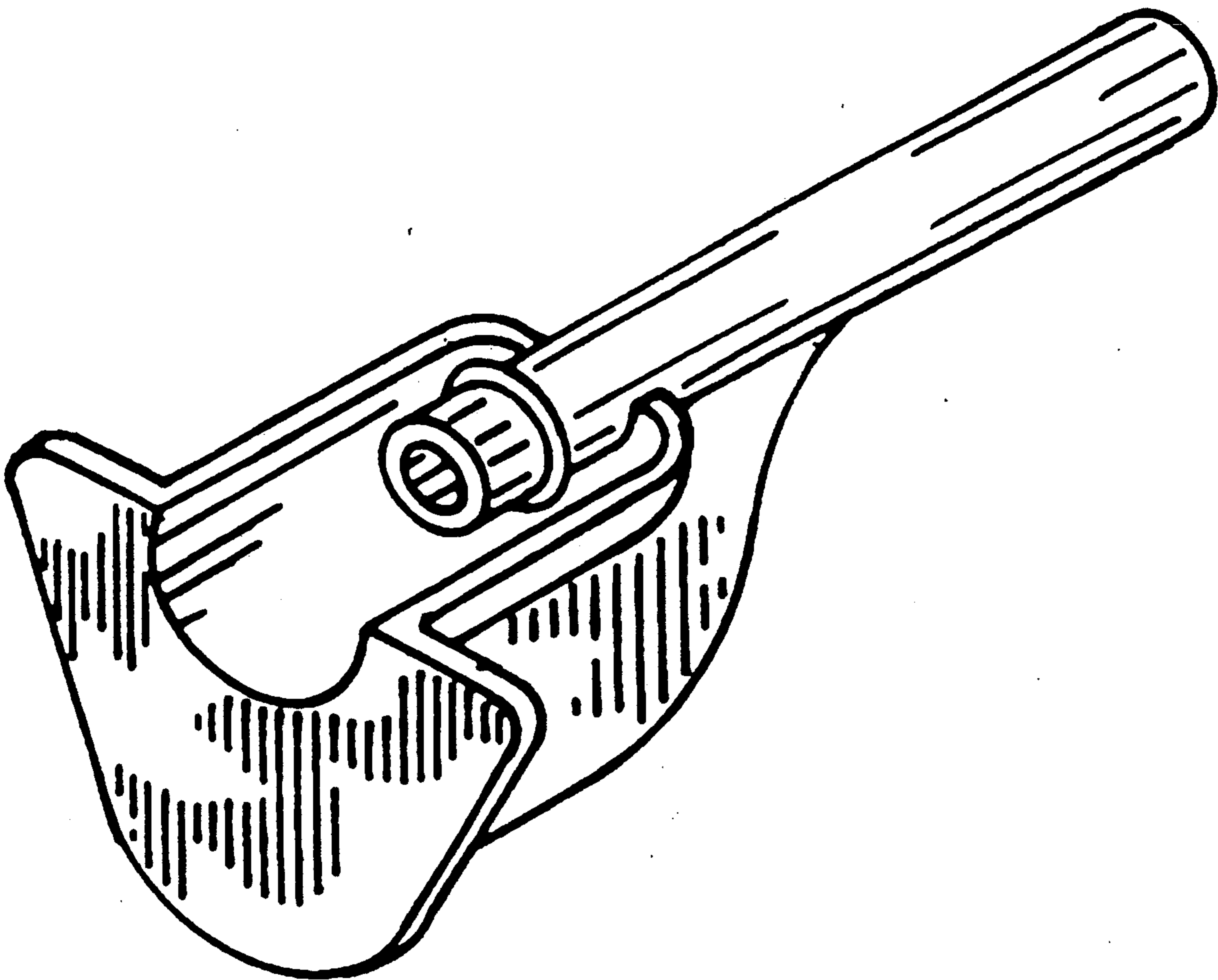

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a