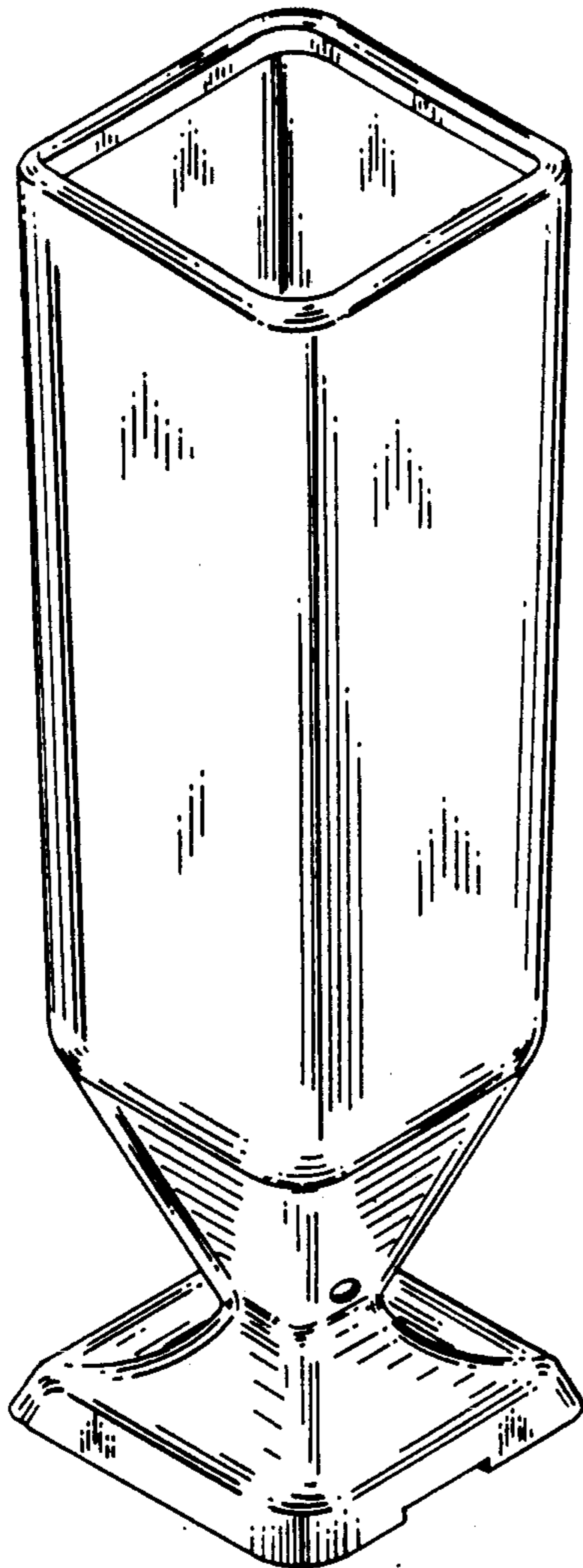

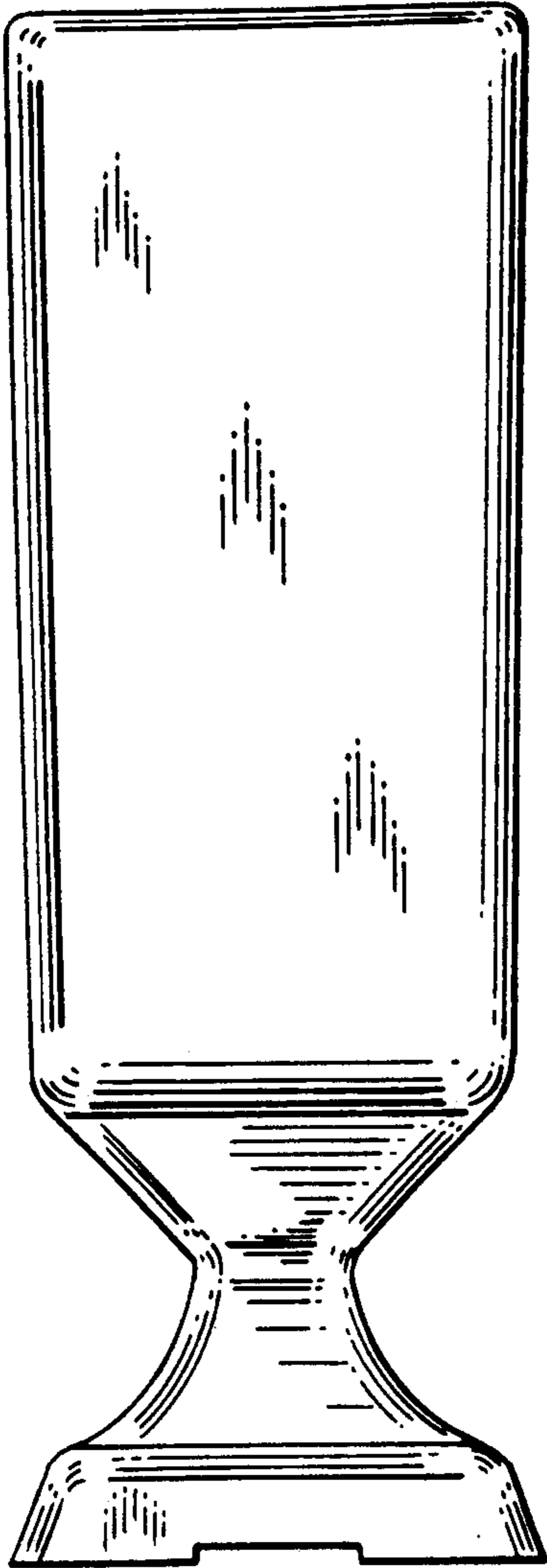
[57] CLAIM

and described.

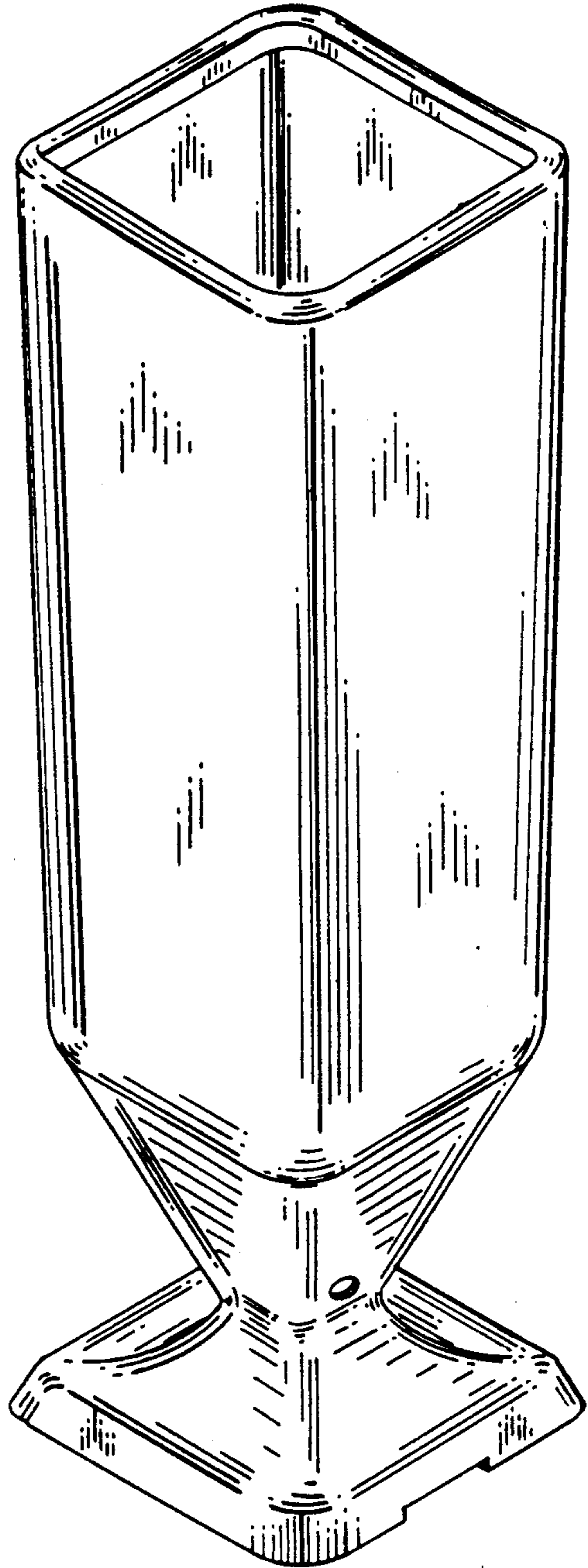
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a grave stone  
vase showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view the opposite side  
being a mirror image;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and

FIG. 6.

