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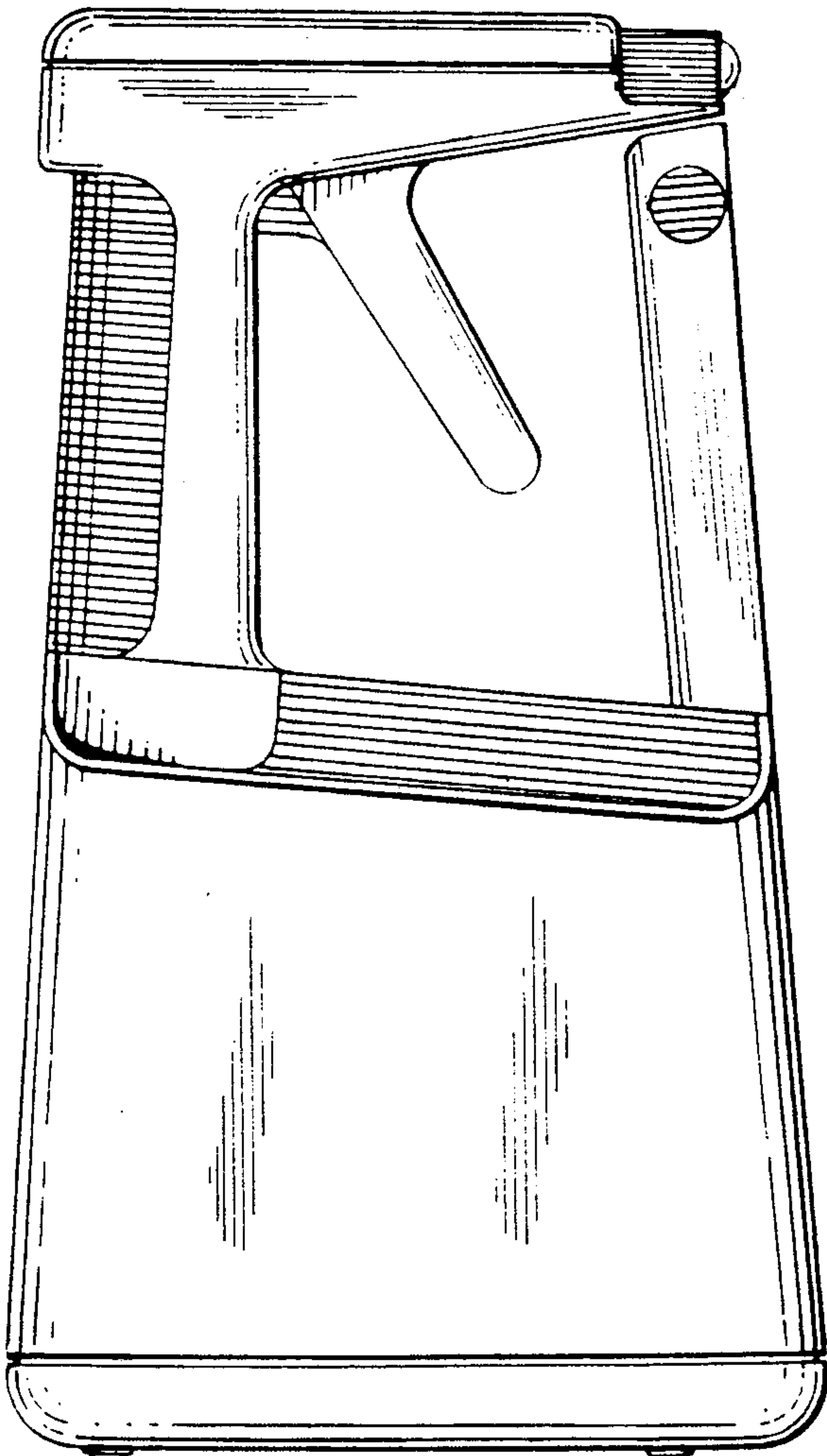
