FIG. 2 is a view in front elevation;

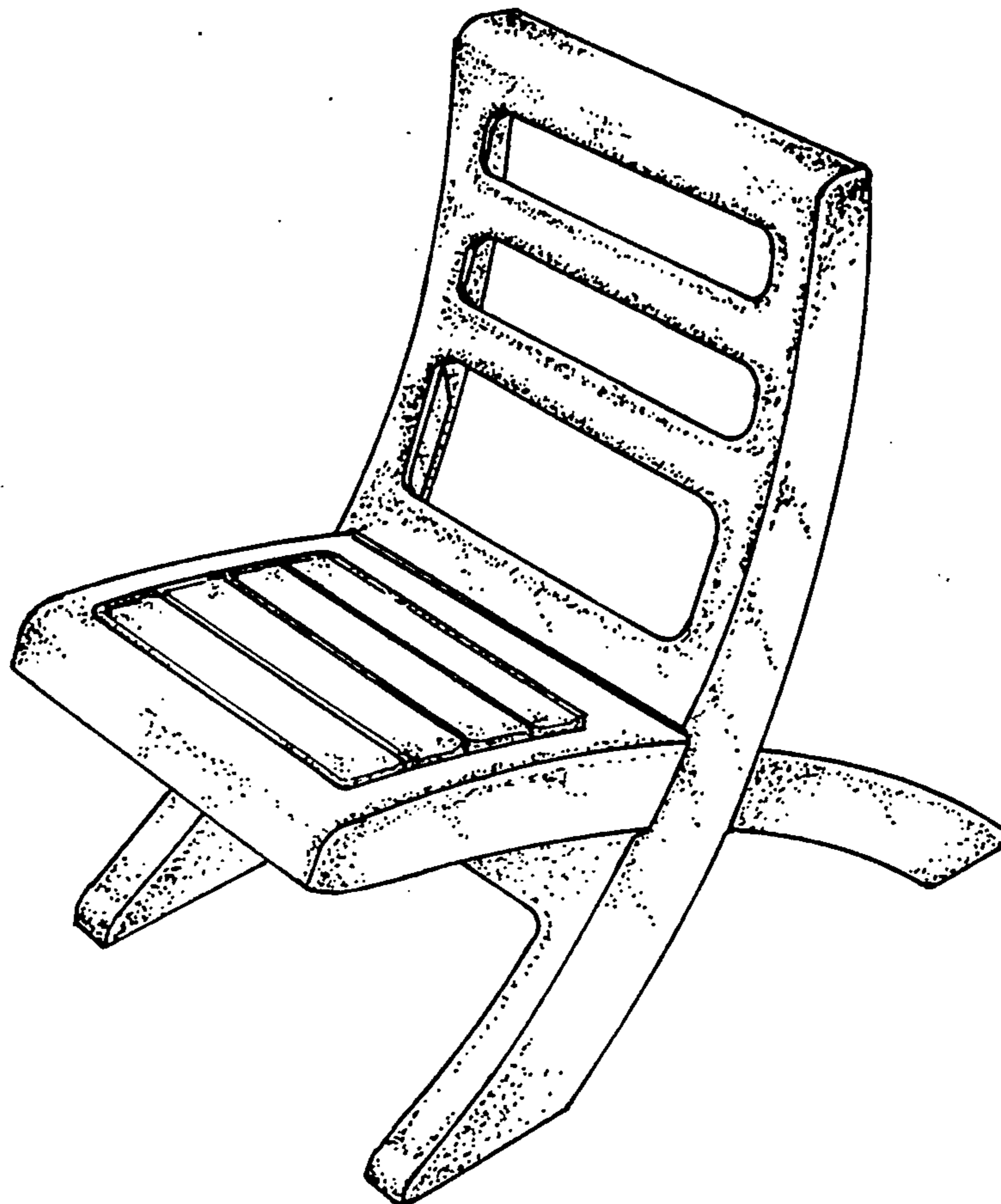
FIG. 3 is a view in rear elevation;

FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view thereof.



