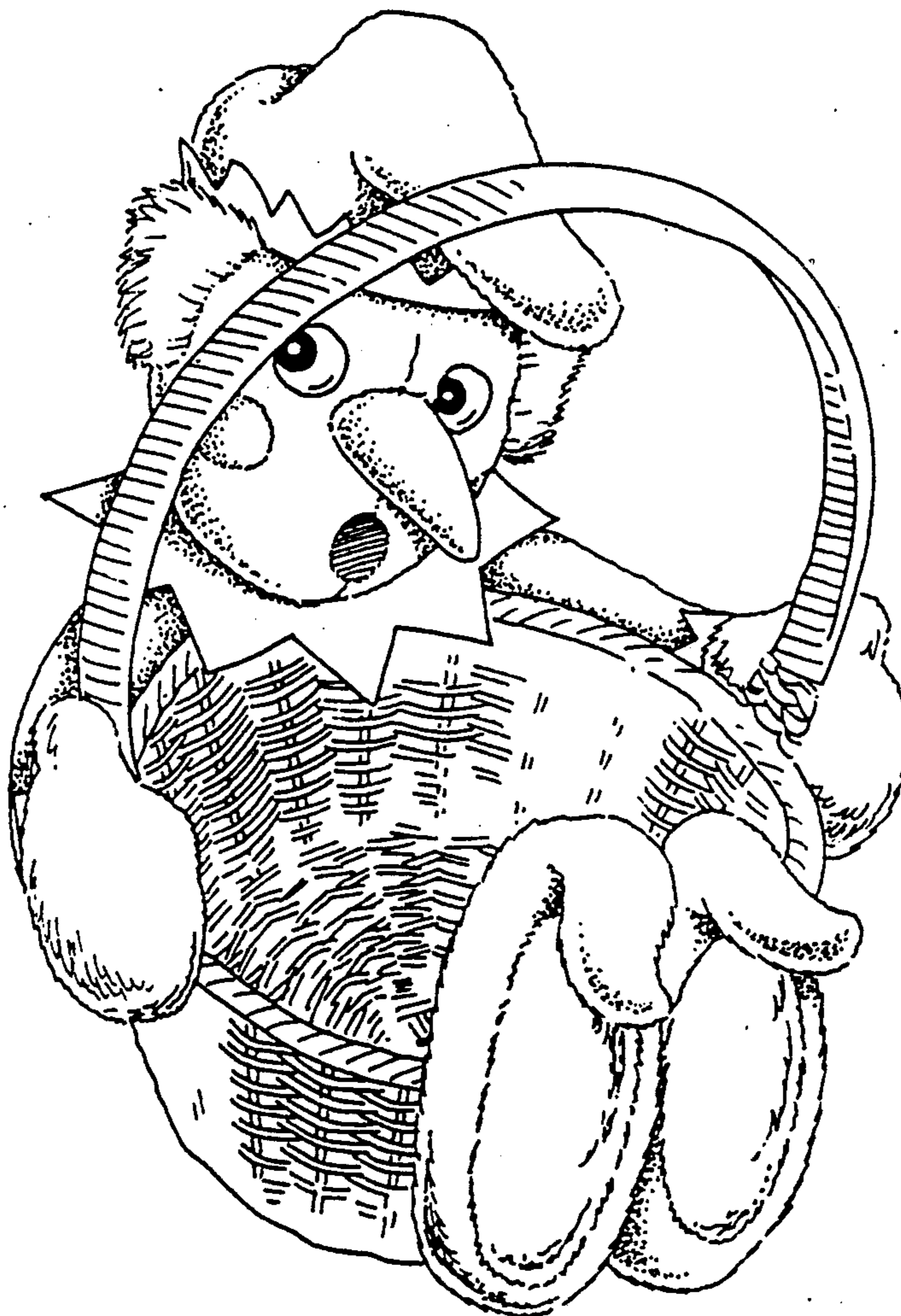

FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, right side perspective view thereof.



