FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a food serving bowl showing our new design;

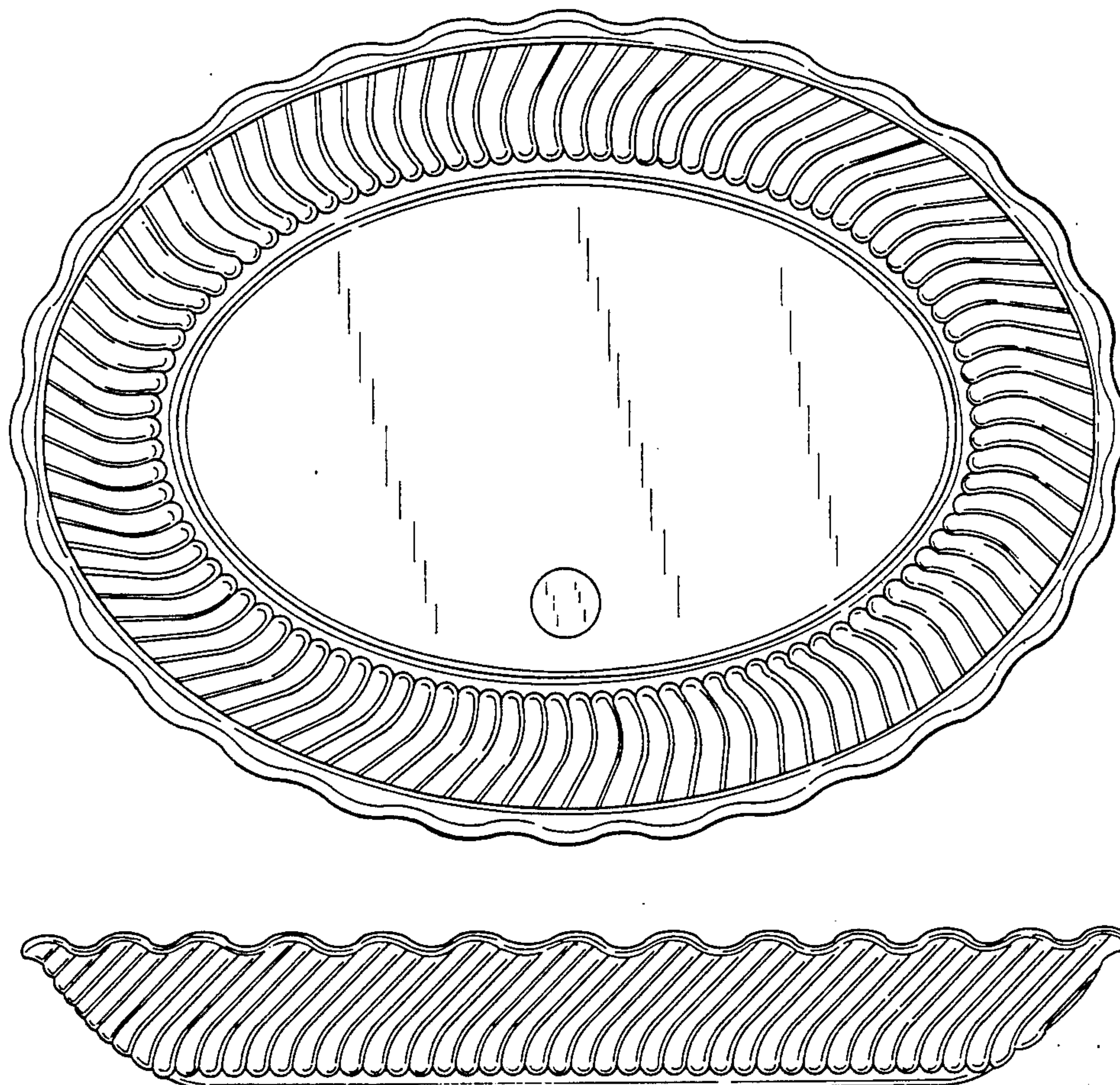
