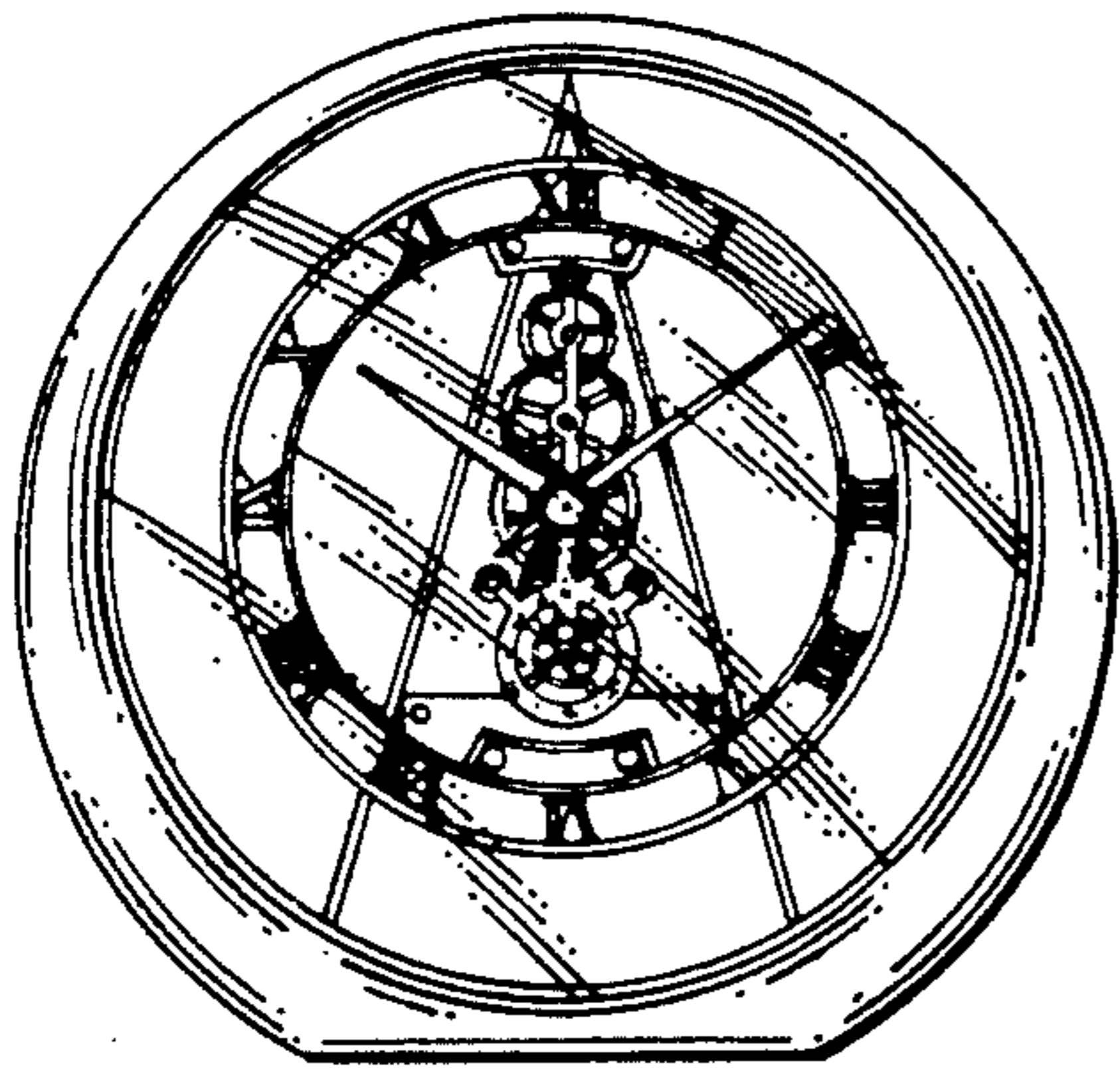

The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

