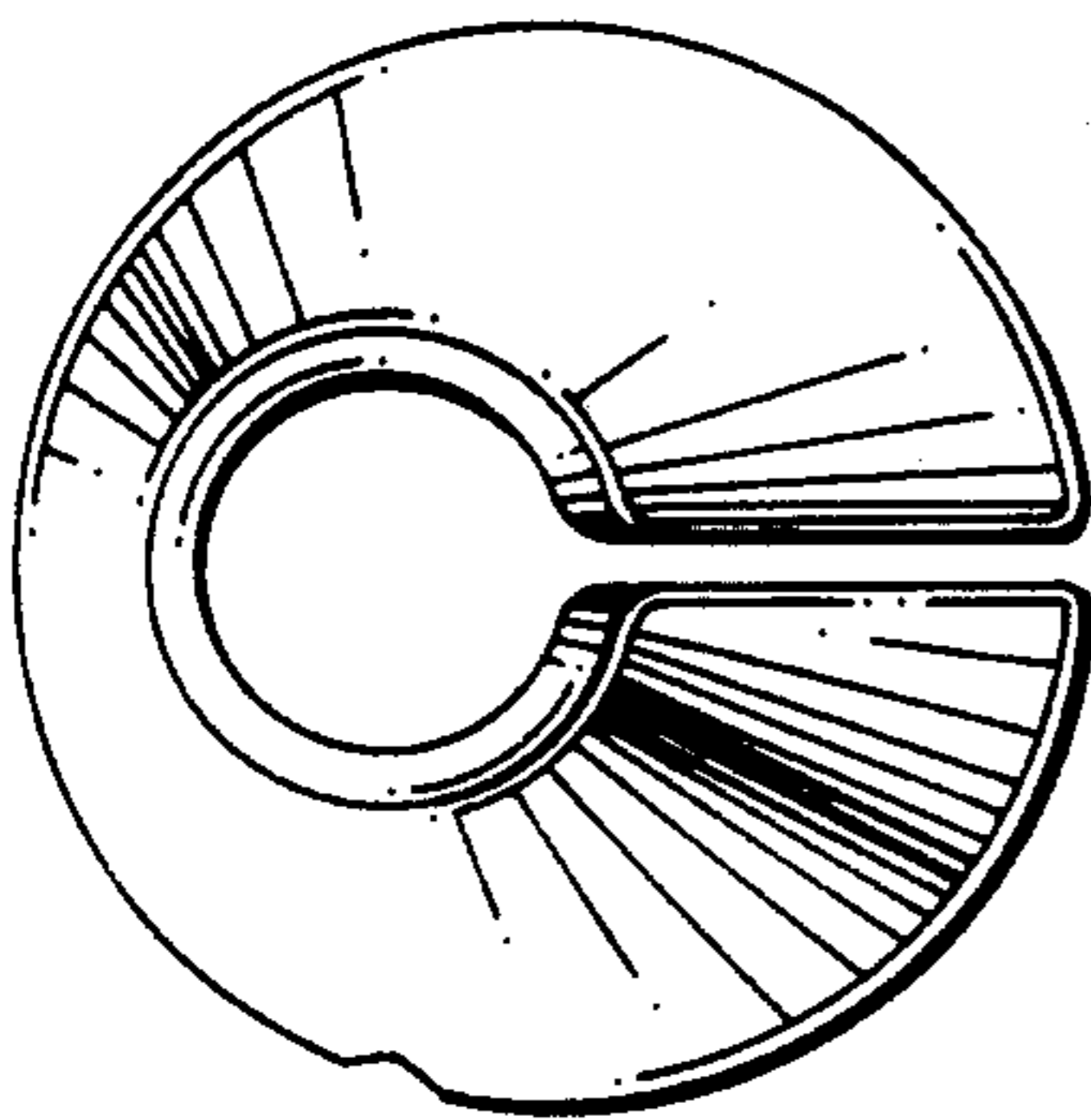

