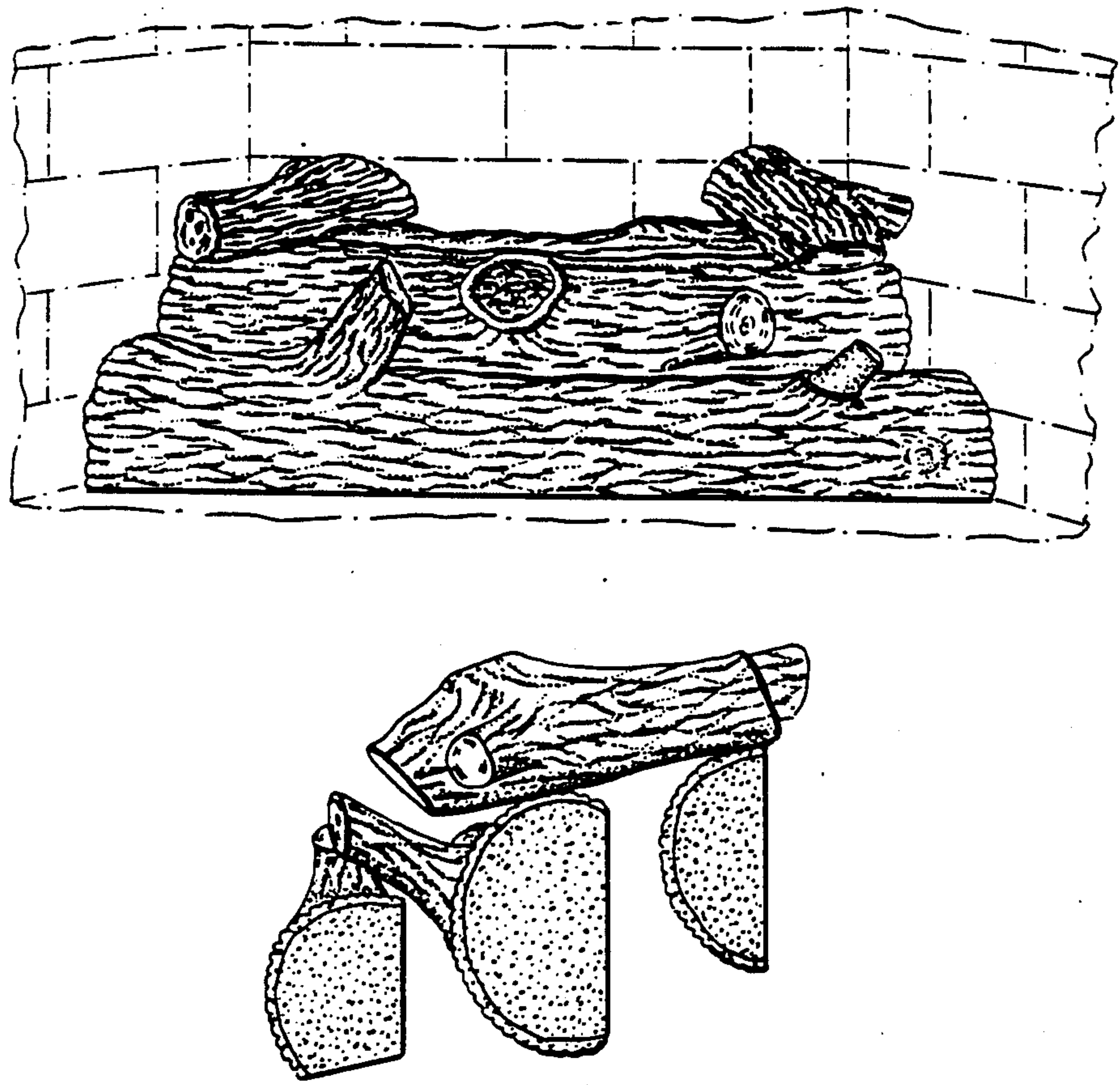

for a gas-fired fireplace, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an artificial log
assemblage for a gas-fired fireplace, showing my new
design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken-line showing of environmental structure in
FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only, and forms no
part of the claimed design.