needle safety guard, showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



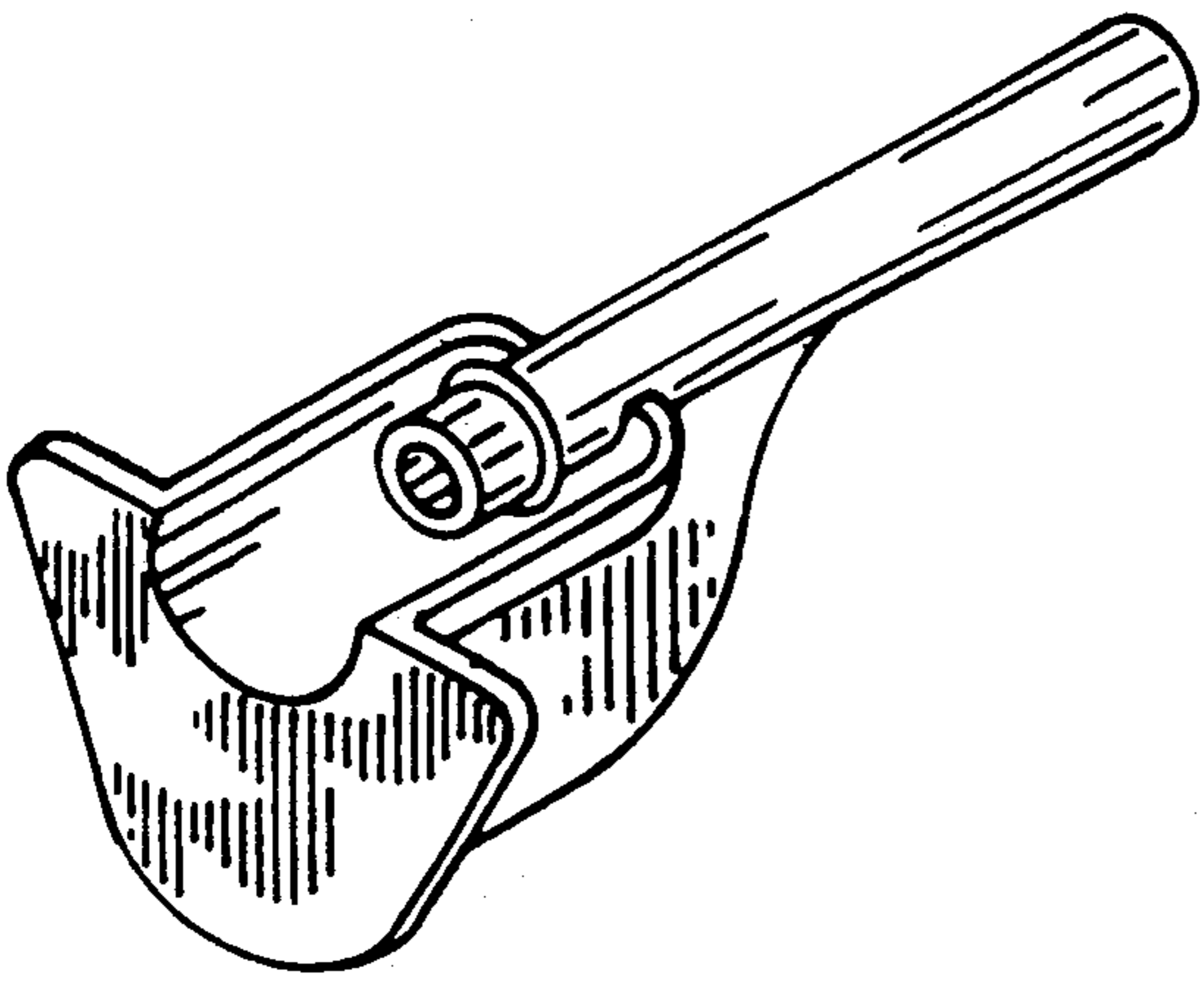

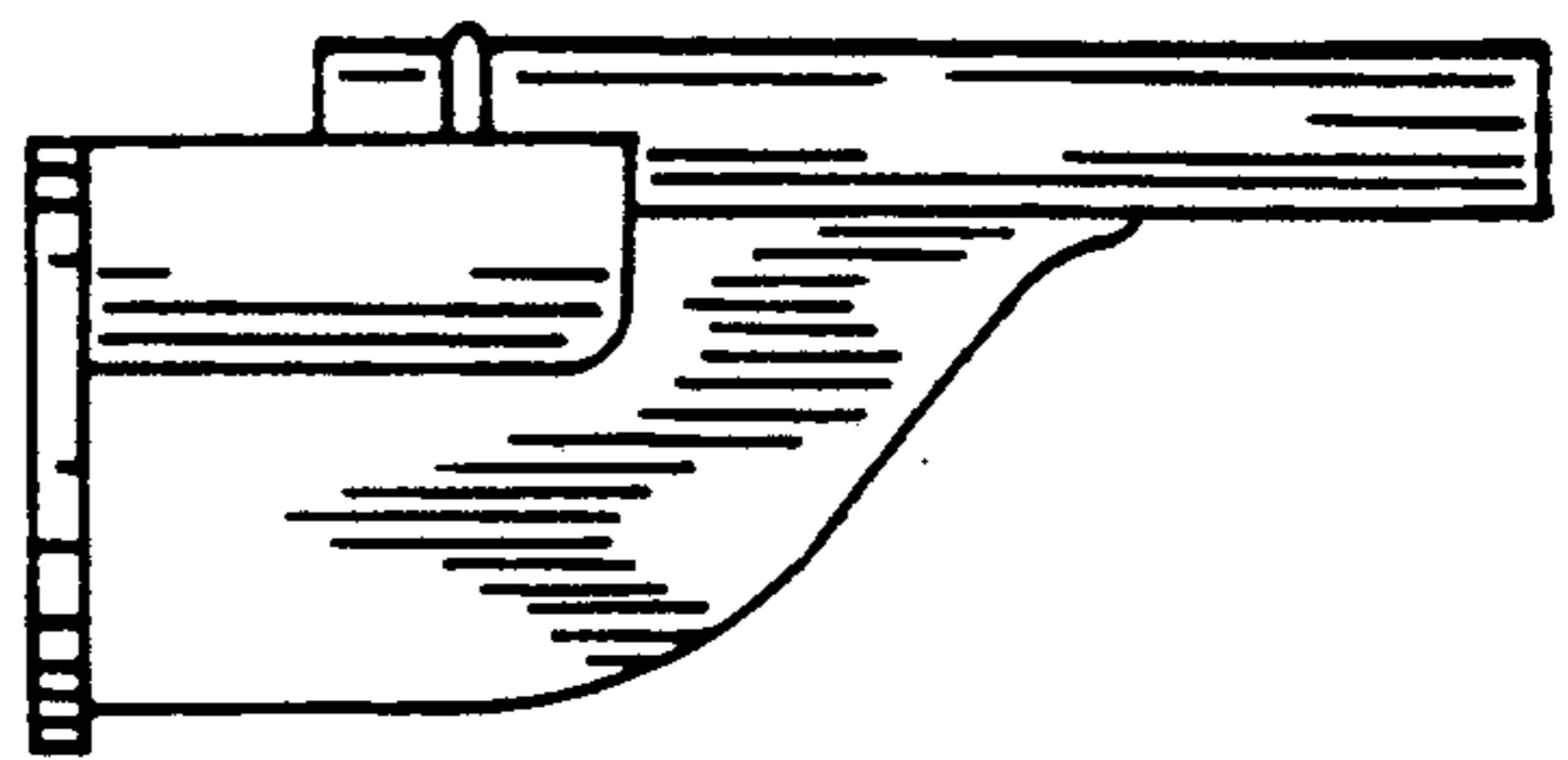