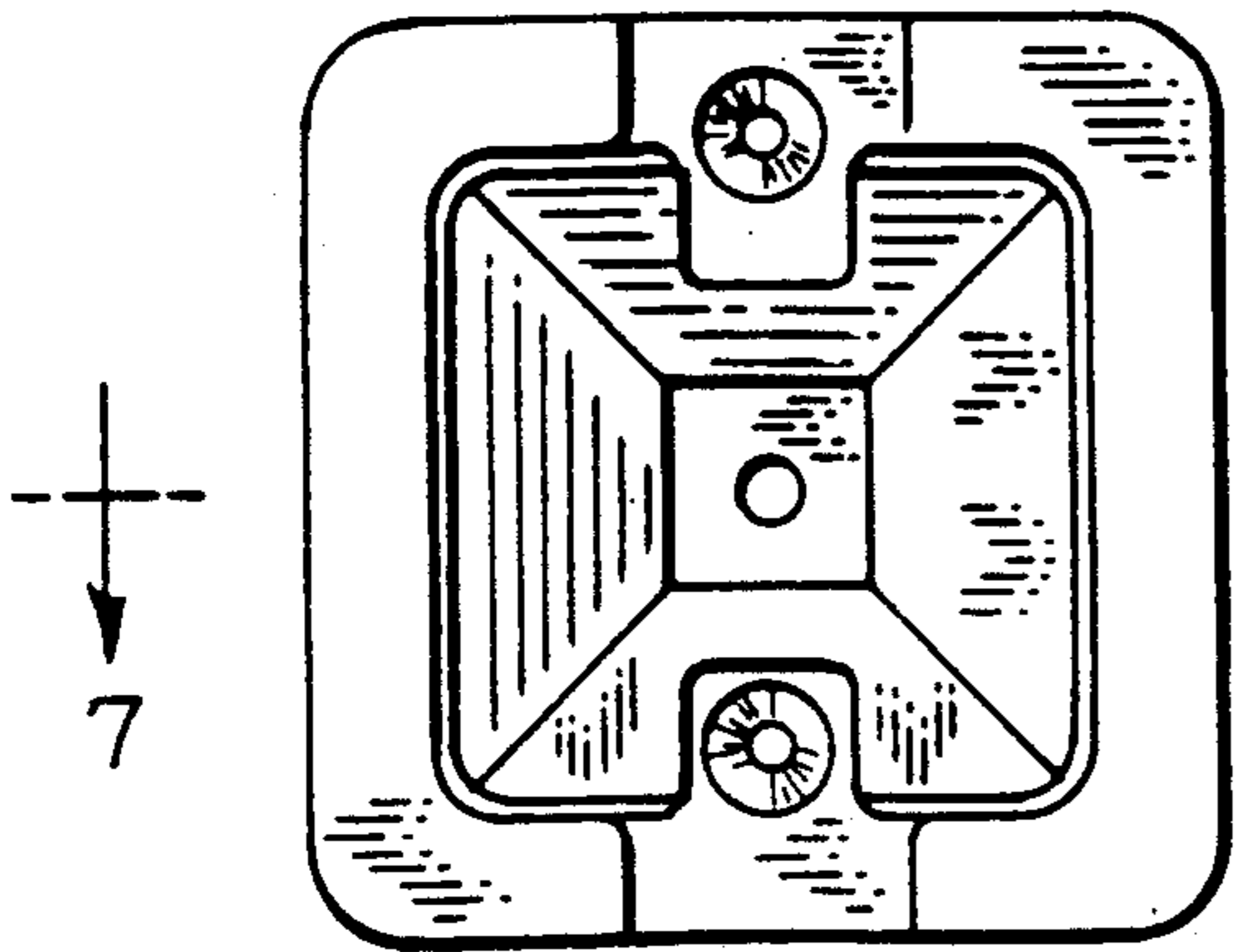




