The ornamental design for a tea pot or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a tea pot or similar article showing my new design, the side opposite is a mirror image thereof;

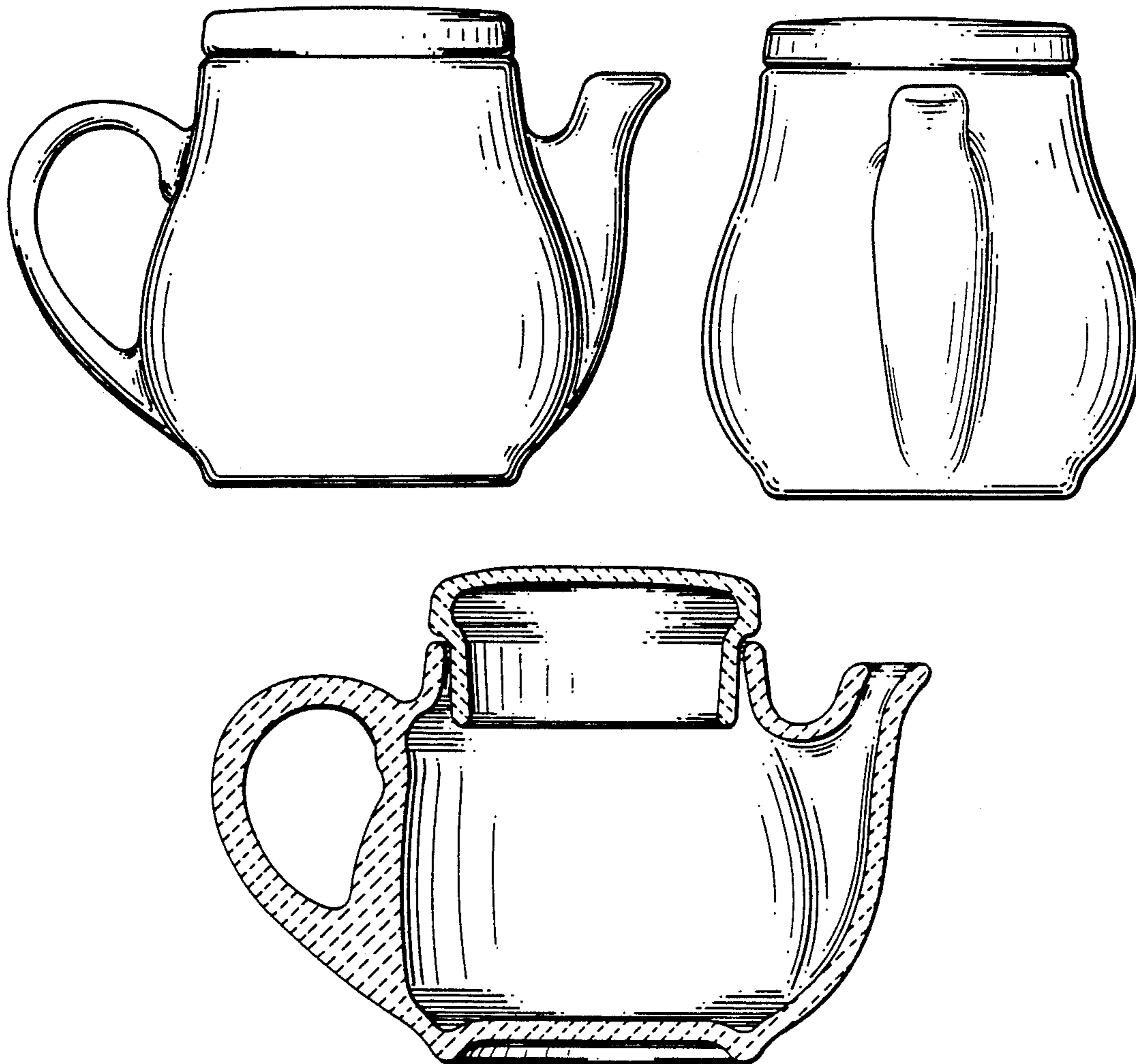
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof from the spout side of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is an end elevational view thereof from the handle side of FIG. 1.