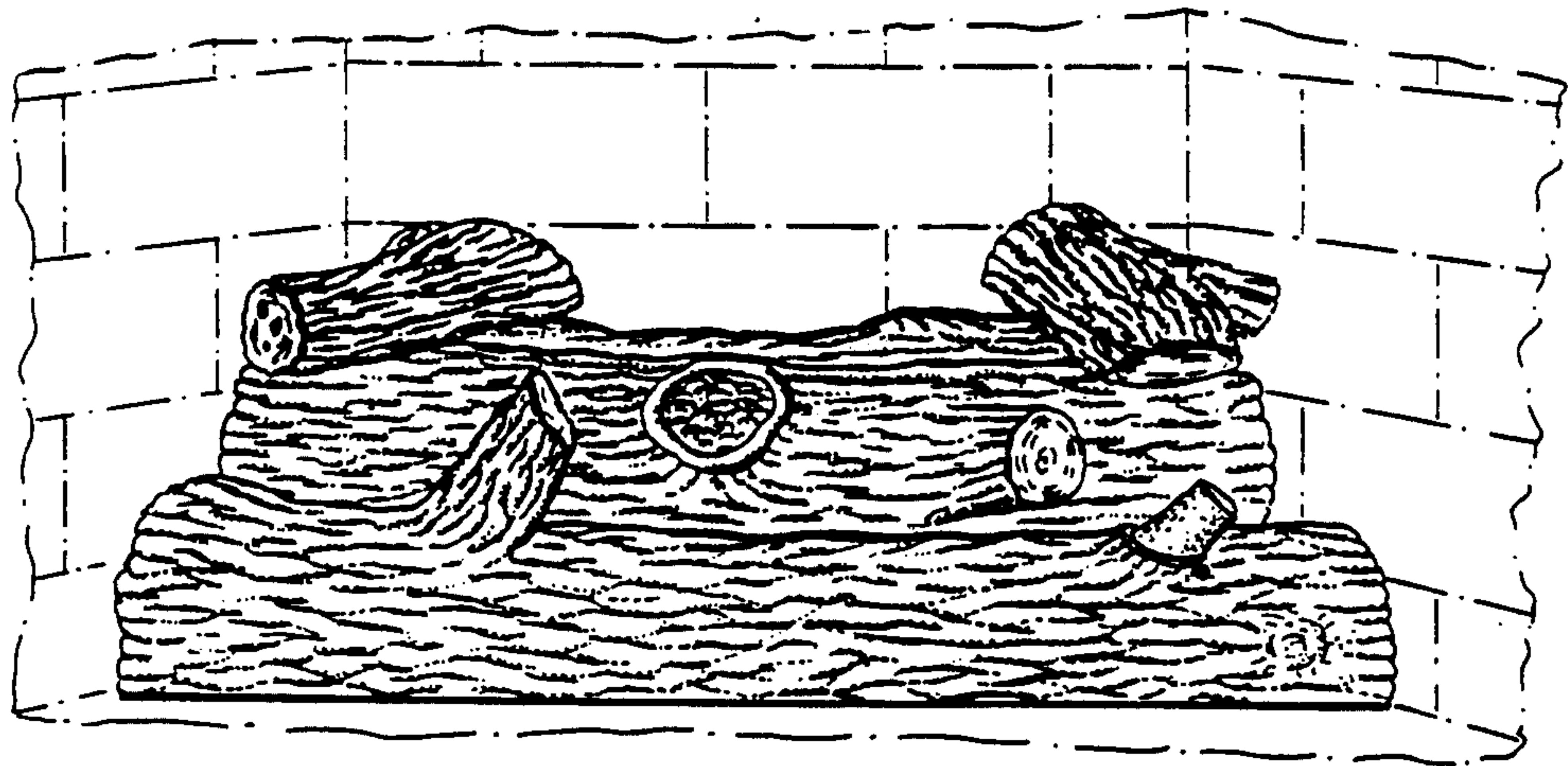

