[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a set of chessman, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the pawn, of the set of chessman, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other sides being identical;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of a rook or castle;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of FIG. 3, the other sides being identical;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a knight;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 5, the other sides being identical;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a bishop;

FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of FIG. 7, the other sides being identical;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of a king;

FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of FIG. 9, the other sides being identical;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of a queen;

FIG. 12 is a side elevational view of FIG. 11, the other sides being identical;

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of FIGS. 1-12;

FIG. 14 is a sectional view taken along line 14—14 of FIG. 8.
