DESCRIPTION

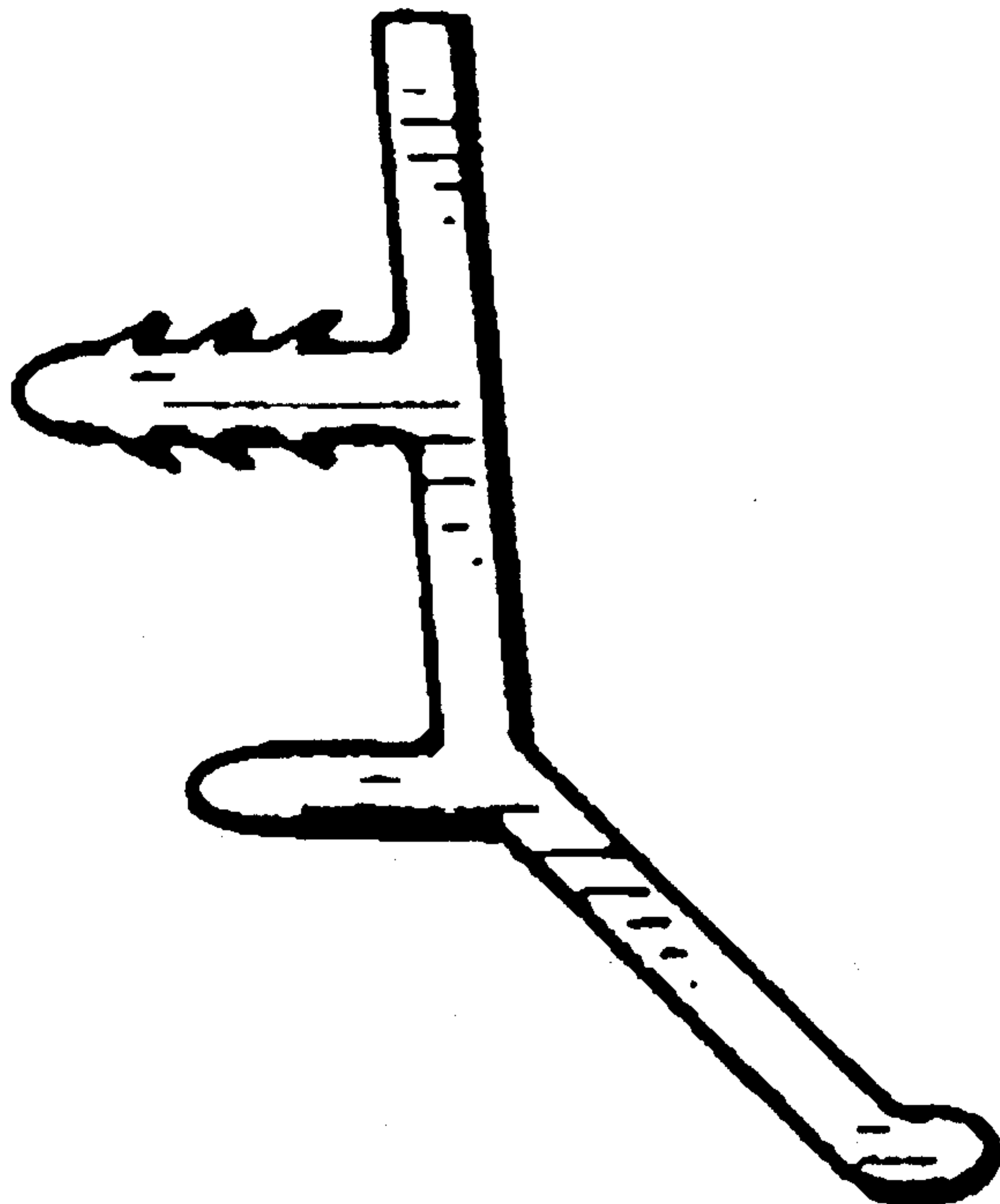
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an overhead door weatherstripping showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof.