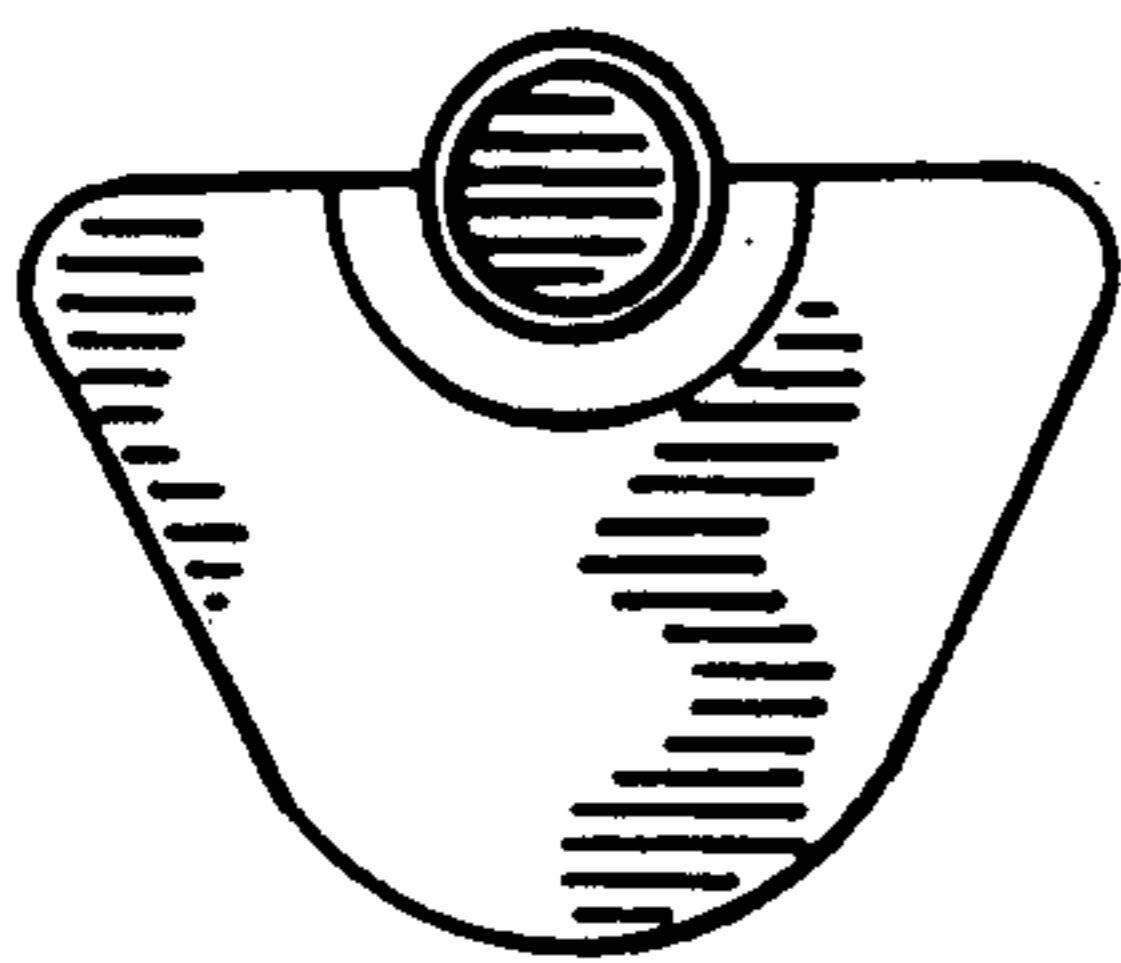

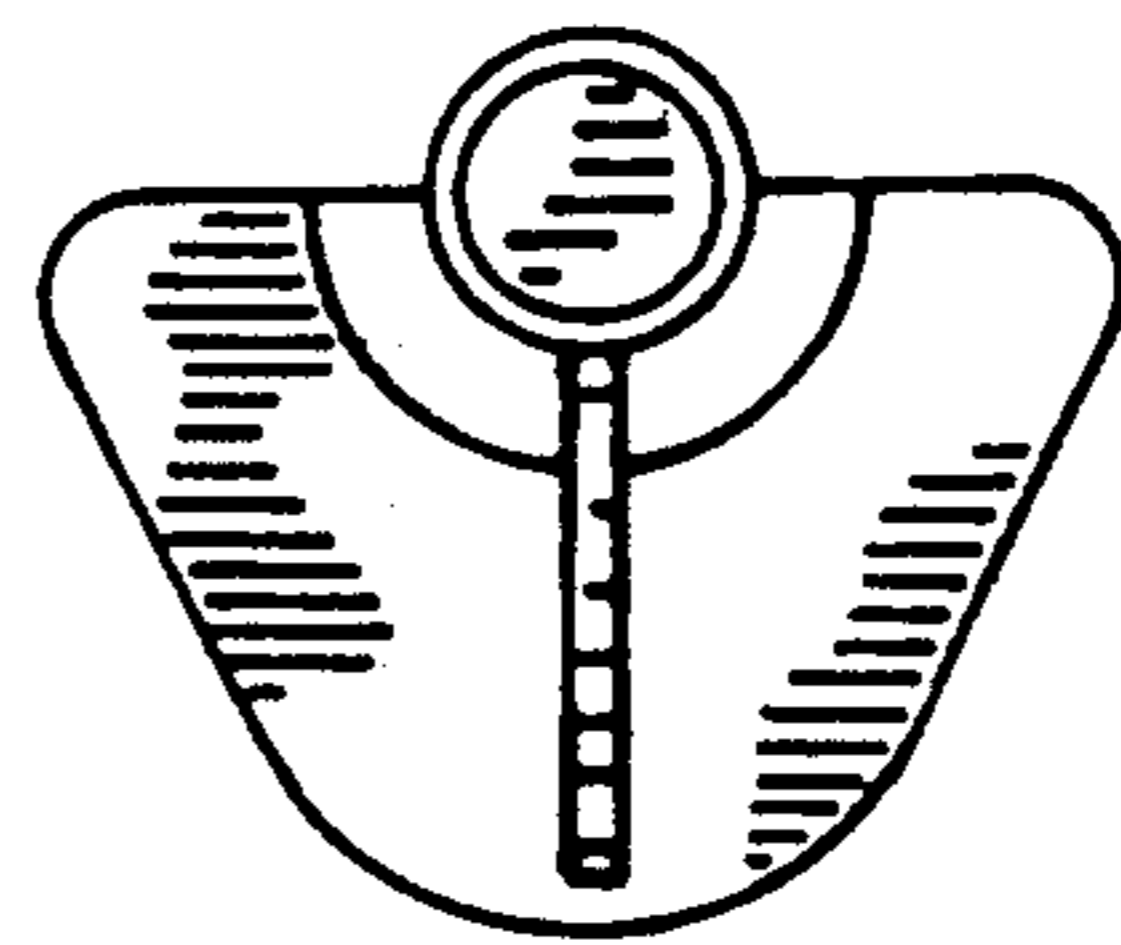
