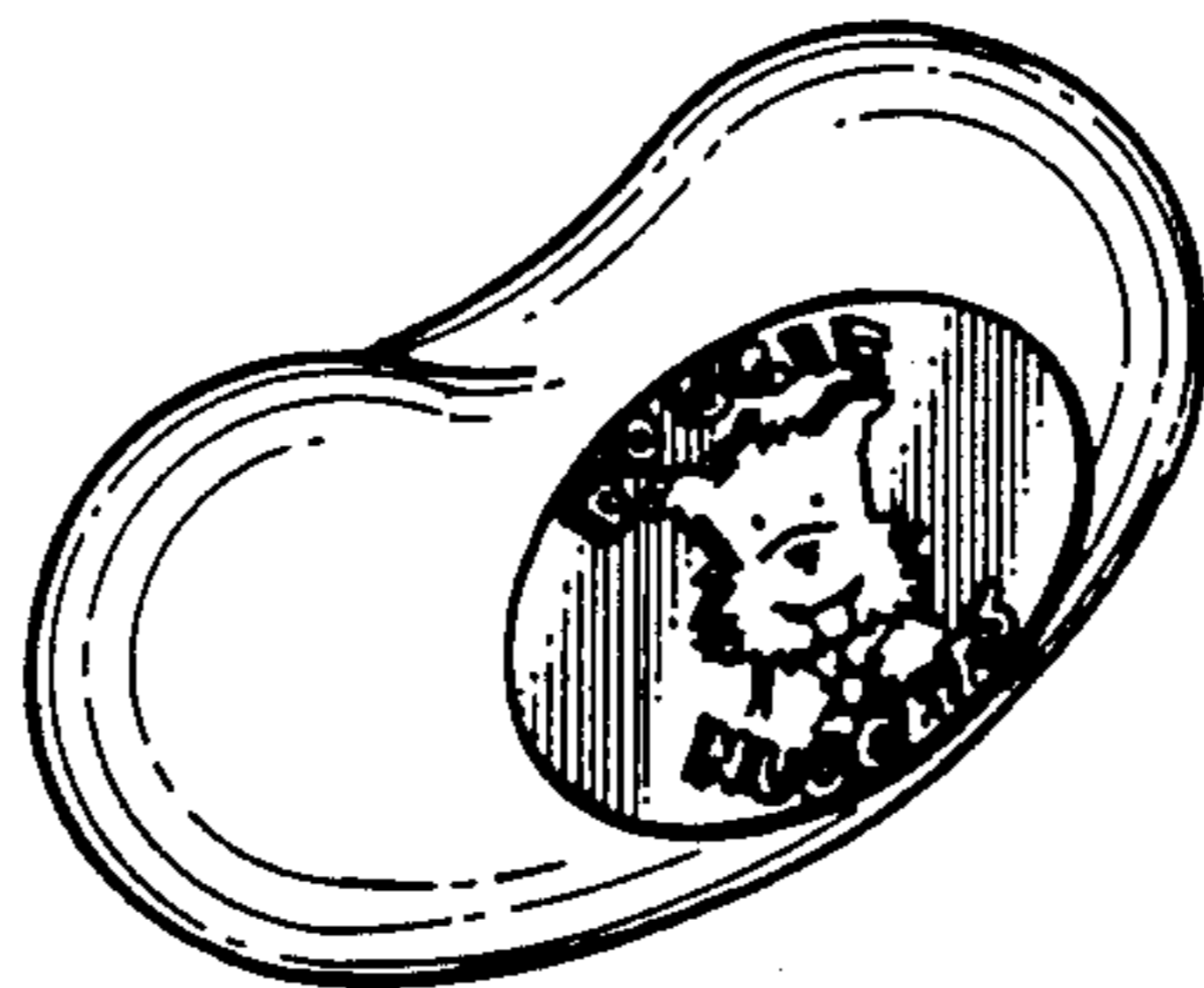
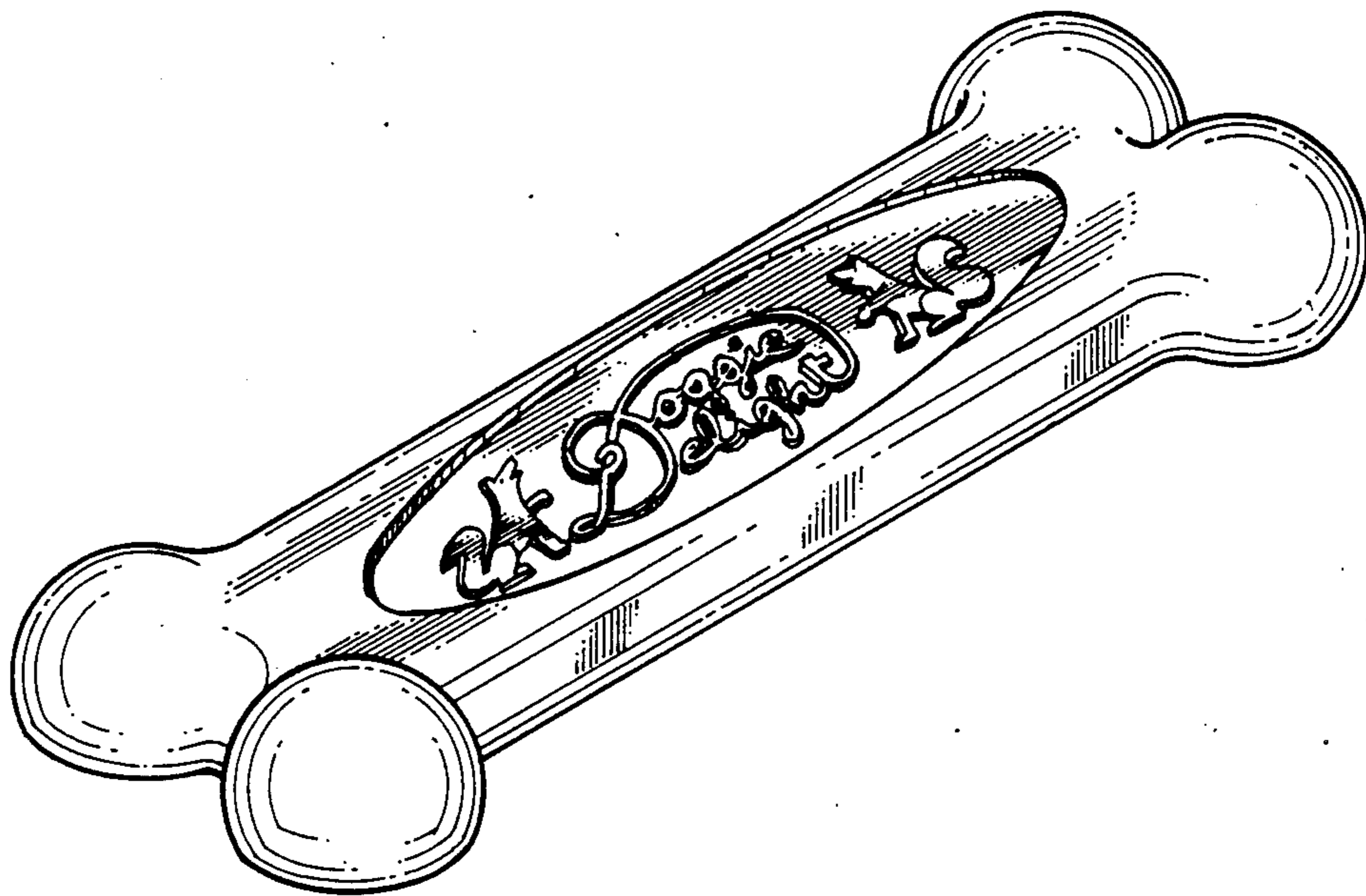
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment, the undisclosed rear being the same.