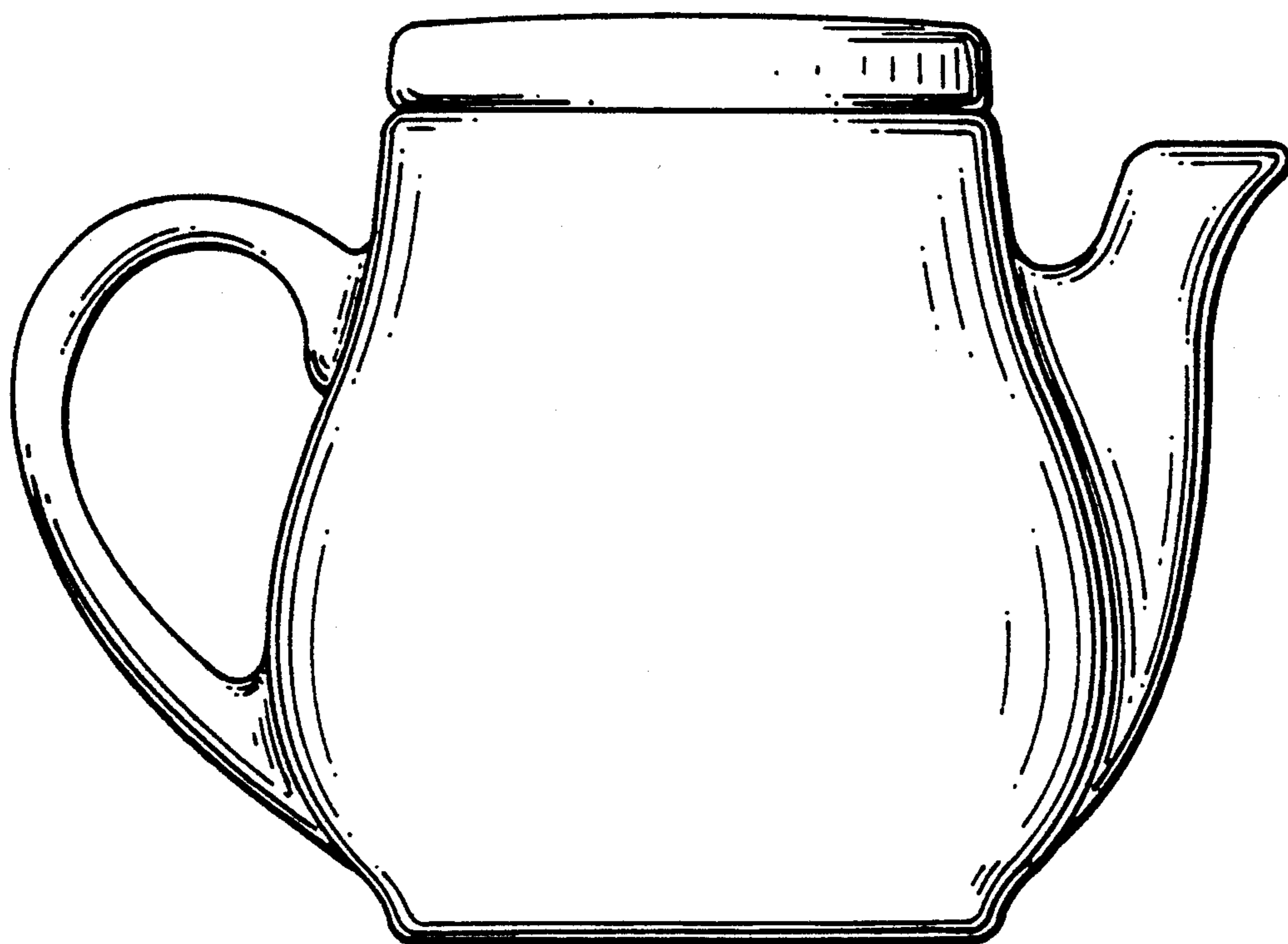