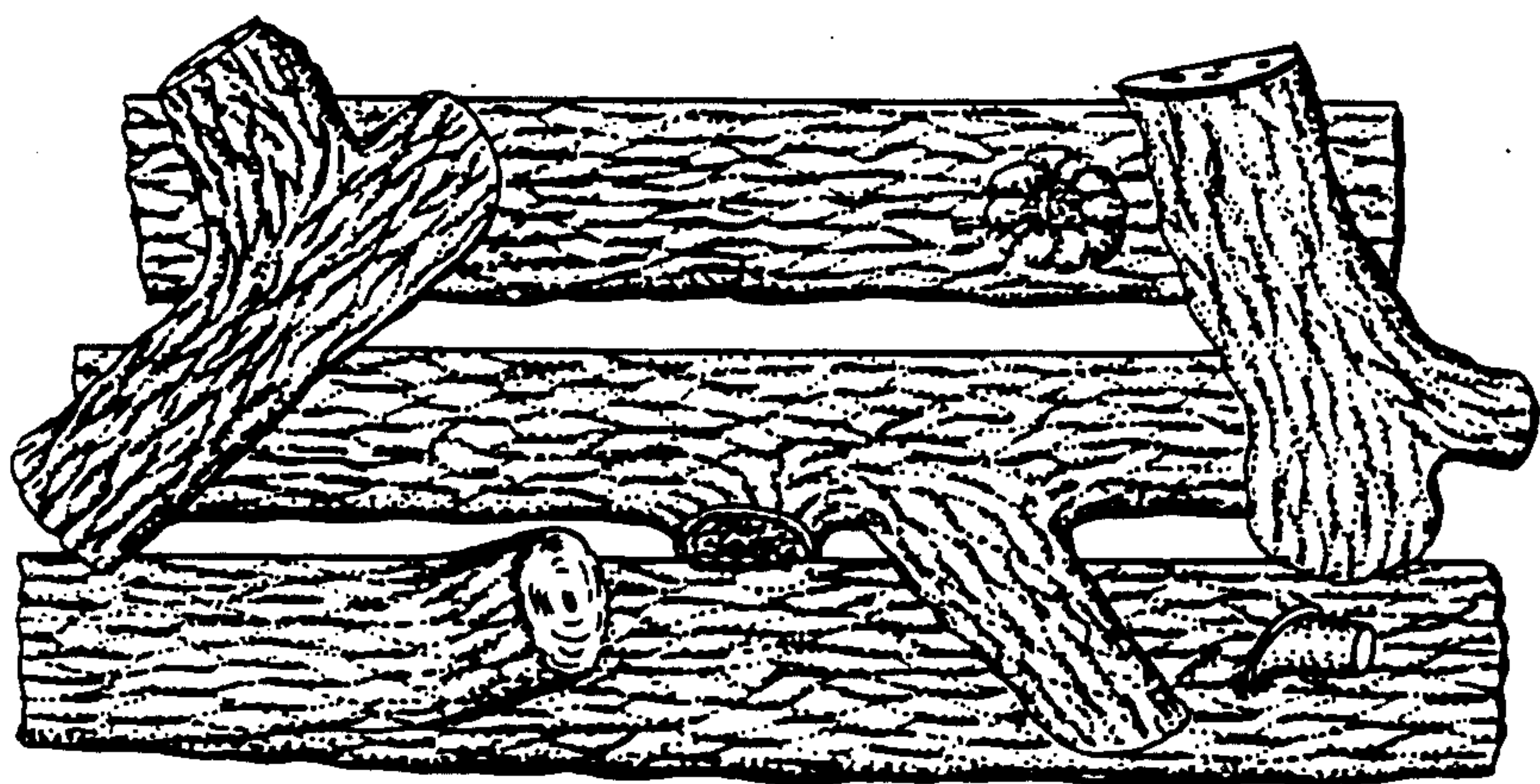

