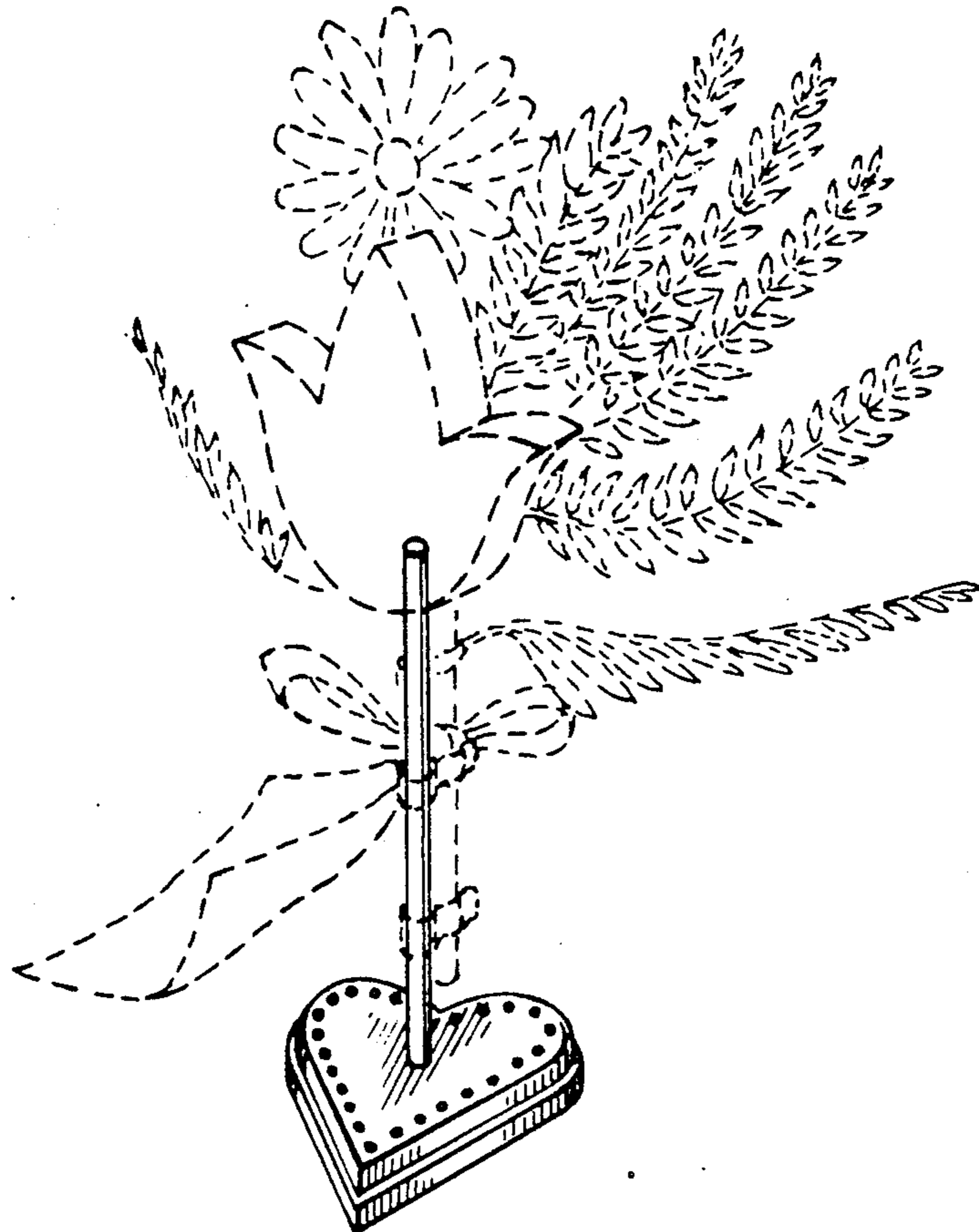

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a flower stand showing my new design the broken line showing in FIG. 1 being for illustration purposes only; FIG. 2 is an enlarged right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary rear elevational view wherein the upper portion has been omitted for convenience of illustration.