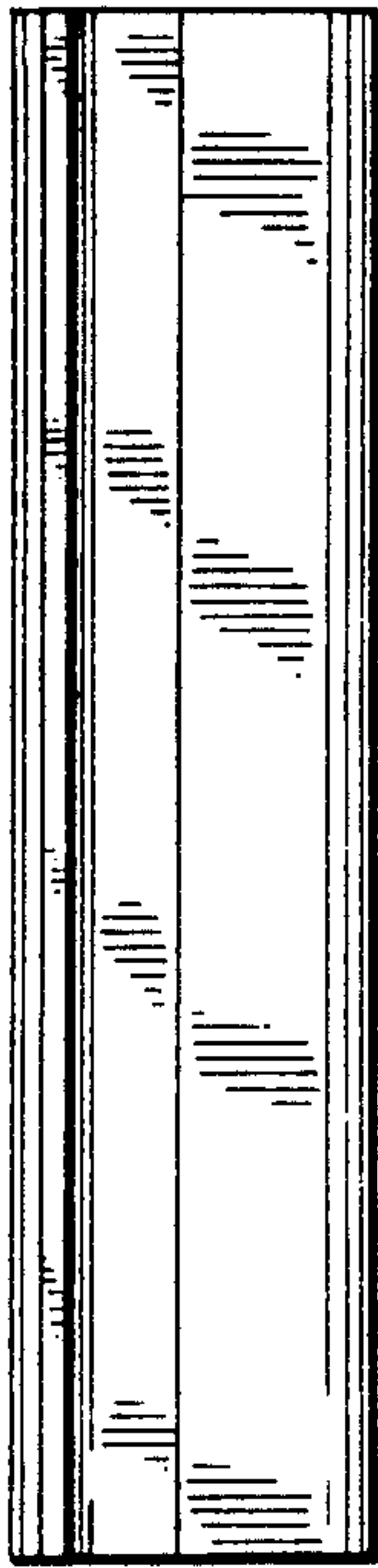

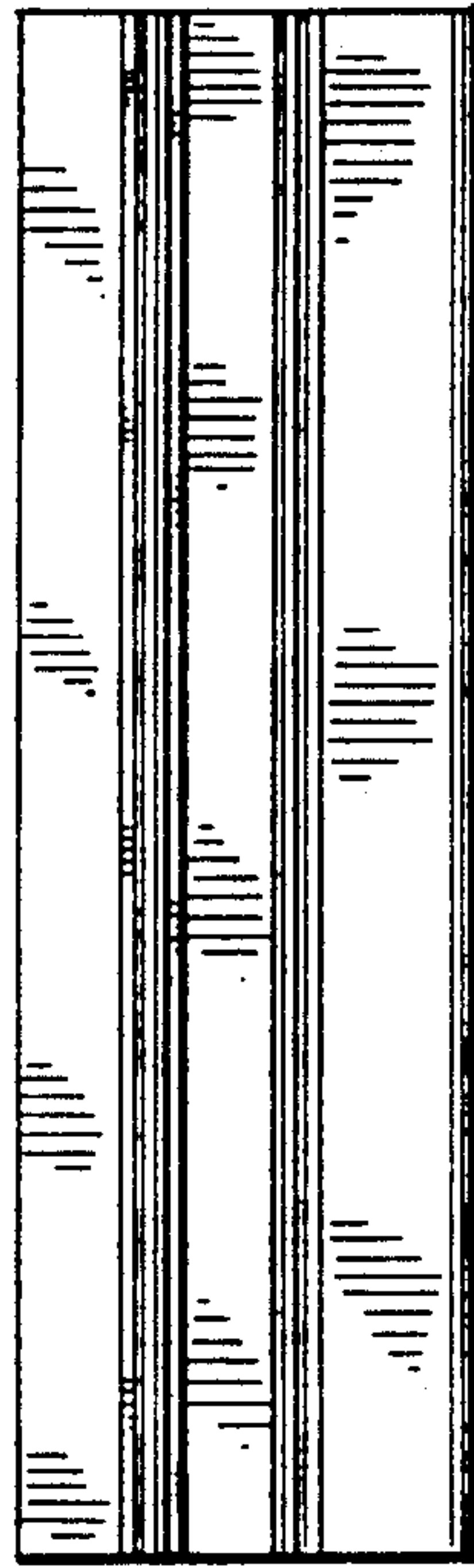