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view;

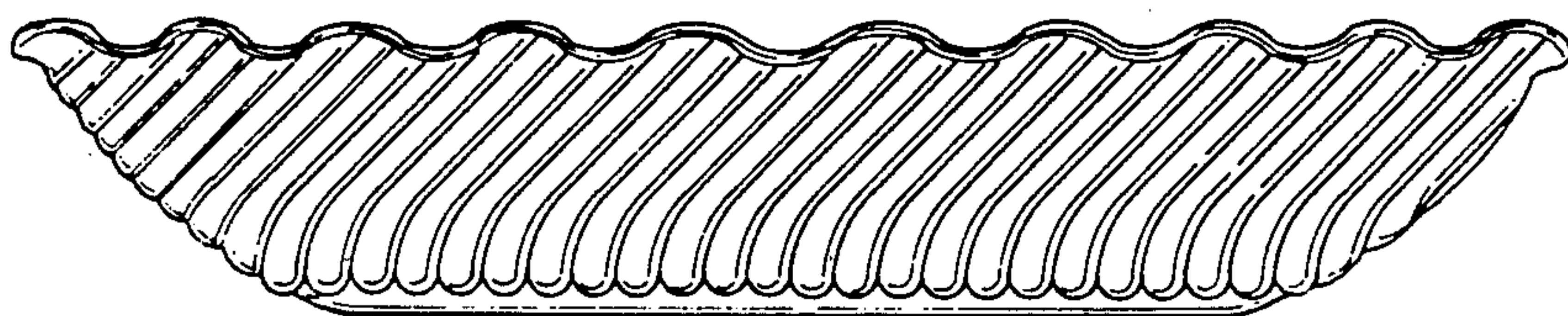
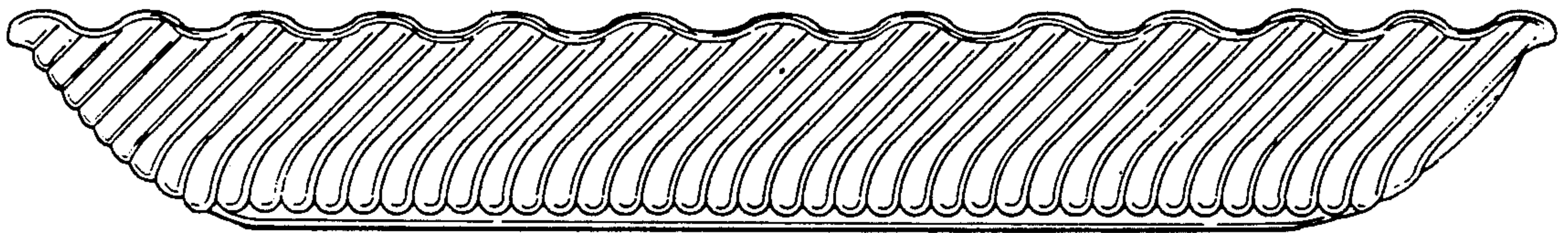