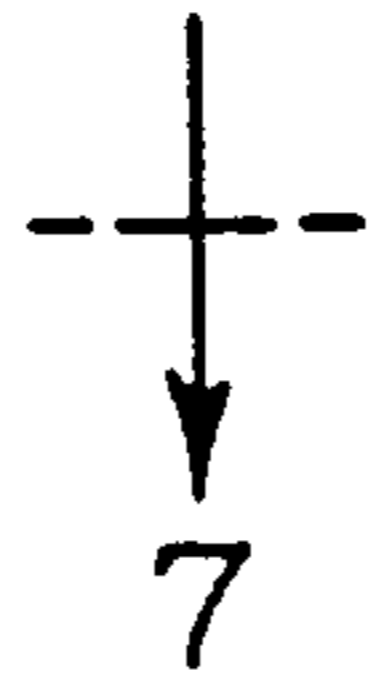

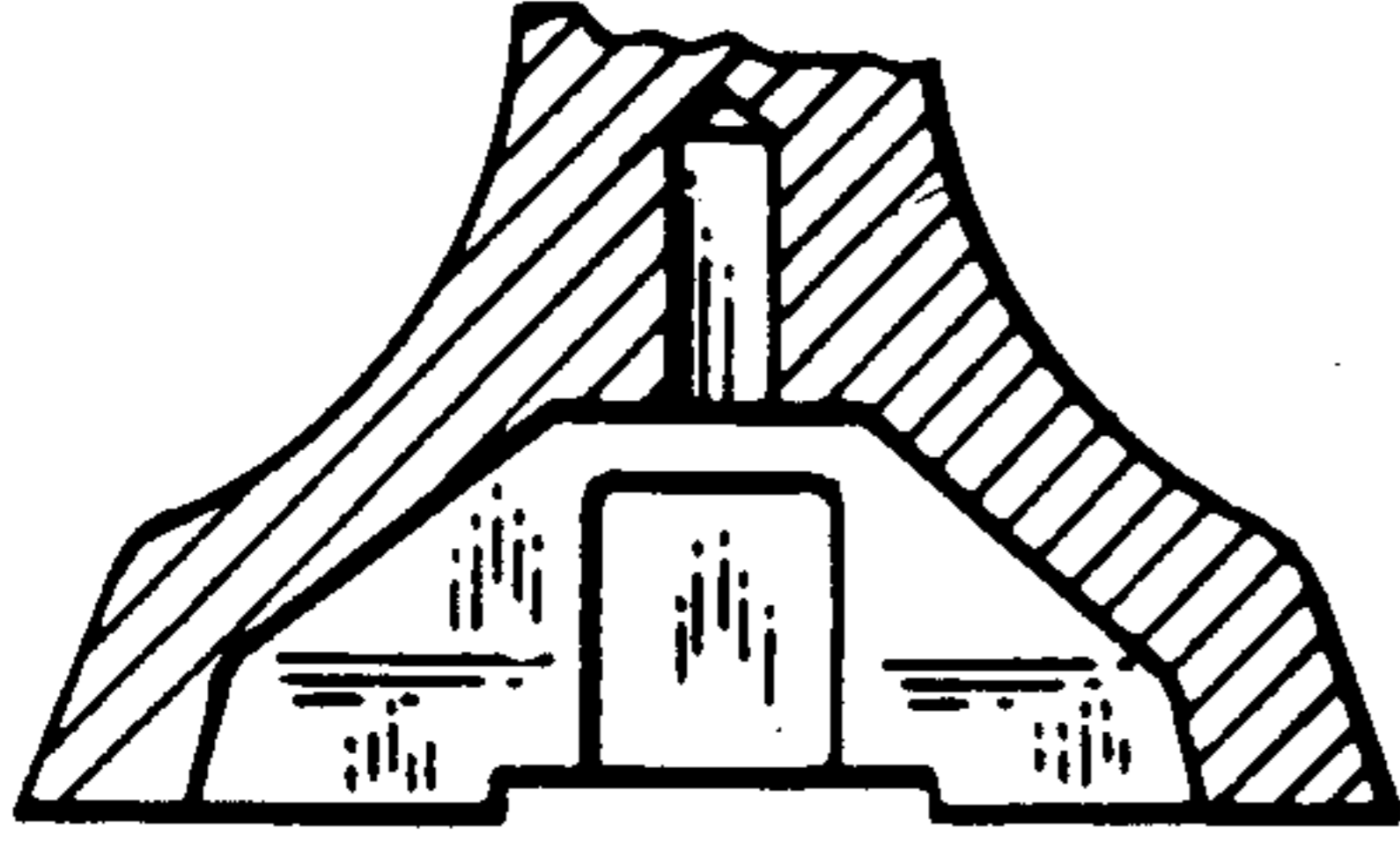

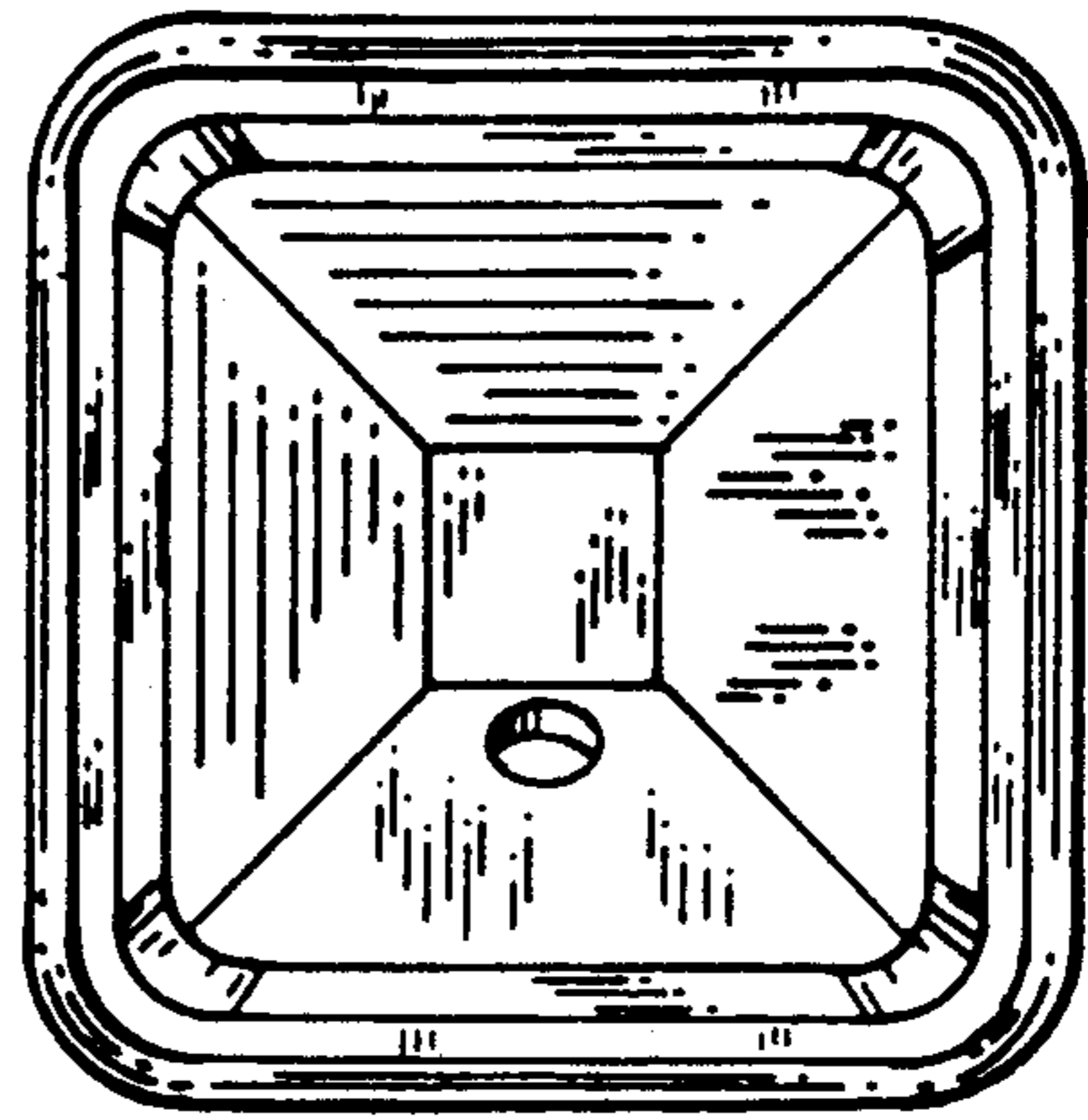