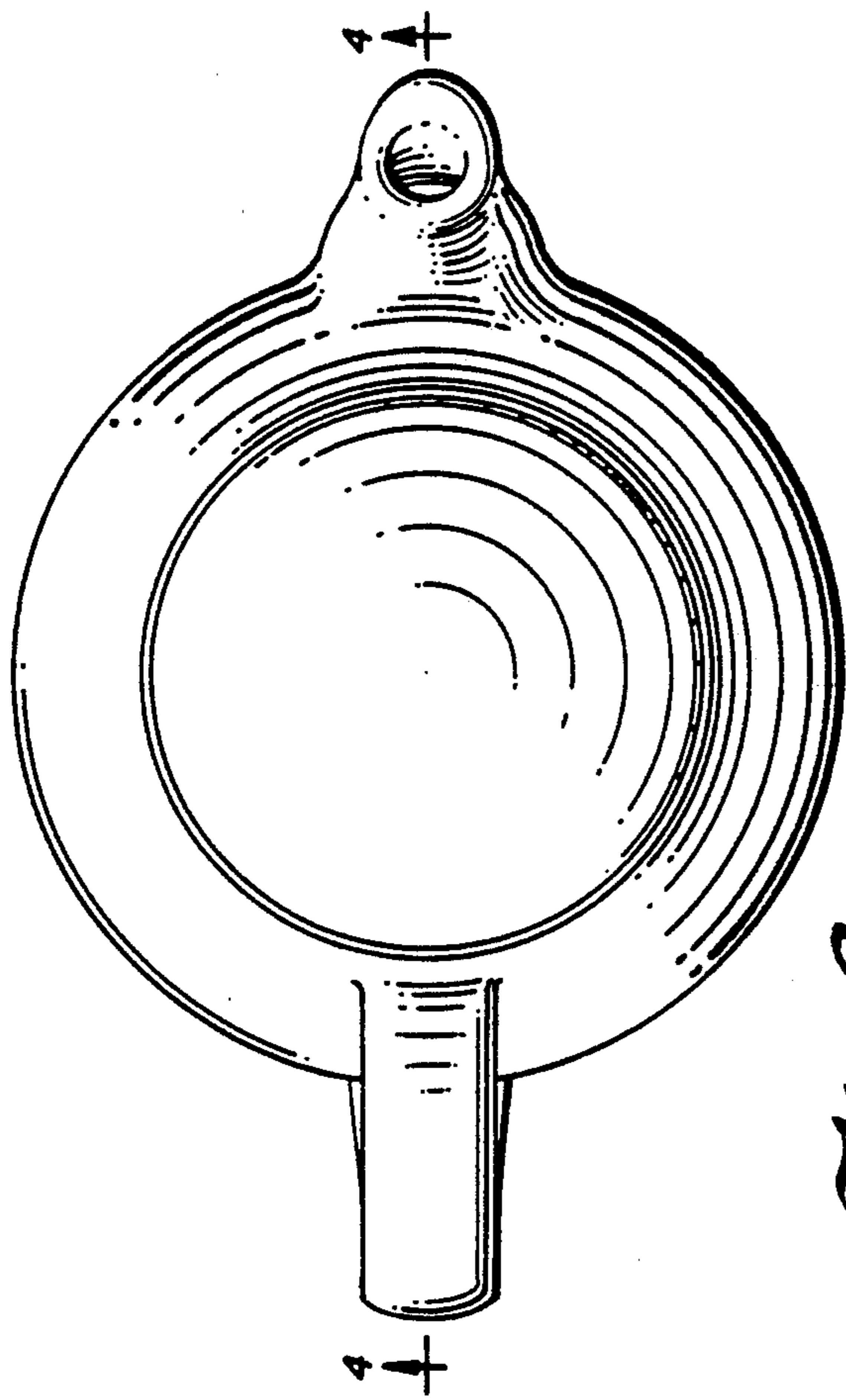