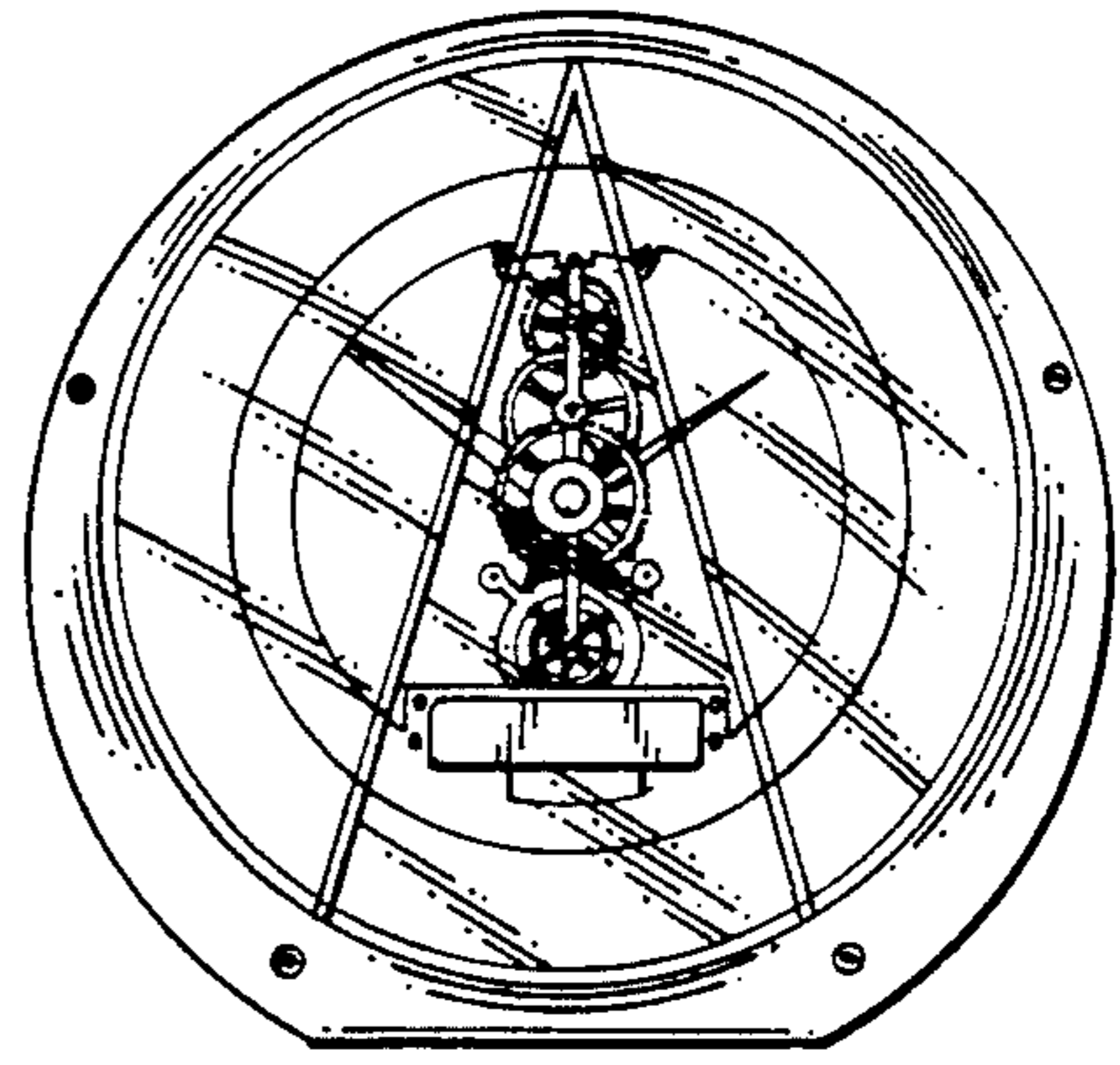
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a front right perspective view thereof.

