FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

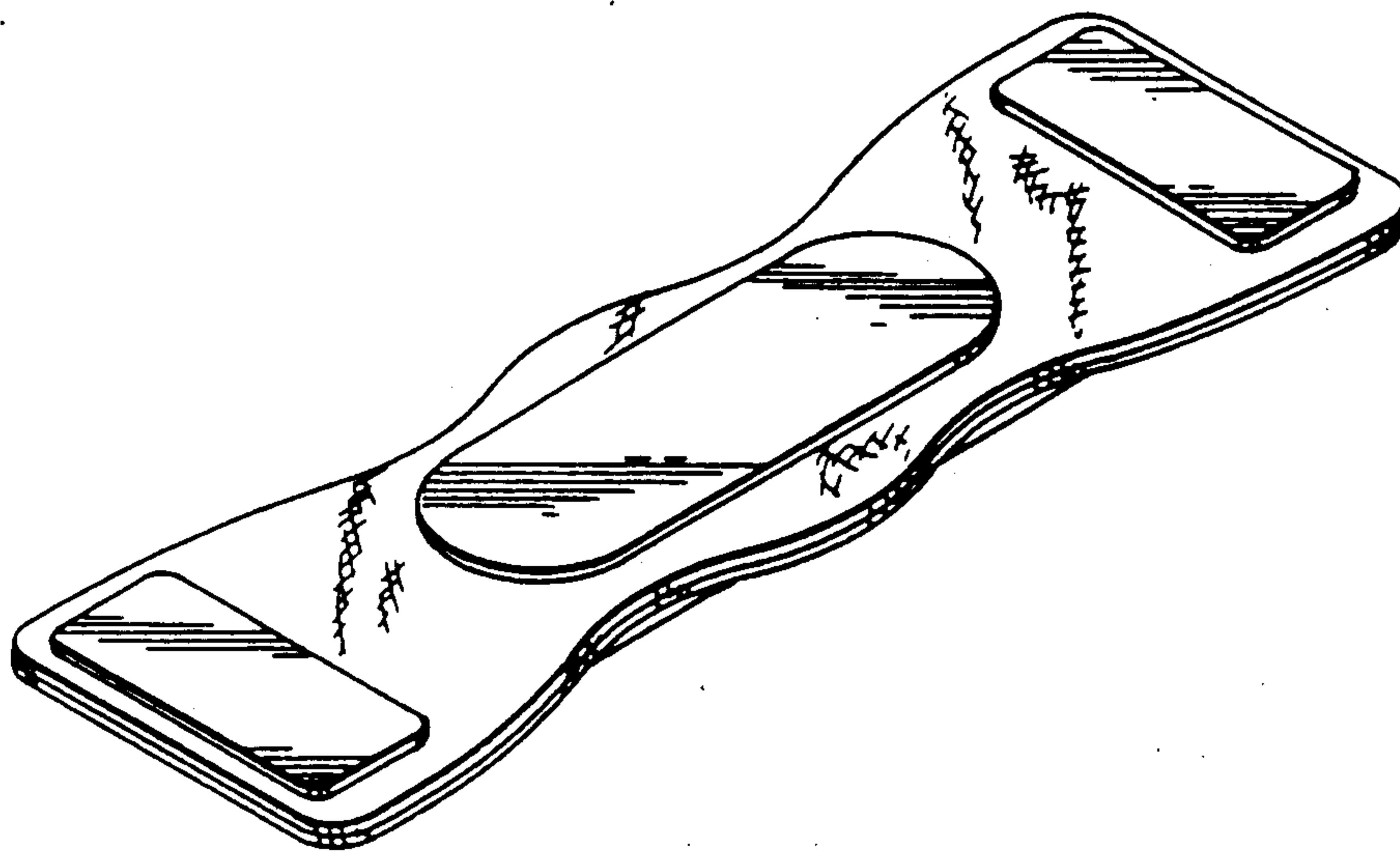
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The cross-line pattern, which is partially shown for ease of illustration, is intended to represent a conventional fabric.



