DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a top, right, front perspective view thereof.

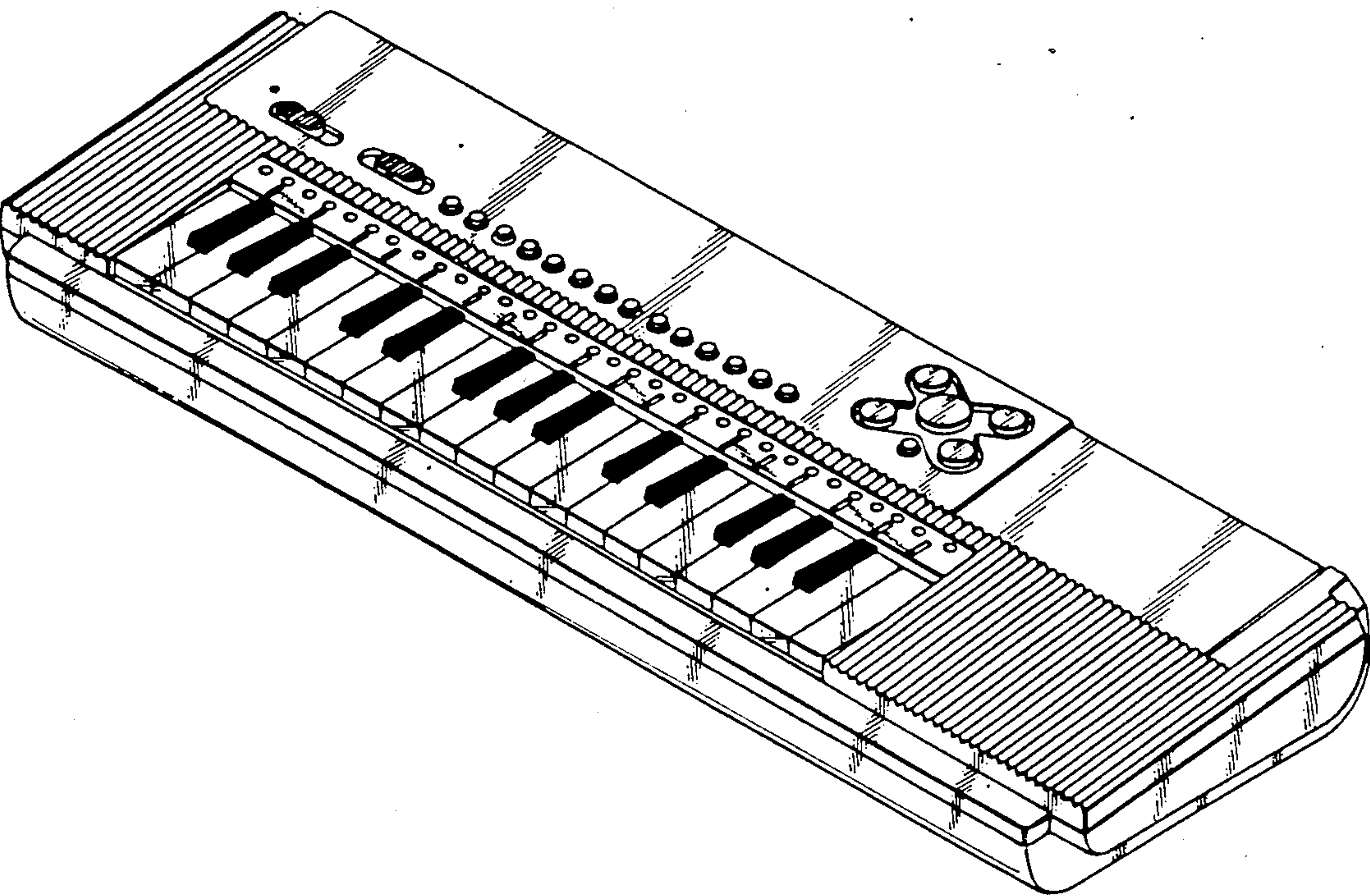