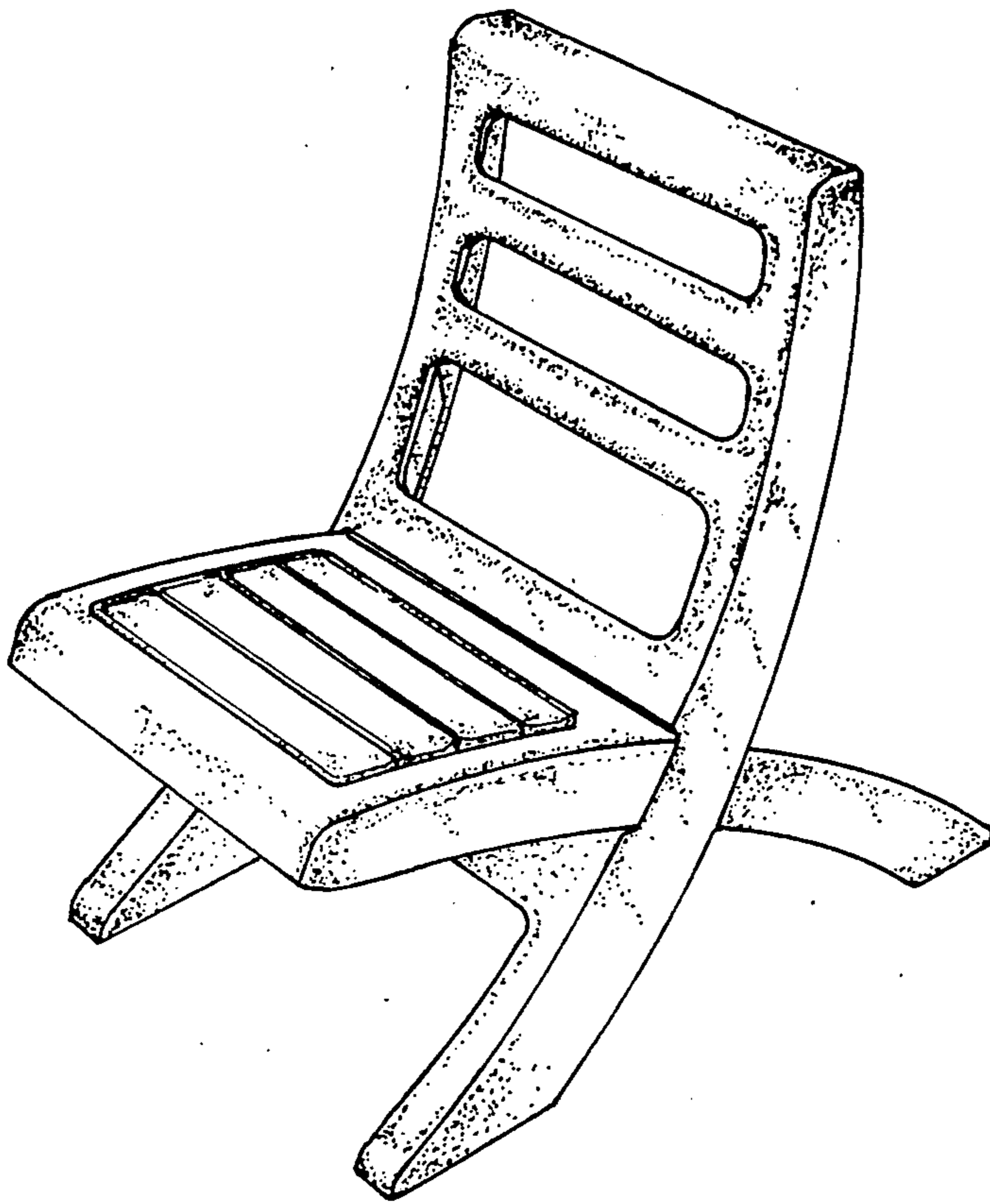

