FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the combined television stand and video accessory storage showing my new design;

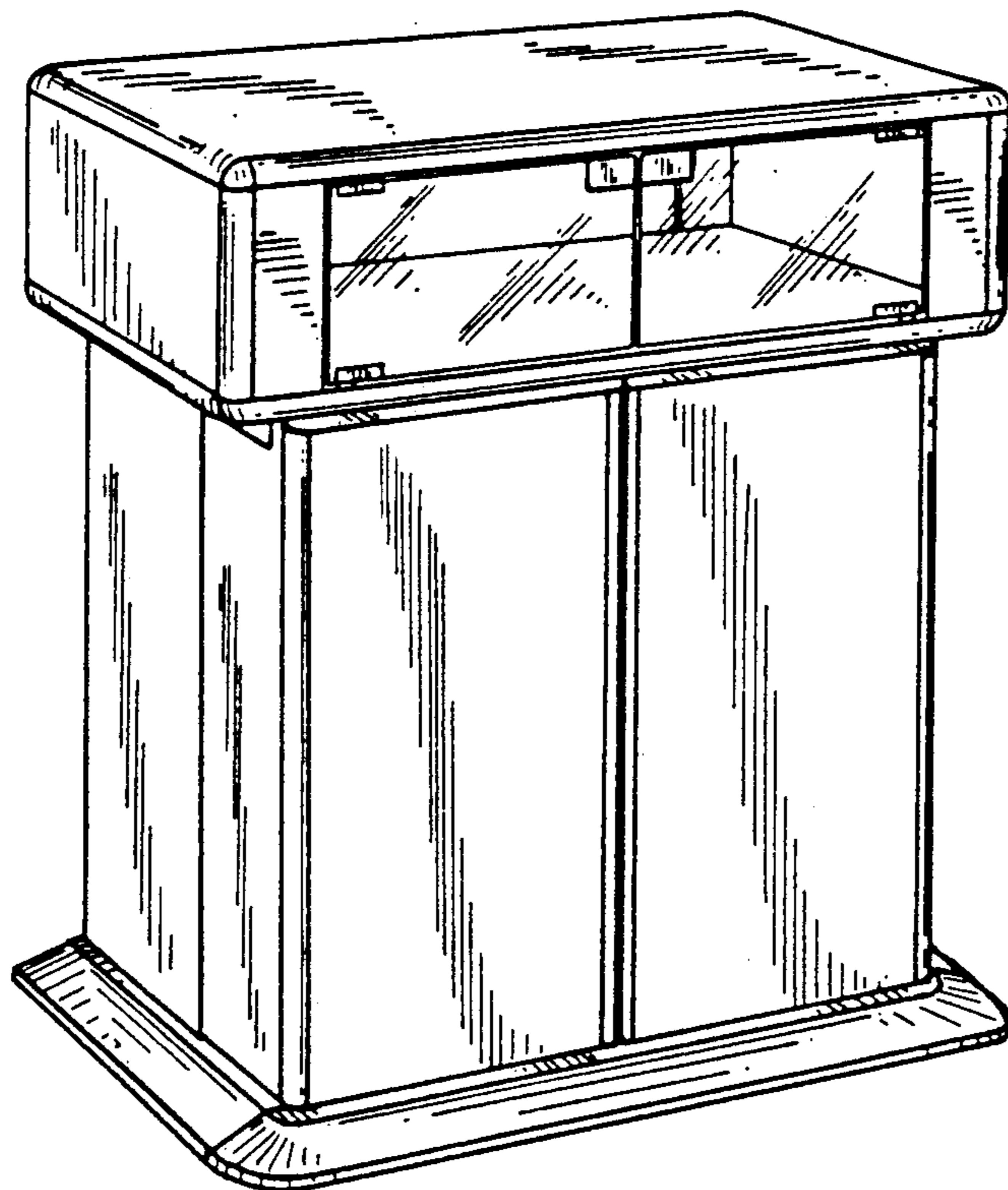
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