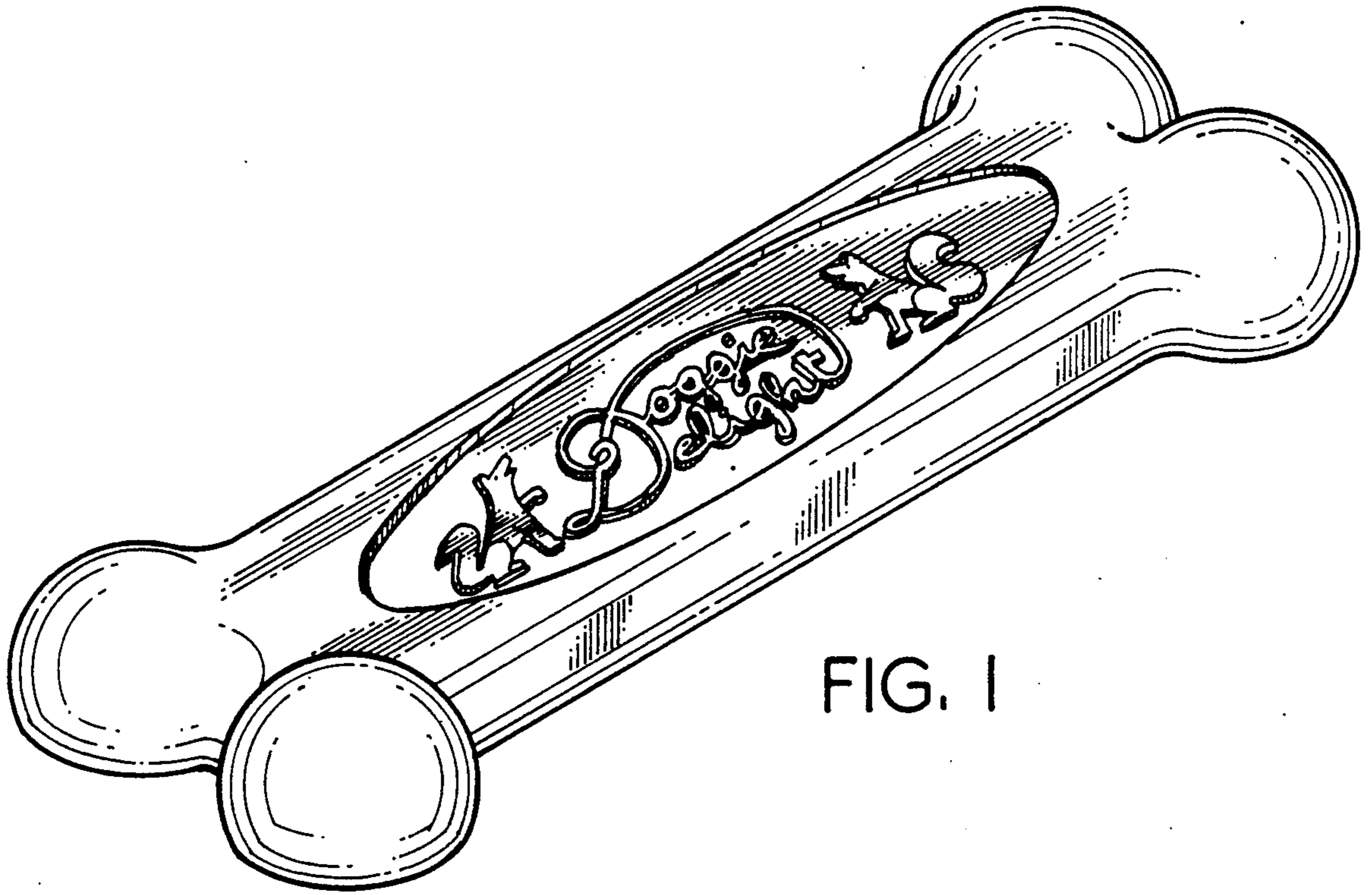