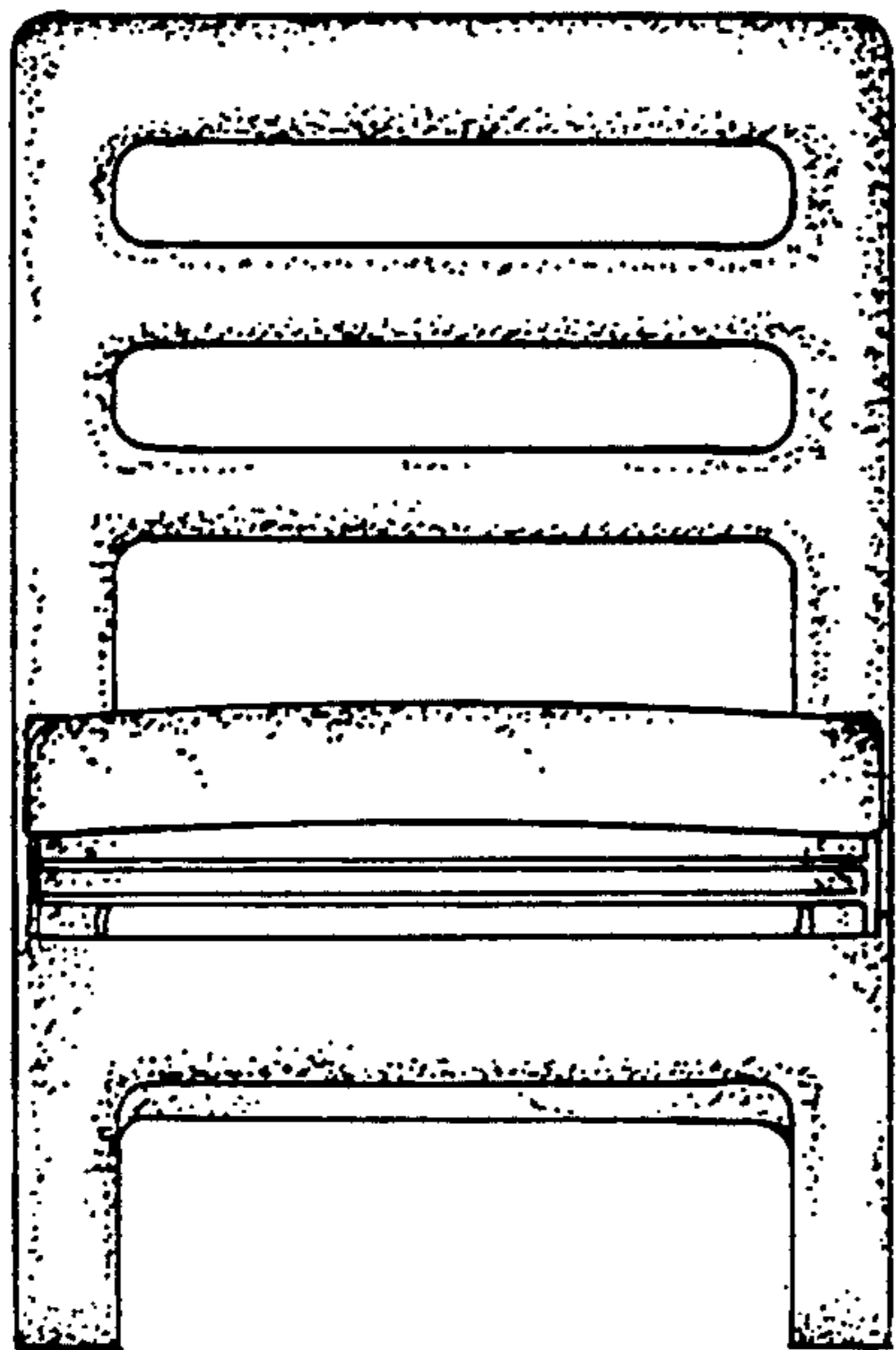

