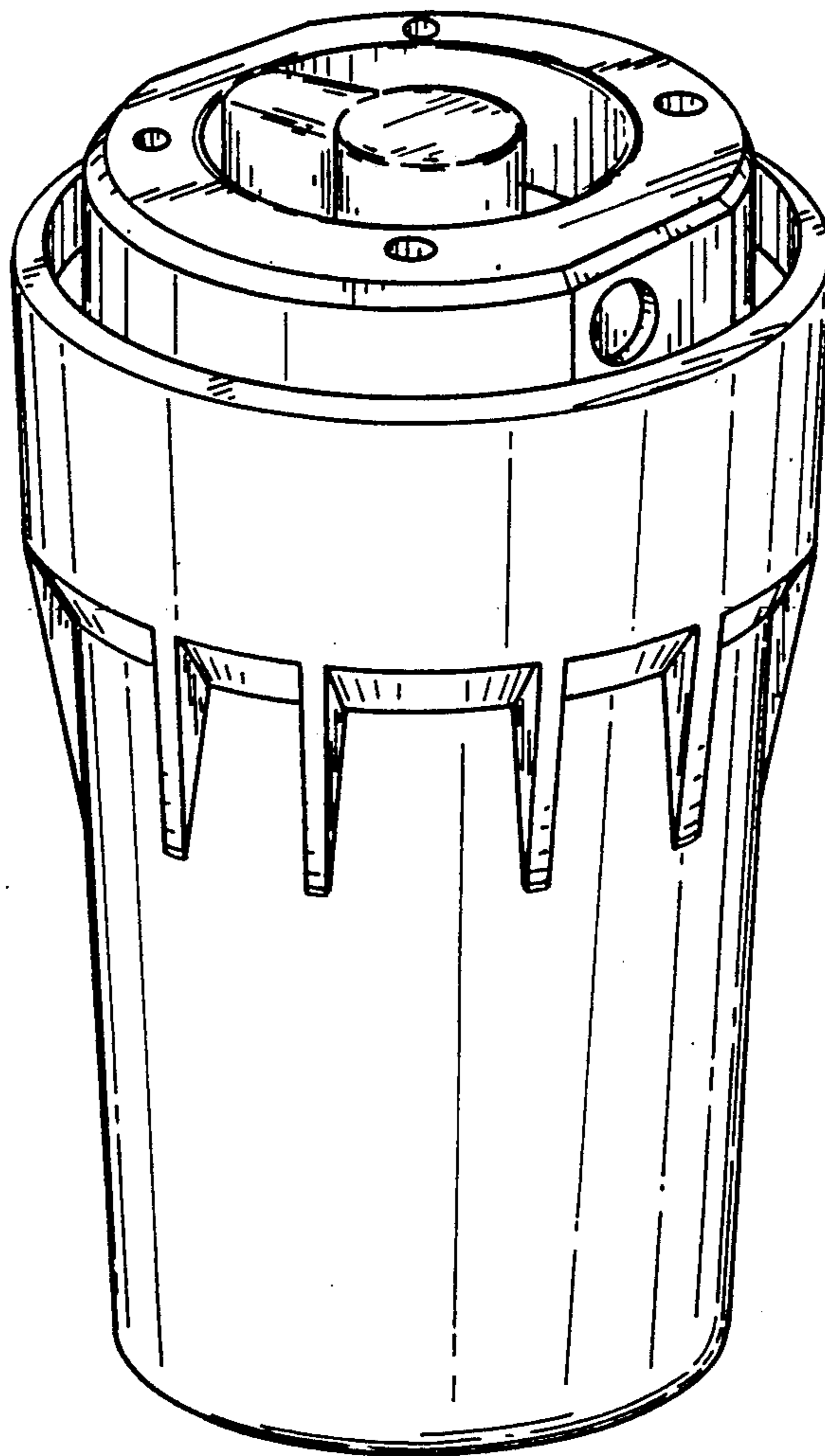

The ornamental design for a