[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for combined container/bottle and cosmetic wand applicators or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded front elevational view of a combined container/bottle and cosmetic wand applicators or the like, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof with applicator caps on;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1, with applicator cap on;

FIG. 4 is a partially exploded side elevational view showing a second embodiment of our new design wherein the applicator caps have been modified;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1, with applicator caps removed;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof, with applicator cap removed;

FIG. 7 is an exploded front elevational view of a combined container/bottle and cosmetic wand applicators or the like showing a third embodiment of our new design;


FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof with applicator caps on;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of FIG. 7, with applicator caps on;


FIG. 10 is a partially exploded side elevational view showing a fourth embodiment of our new design wherein the applicator caps have been modified;
