The ornamental design for a notebook, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a notebook showing my new design in a partially open position;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof in a fully closed position;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof in a fully closed position;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof in a fully closed position;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof in a fully closed position;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof in a fully closed position;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof showing the front cover opened; and
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof showing the rear cover opened.

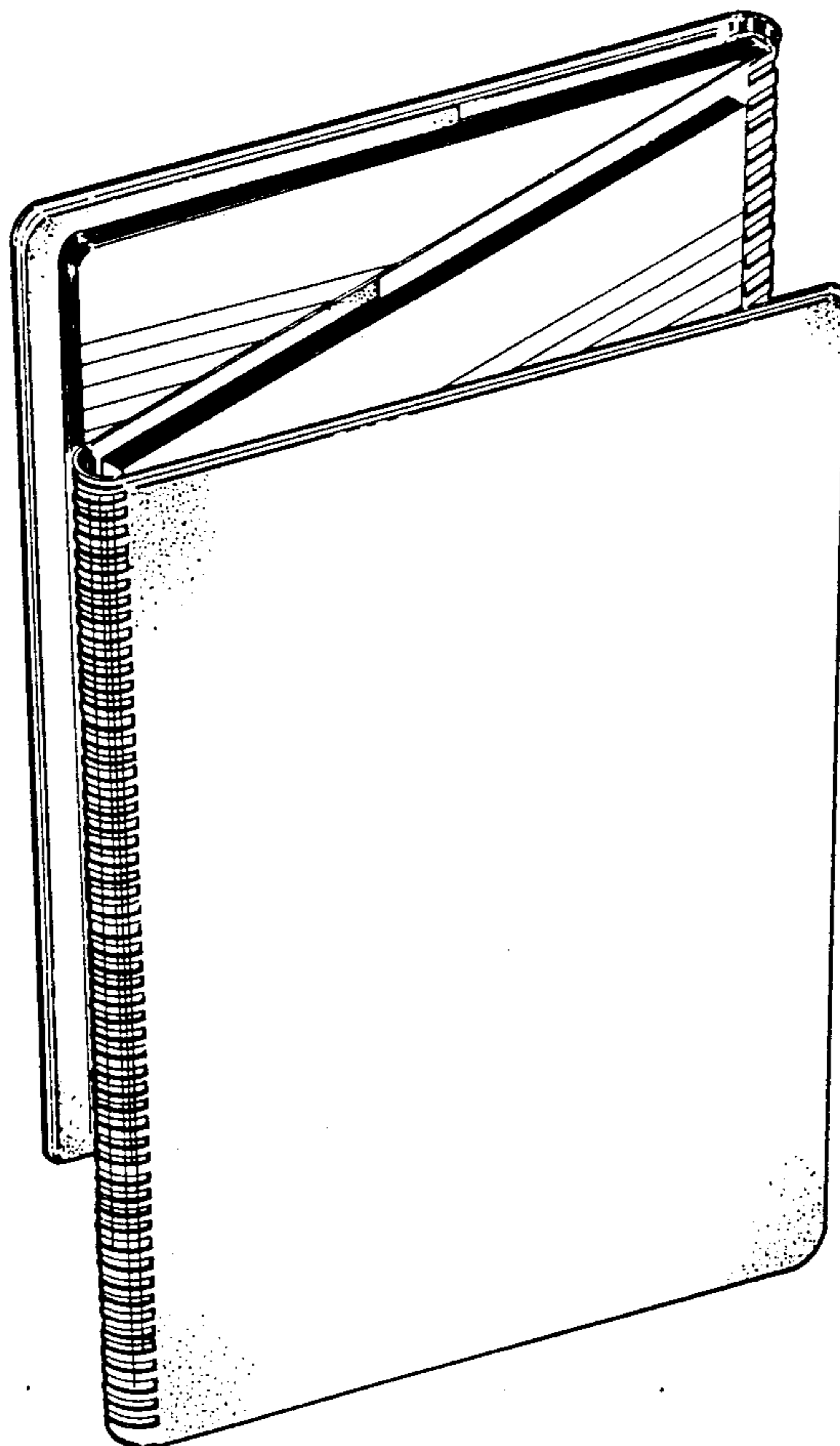

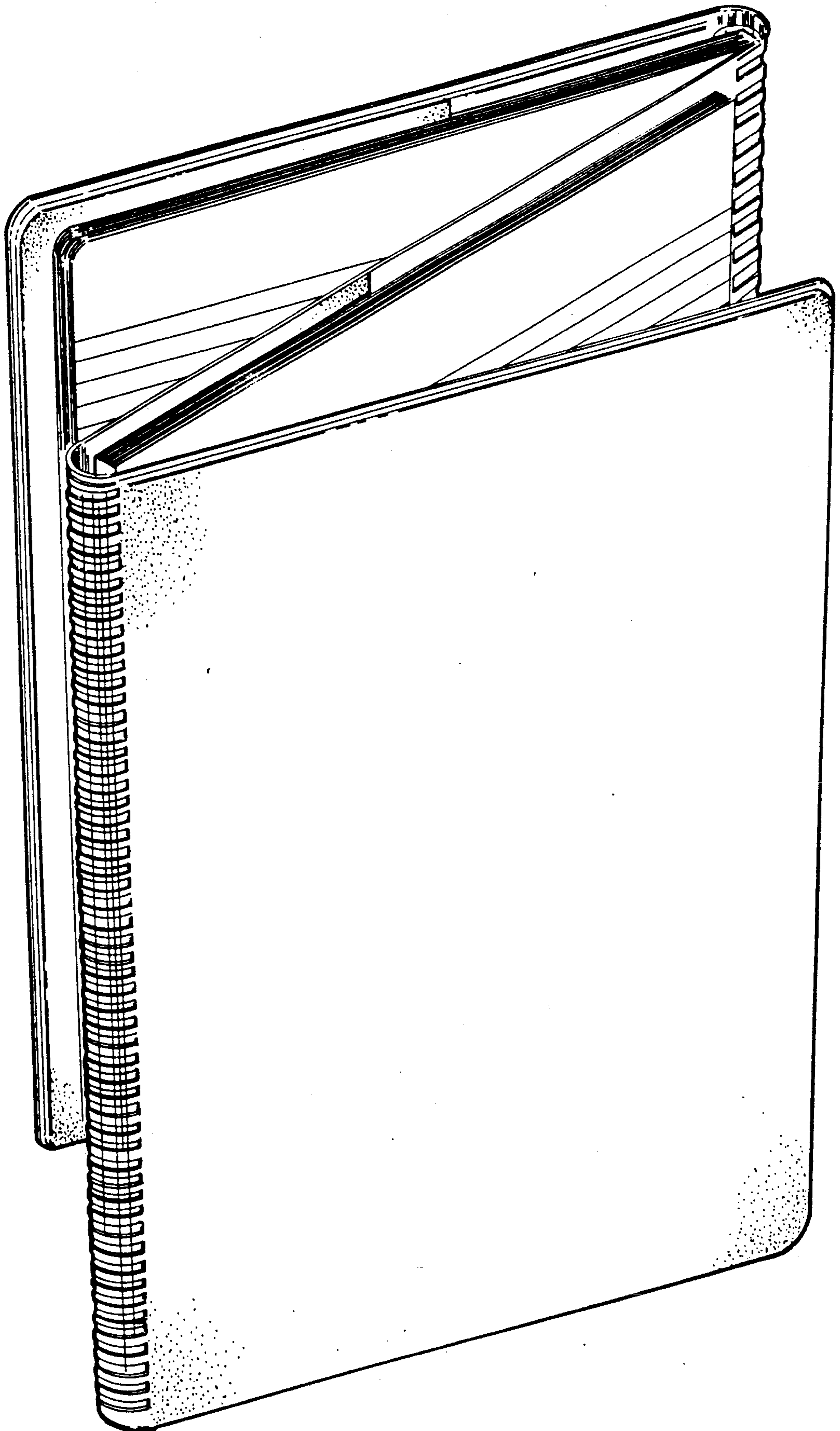

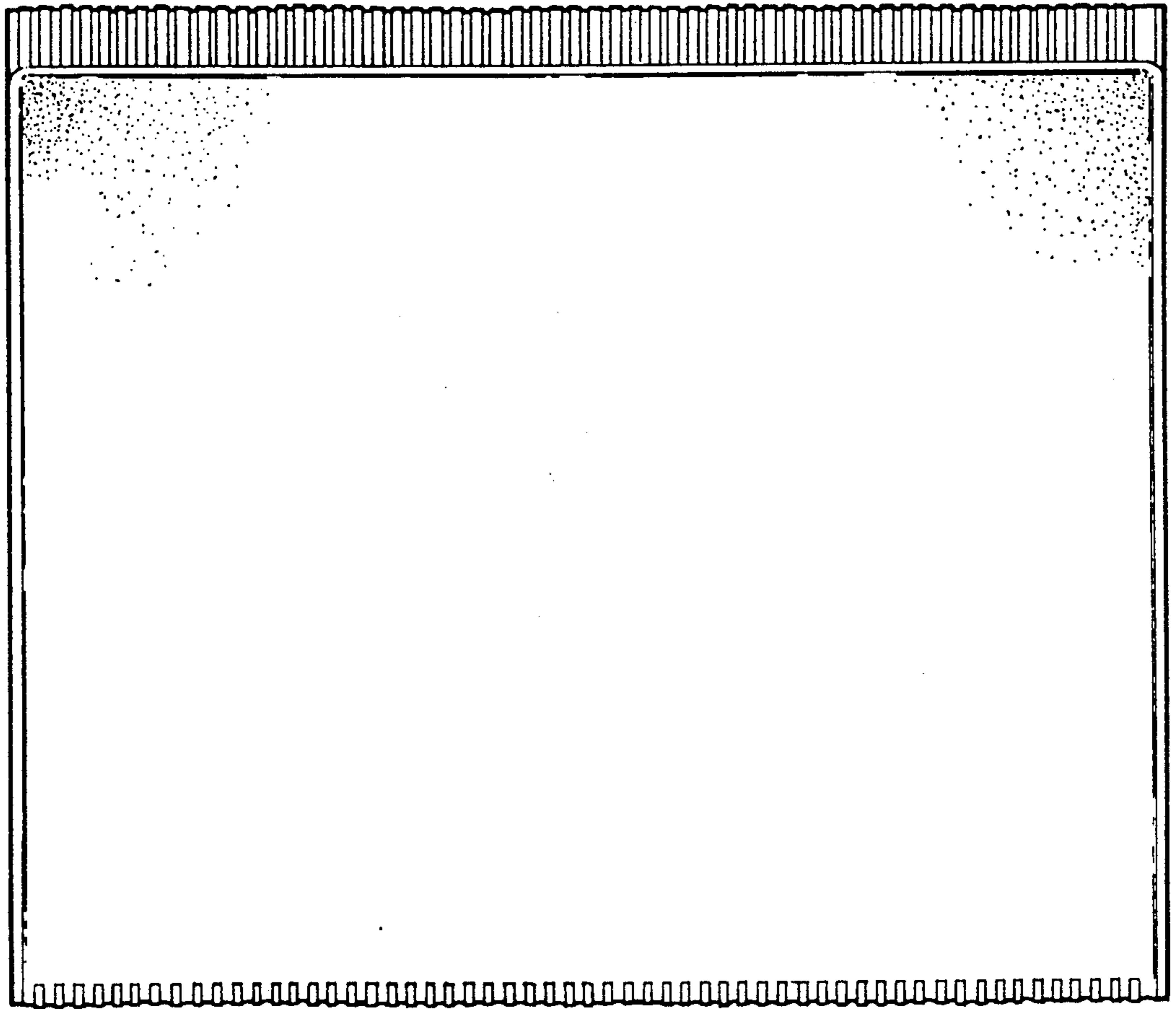

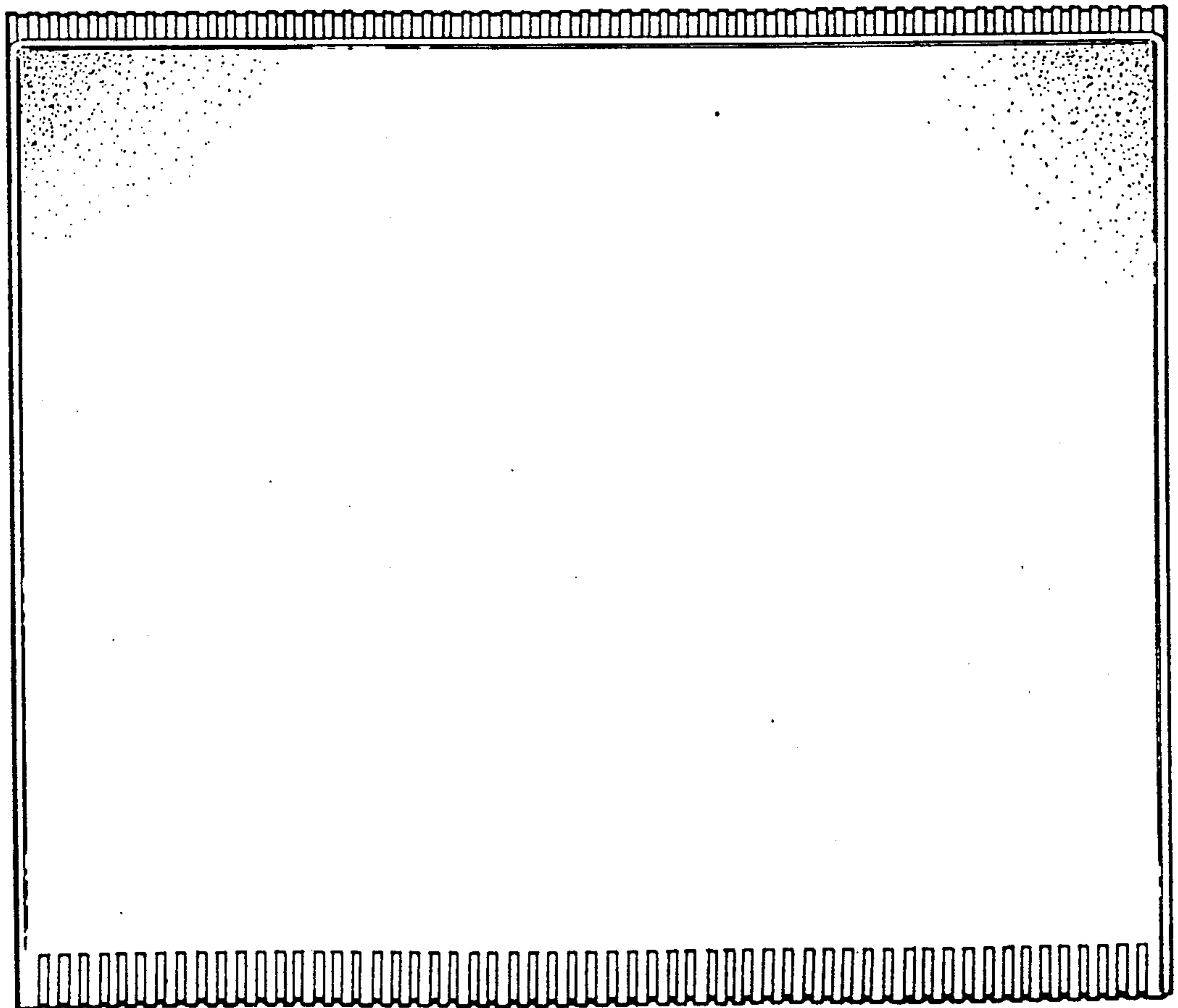