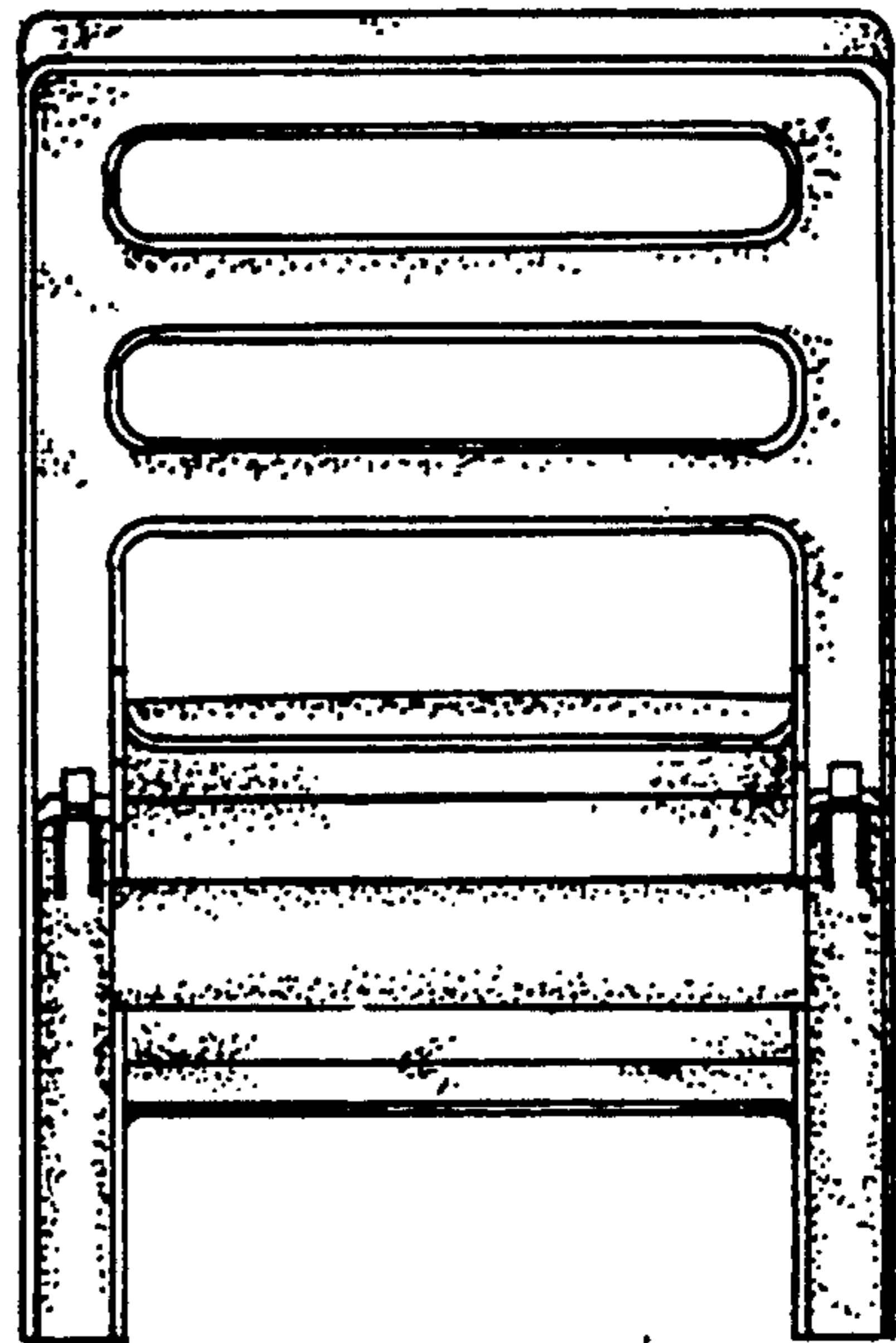