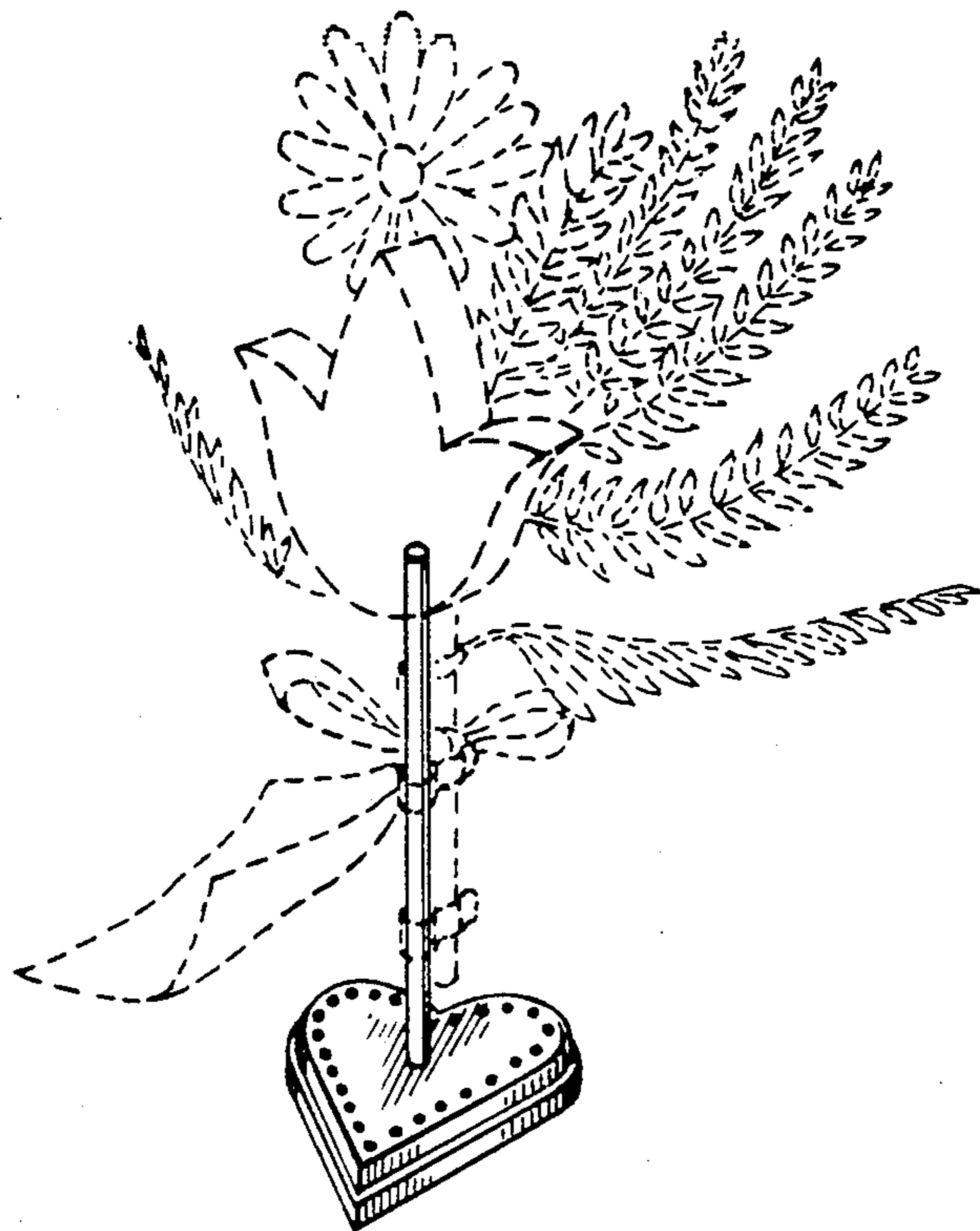

