FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, all other sides being identical thereto;

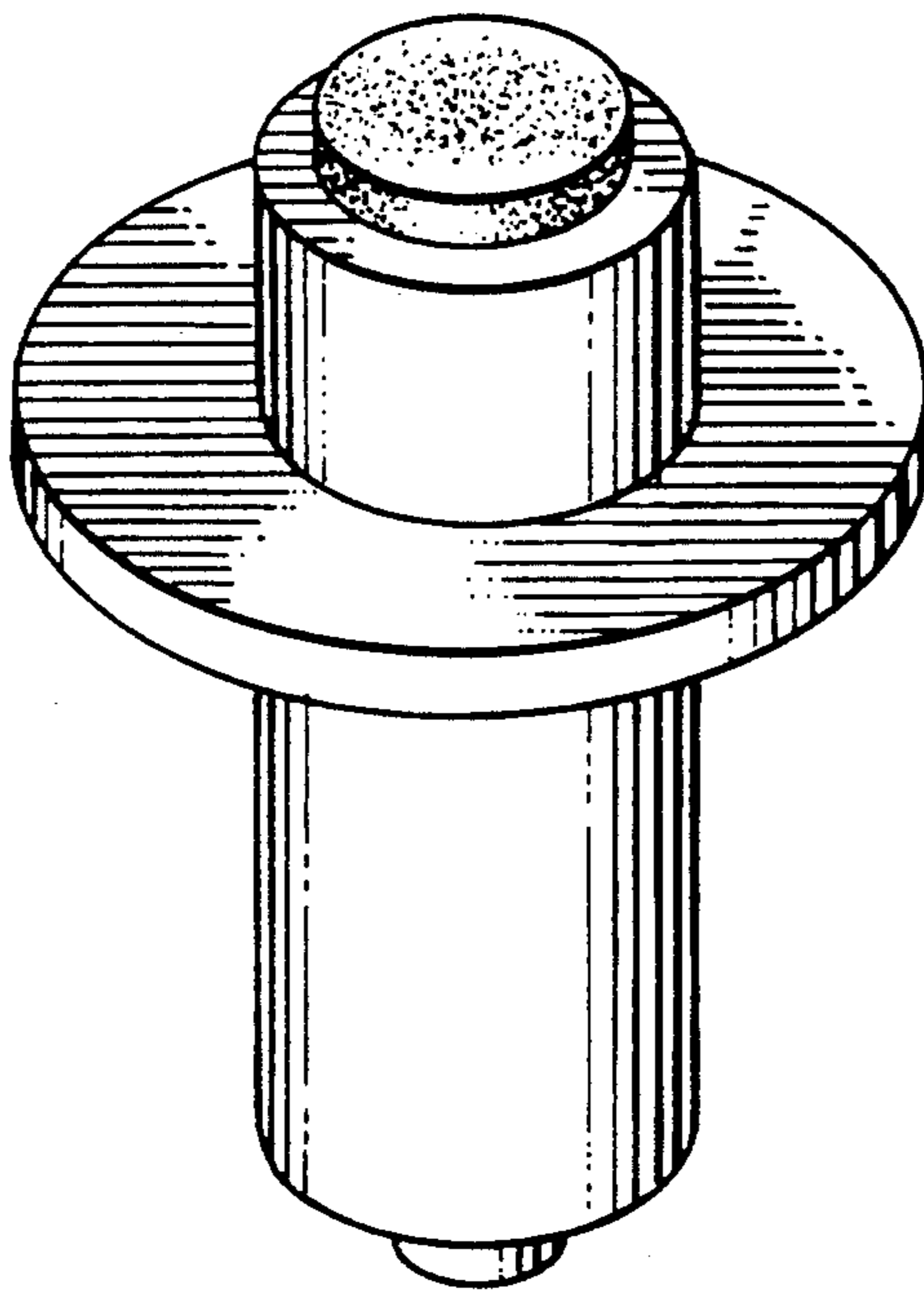