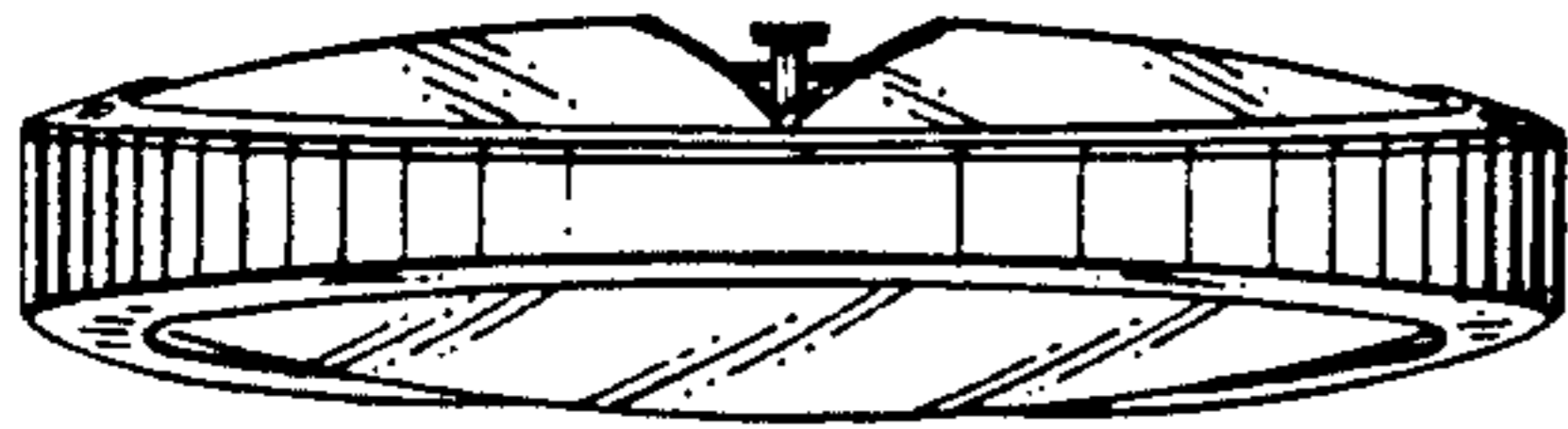




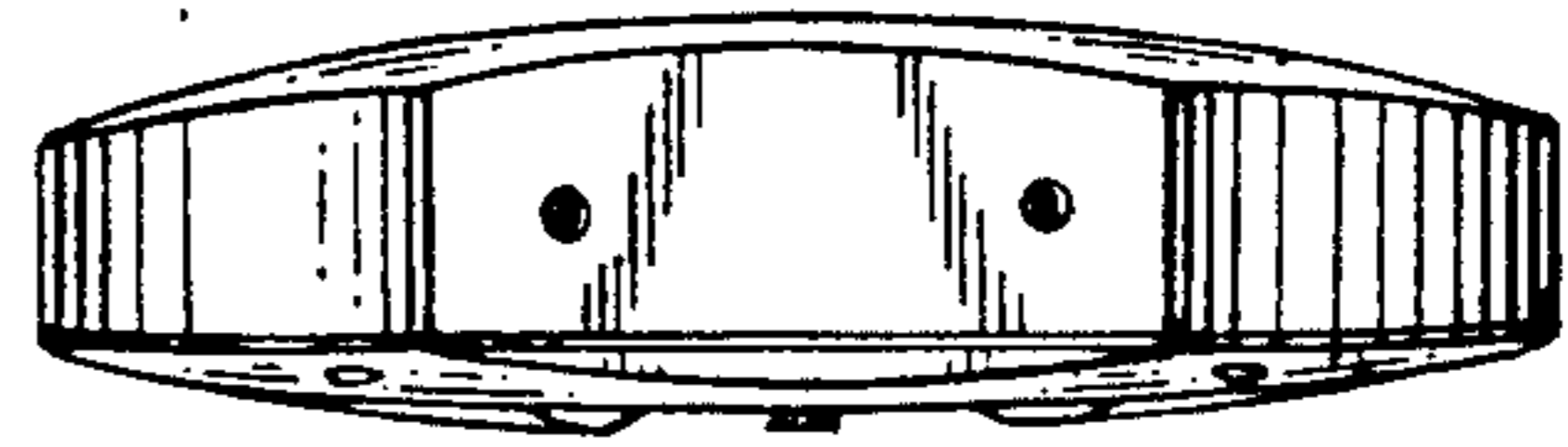