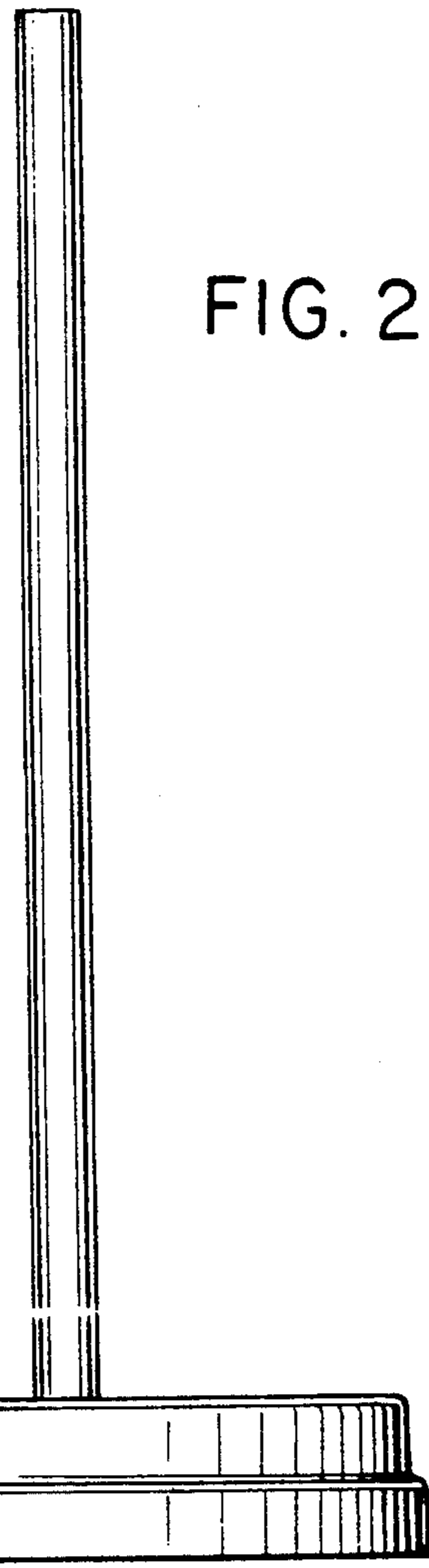