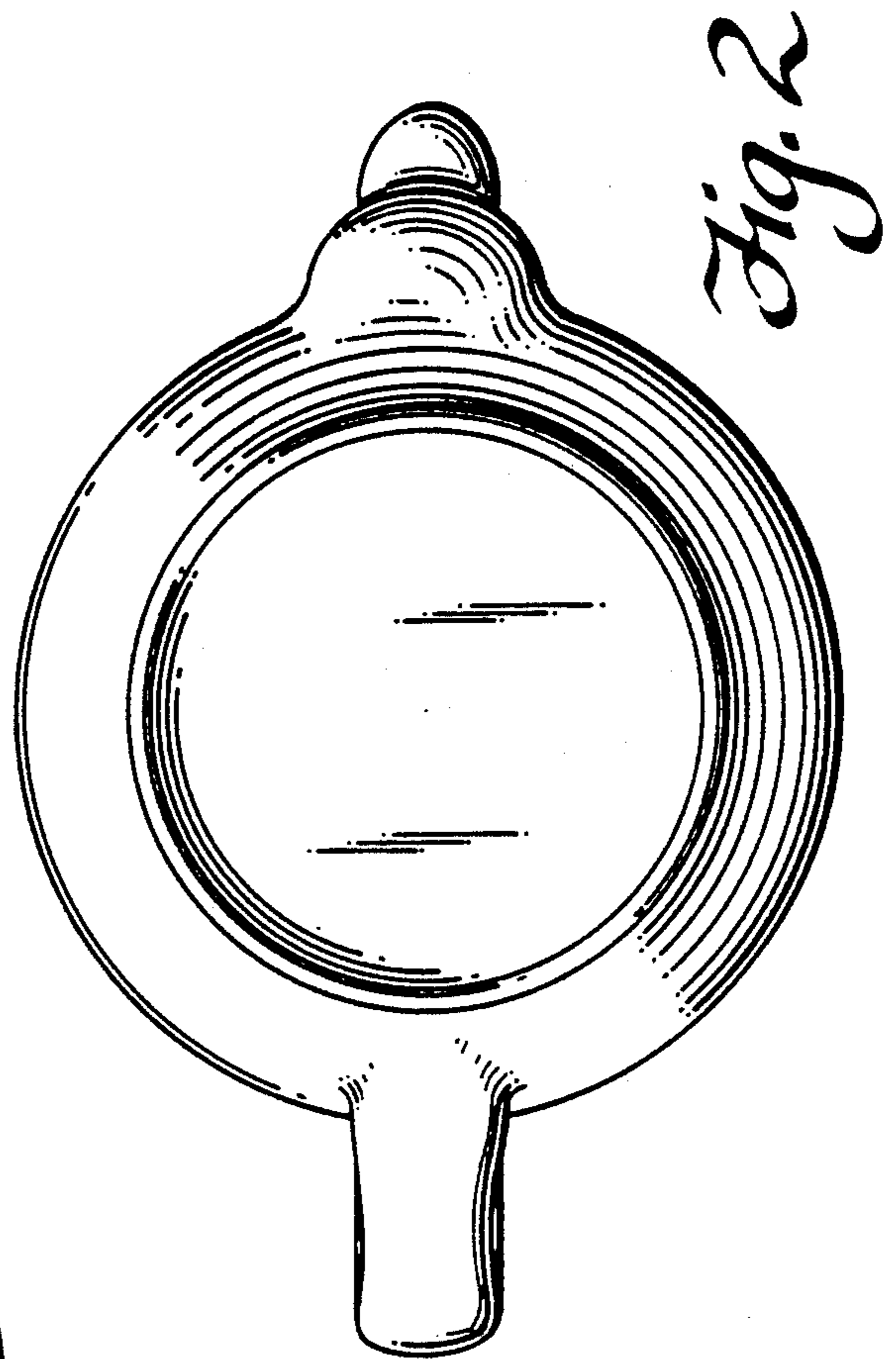

