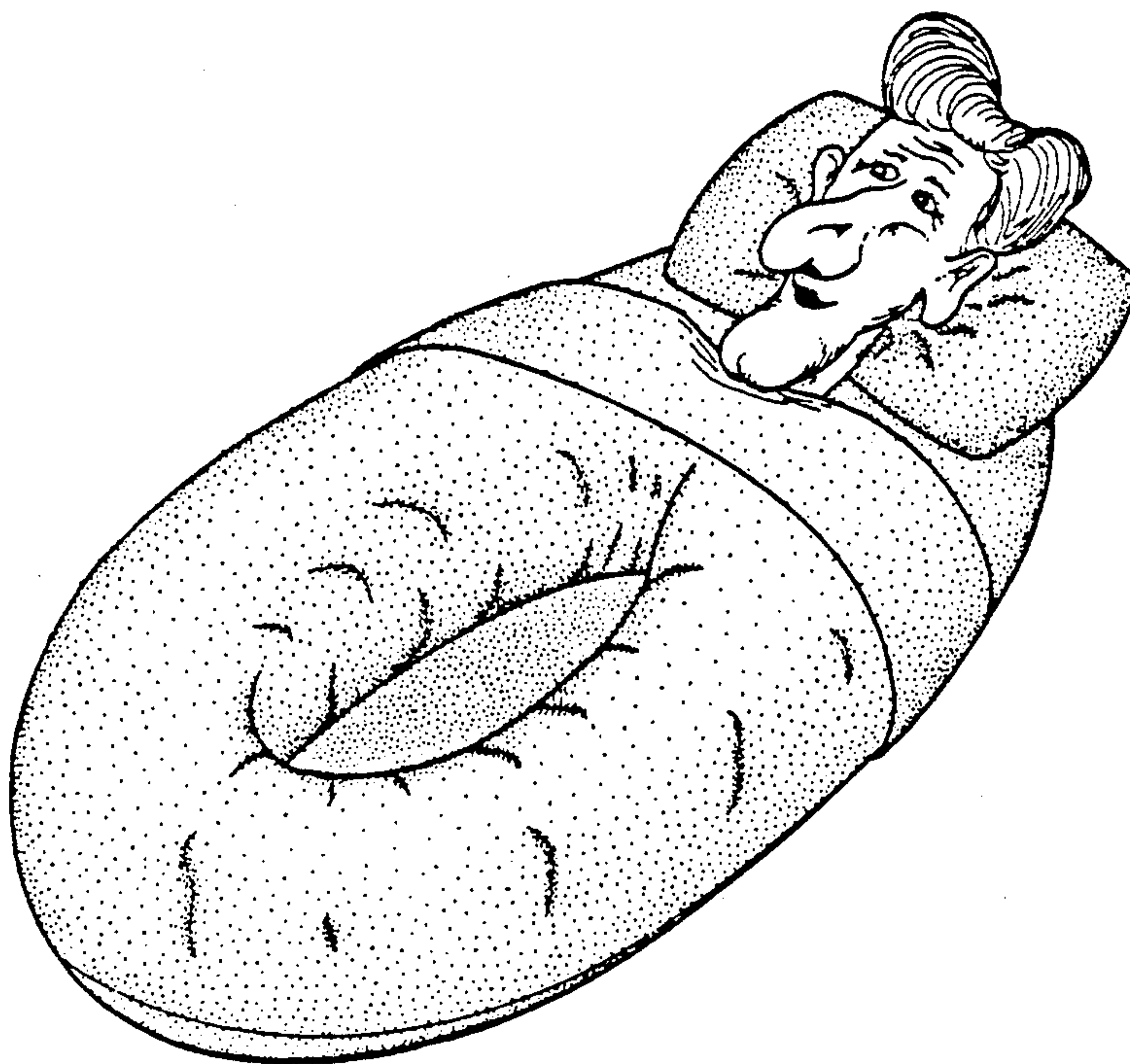

The ornamental design for a house slipper or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a house slipper or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the slipper;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the slipper.