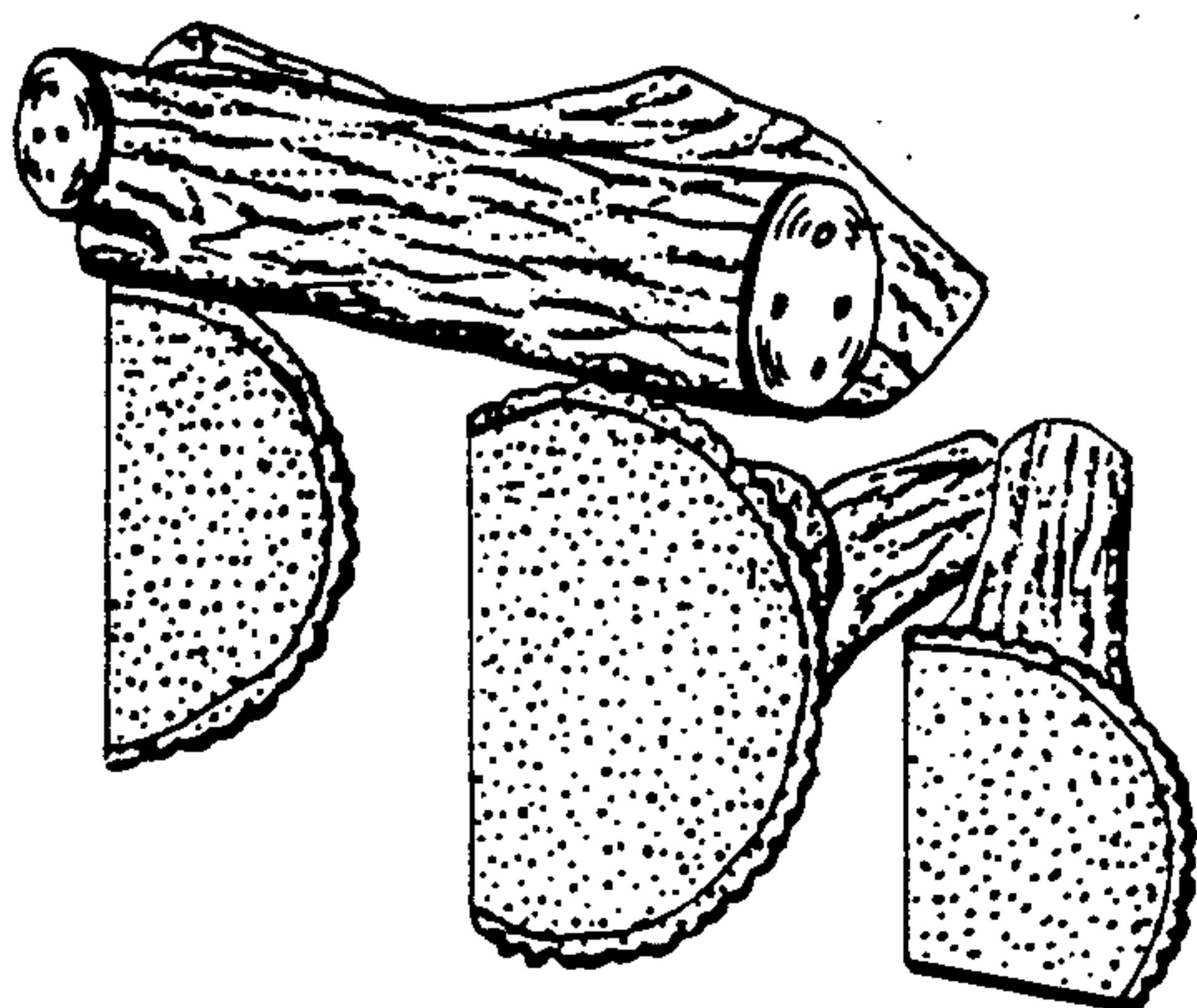

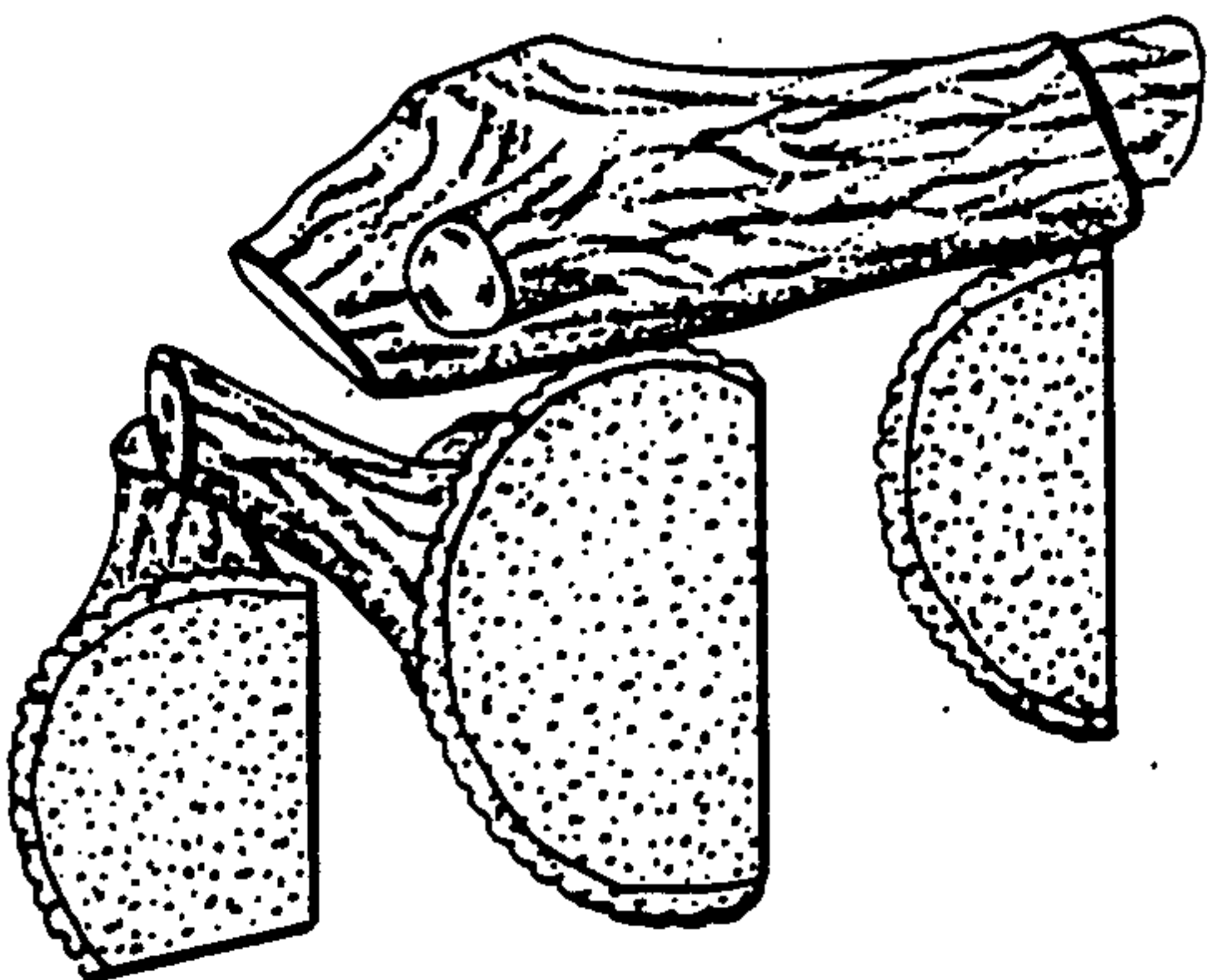