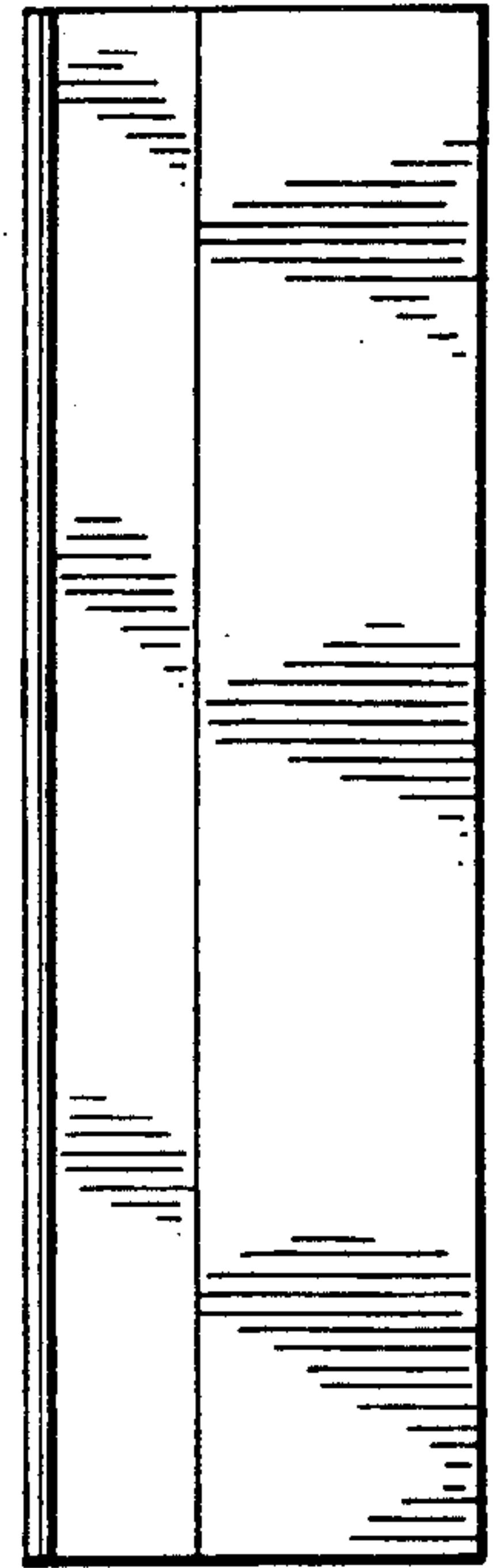

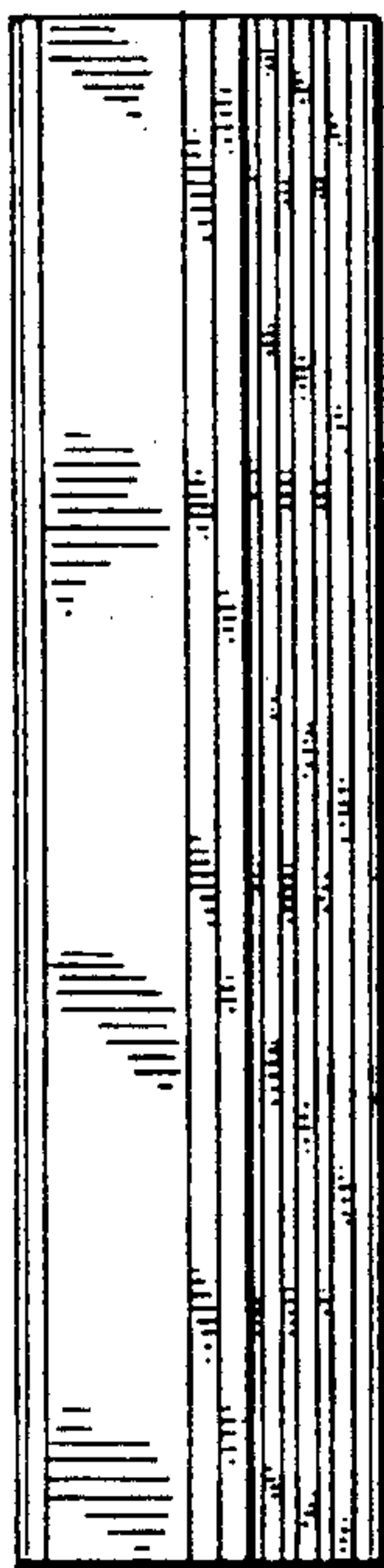

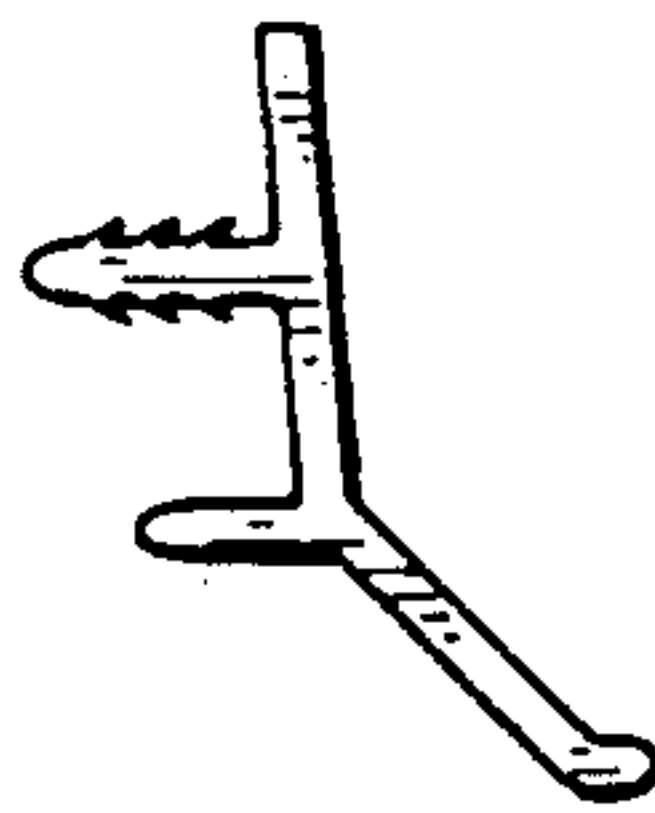