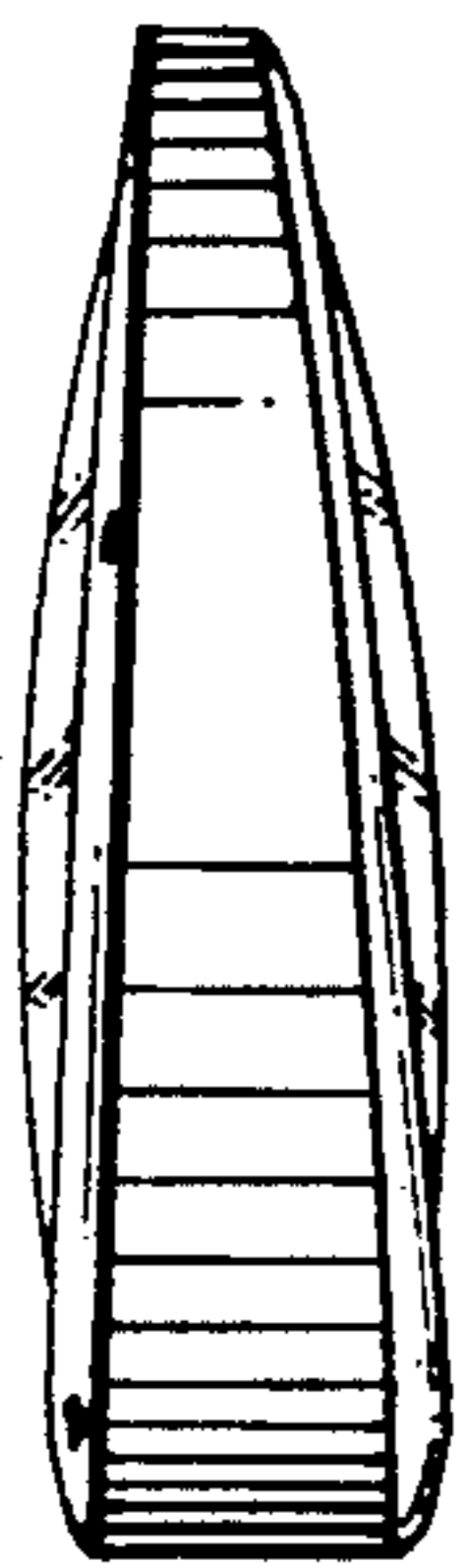

