[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a baby feeder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a baby feeder, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof, with an inverted

nipple a temperature measuring ring and a nipple supporting ring attached to the feeder of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the nipple supporting ring;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the baby feeder with the nipple extended and a retaining collar attached;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the retaining collar;

FIG. 6 is an elevational view of the baby feeder with the nipple inverted, a closure cap and a retainer collar attached;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the retaining collar and its closure cap;

FIG. 8 is an elevational view of the baby feeder with a closure cap attached;

FIG. 9 is a top perspective view of the closure cap;

FIG. 10 is an underside perspective view of the closure cap;

FIG. 11 is a perspective view corresponding with FIG. 4, and showing handles attached to the container;

FIG. 12 is an underside view of the handles of FIG. 11;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 14 is a top plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 15 is a top plan view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 17 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 18 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 4;

FIG. 19 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 20 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 21 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 11;


FIG. 22 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;


FIG. 23 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 24 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7; and,


FIG. 25 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9.

All other sides of FIGS. 1-8 and the opposite side of FIG. 11 are identical to that shown.




















