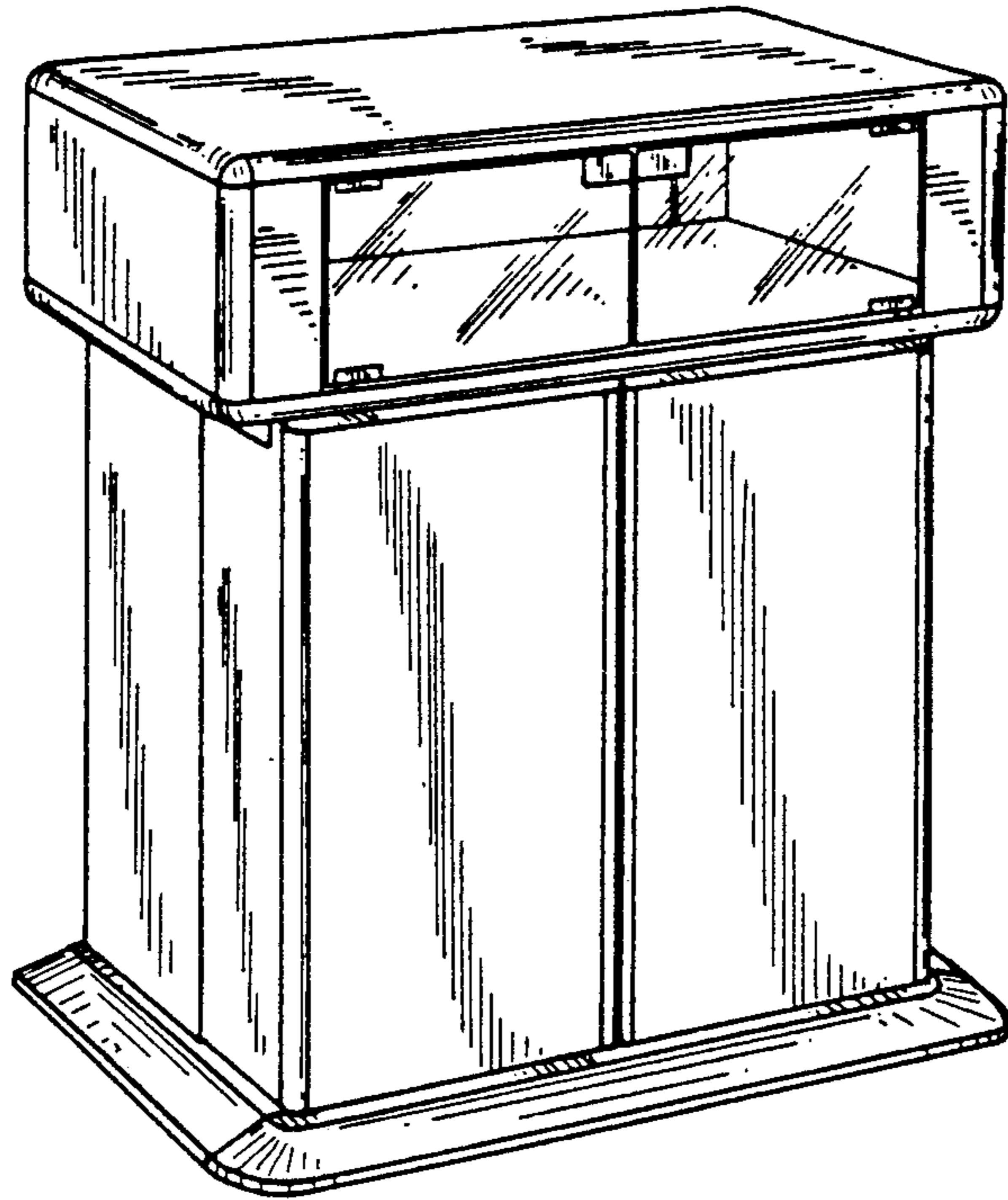