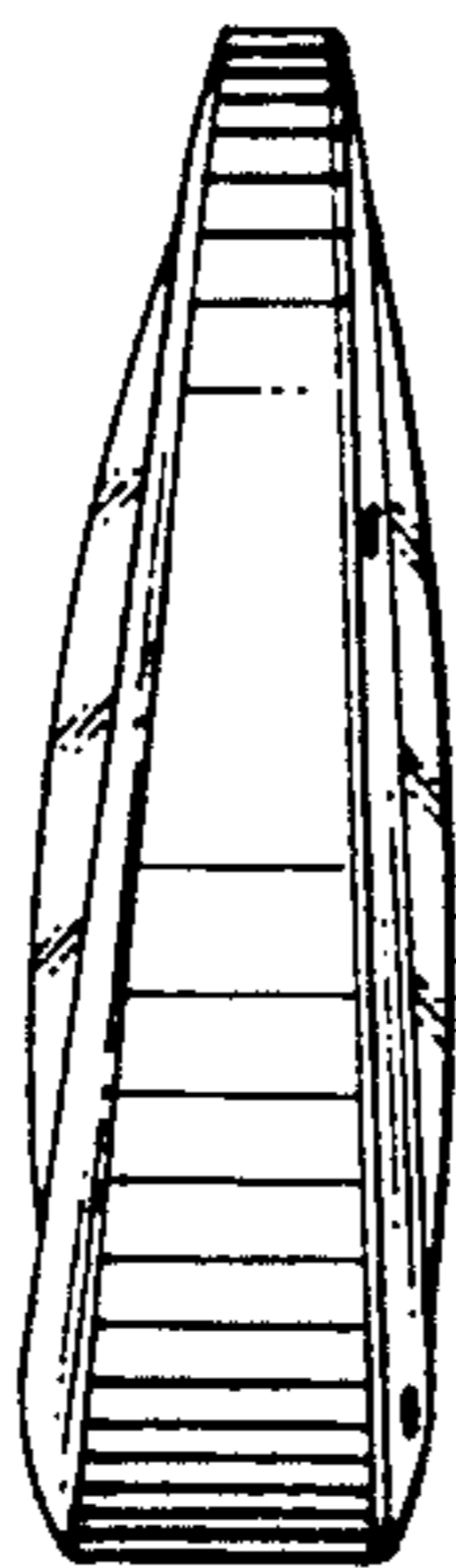

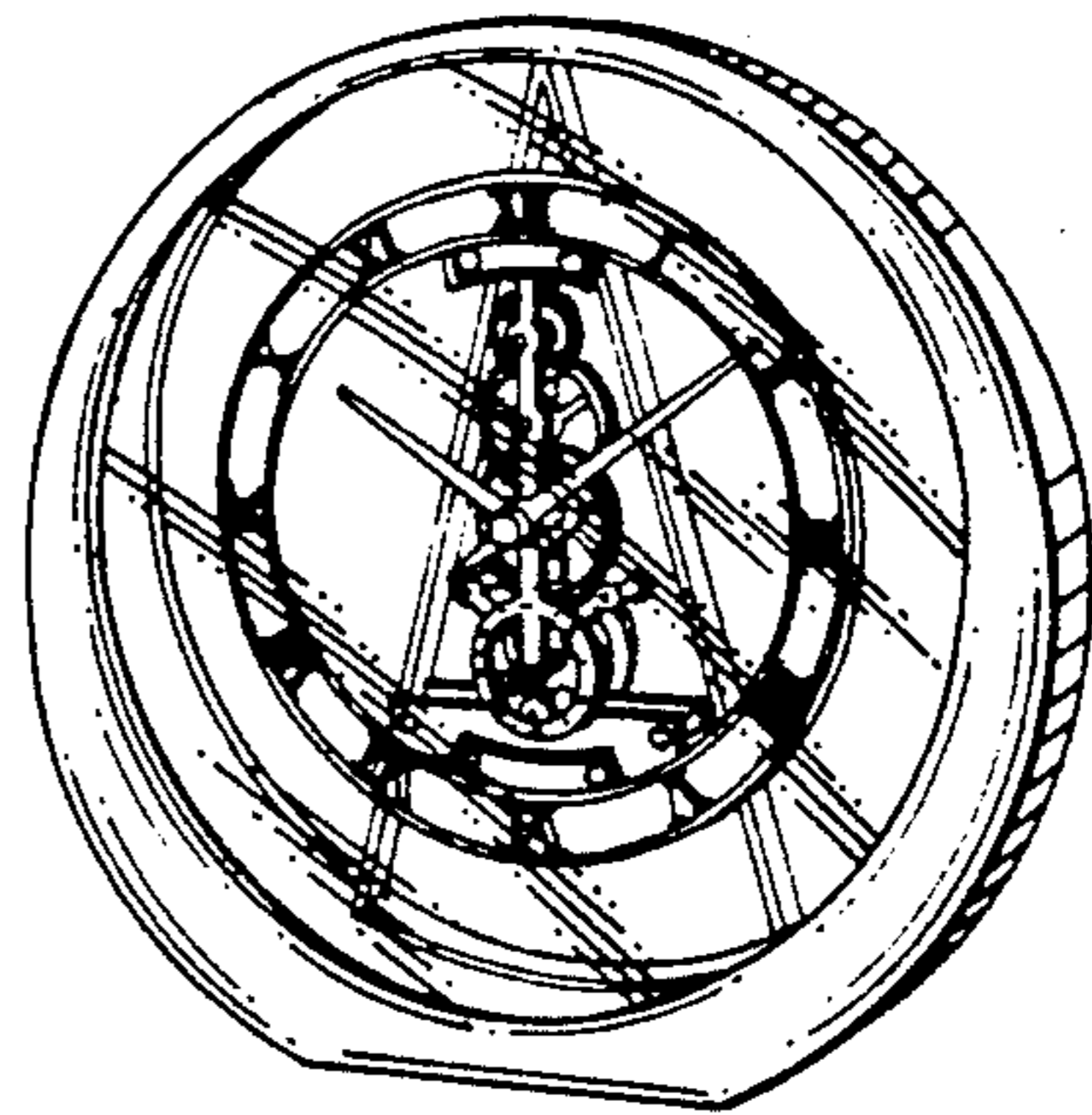