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the slipper.
FIG. 5 is a left elevational view.
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the slipper.



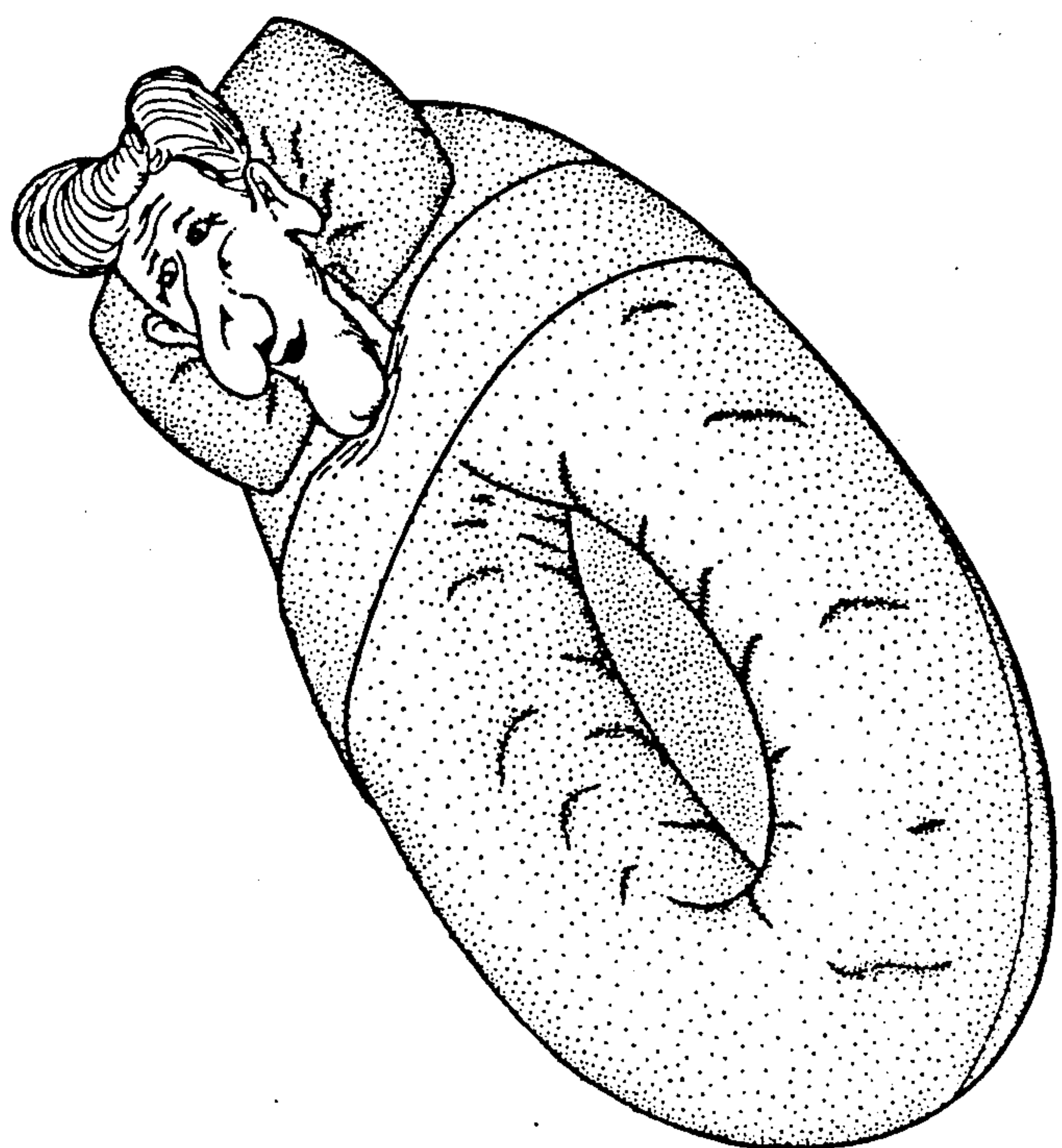

