[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a remote controlled dual lamp searchlight for vehicle, boat, or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a remote controlled dual lamp searchlight for vehicle, boat or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

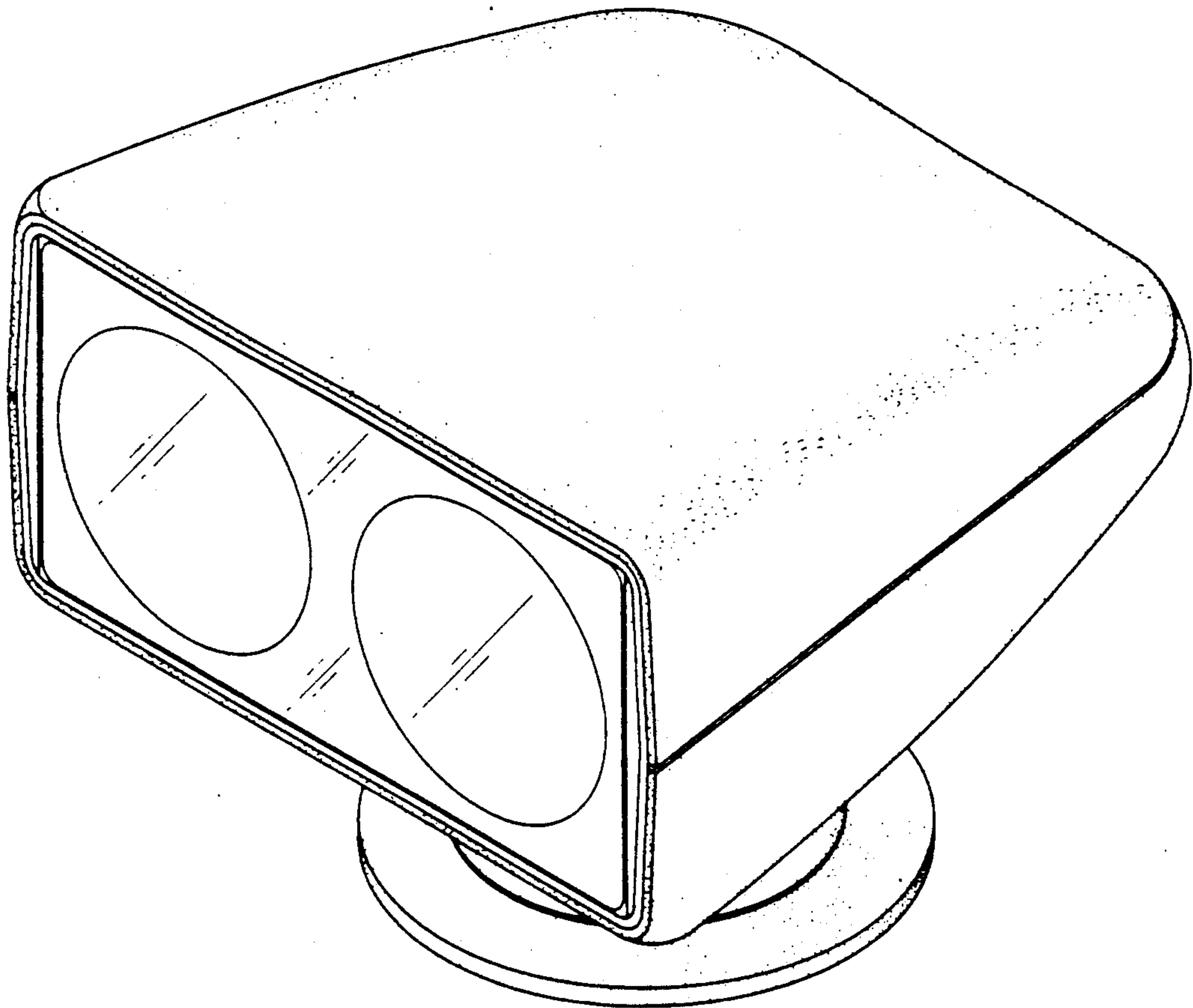

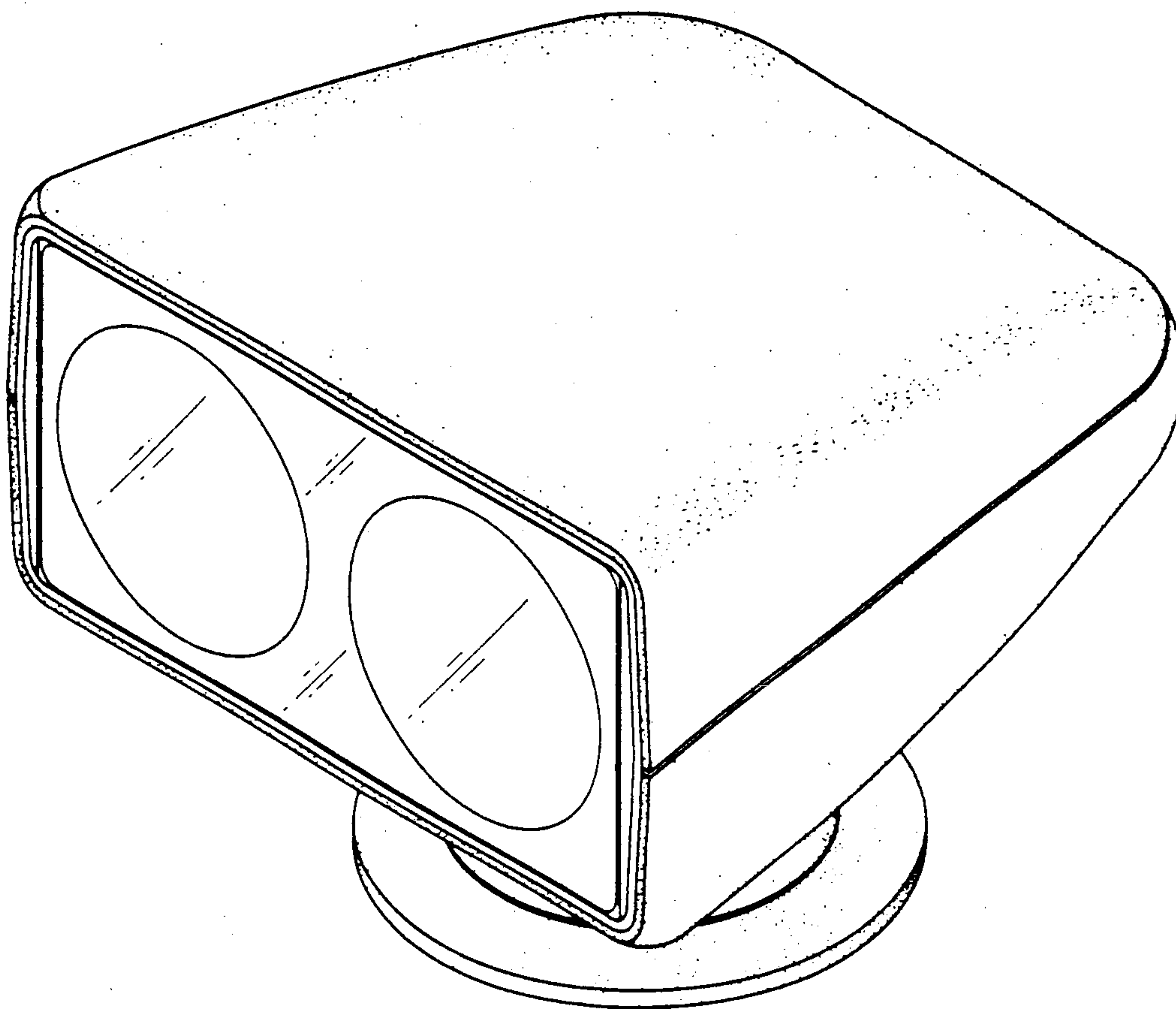