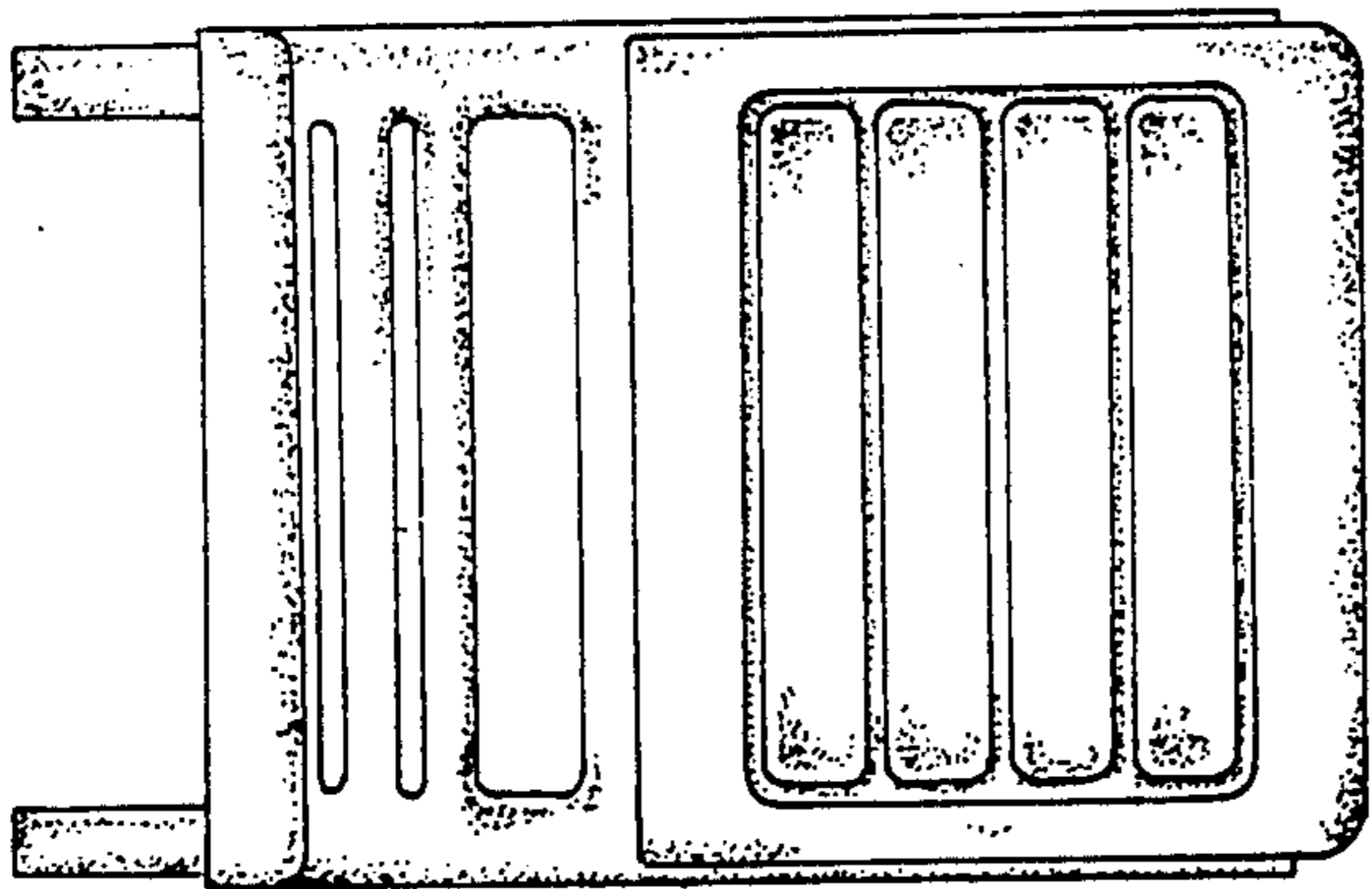