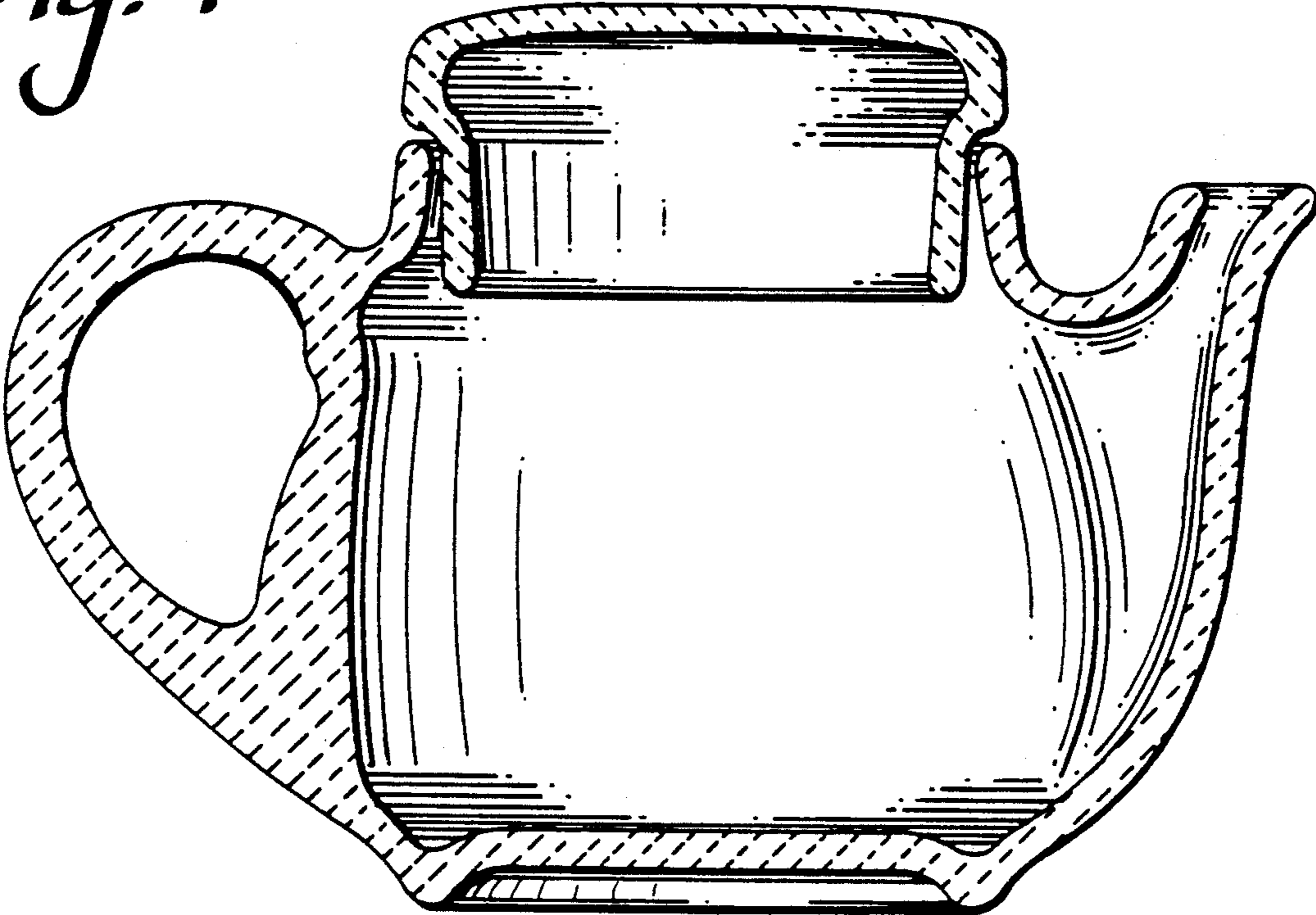