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

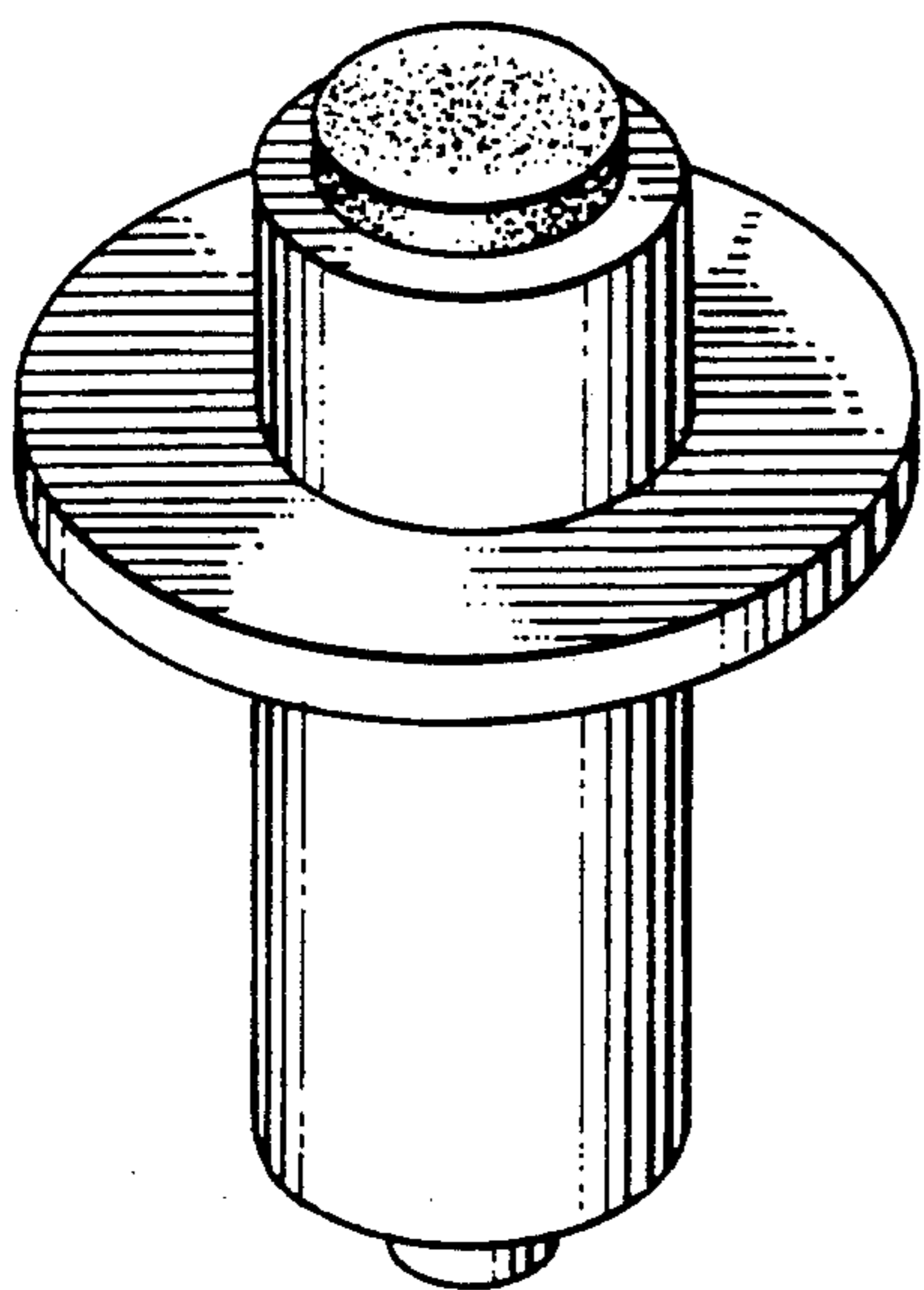