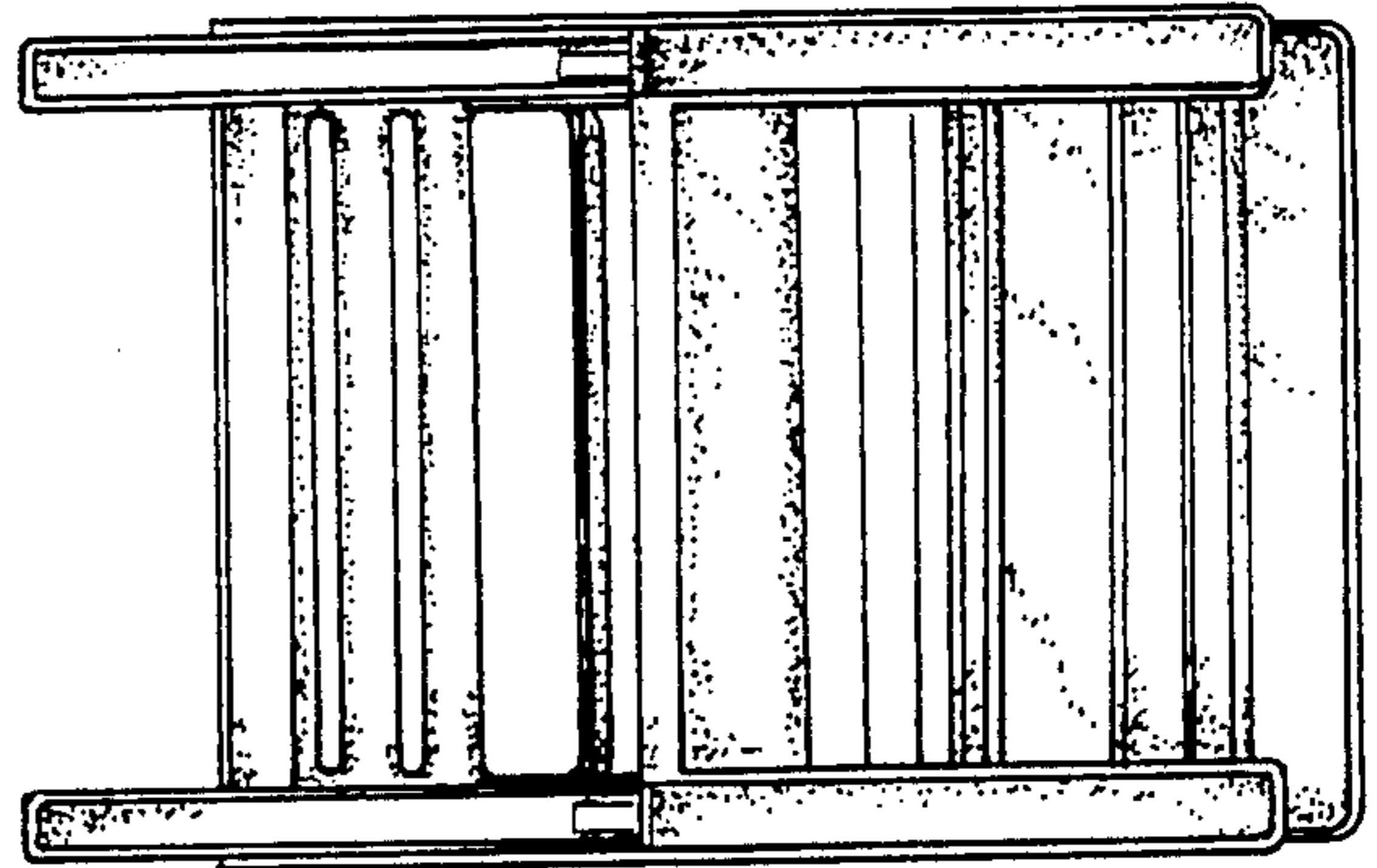