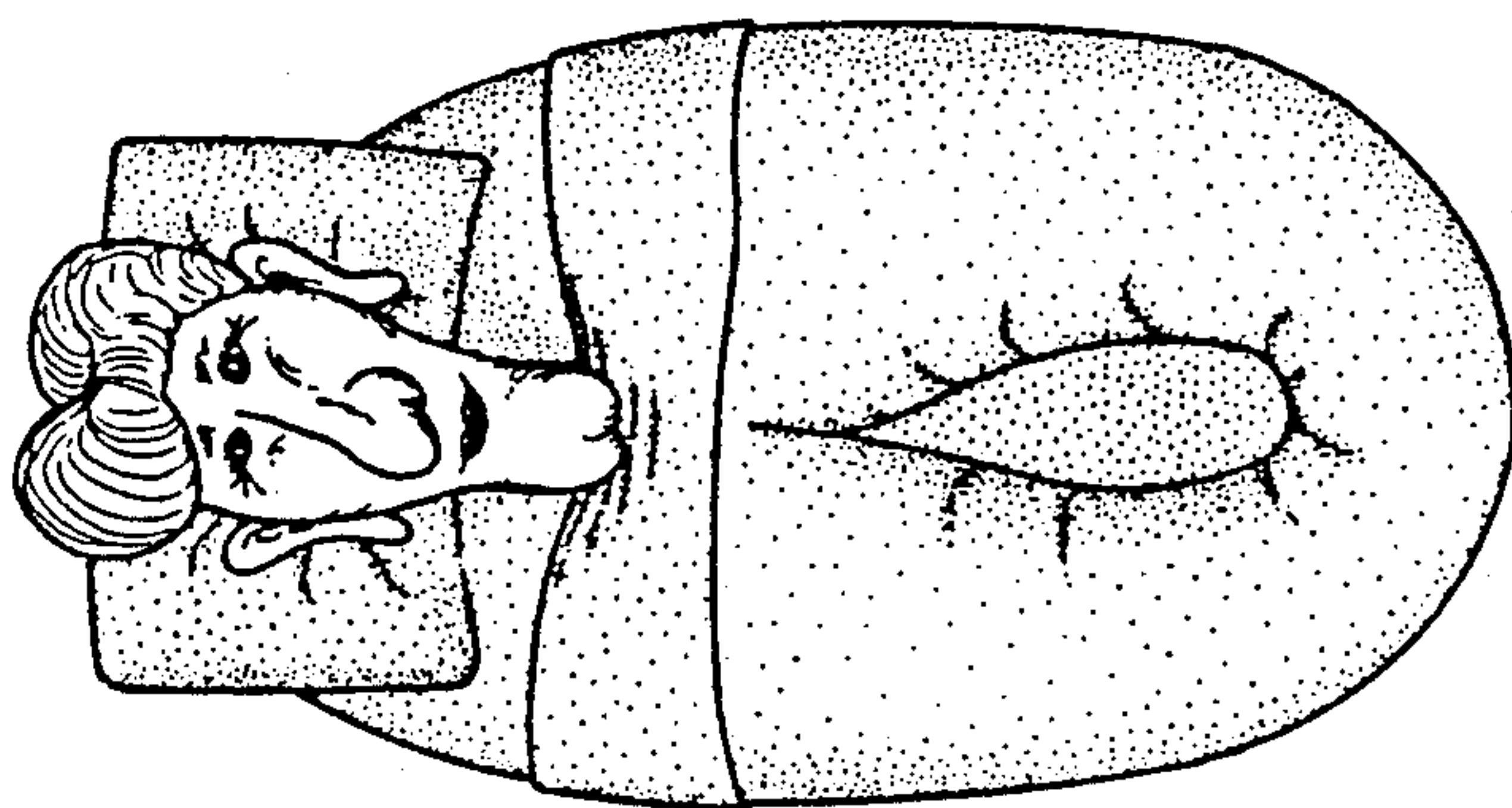

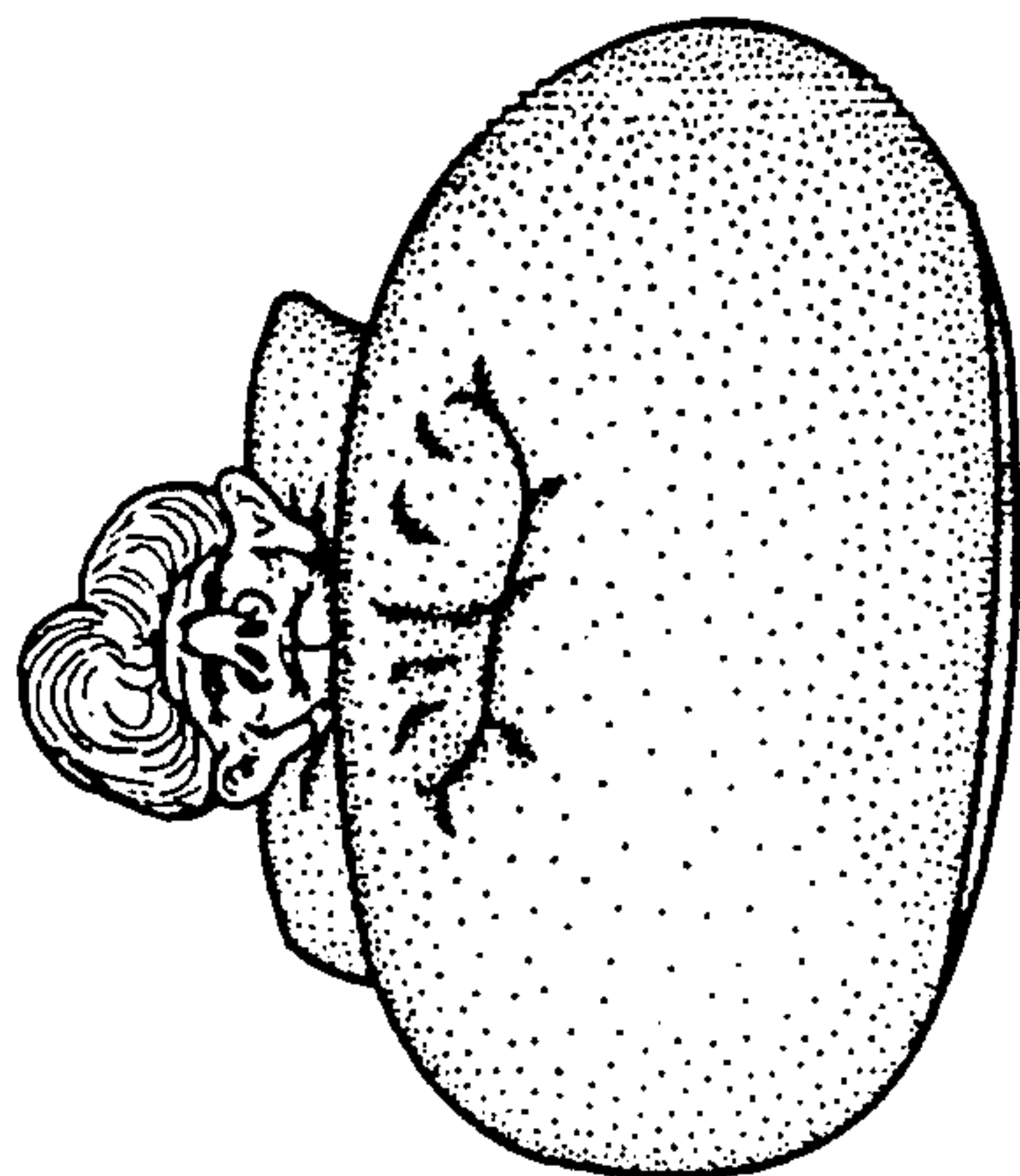