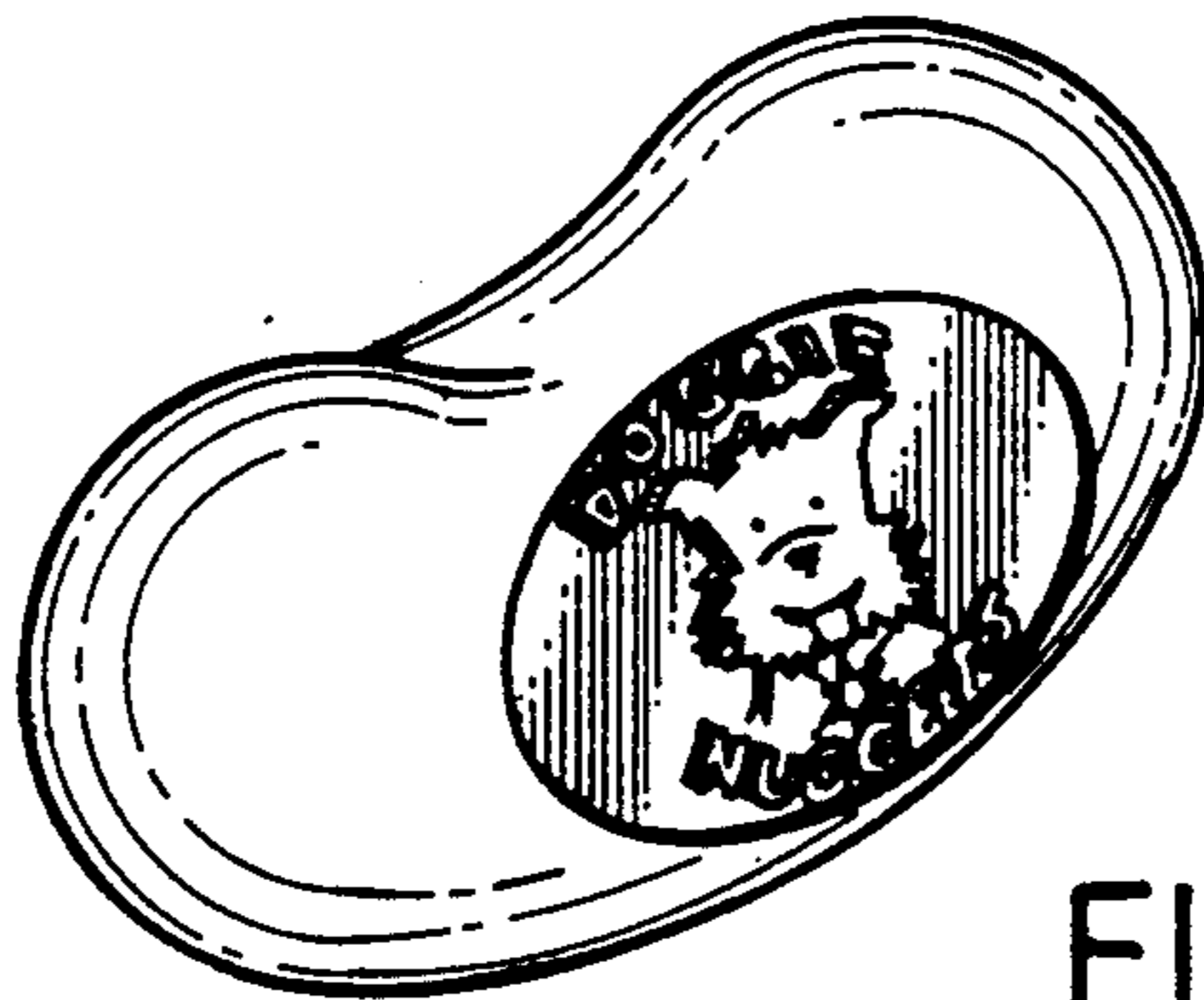