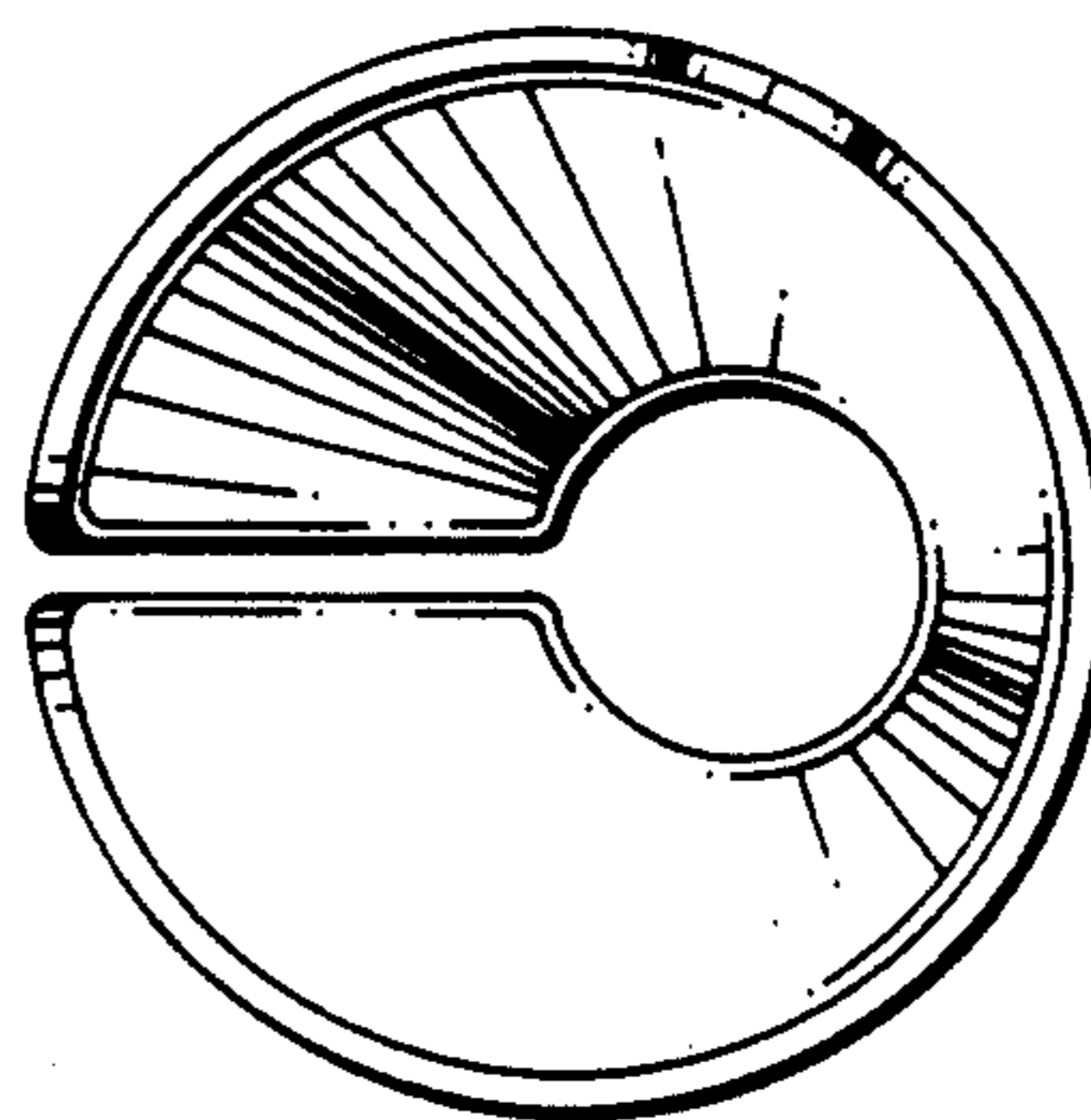