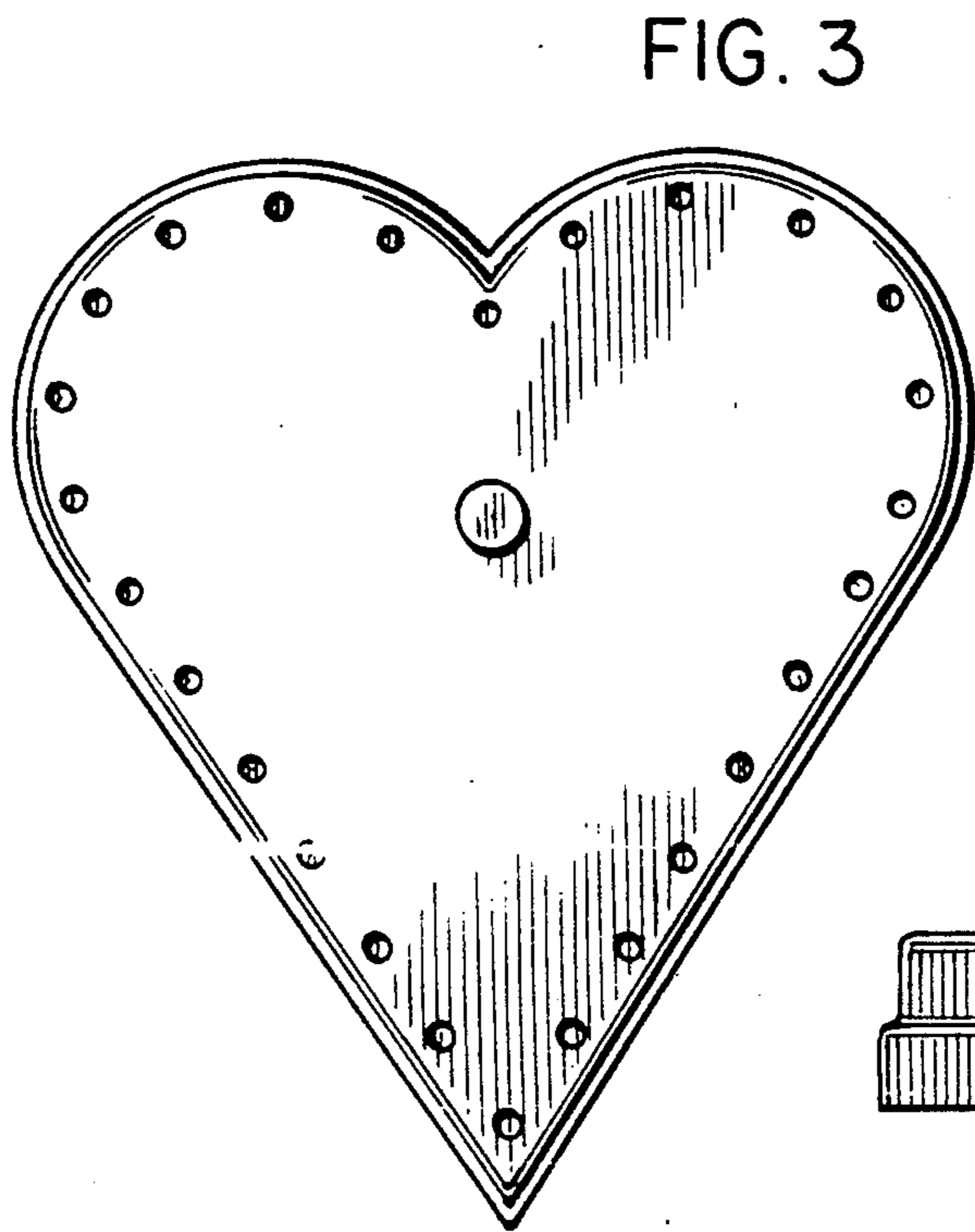

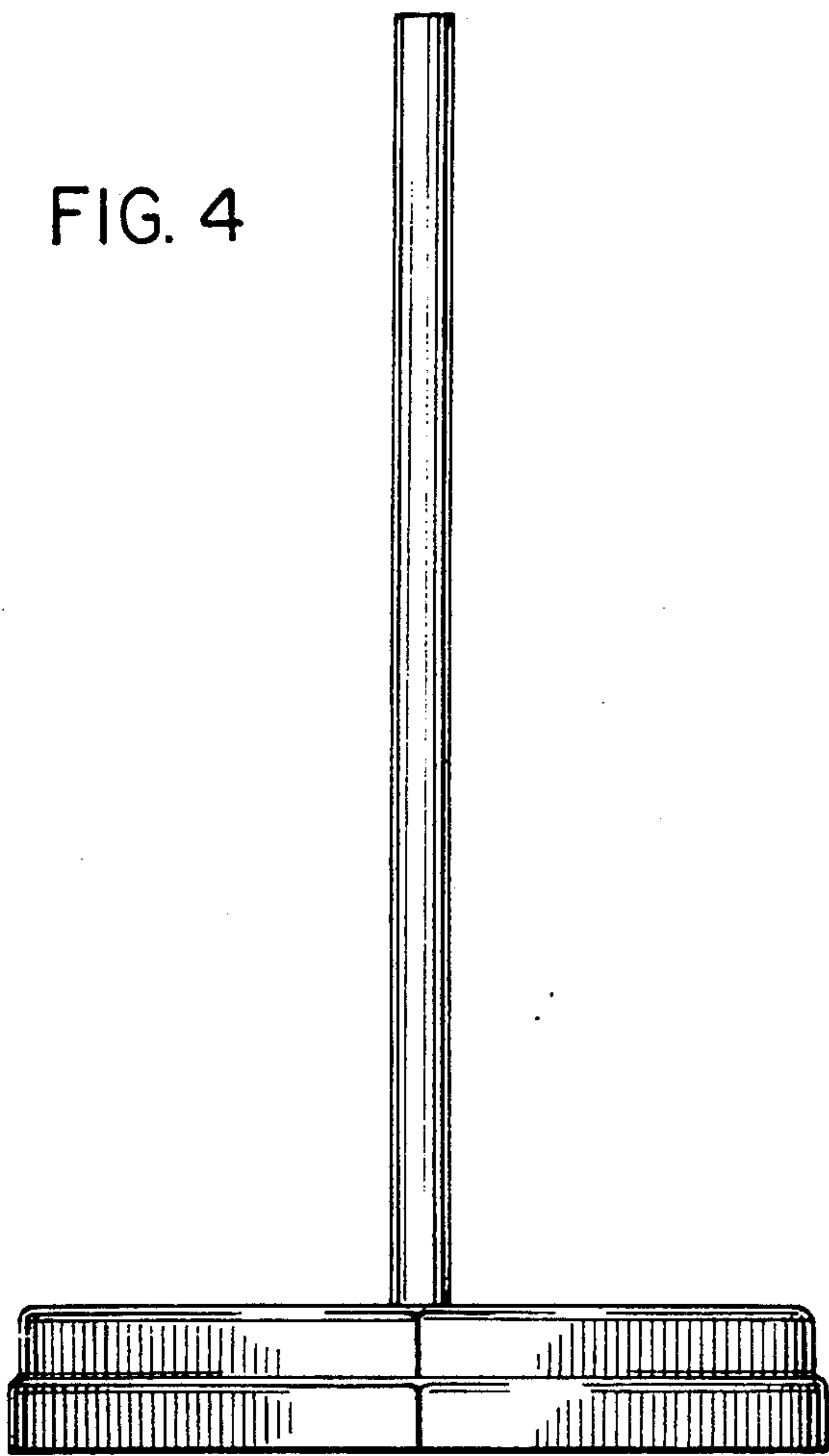

