DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side perspective view of the combined front panel and bumper unit exterior surface for a motor home showing the new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

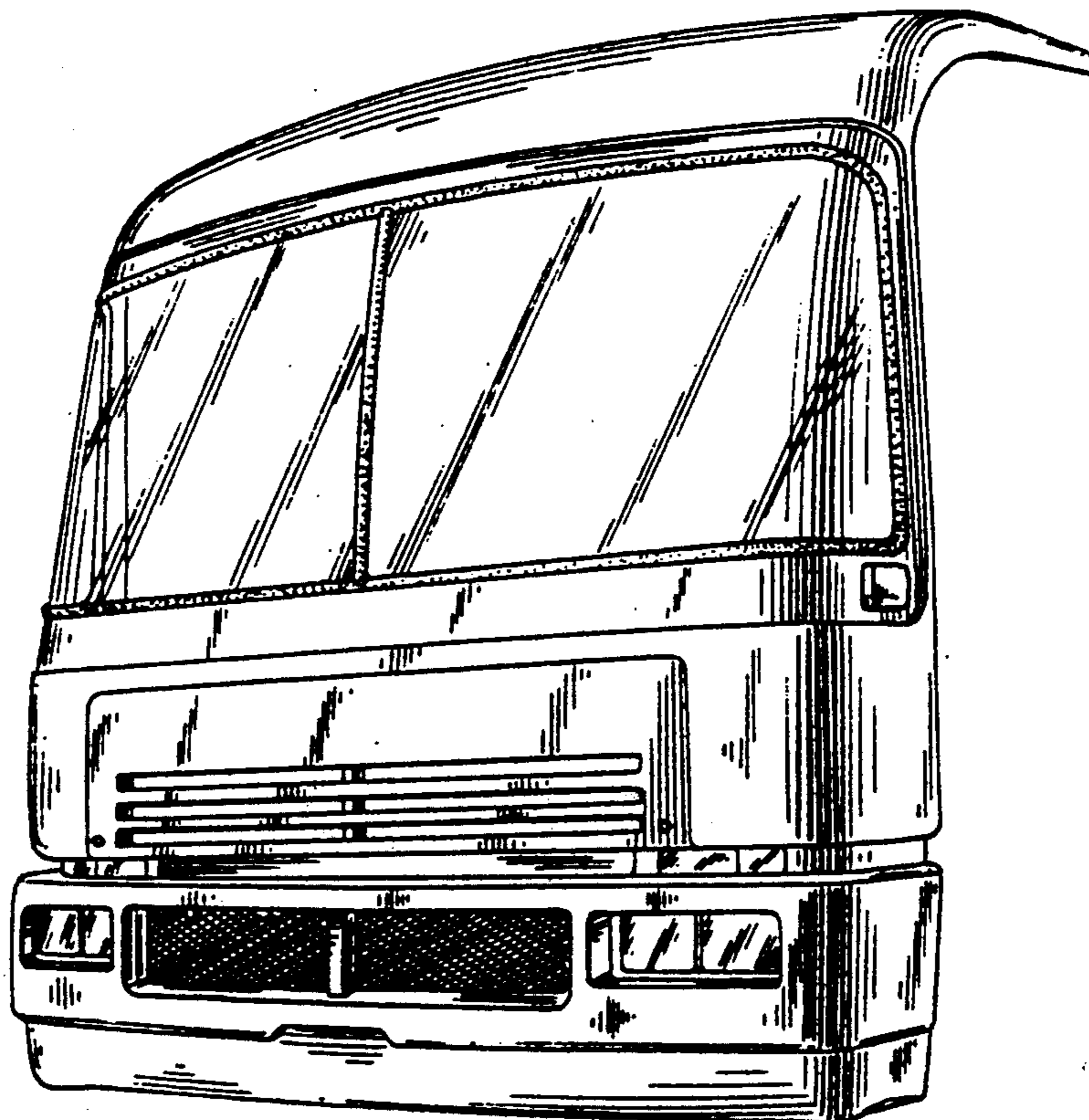