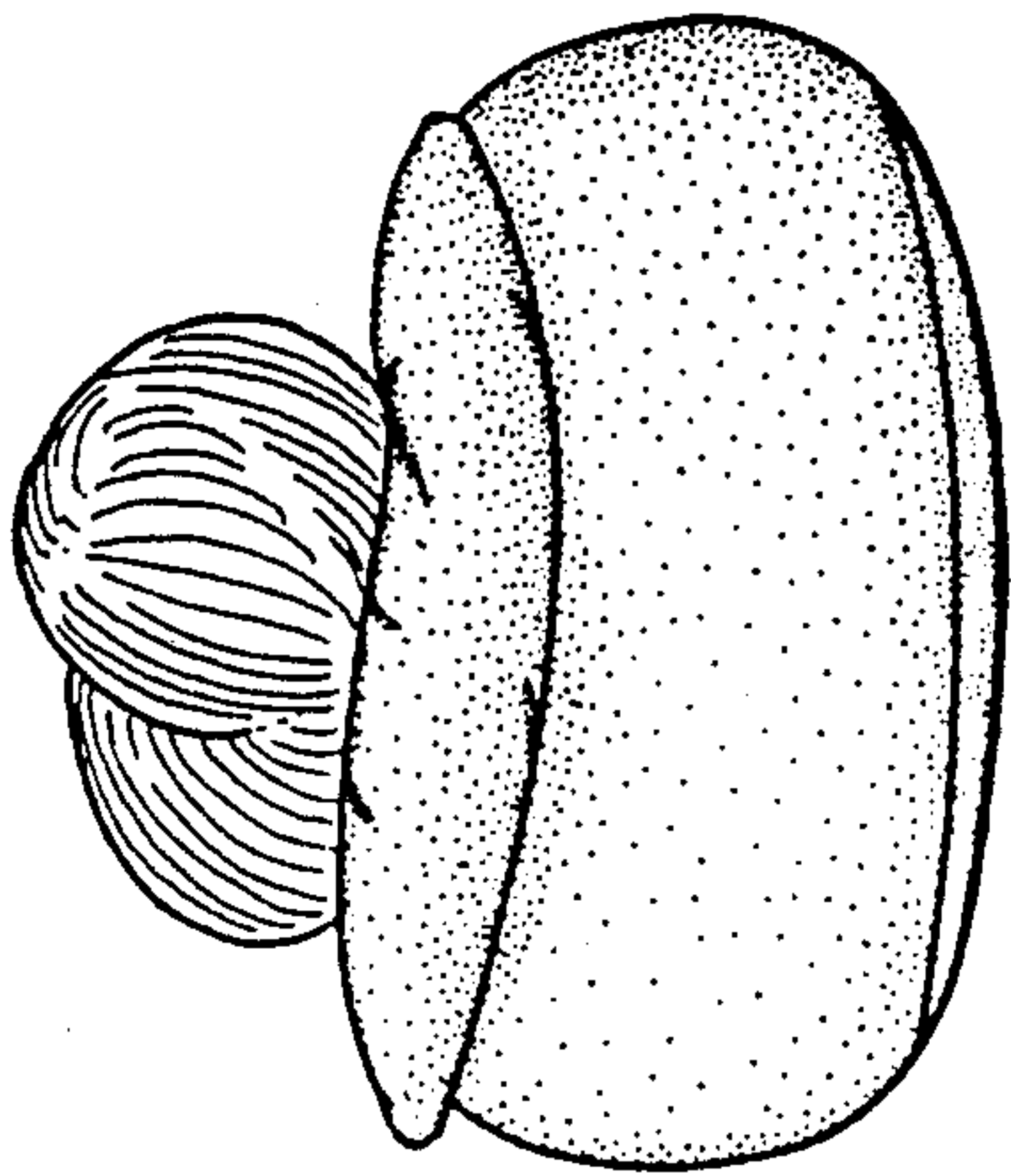