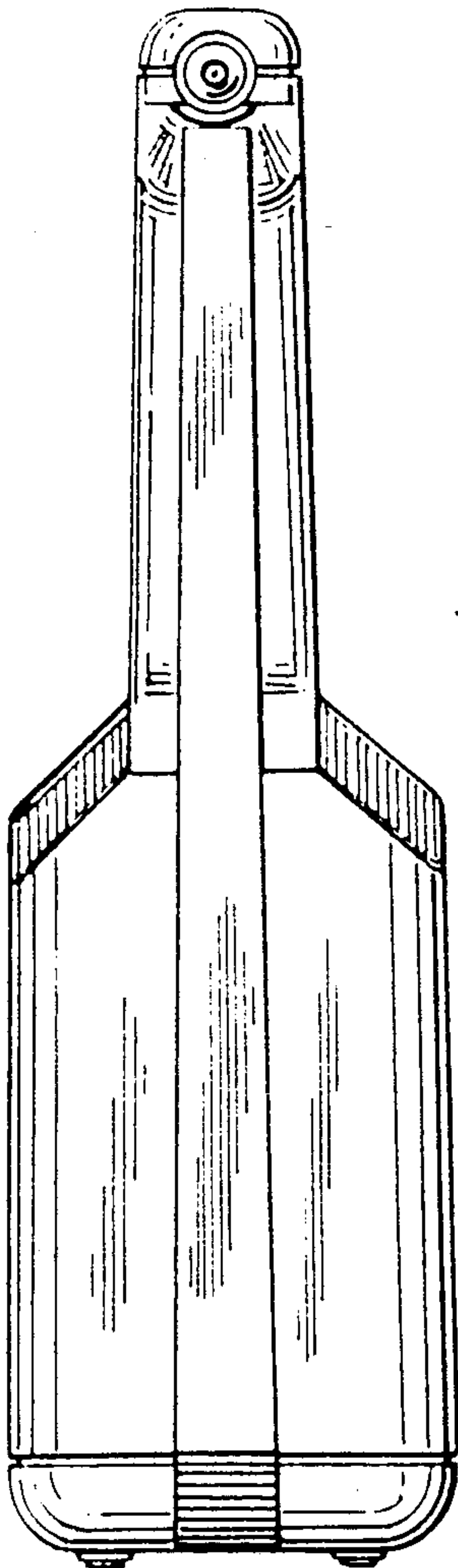
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined horticultural spray and watering can showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof, the spout shown in an alternative position; and
FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof.



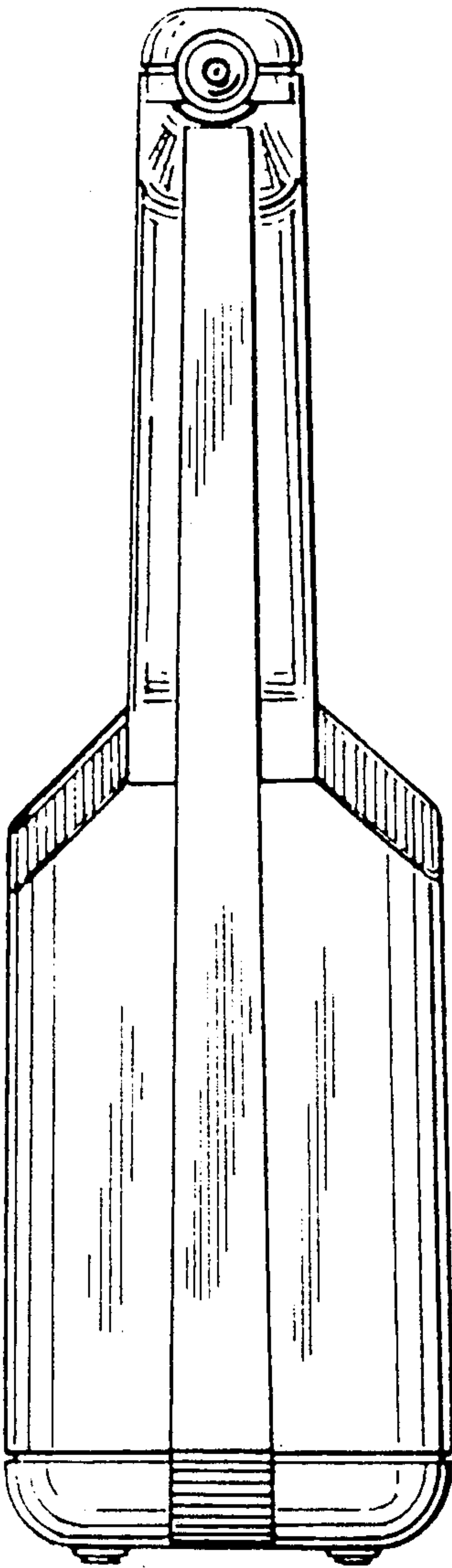