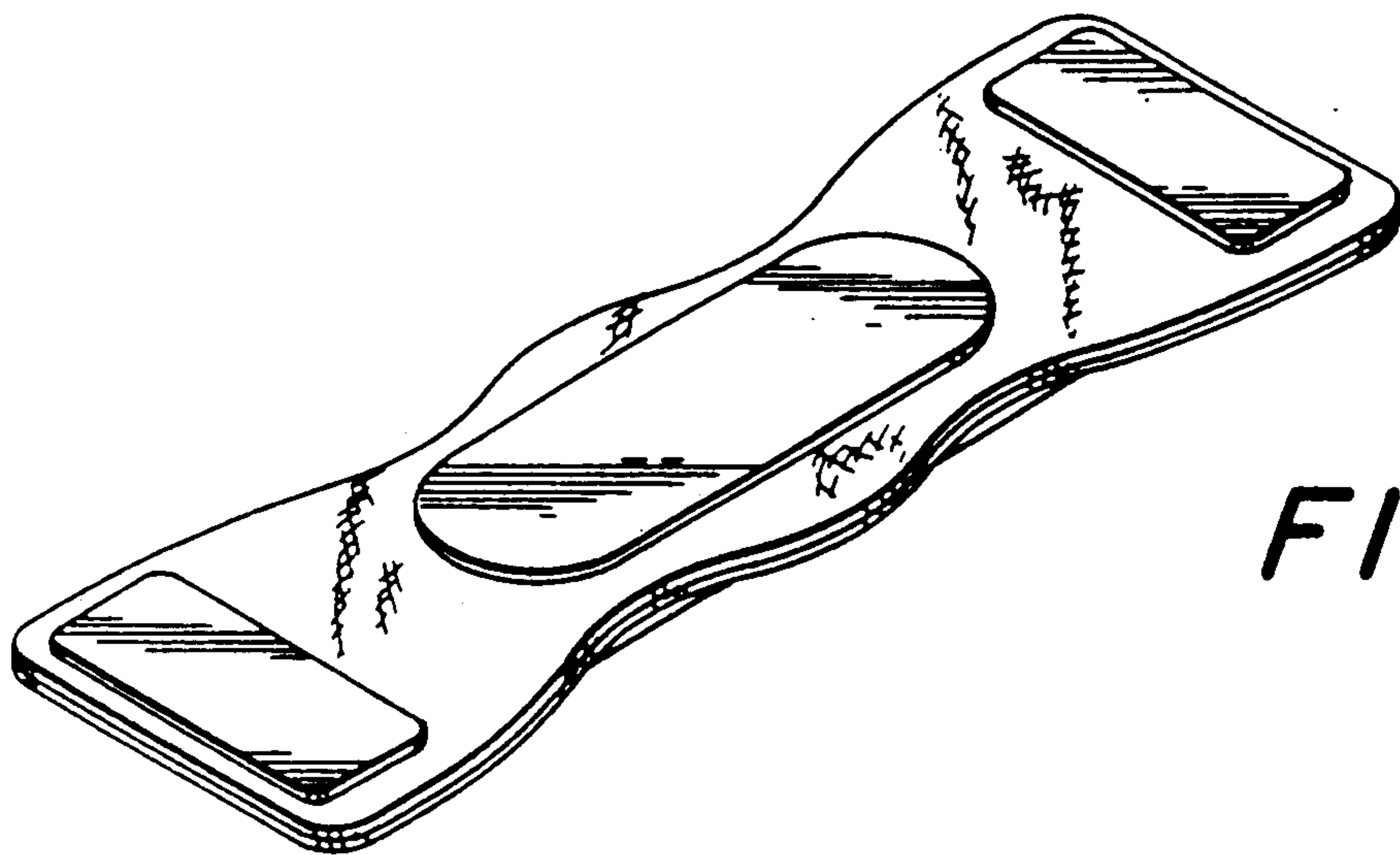

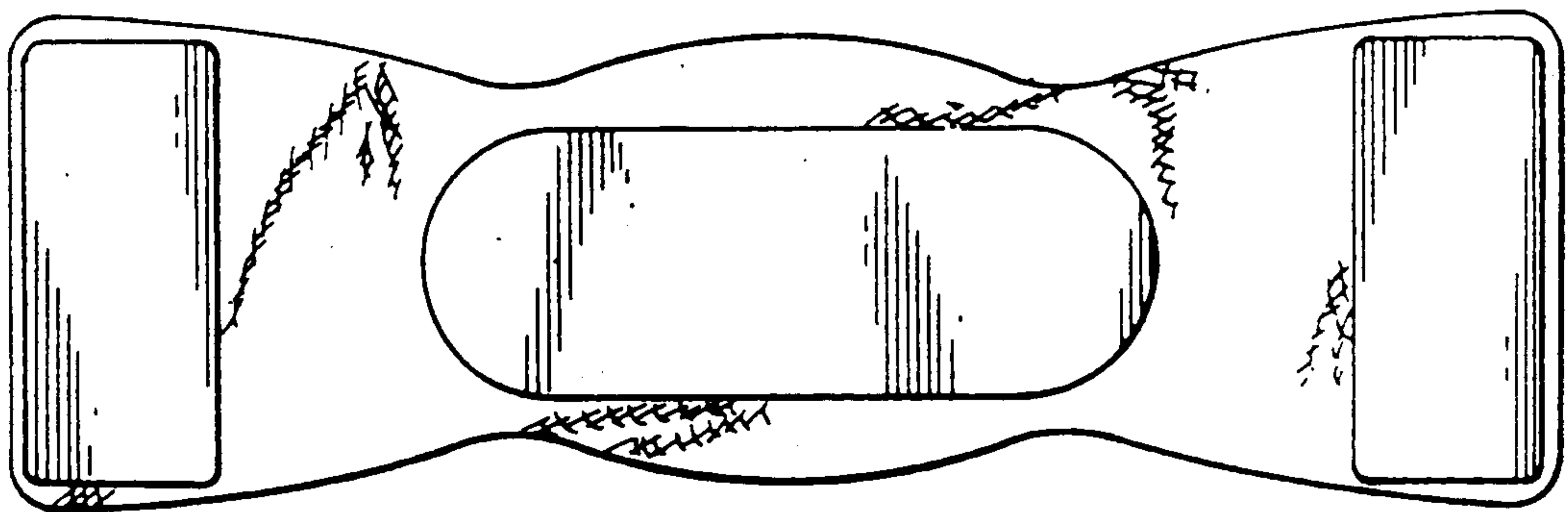