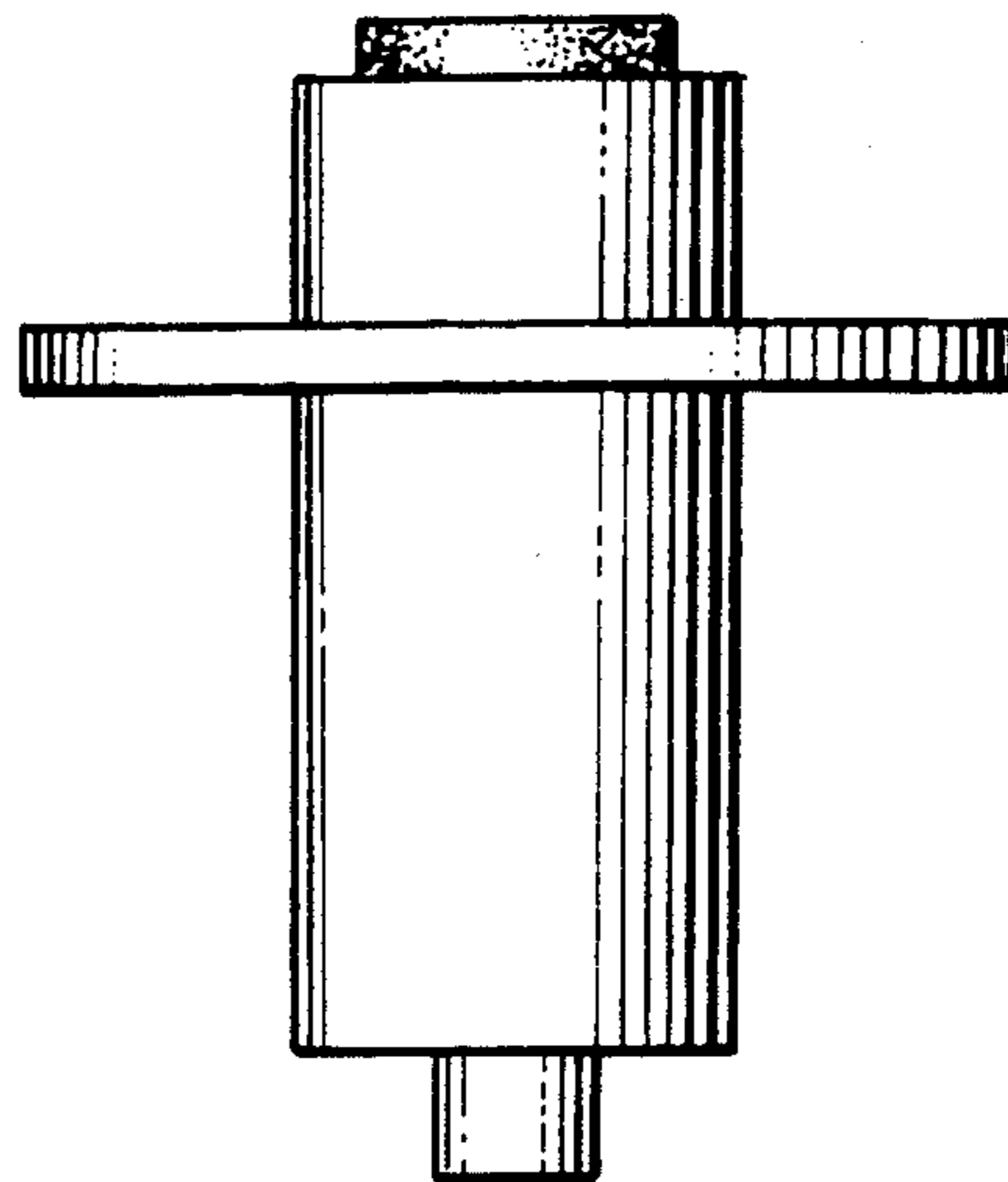