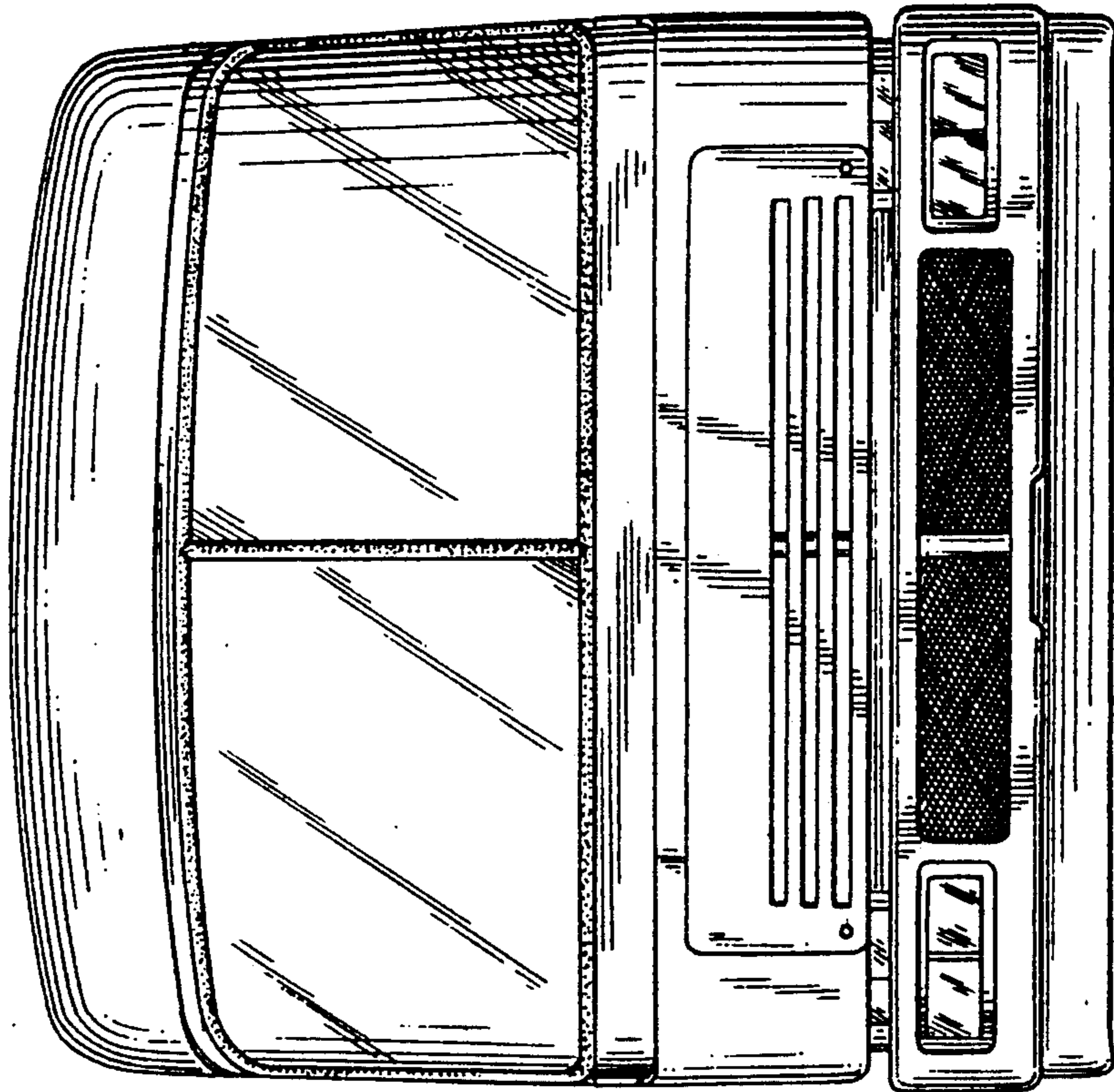

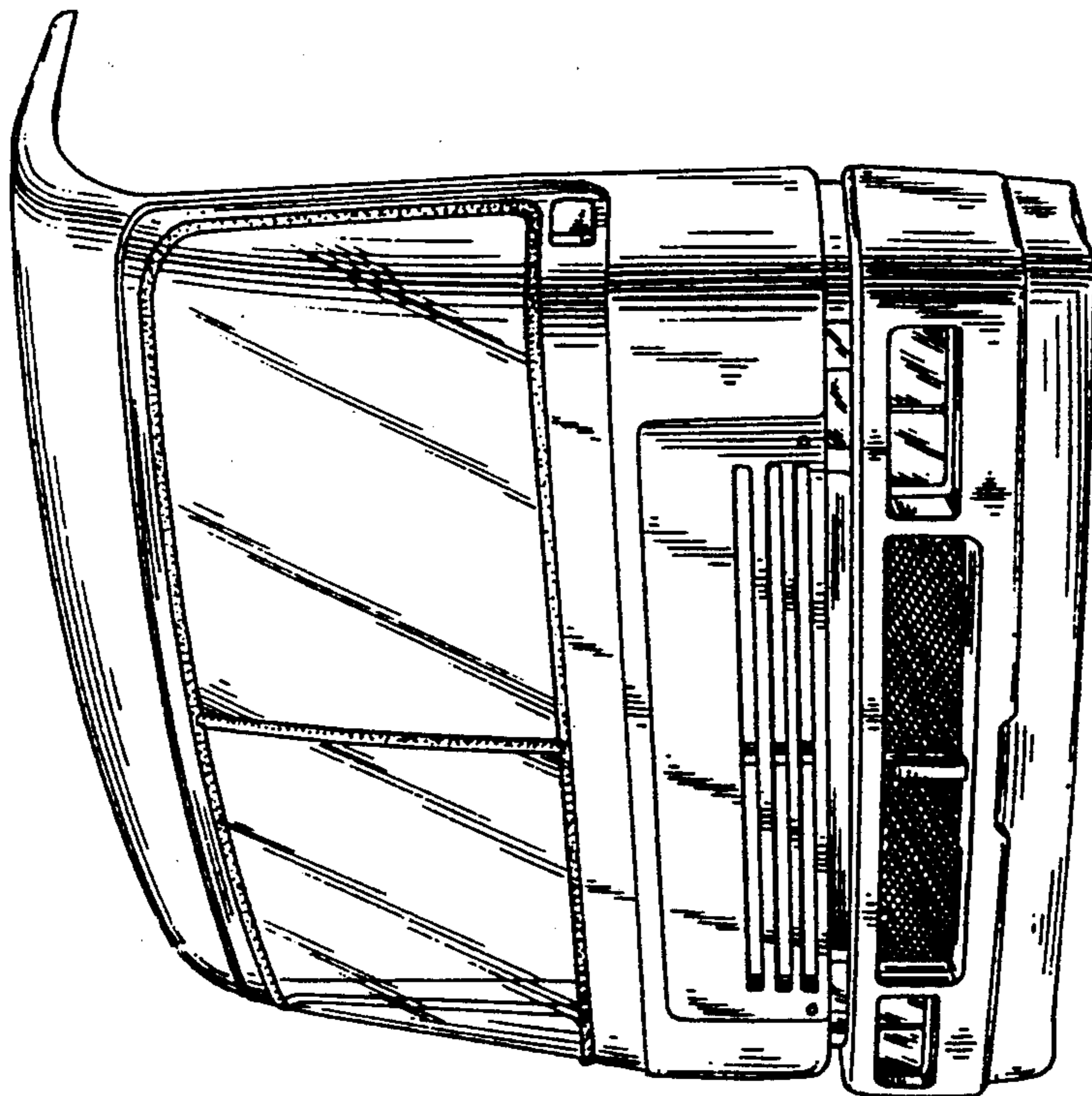