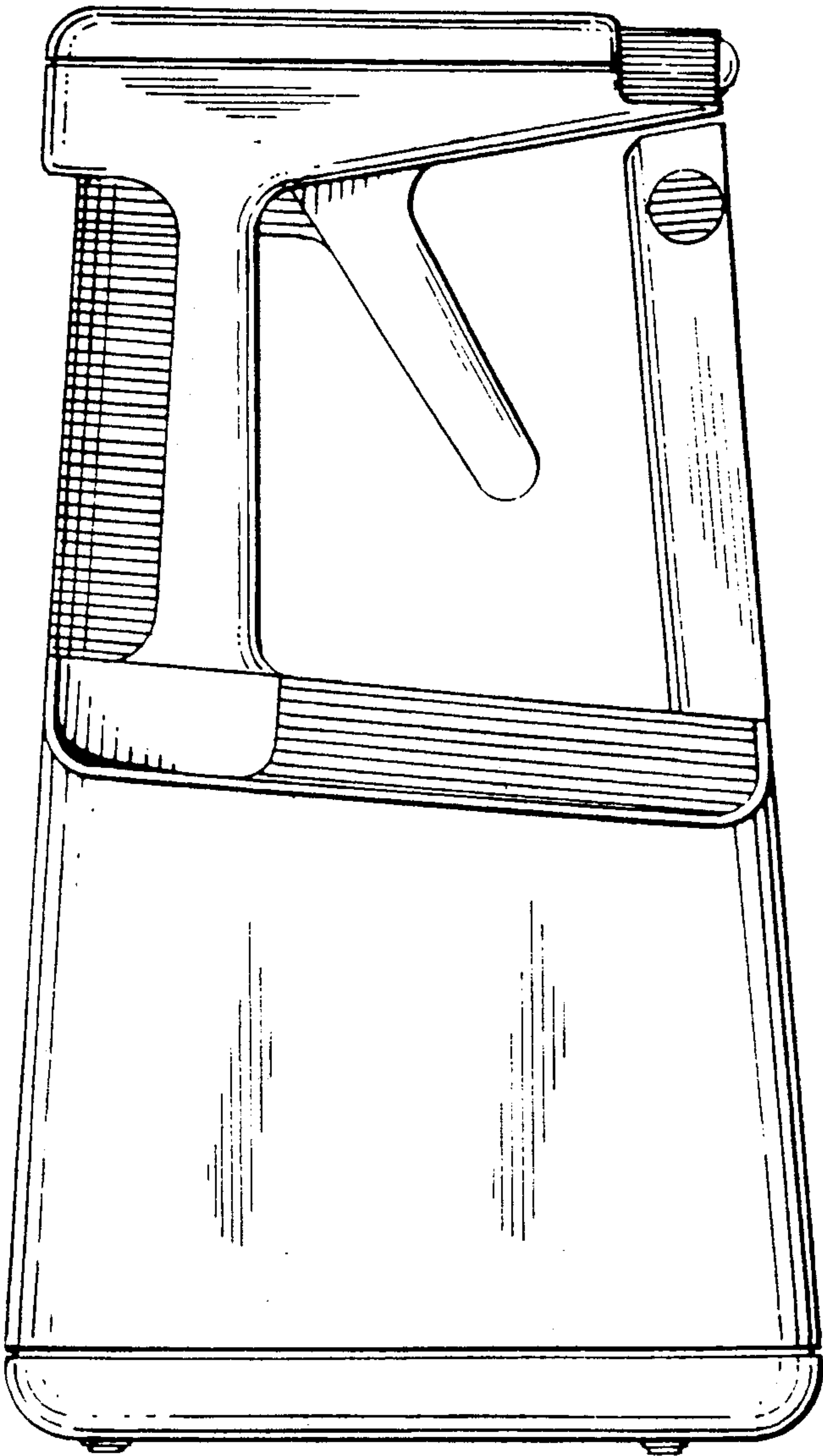

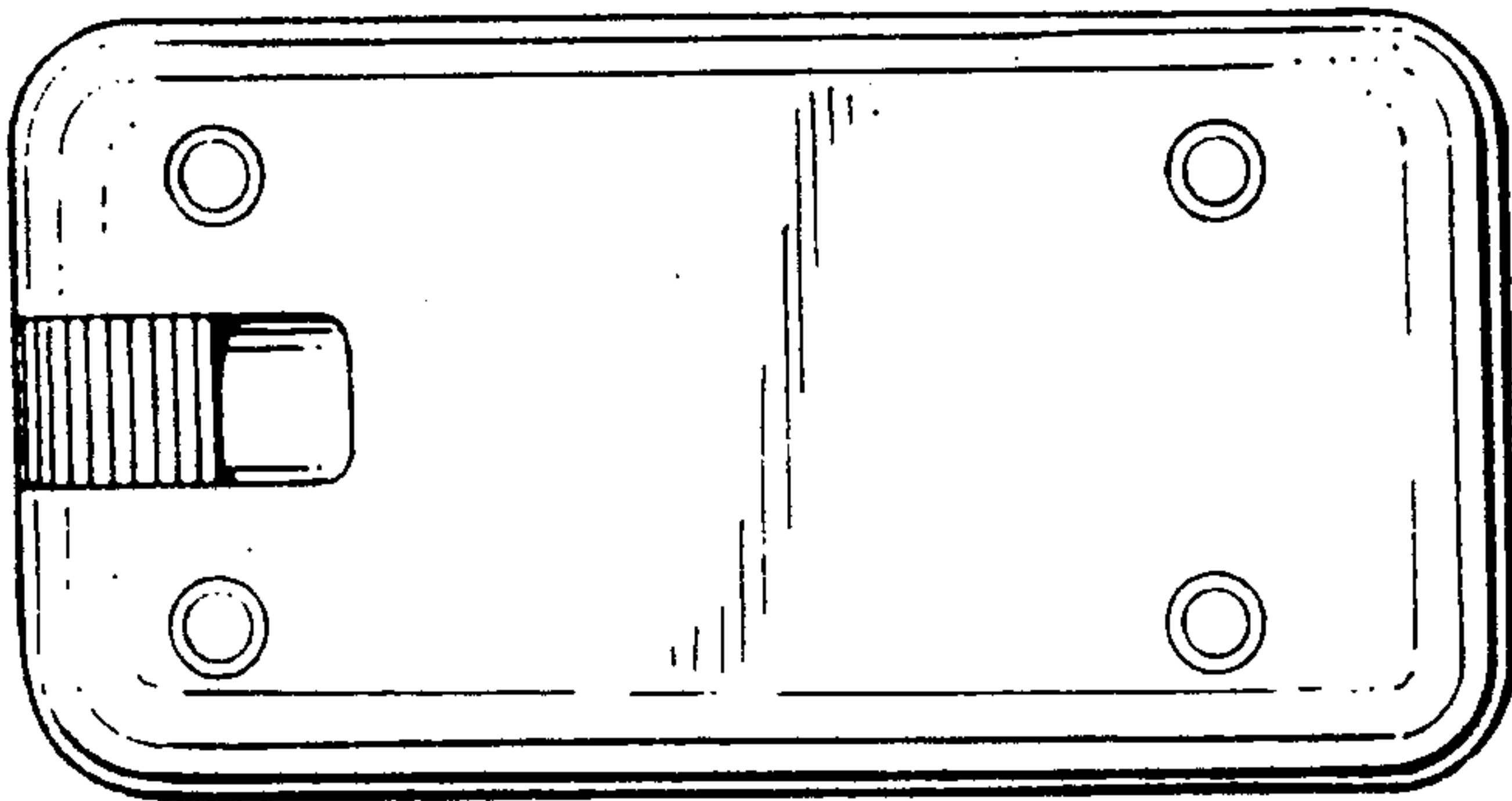

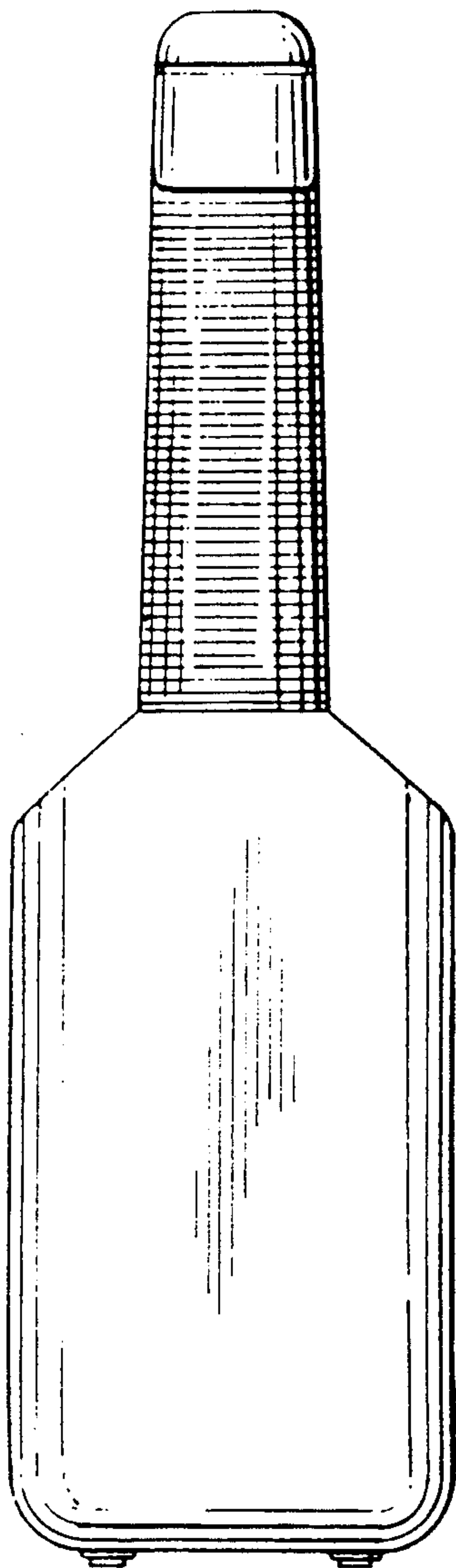