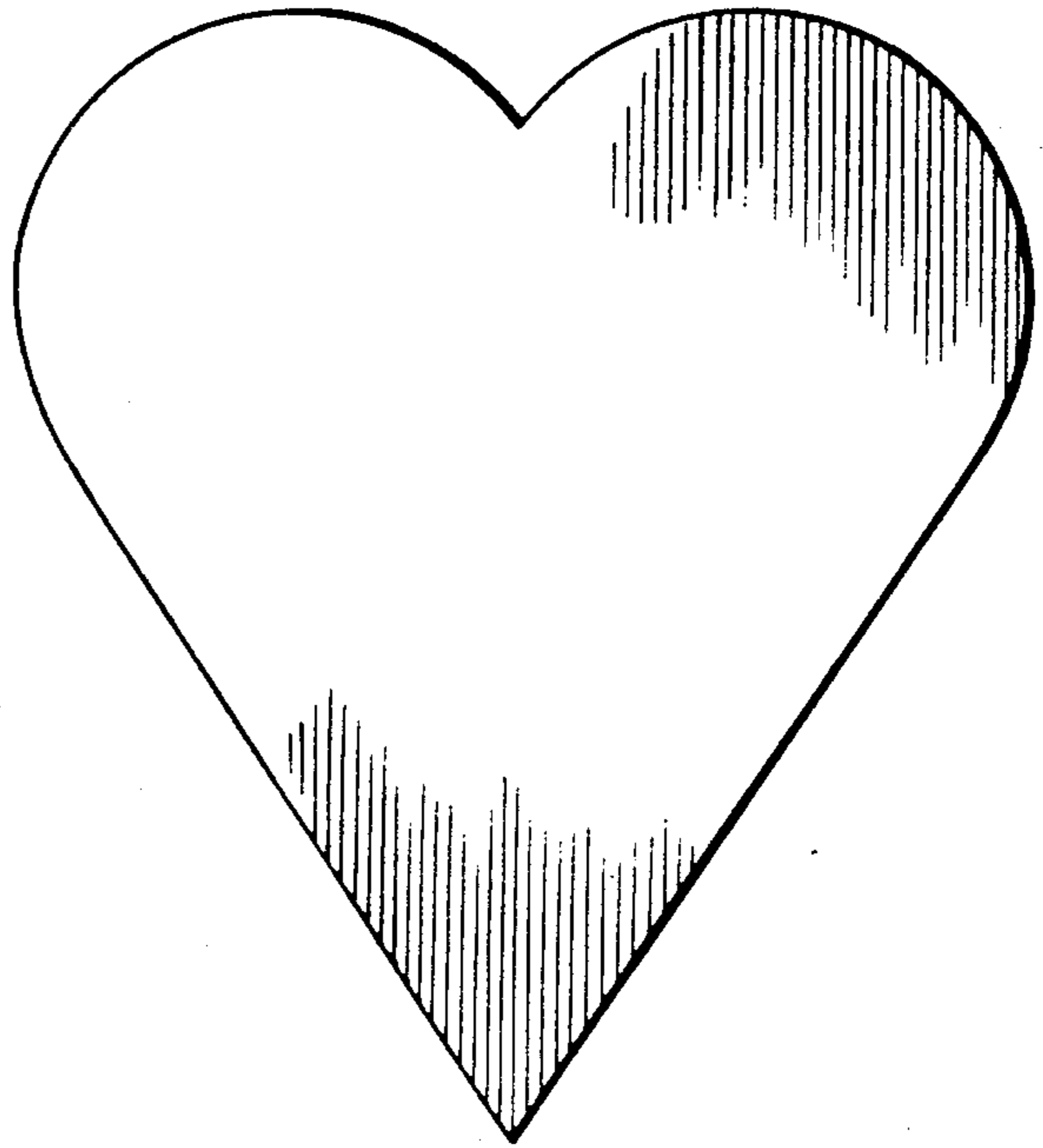