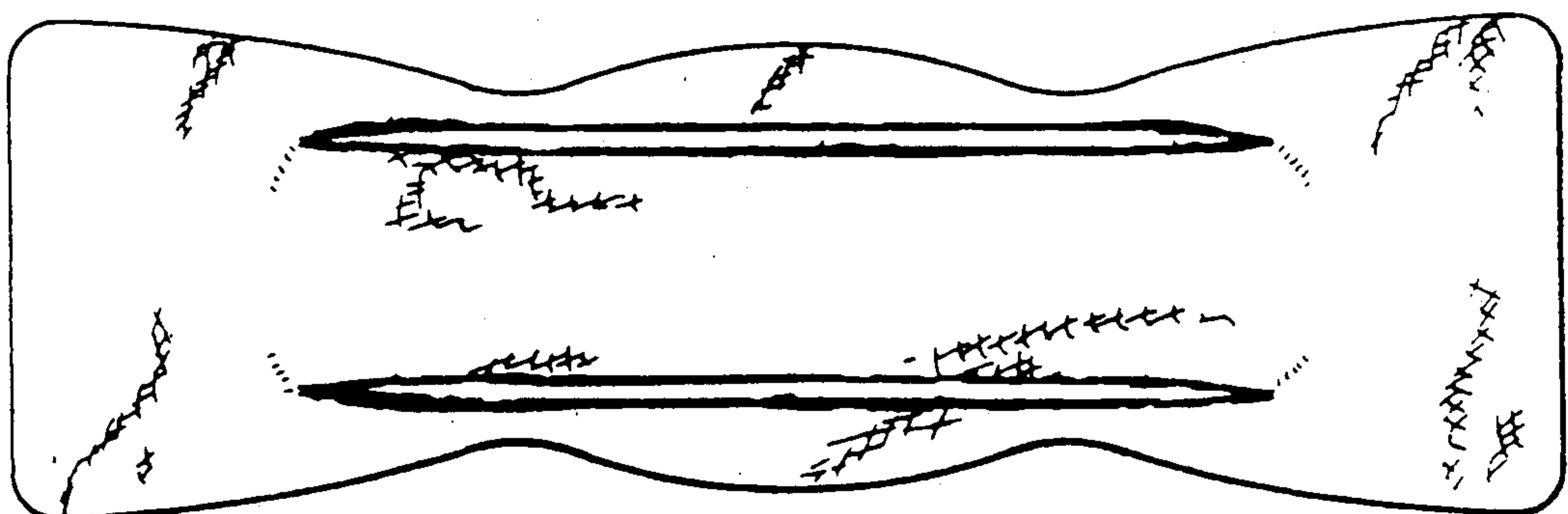

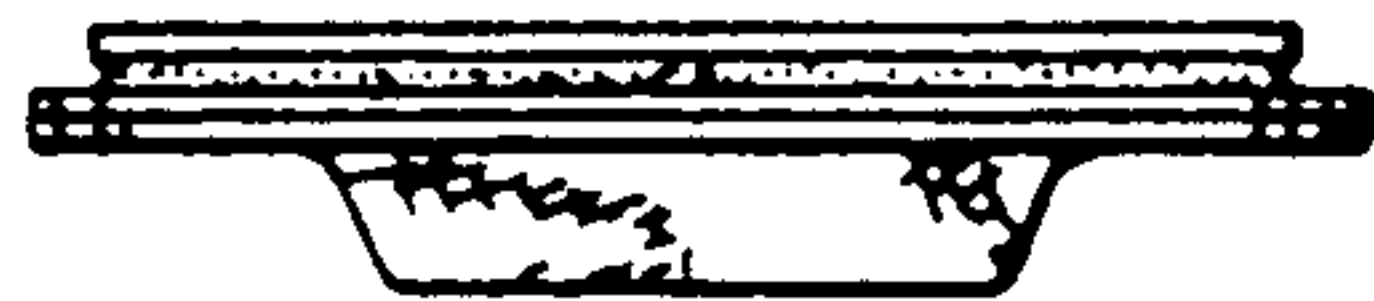