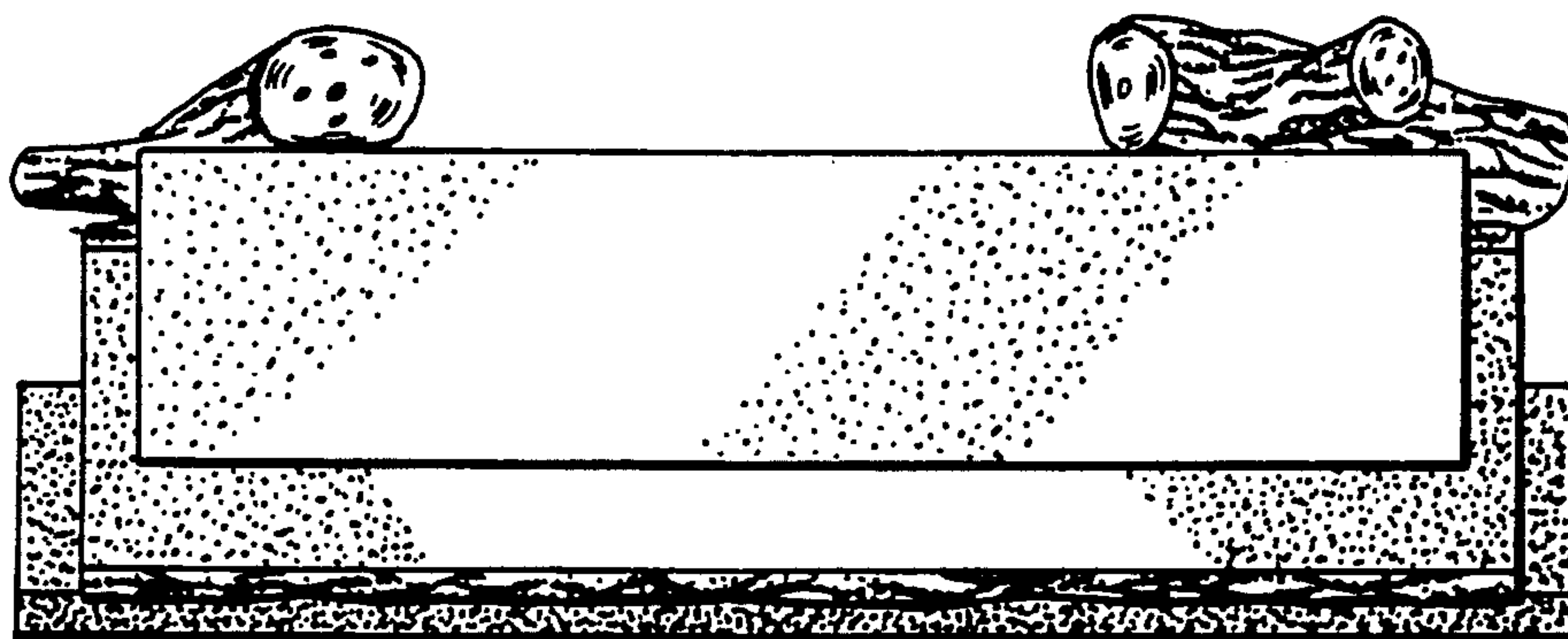