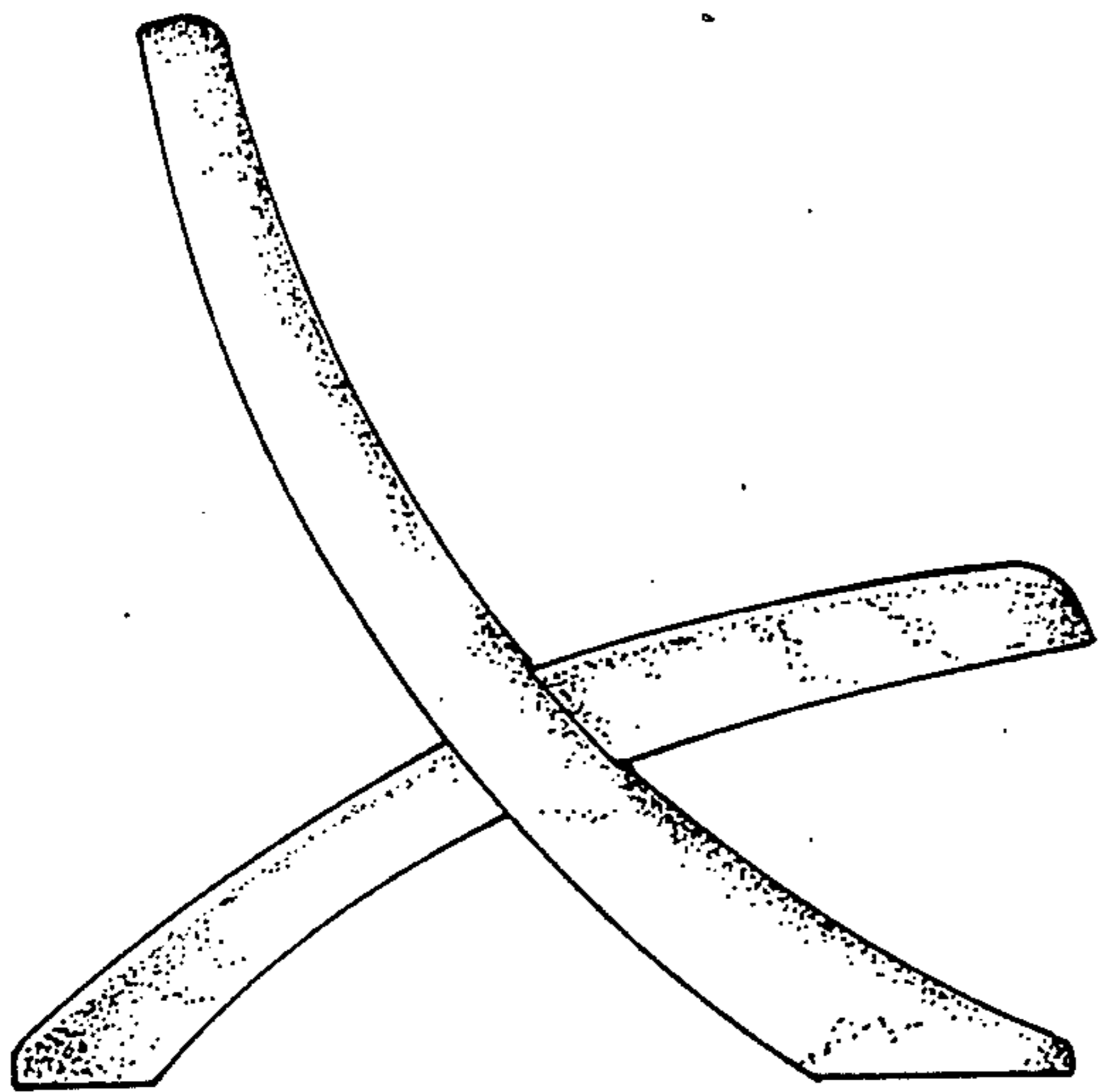