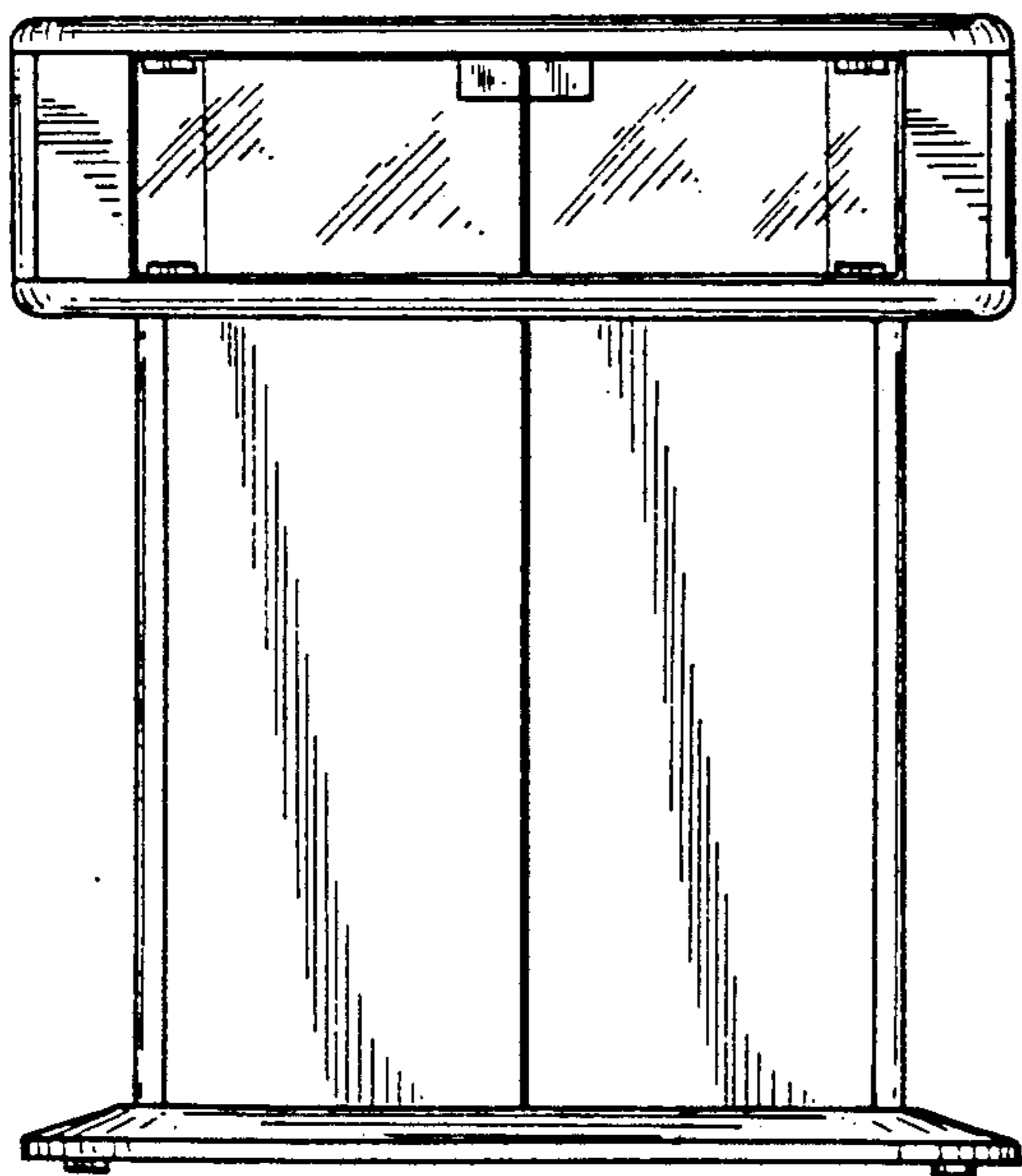

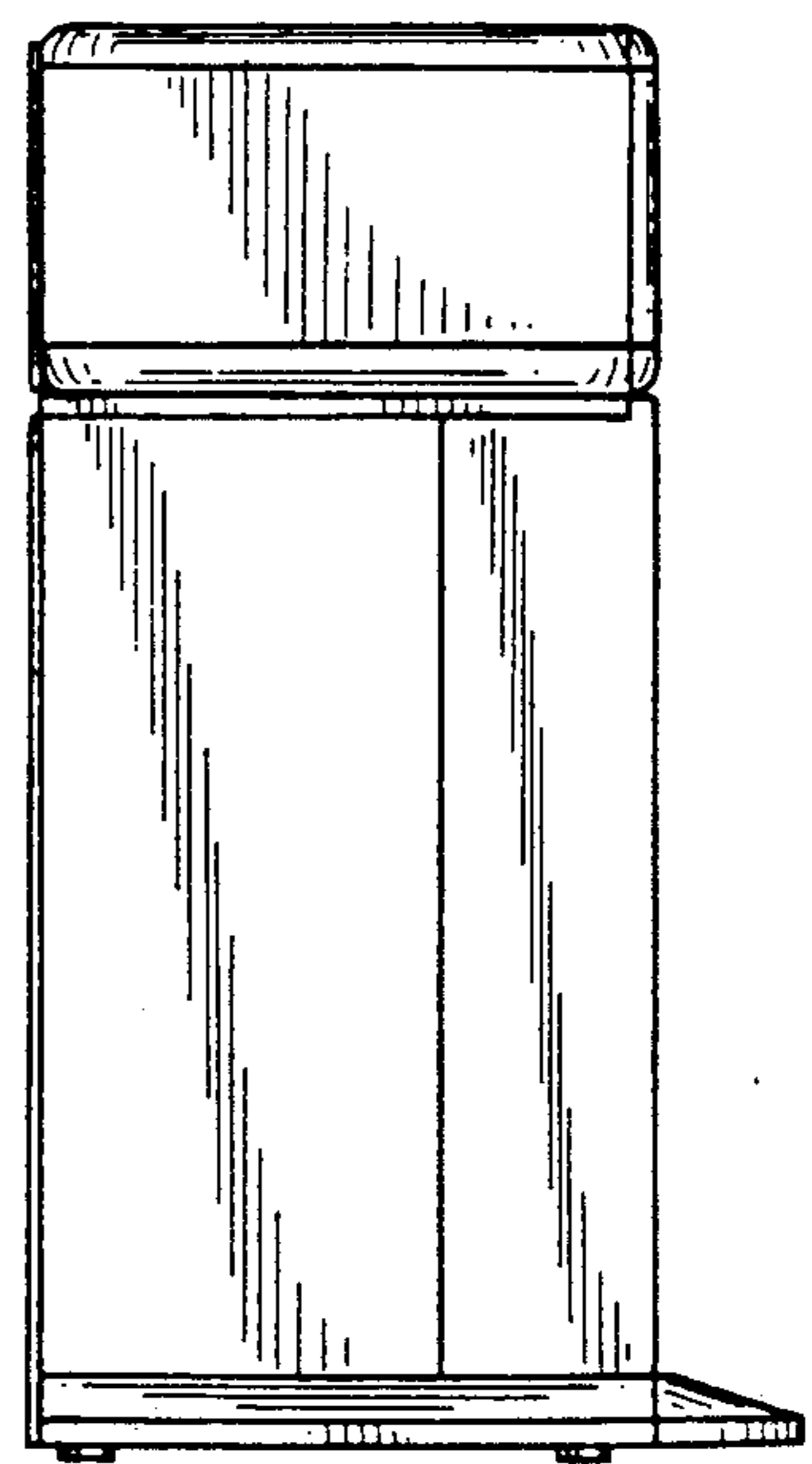