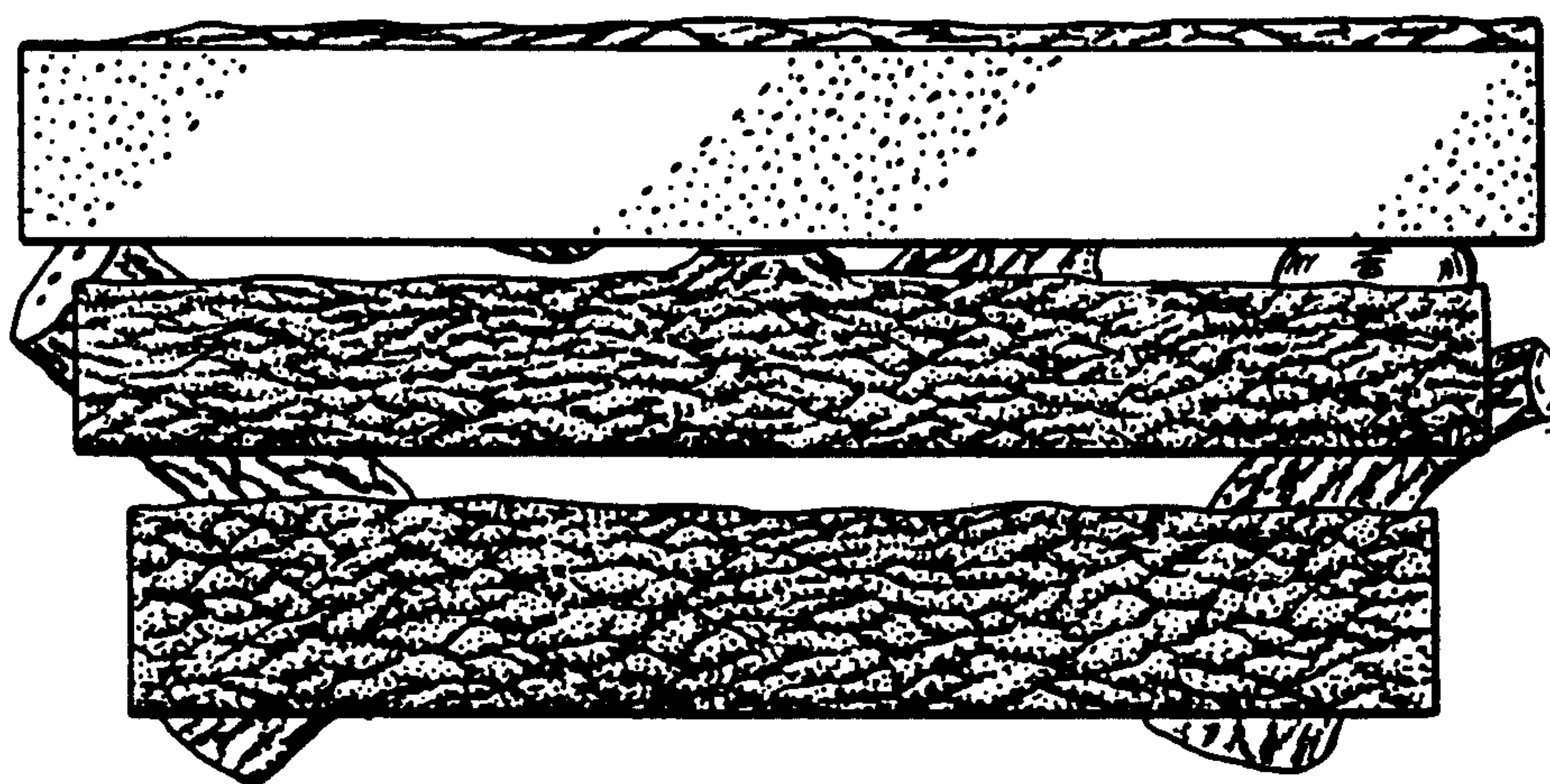