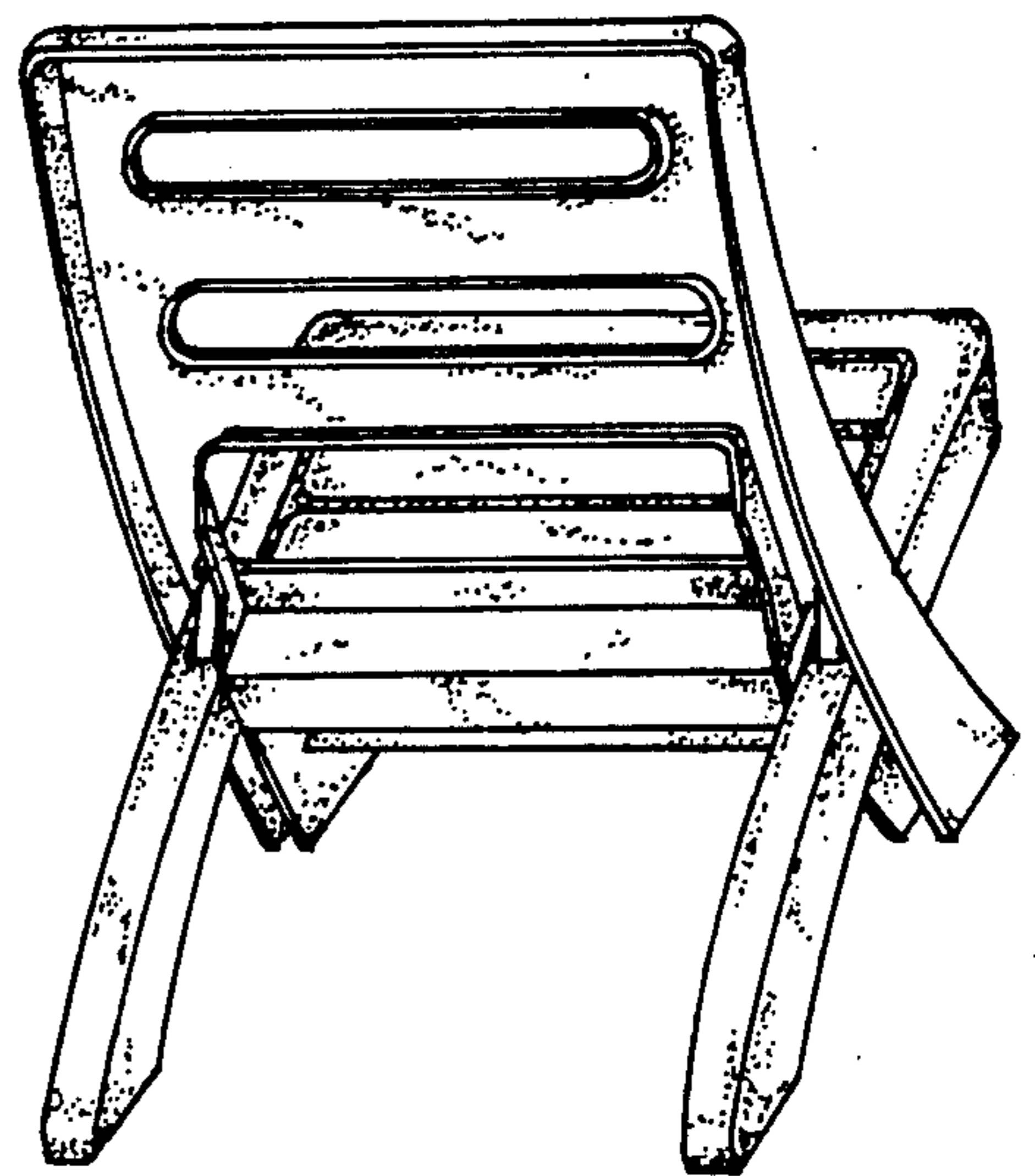