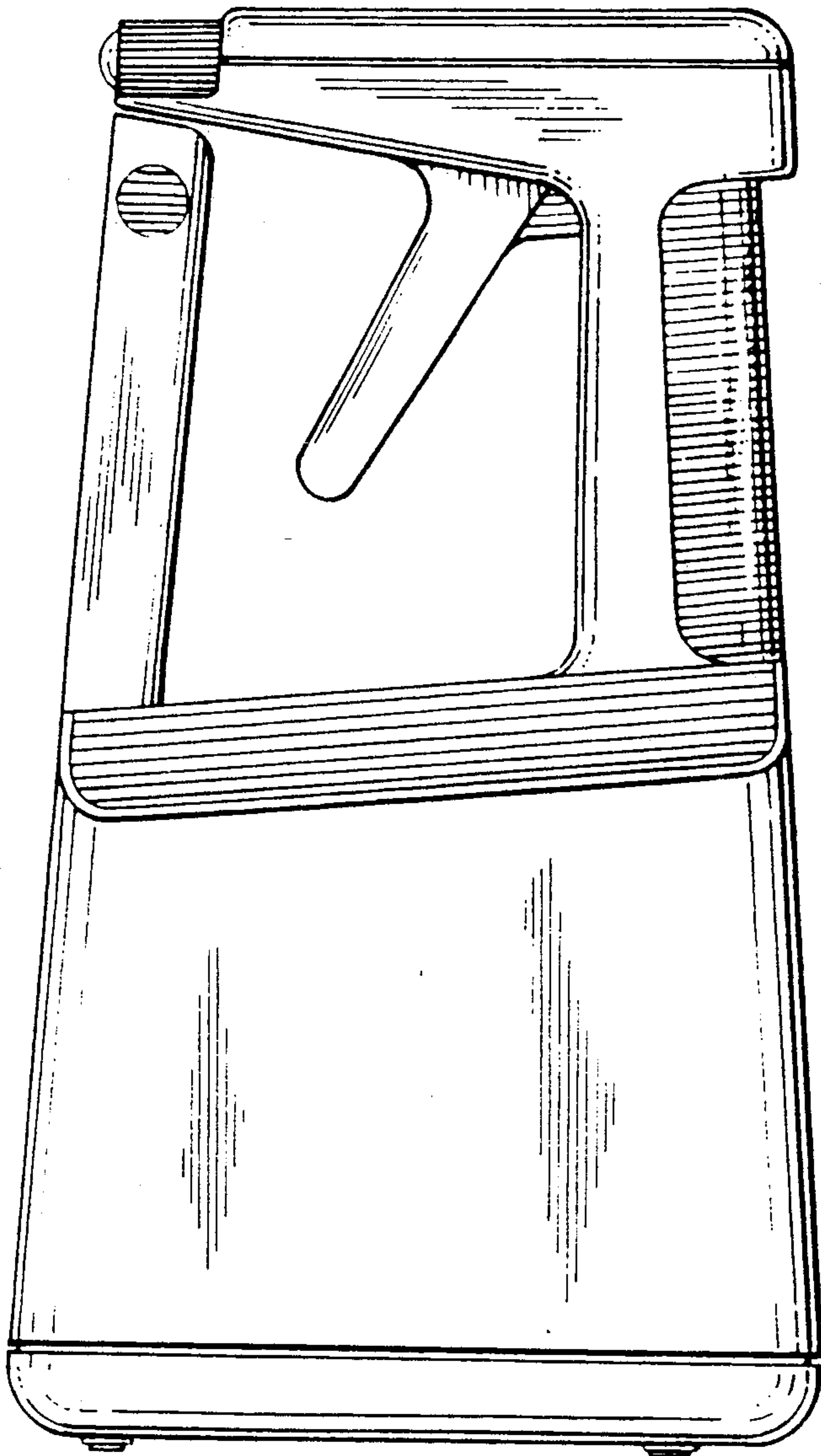

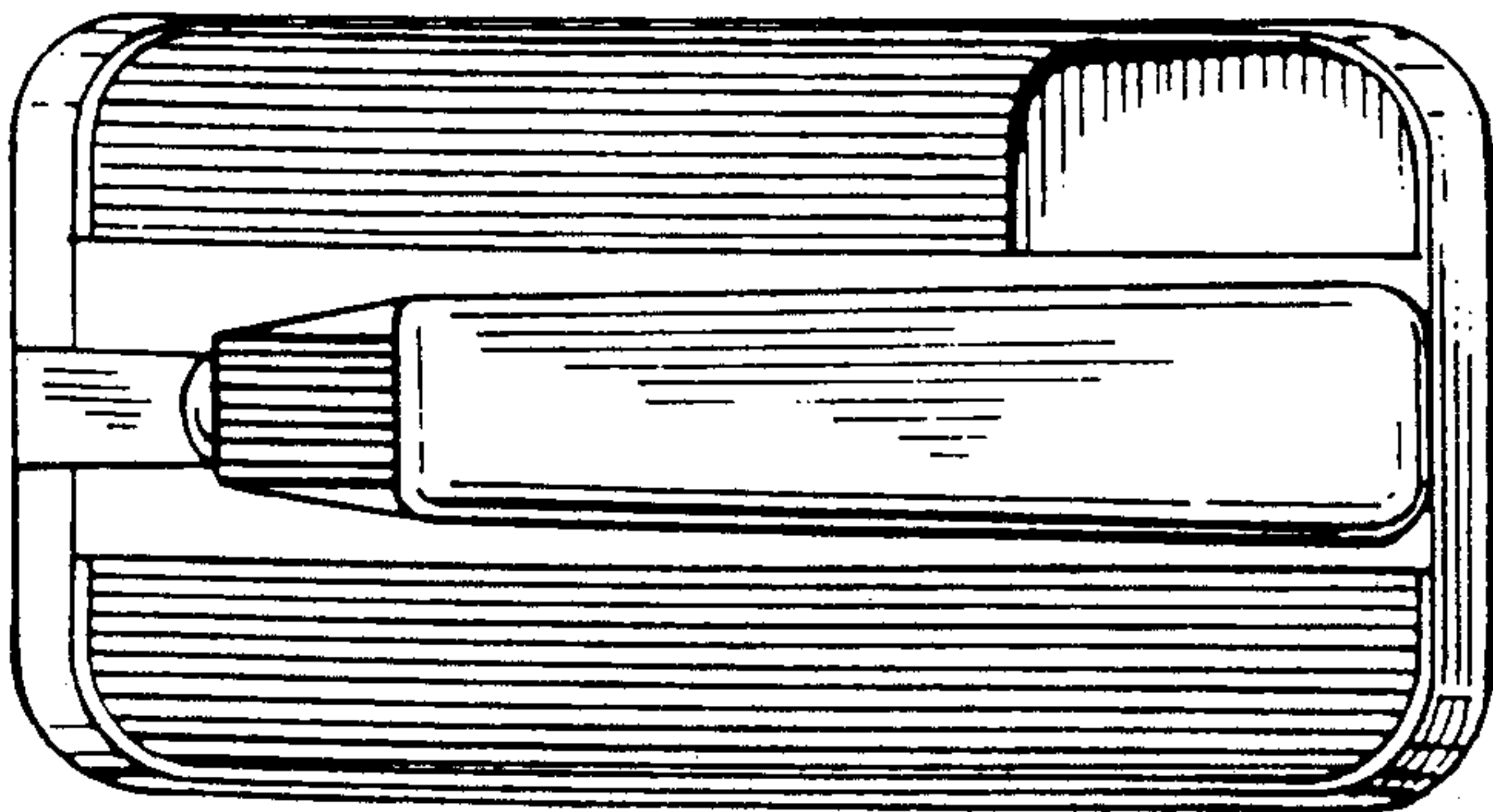