water filter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a water filter showing my new design, on an enlarged scale; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



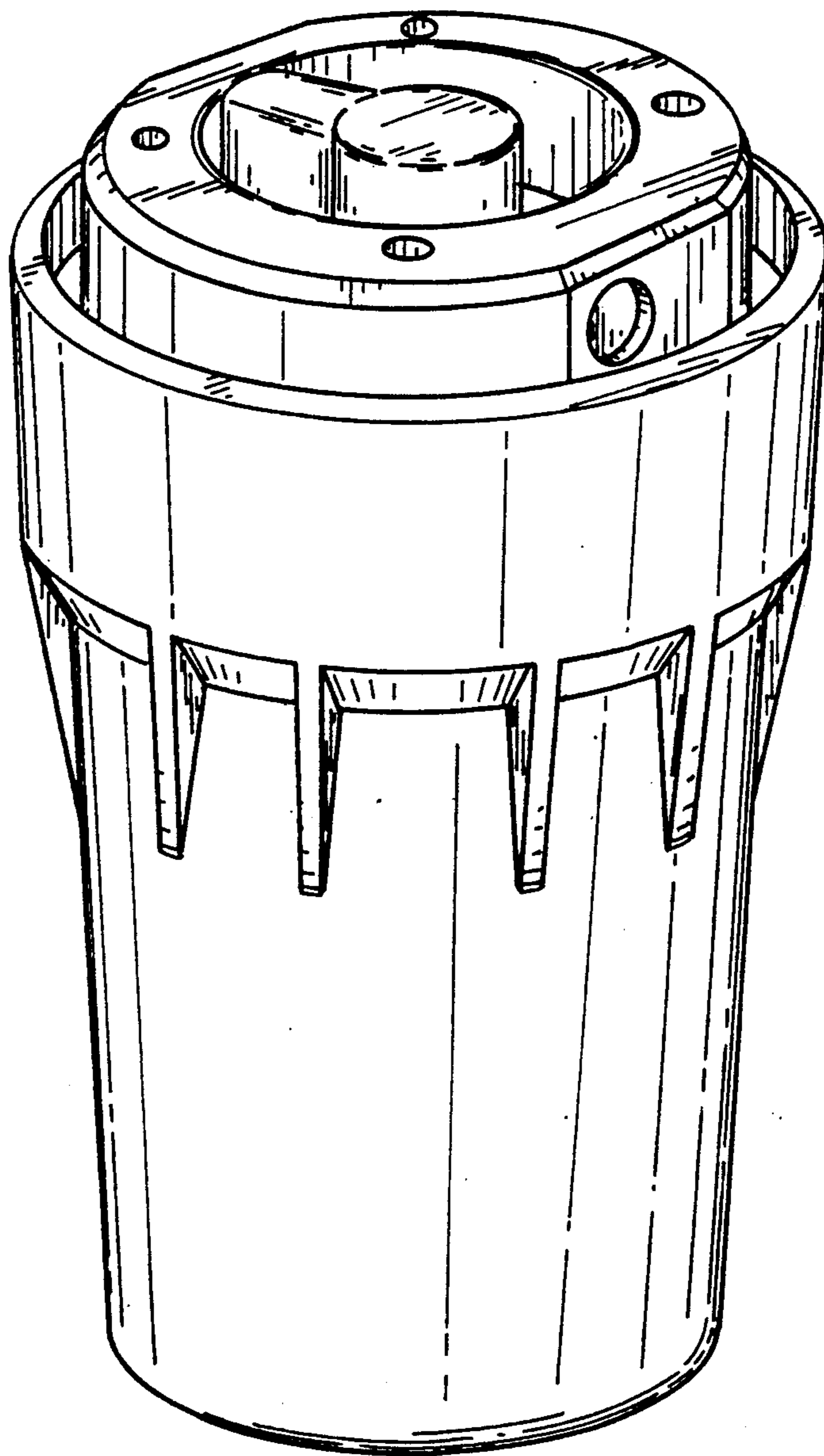