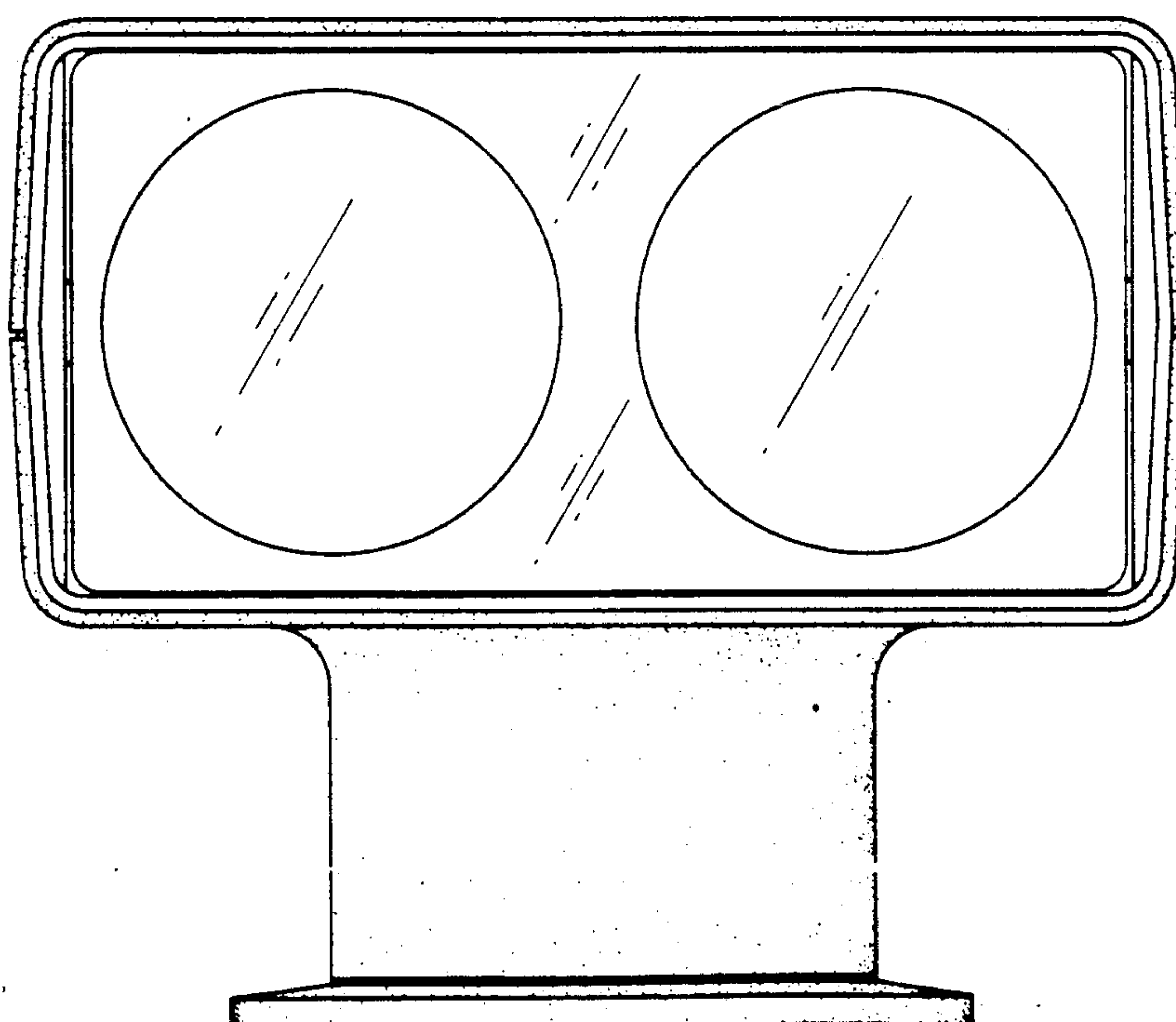

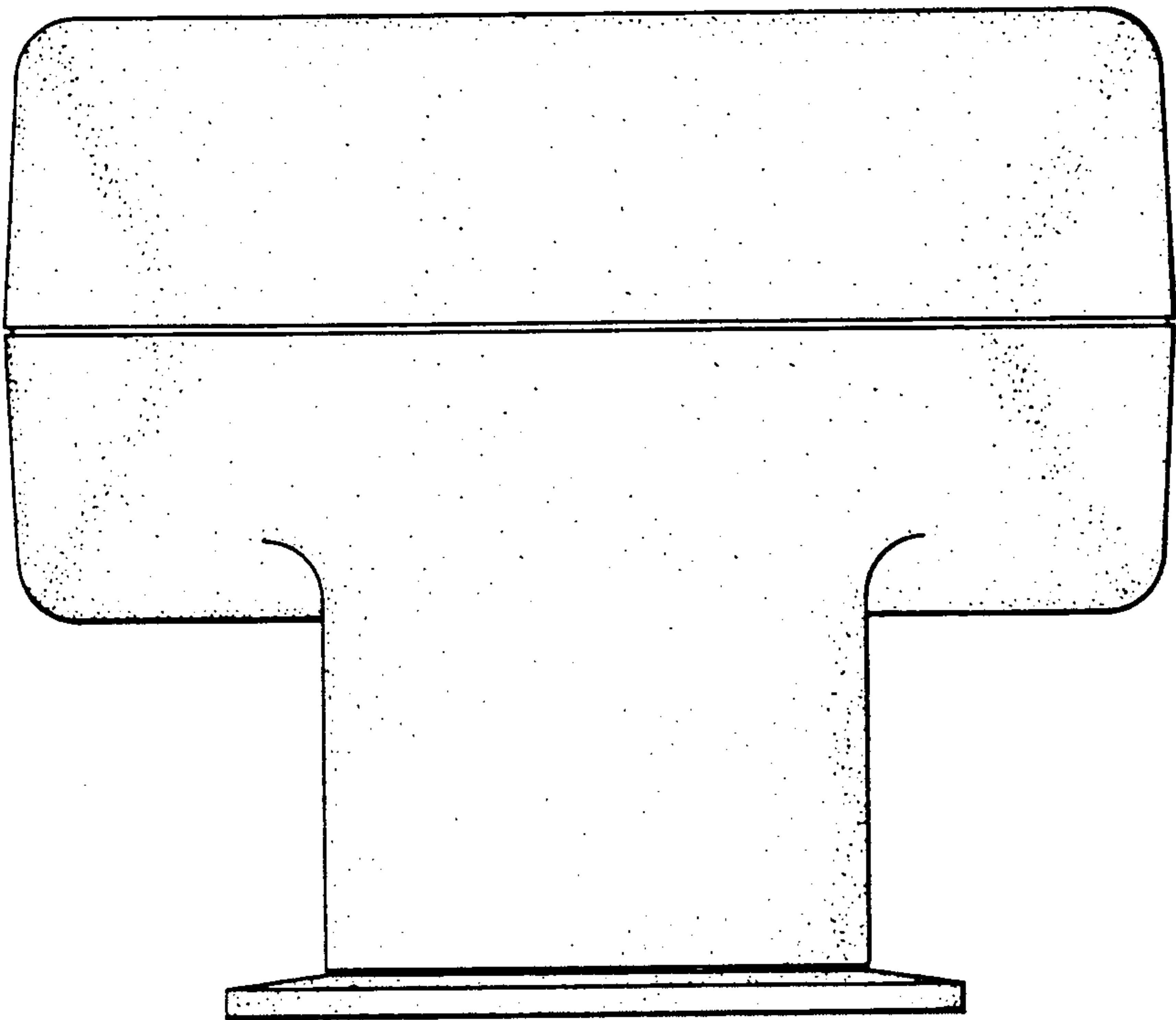