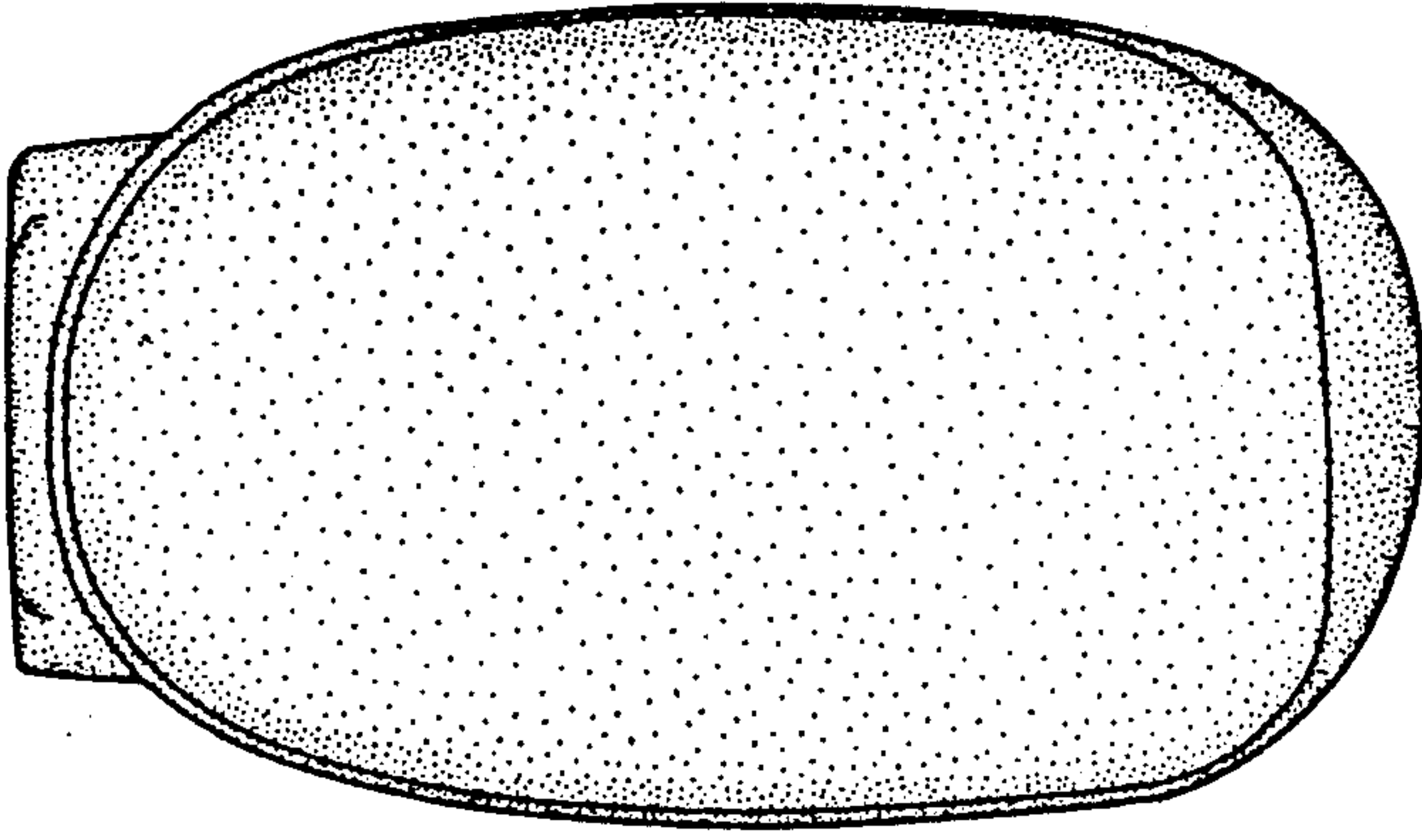

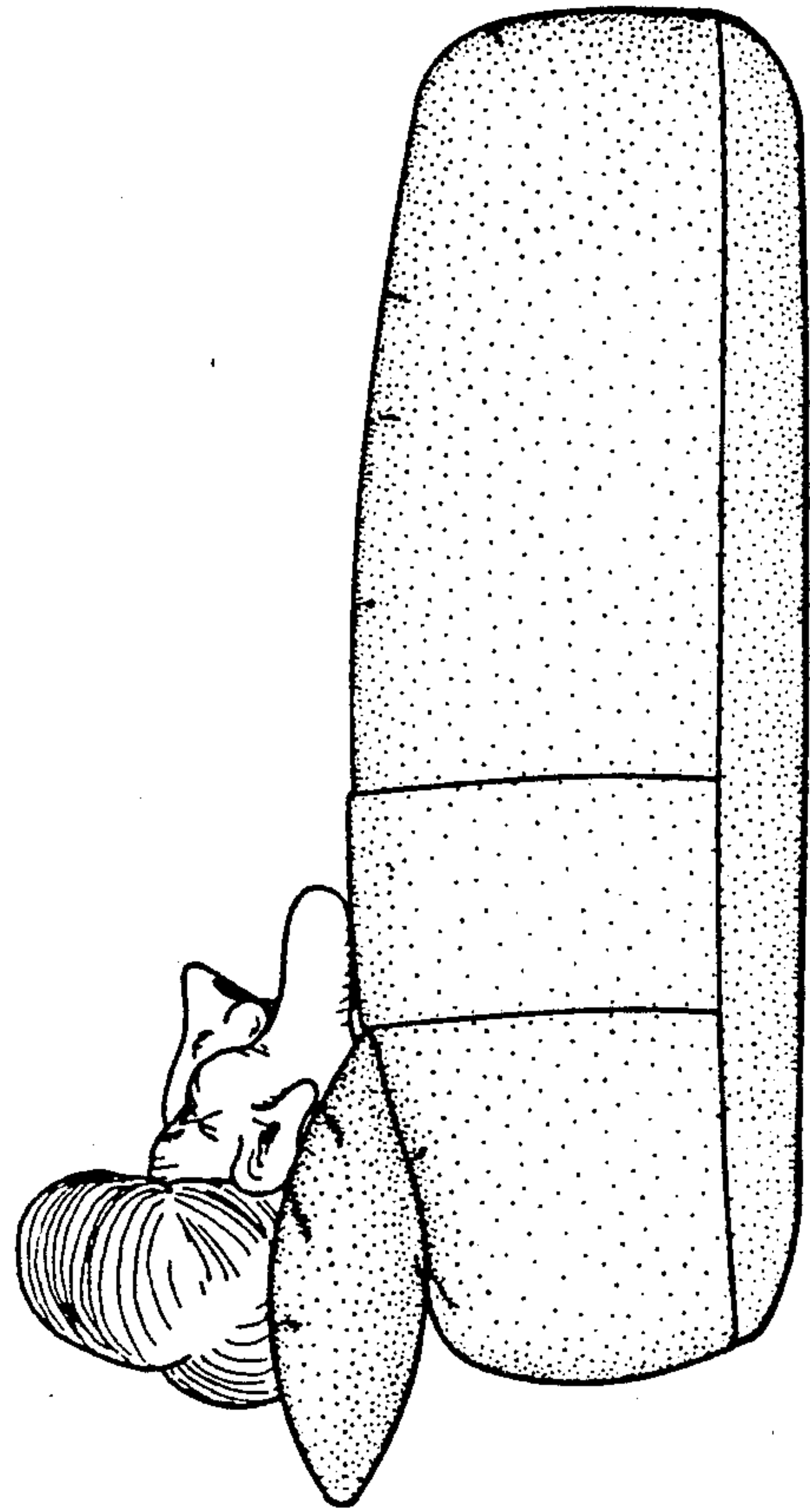