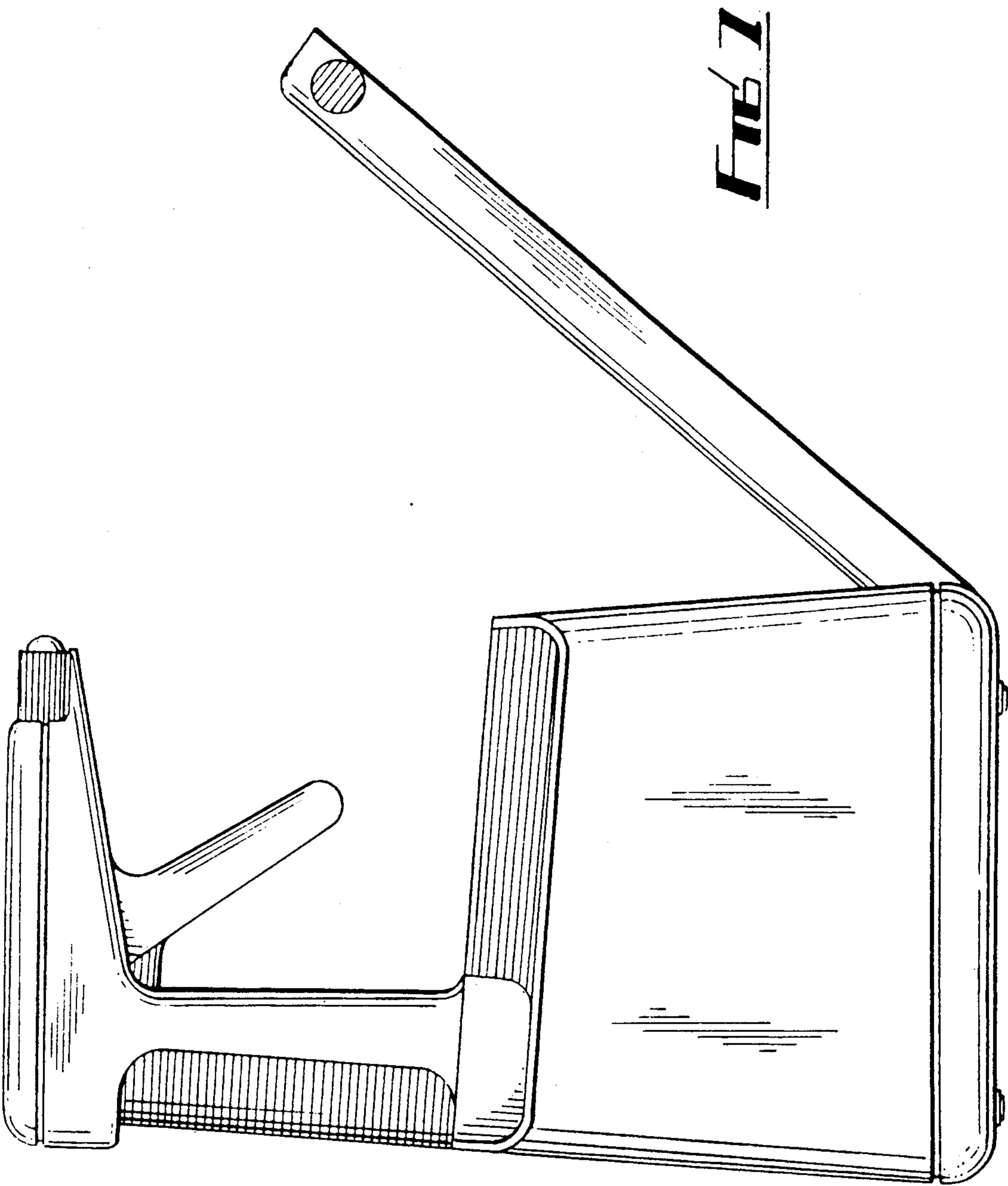

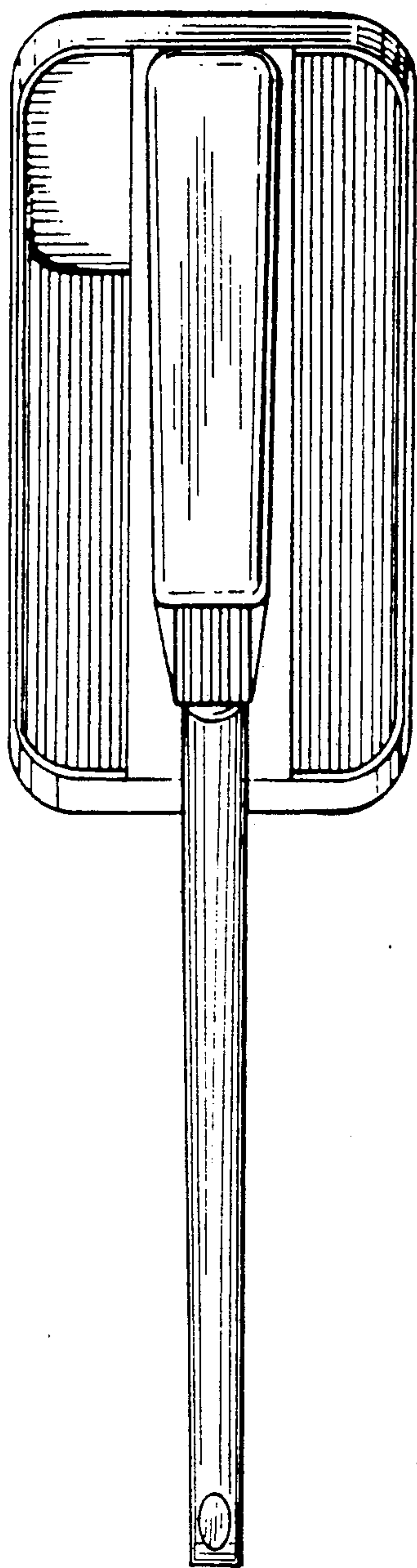