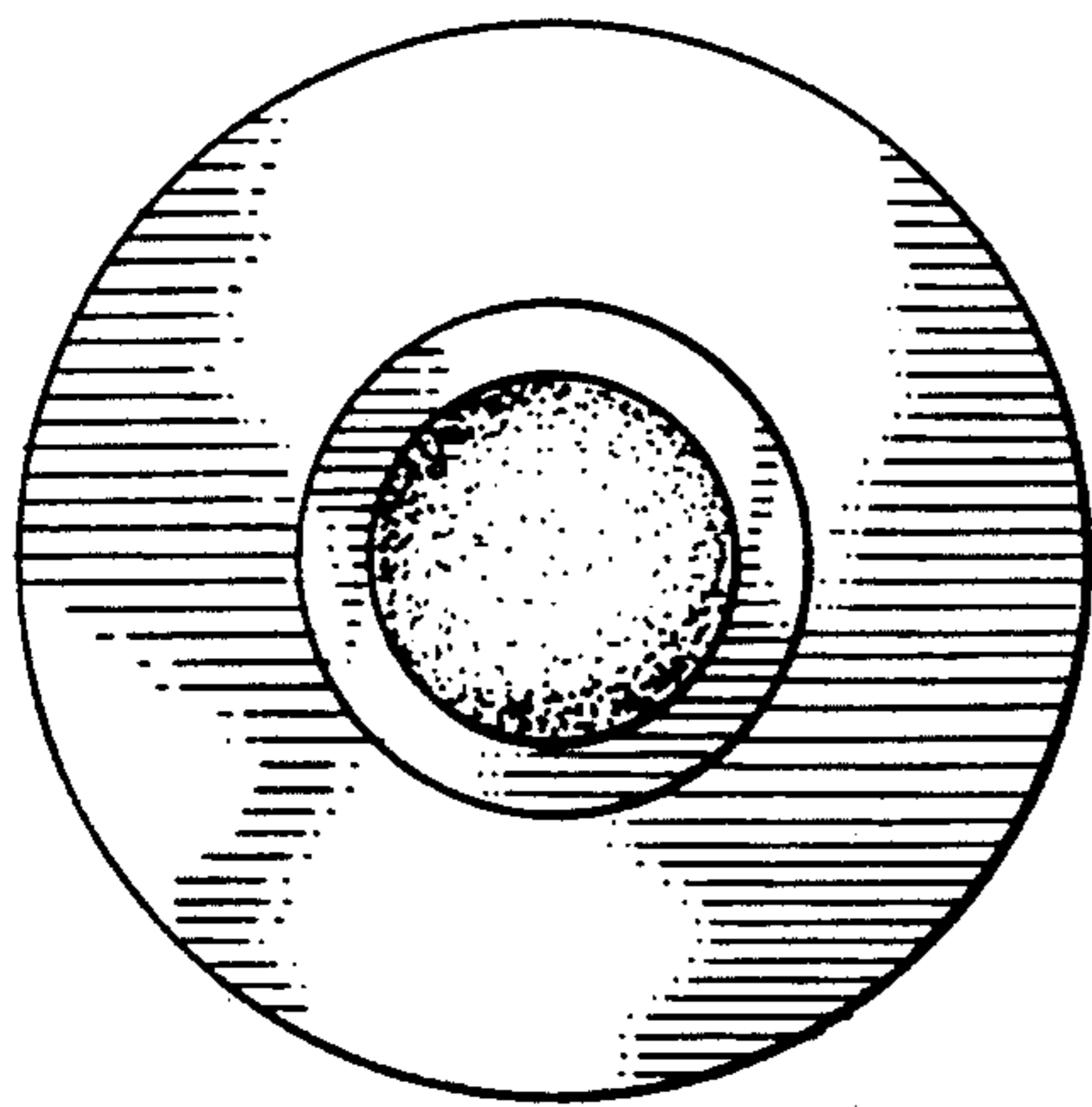

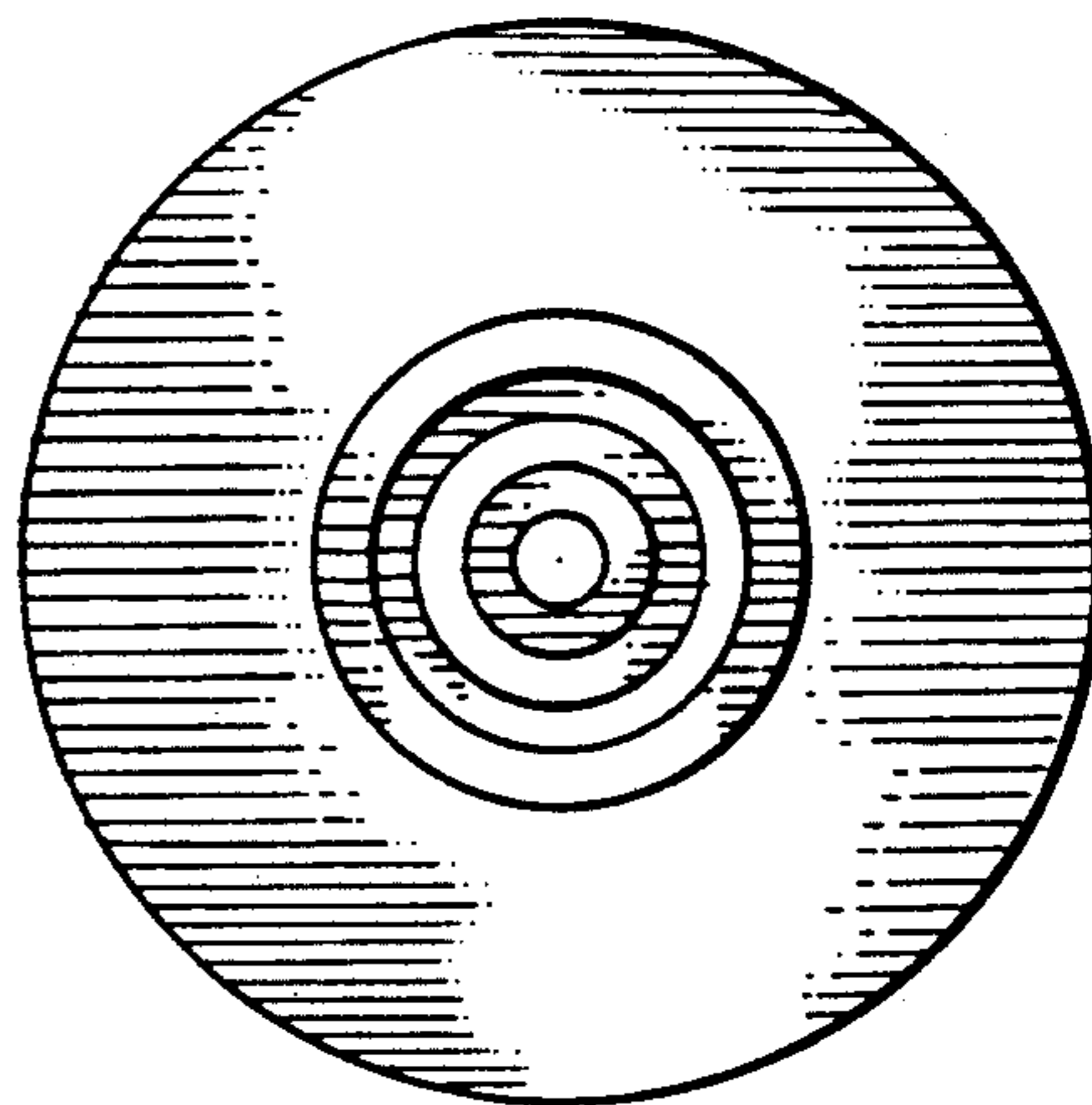
