[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bicycle lamp or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a bicycle lamp or similar article showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of a second embodiment showing my new design;


FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 10 is an exploded side elevational view thereof, showing the front and rear portions of the lamp detached from one another, the opposite side of the lamp being a mirror image.













