[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display stand for noting television schedules, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a display stand for noting television schedules showing my new design; and

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, with the right side being a mirror image.

The undisclosed rear of the display member and the top and bottom of the base are flat and plain.



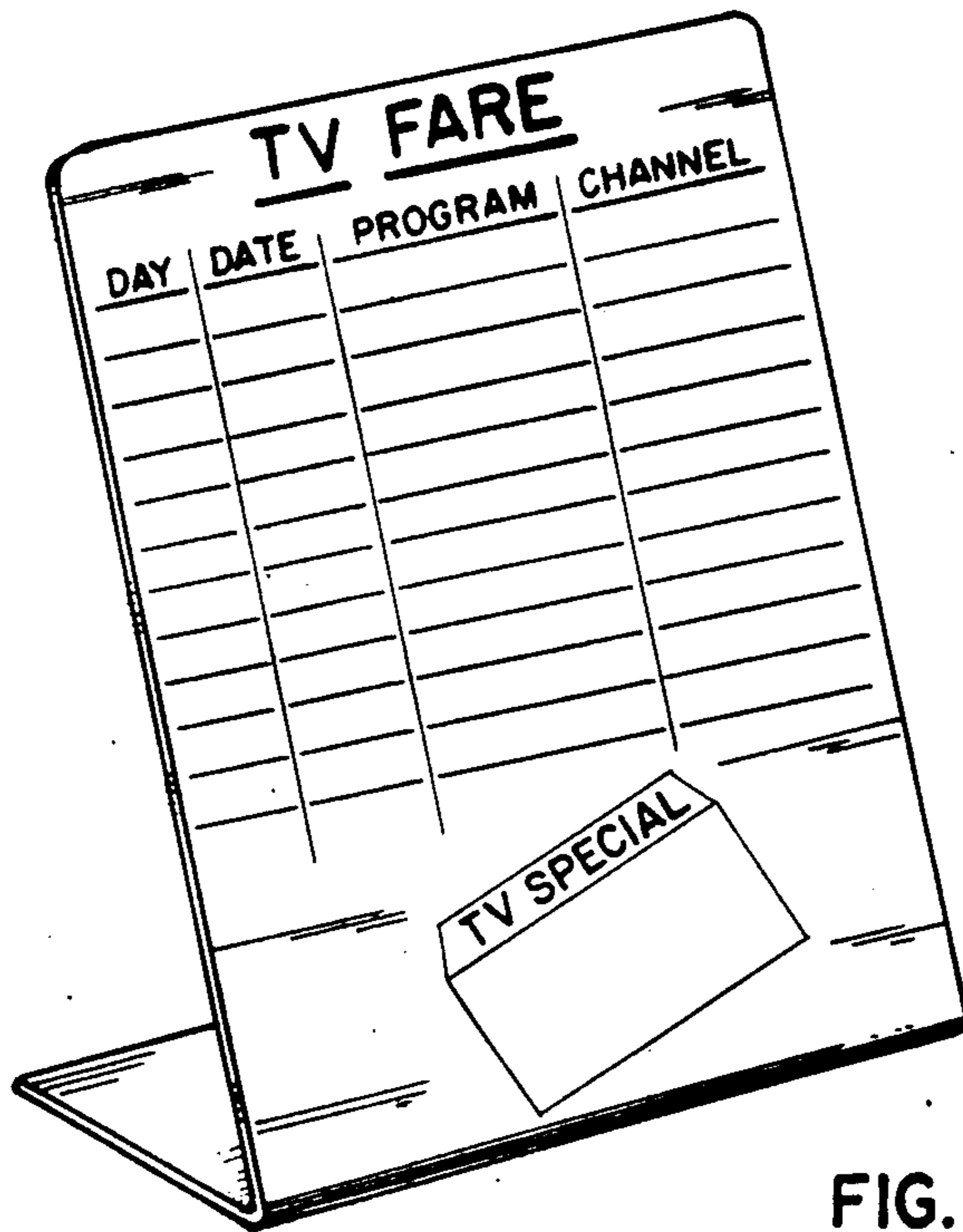

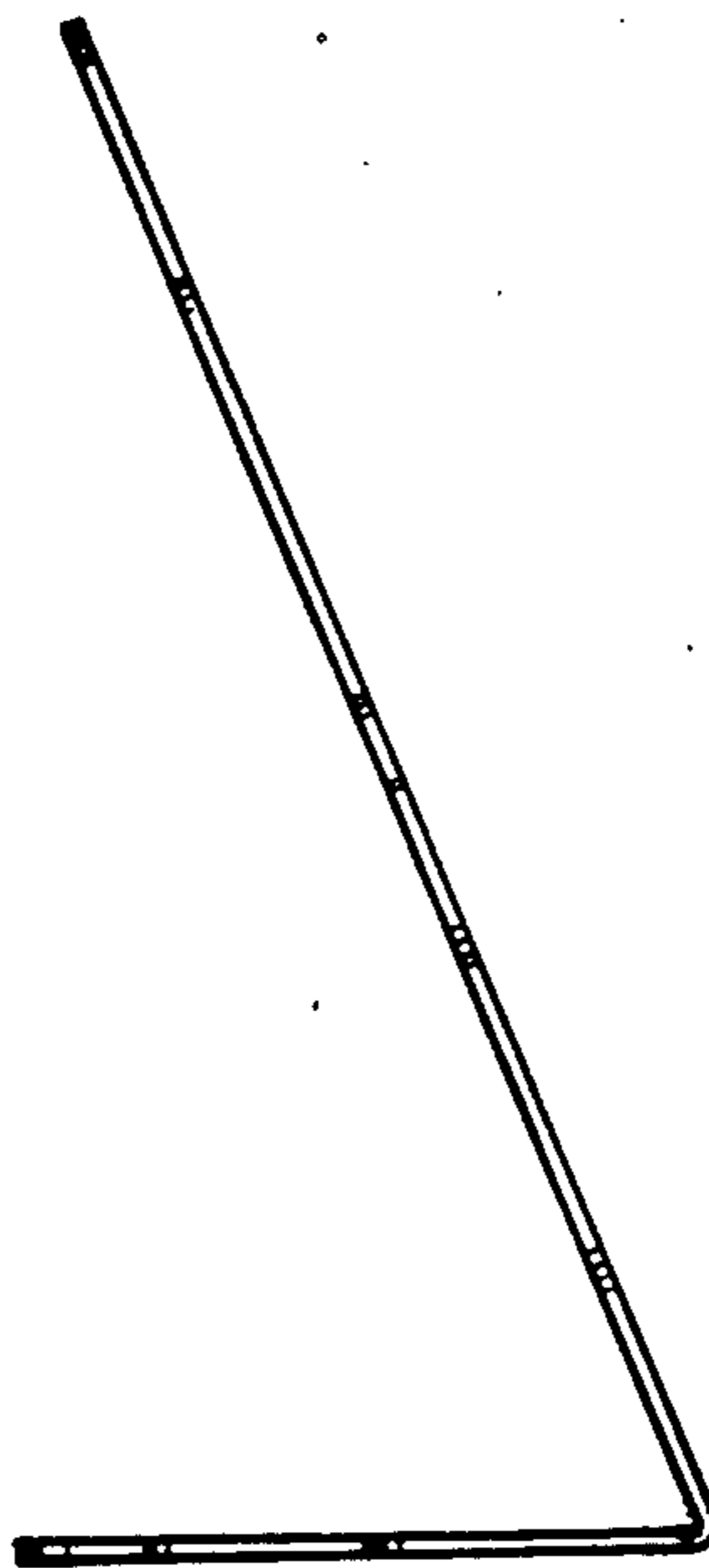