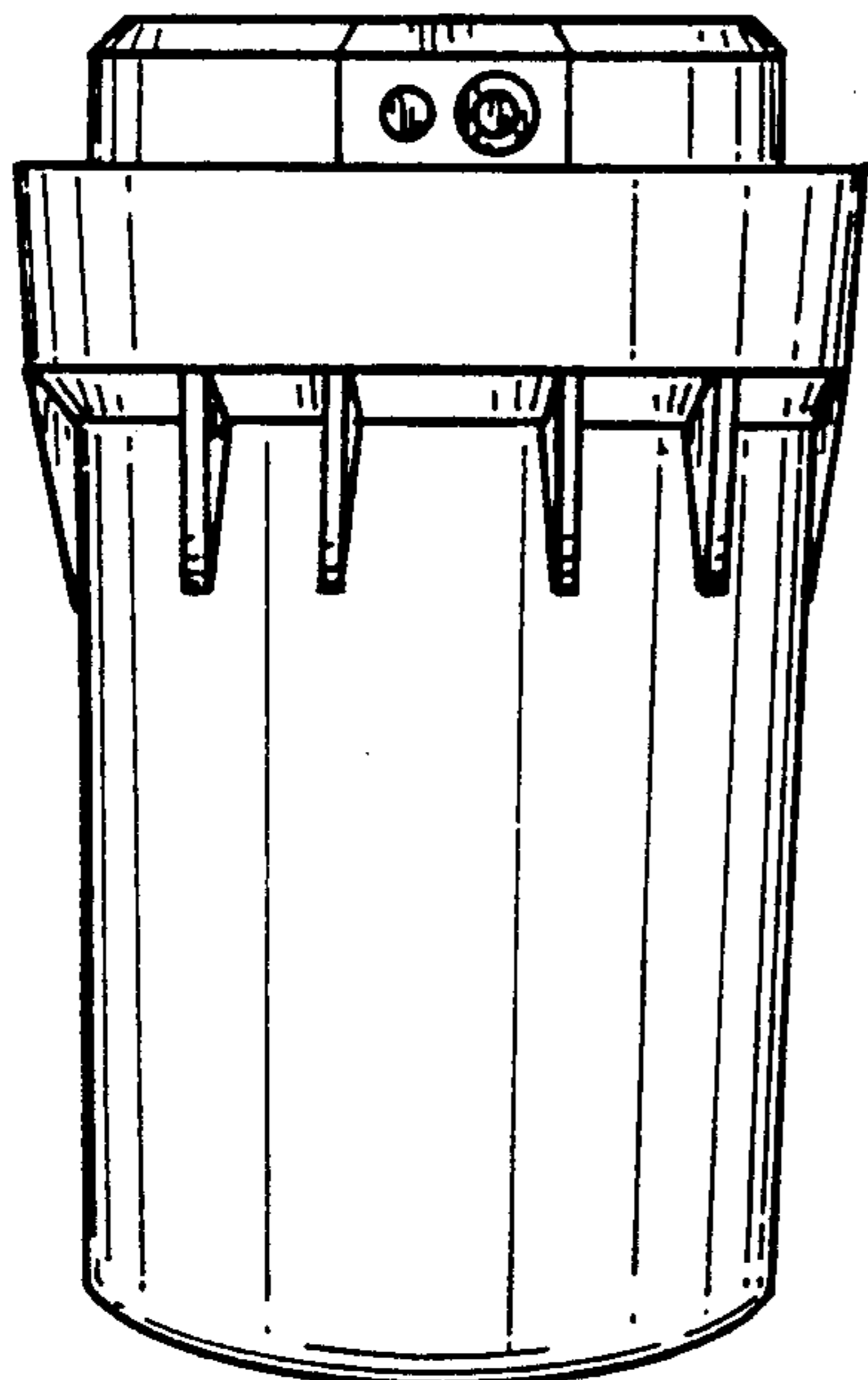

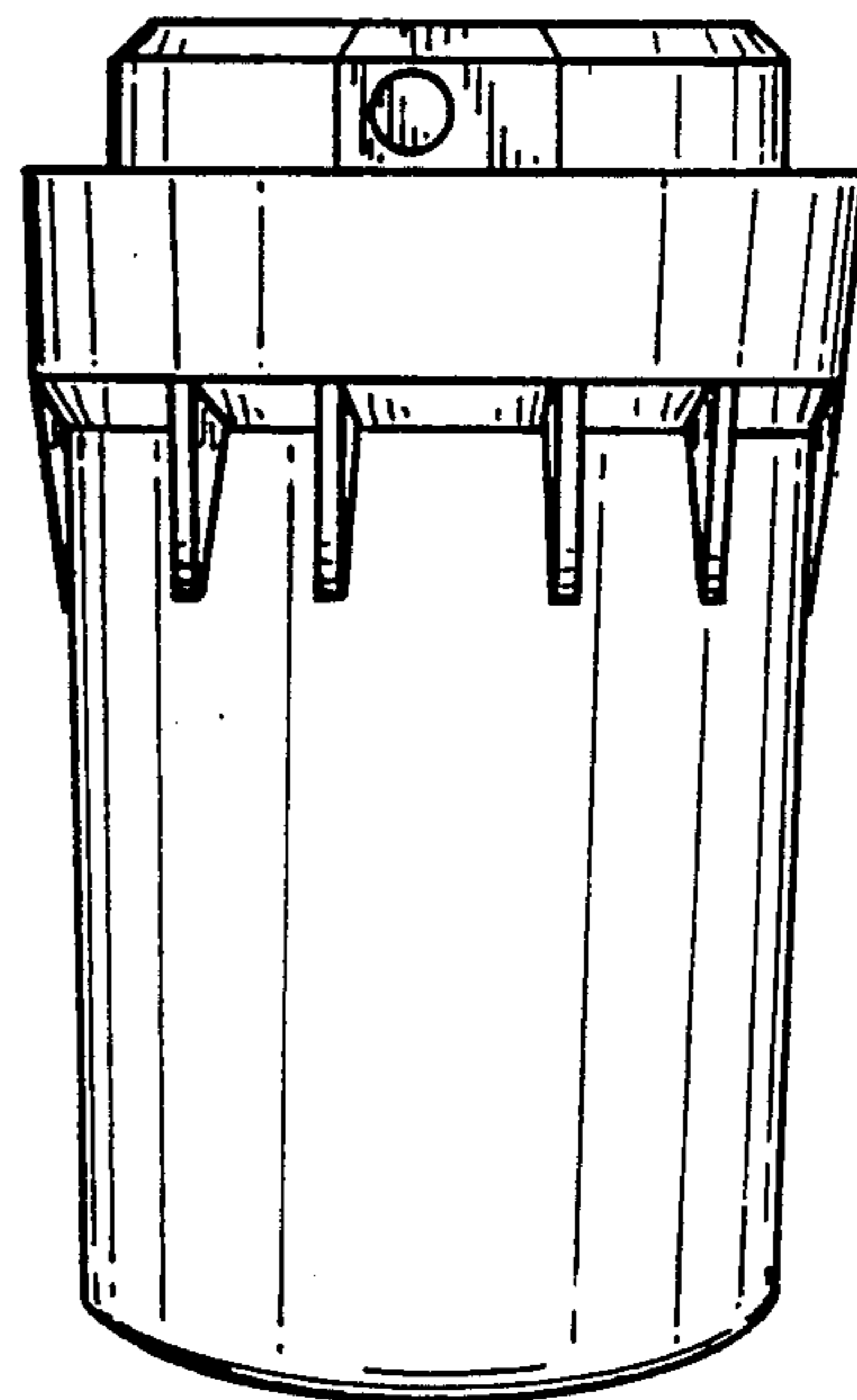