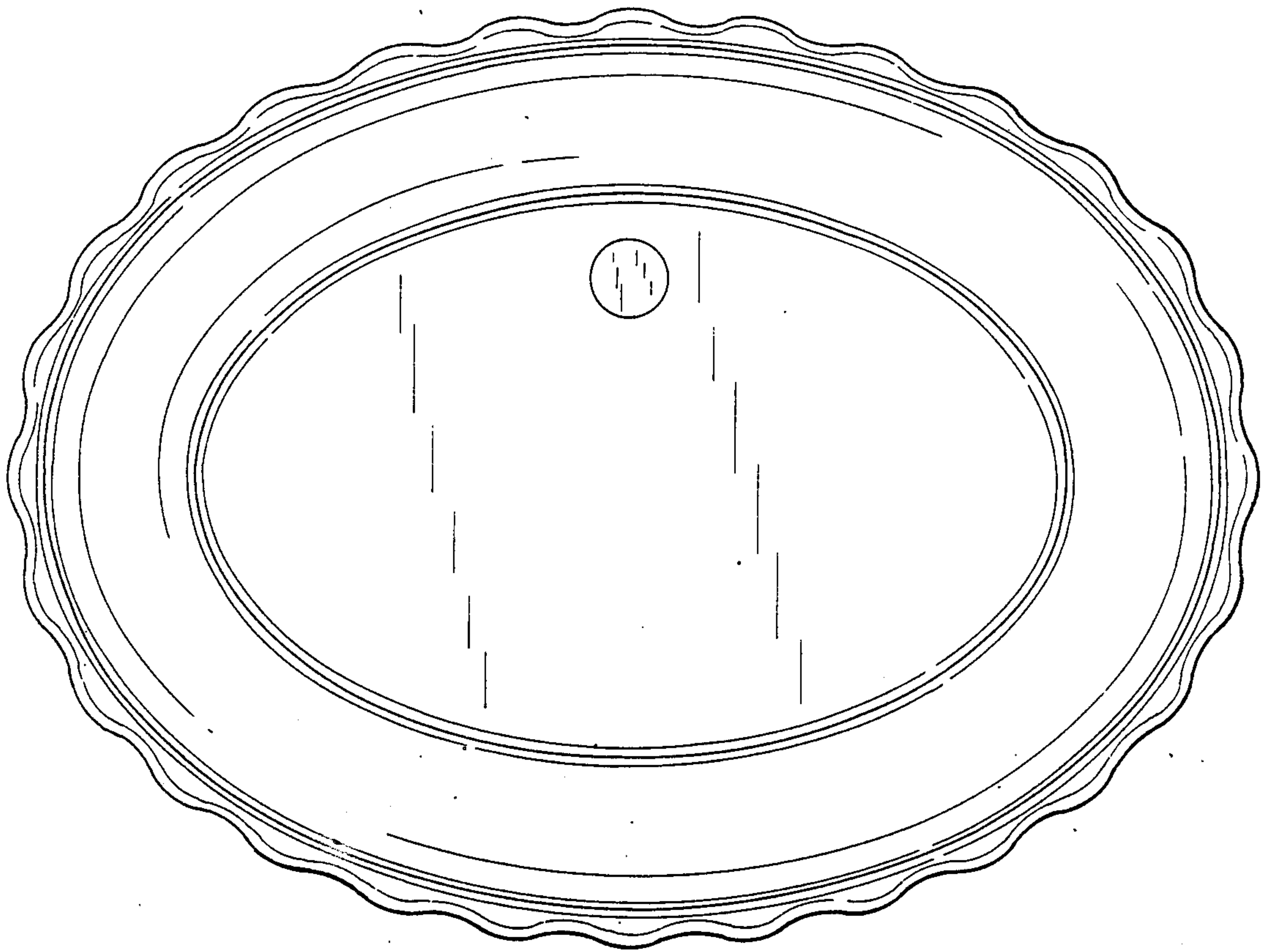
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view;

FIG. 6 is an elevational view thereof of the end opposite that