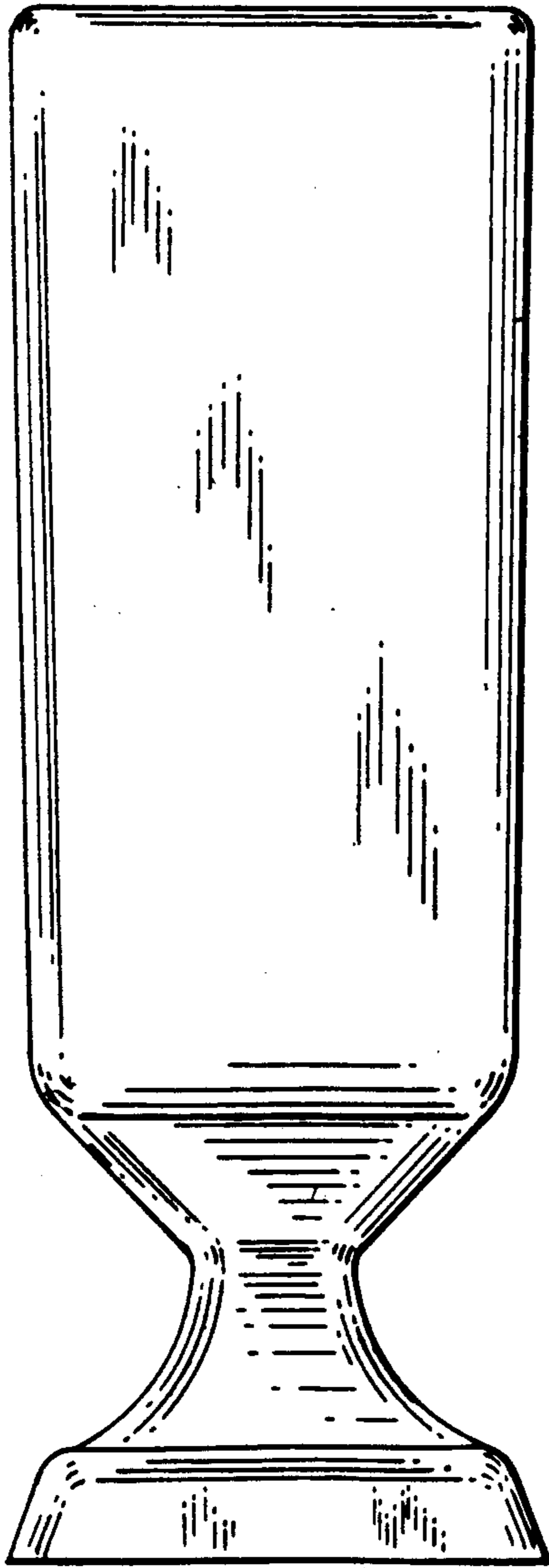