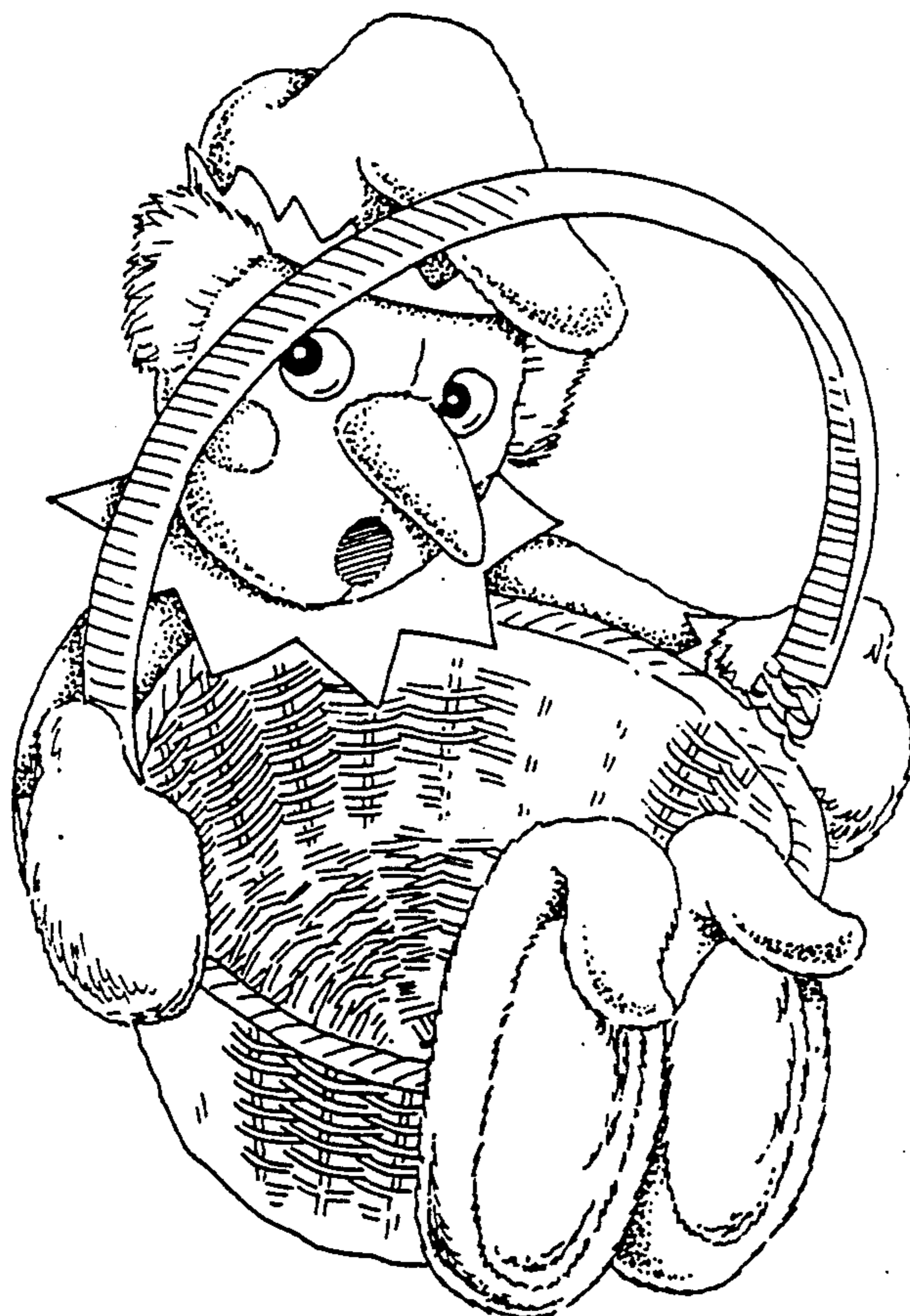