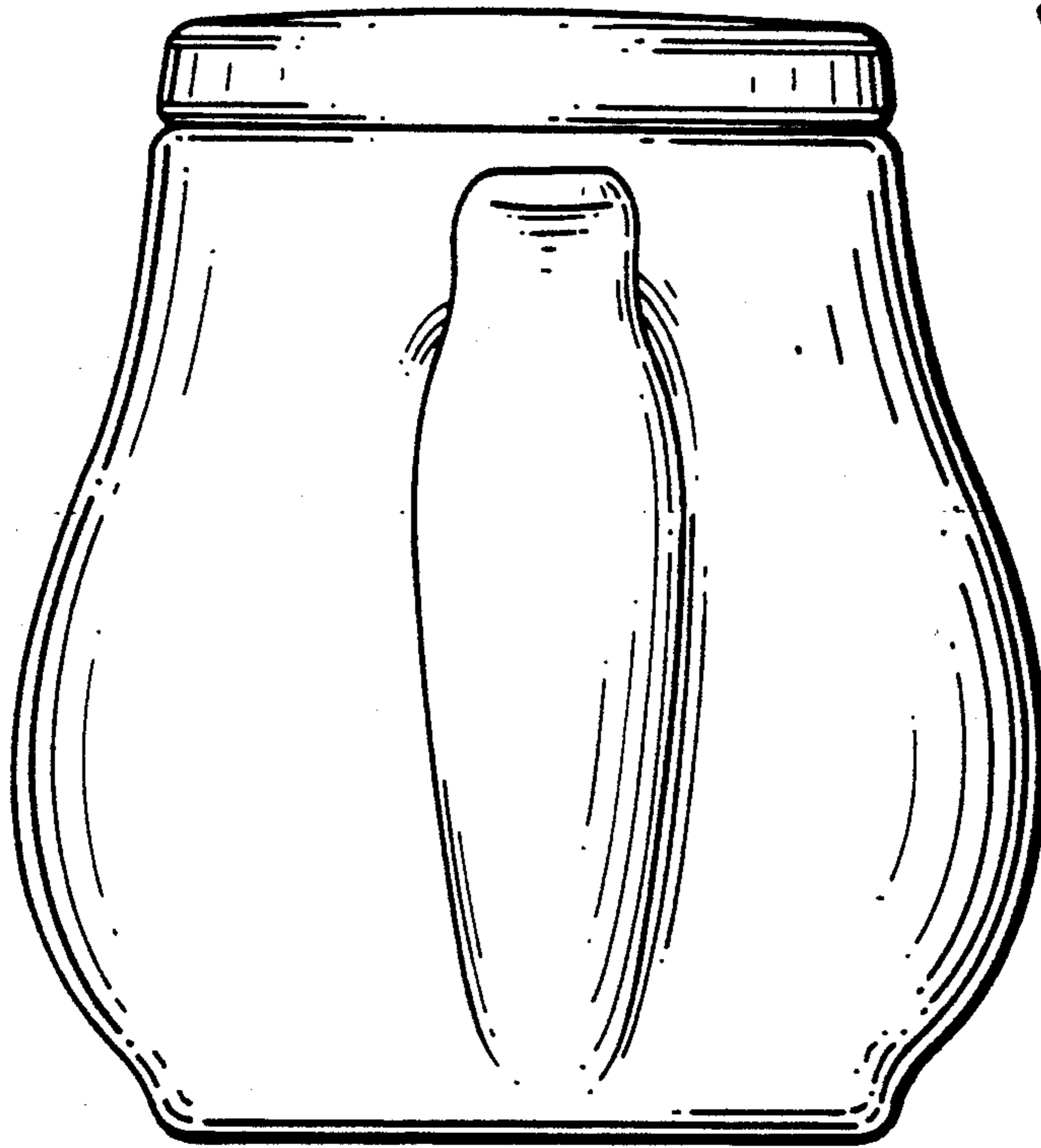