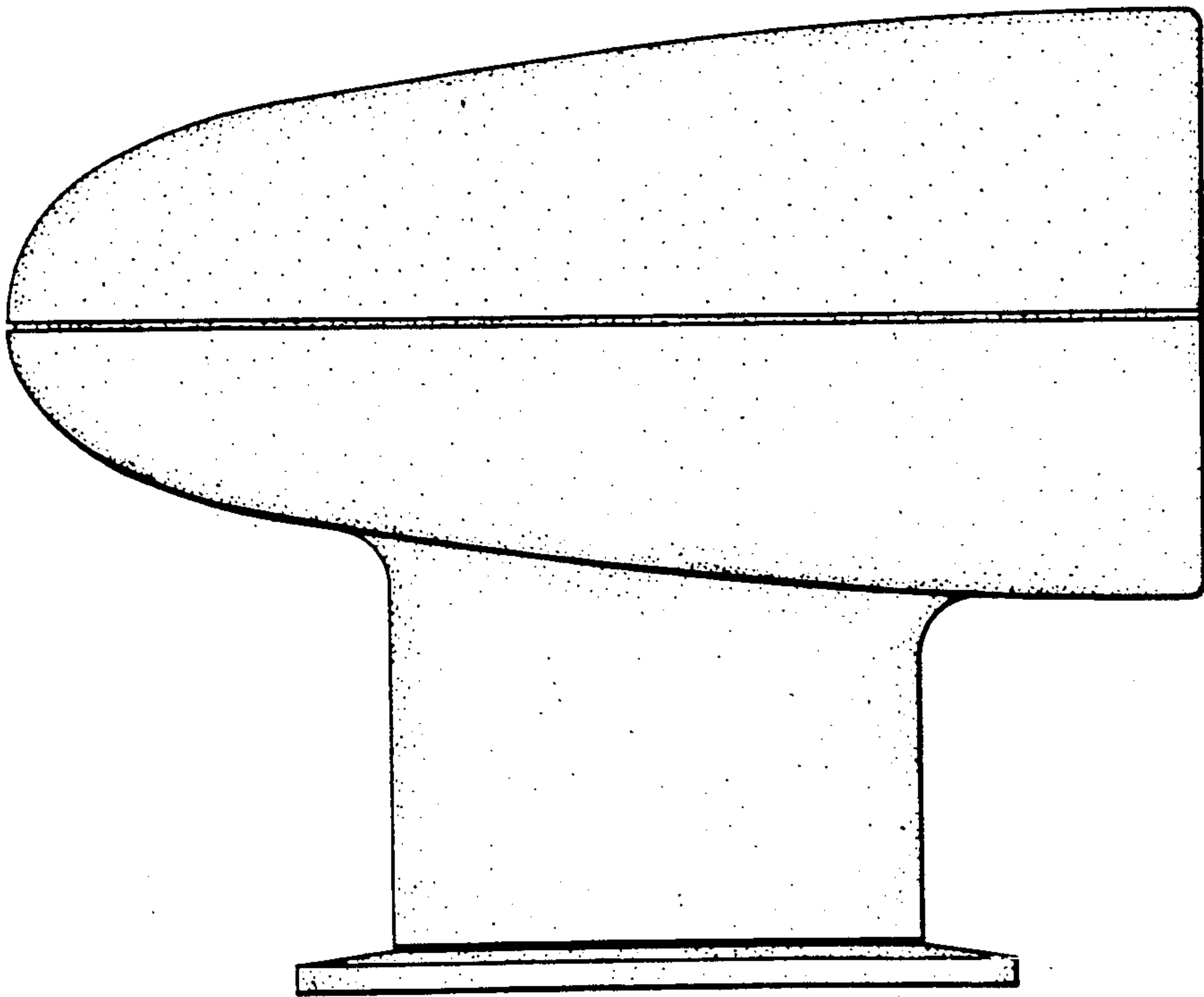

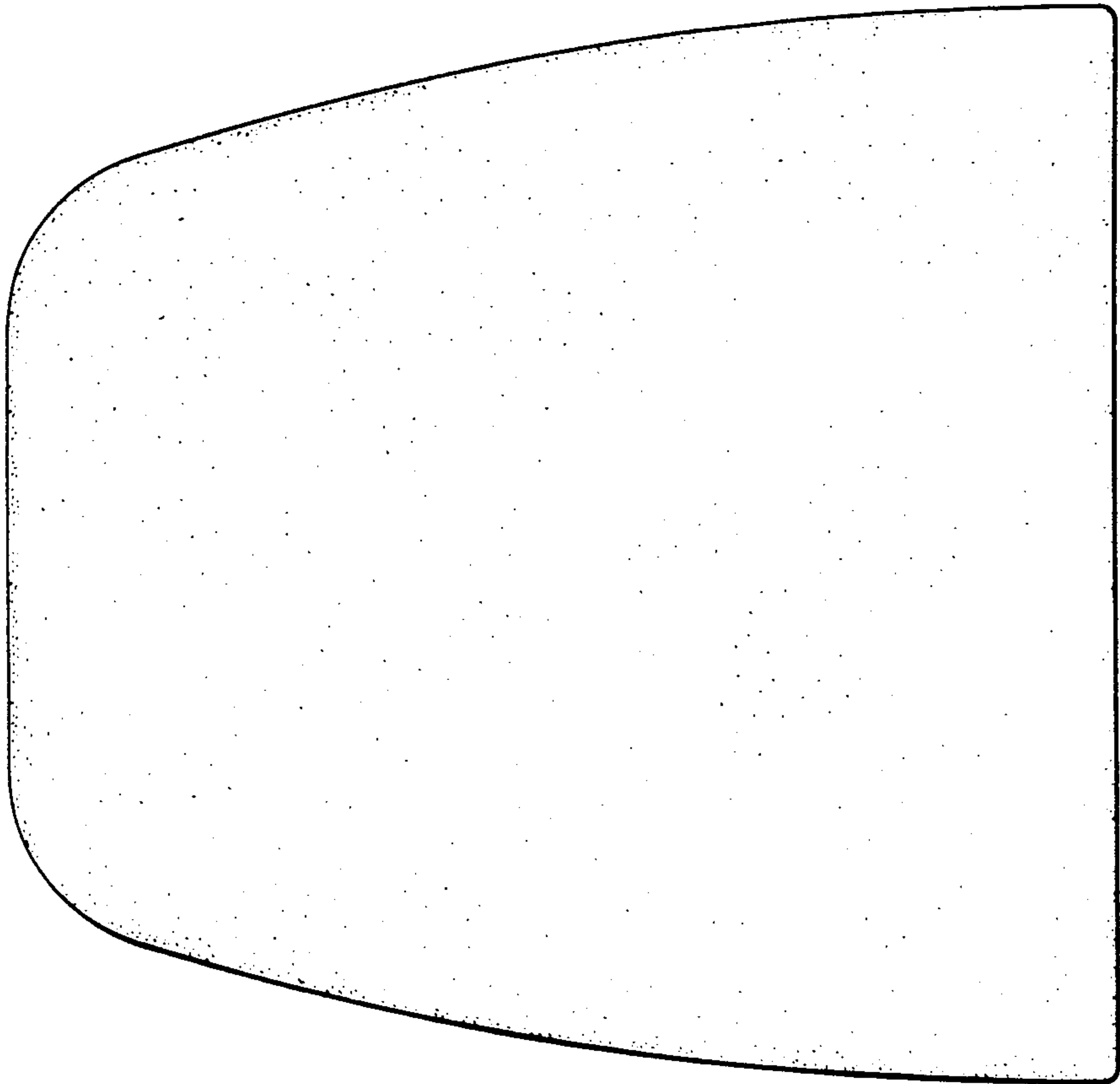