shown in FIG. 3.





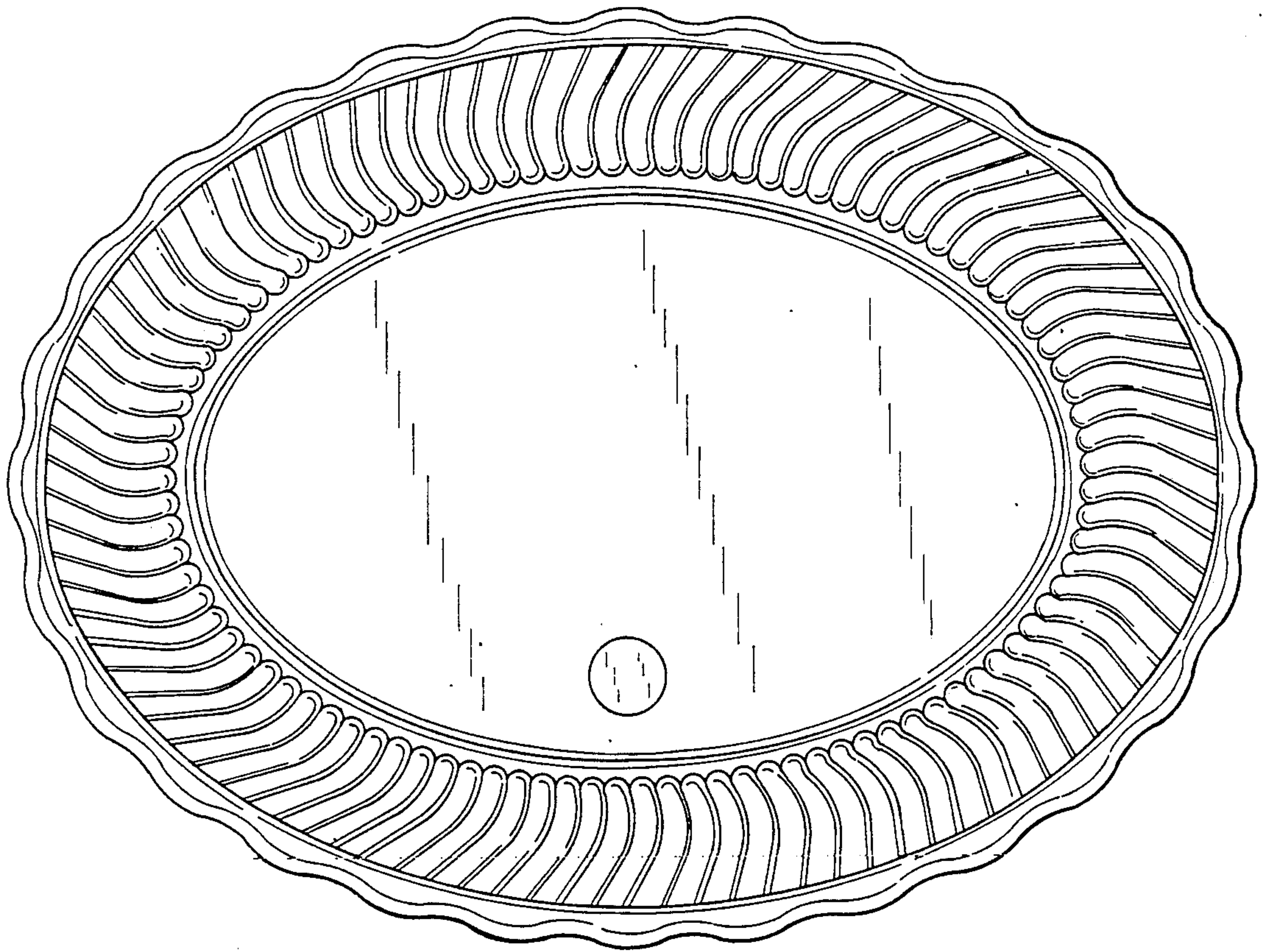

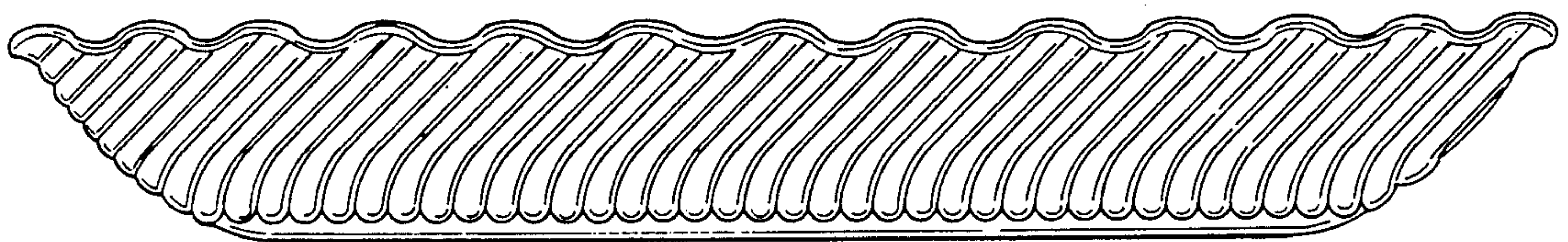

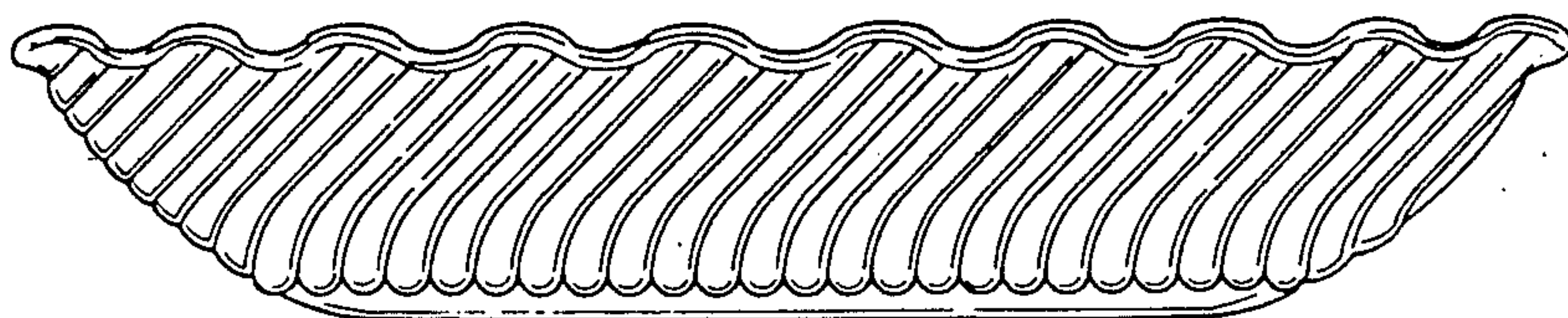