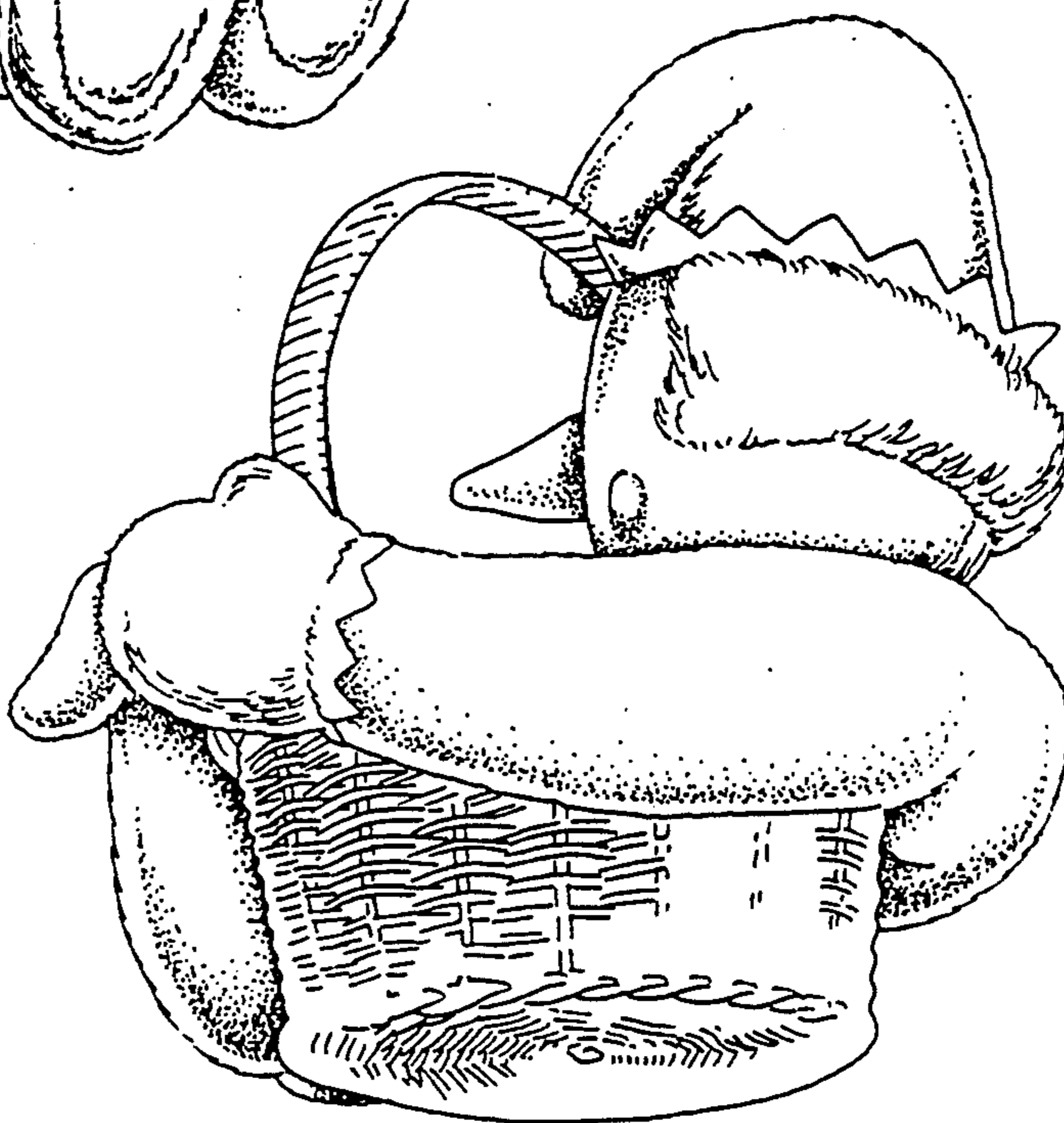