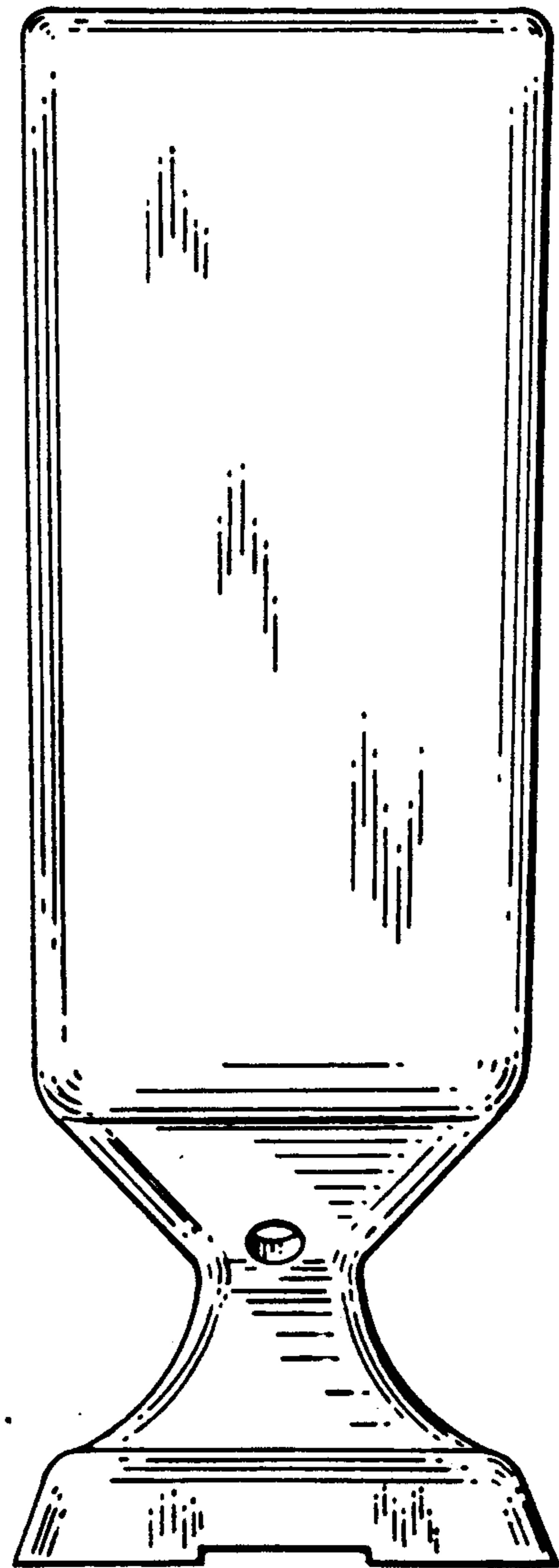