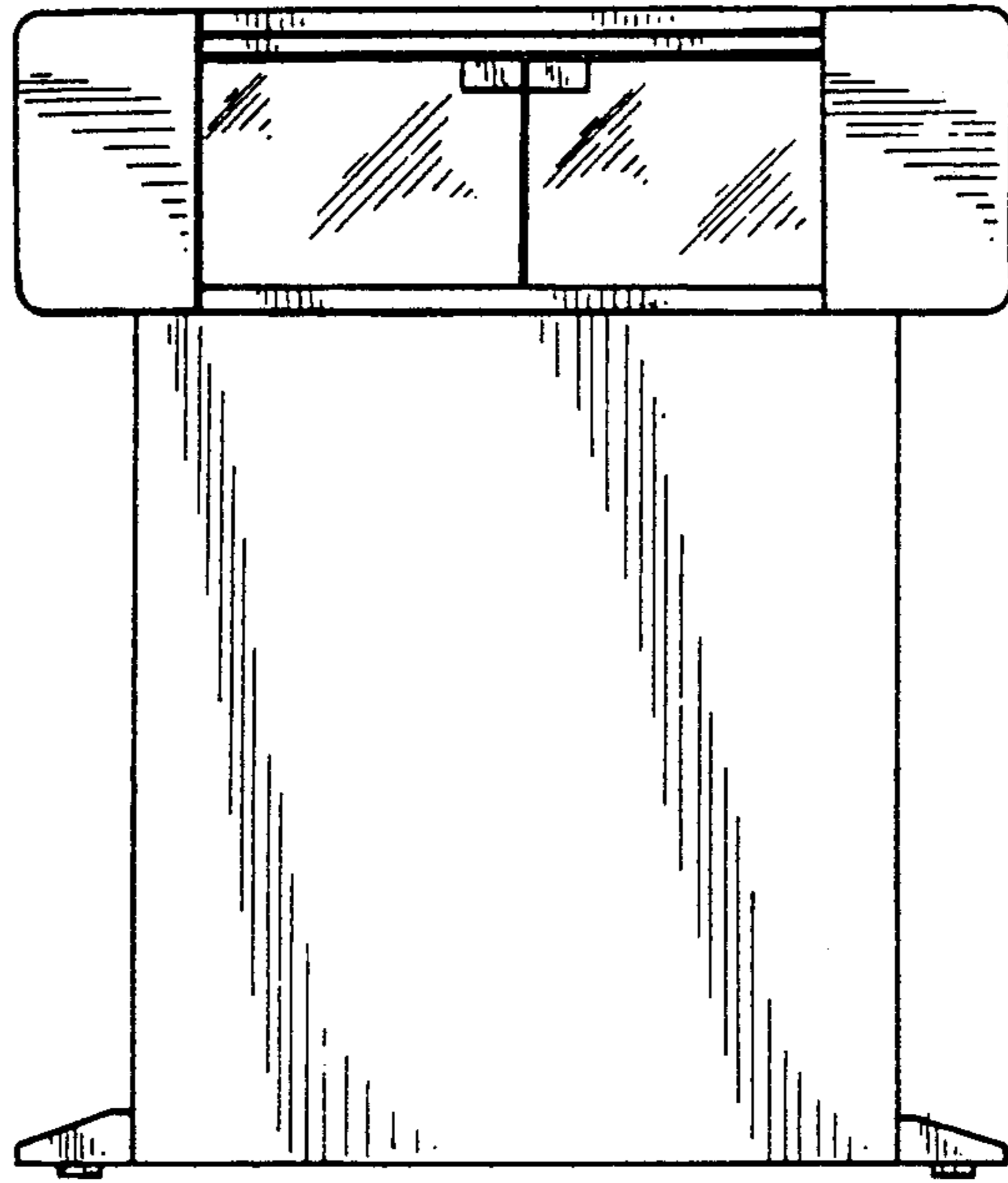