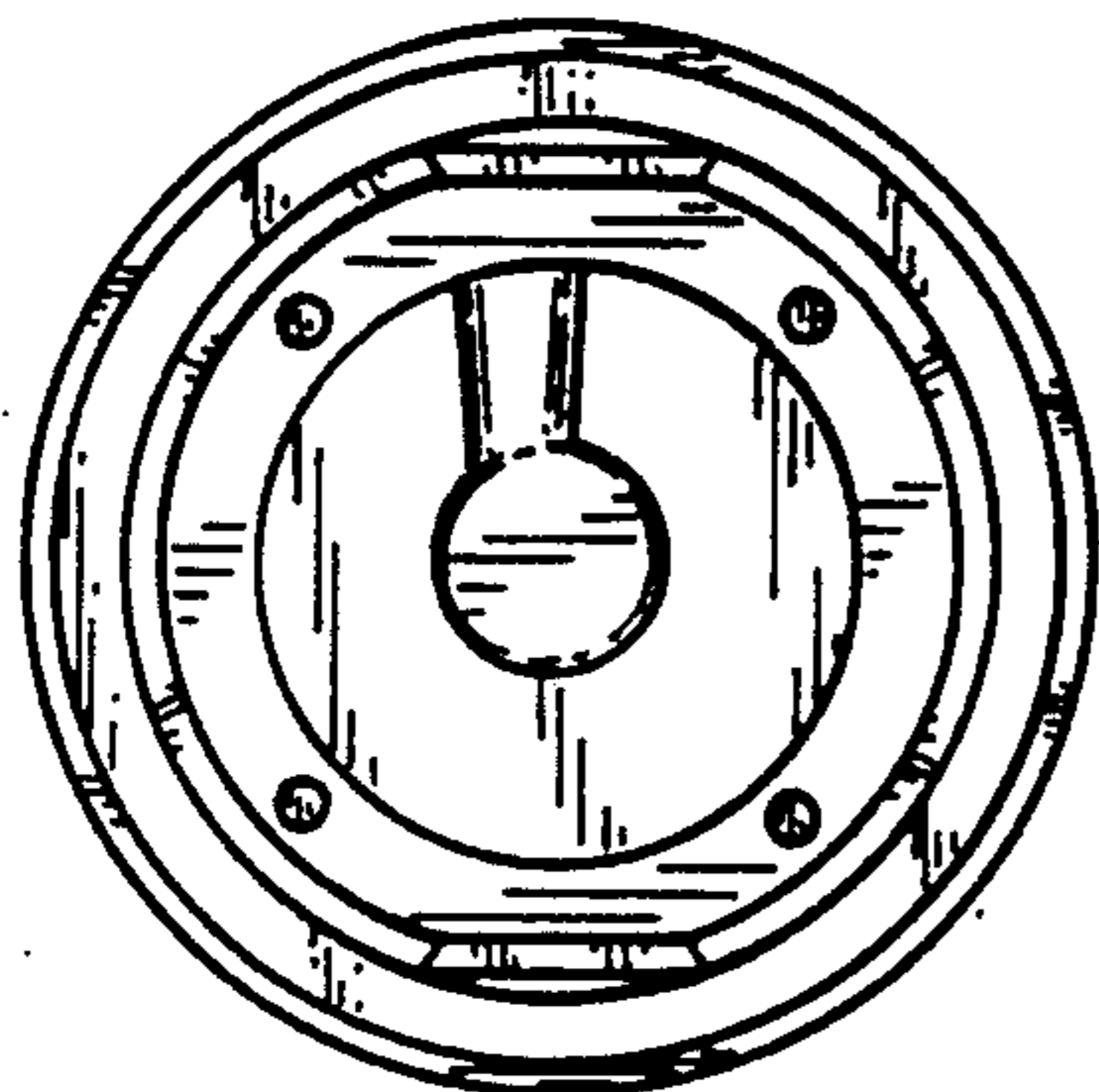