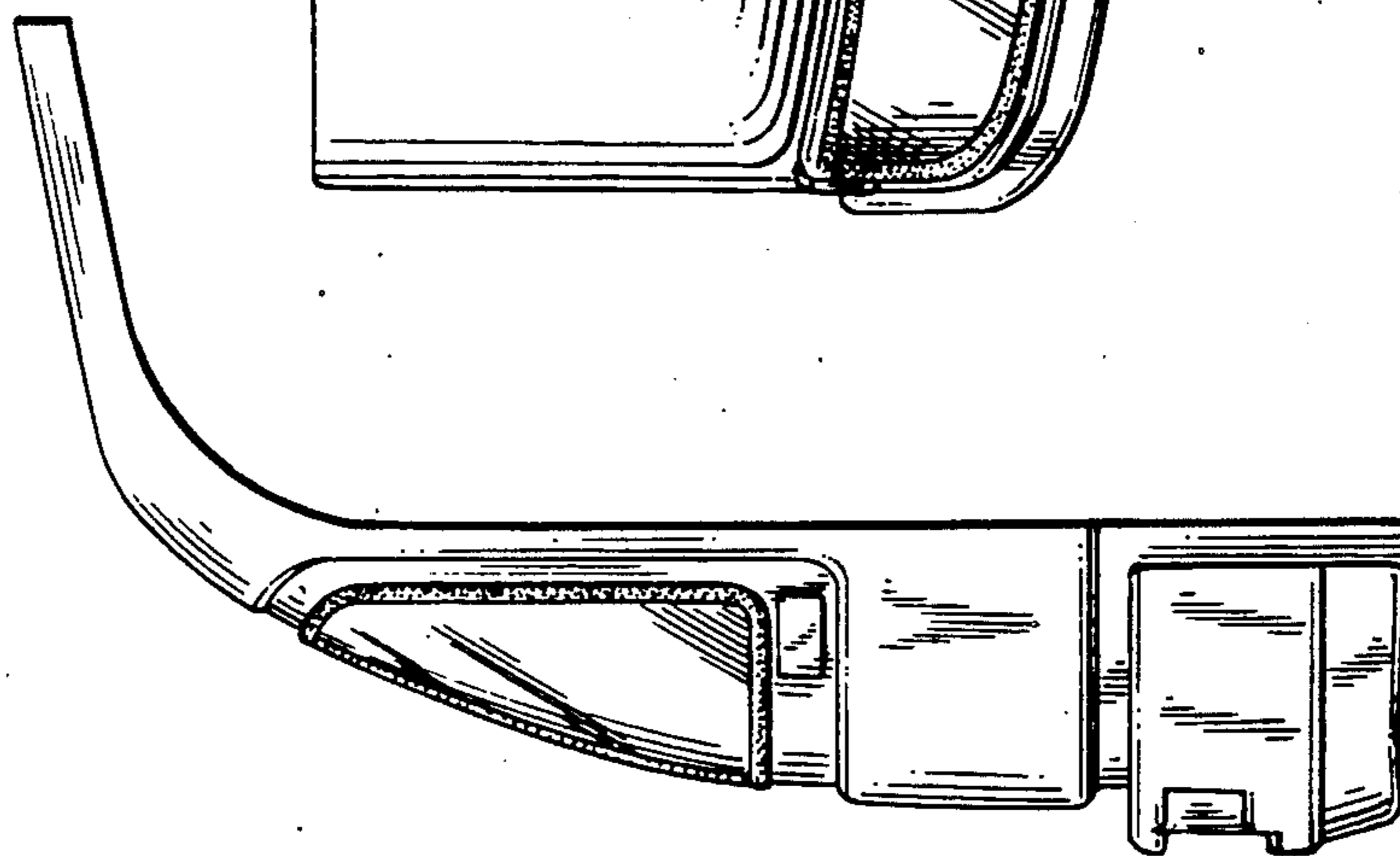

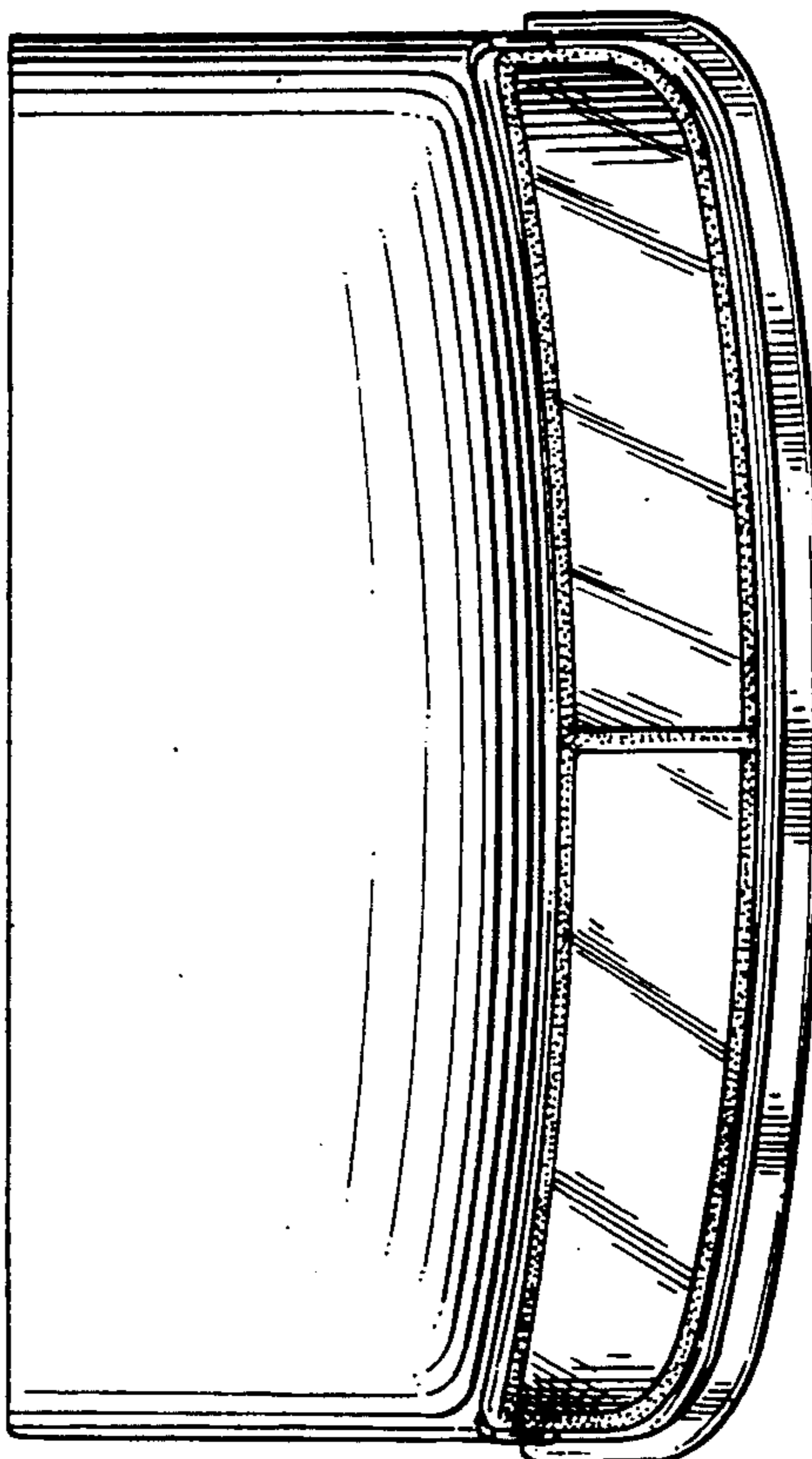