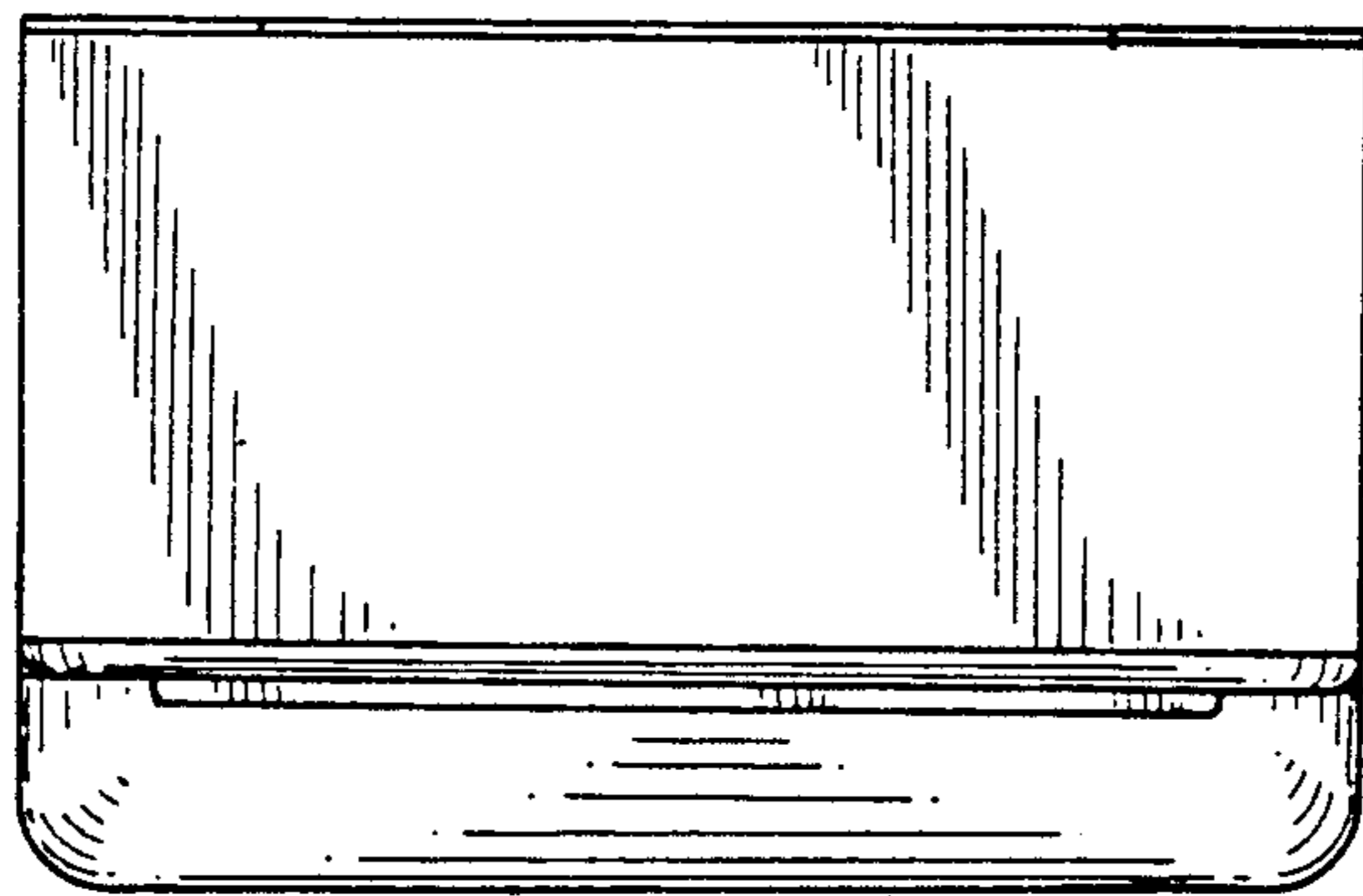

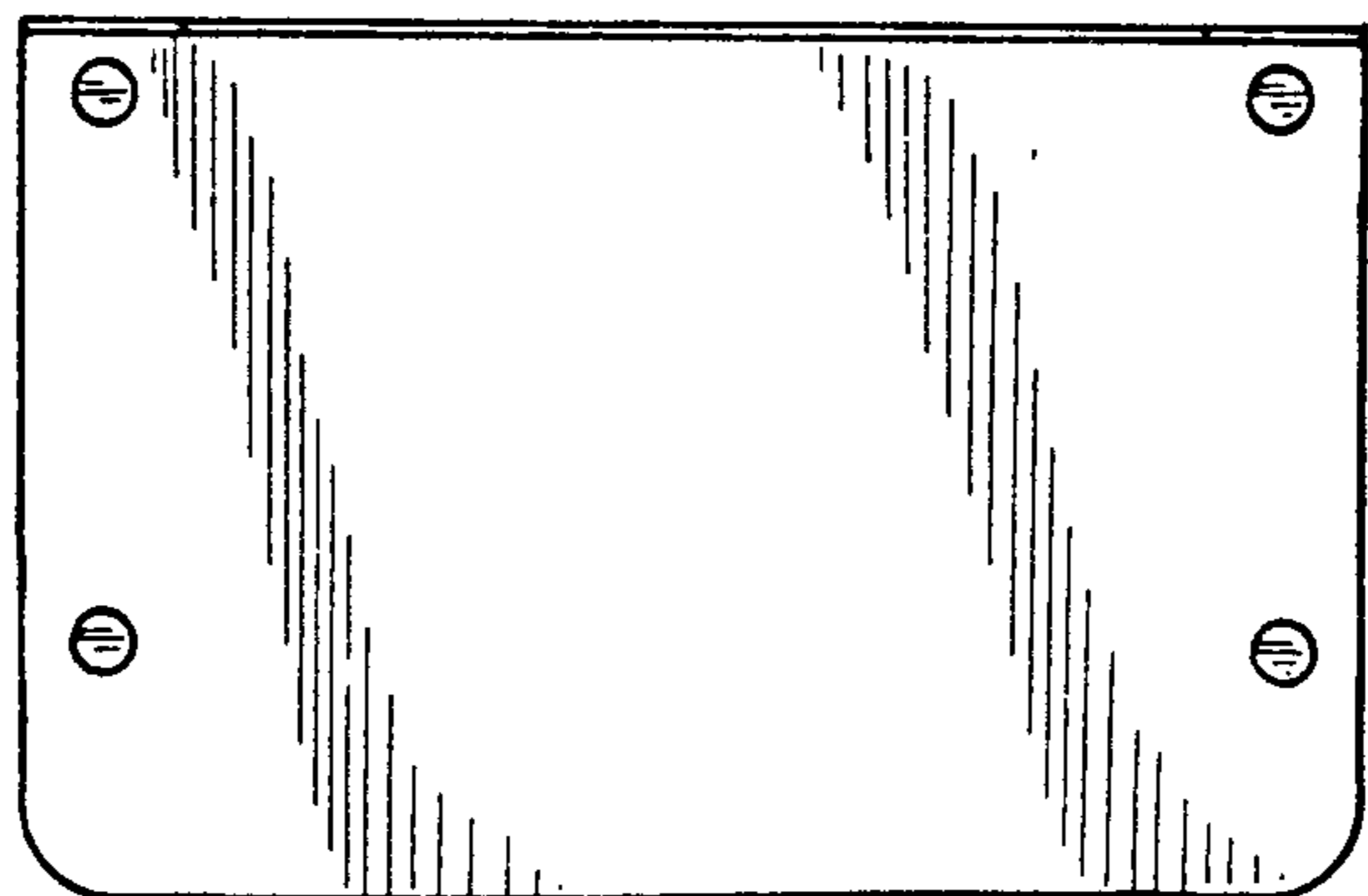