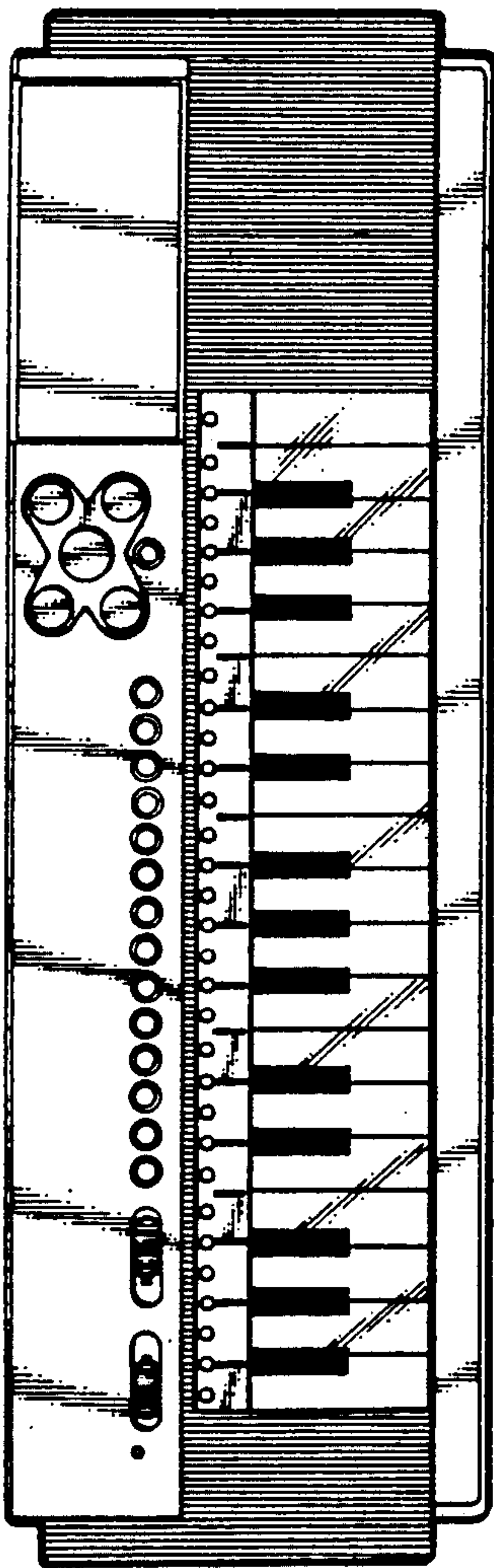

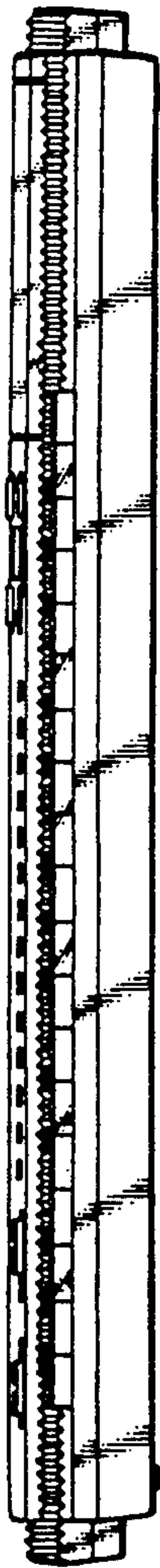

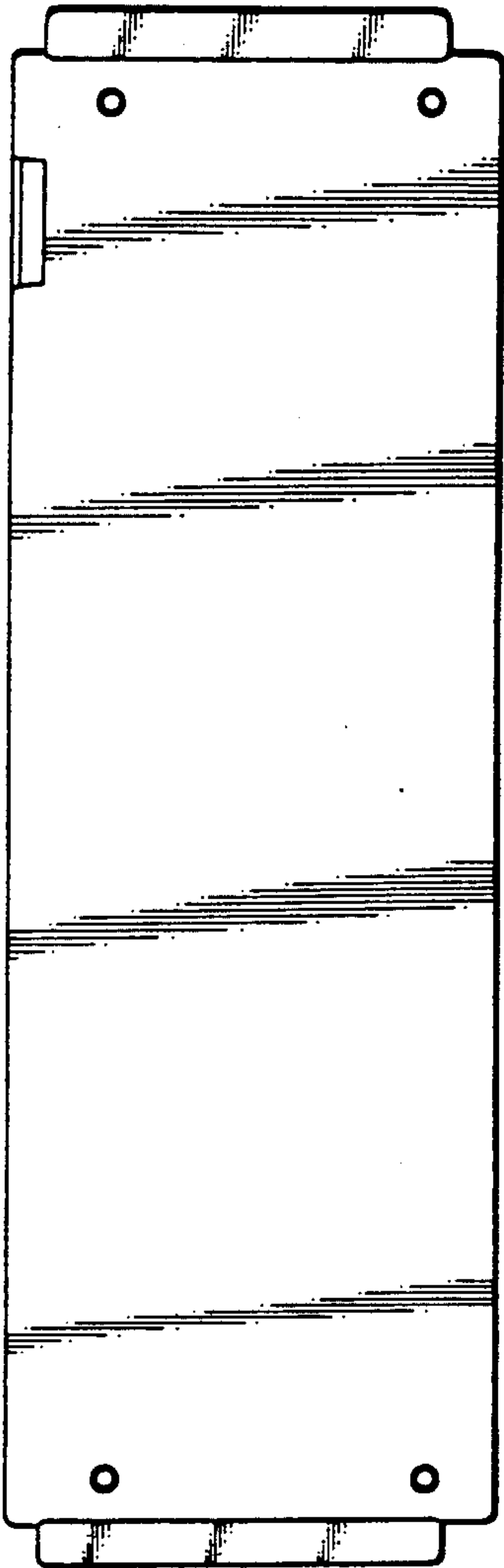