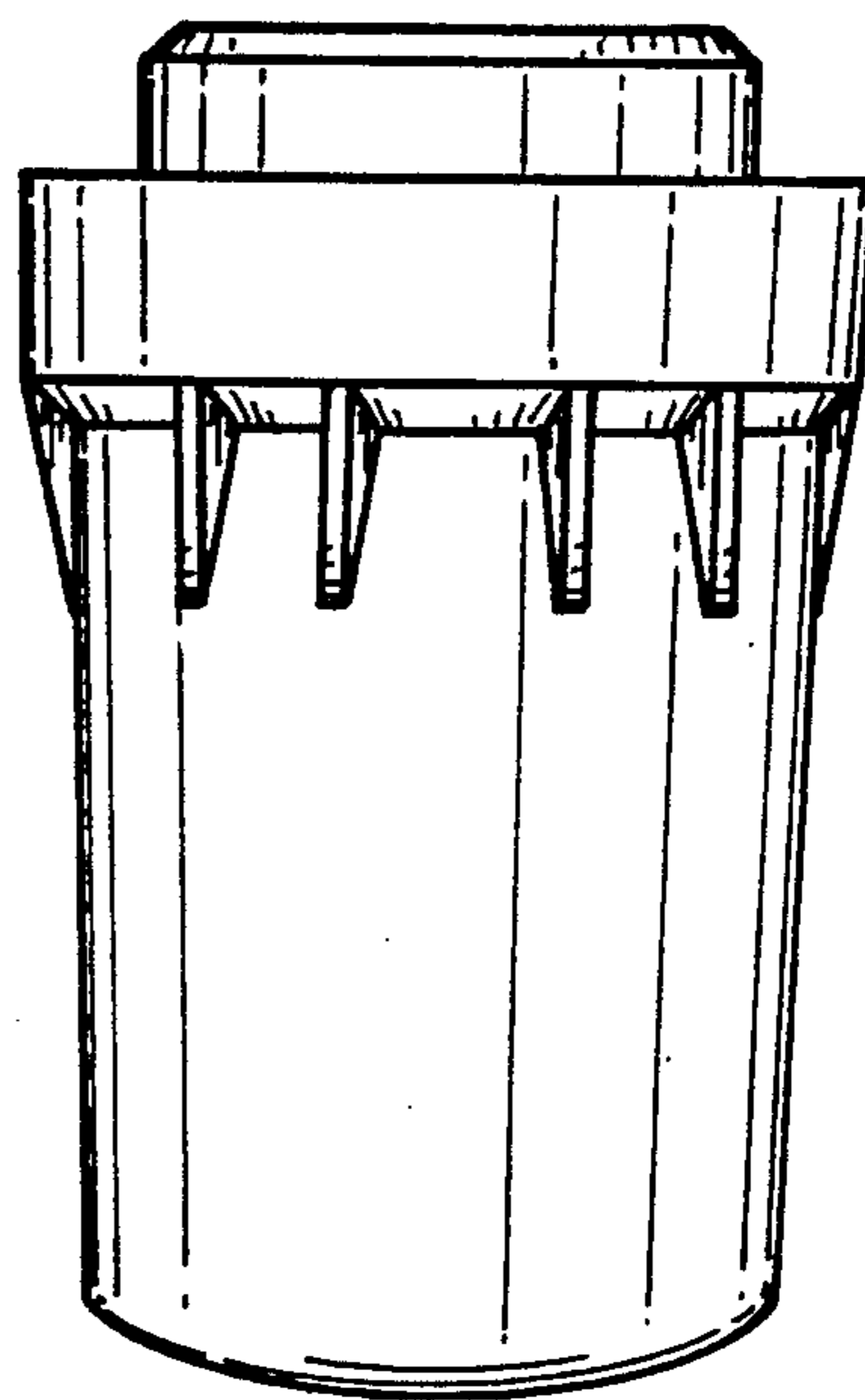

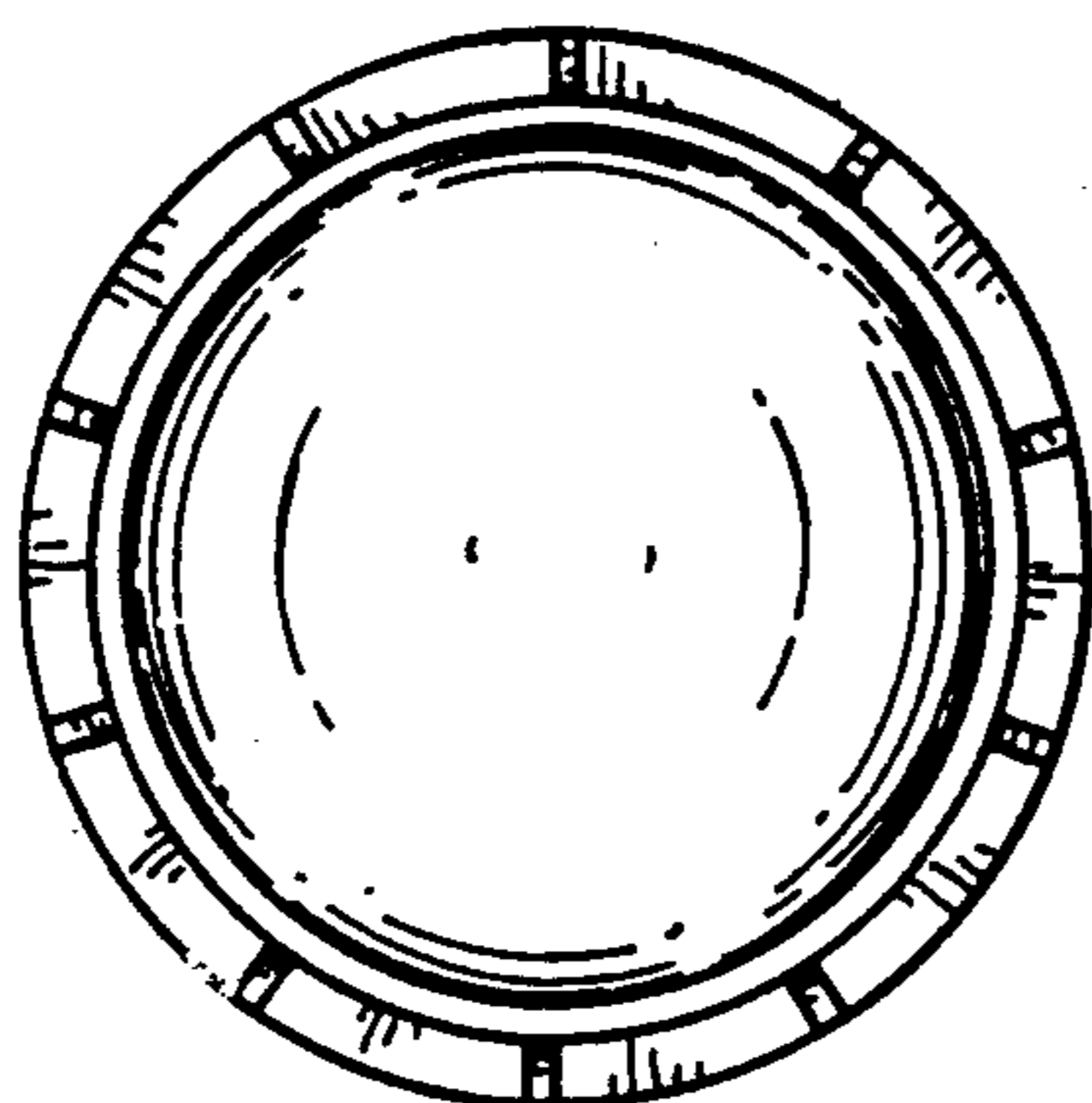