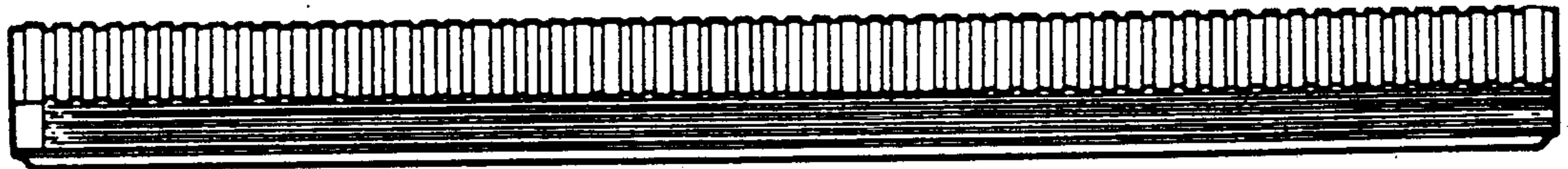

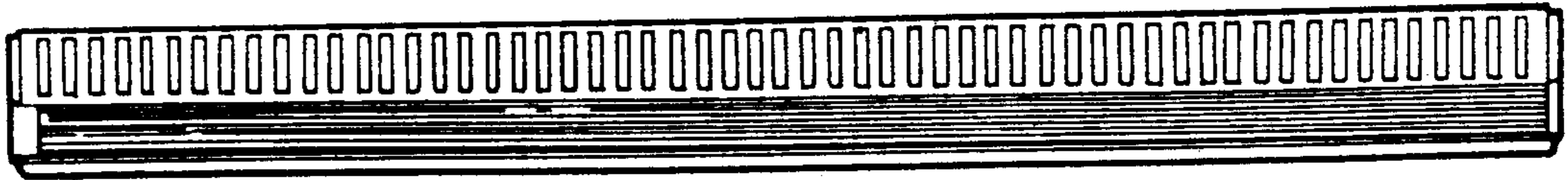

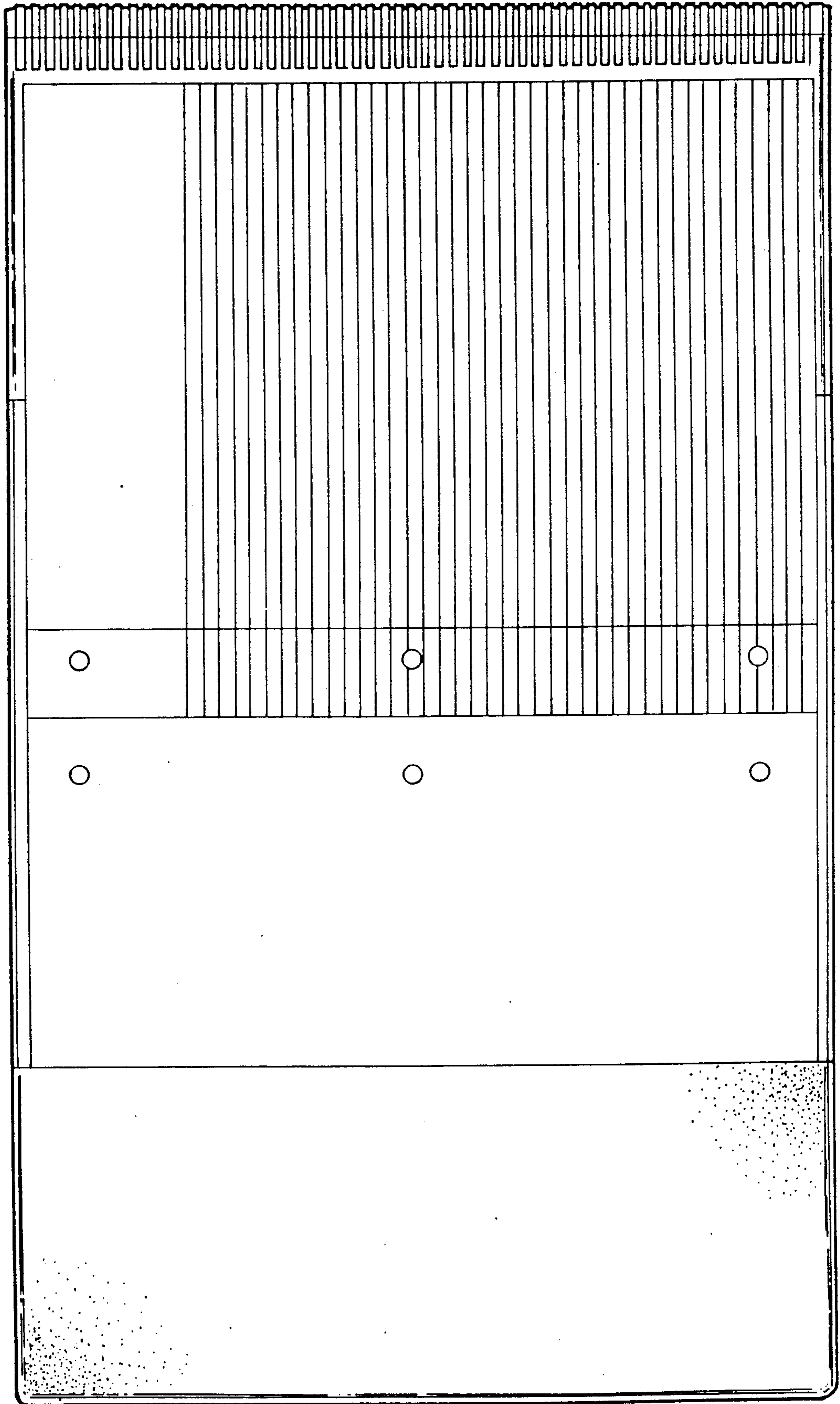

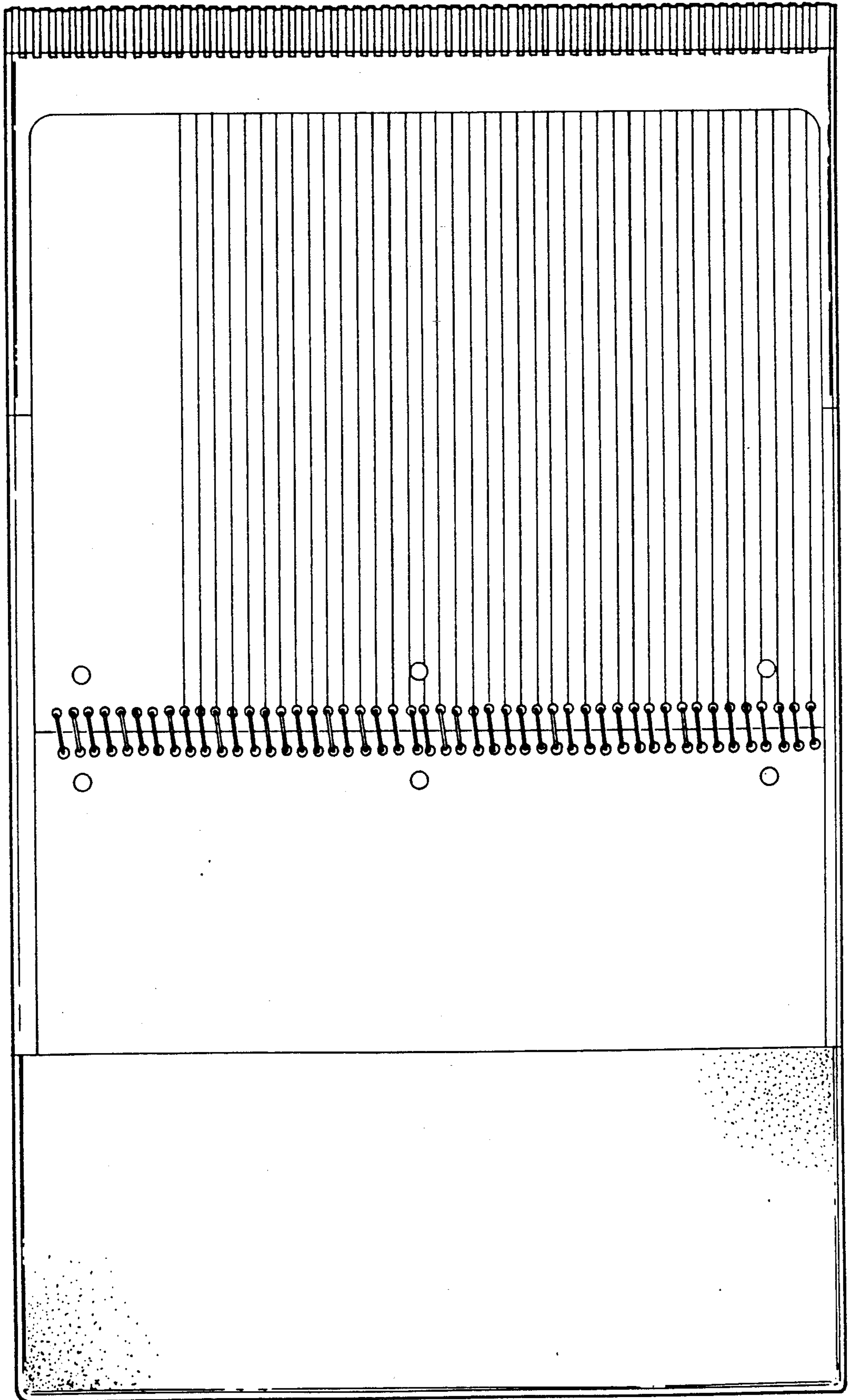
