DESCRIPTION

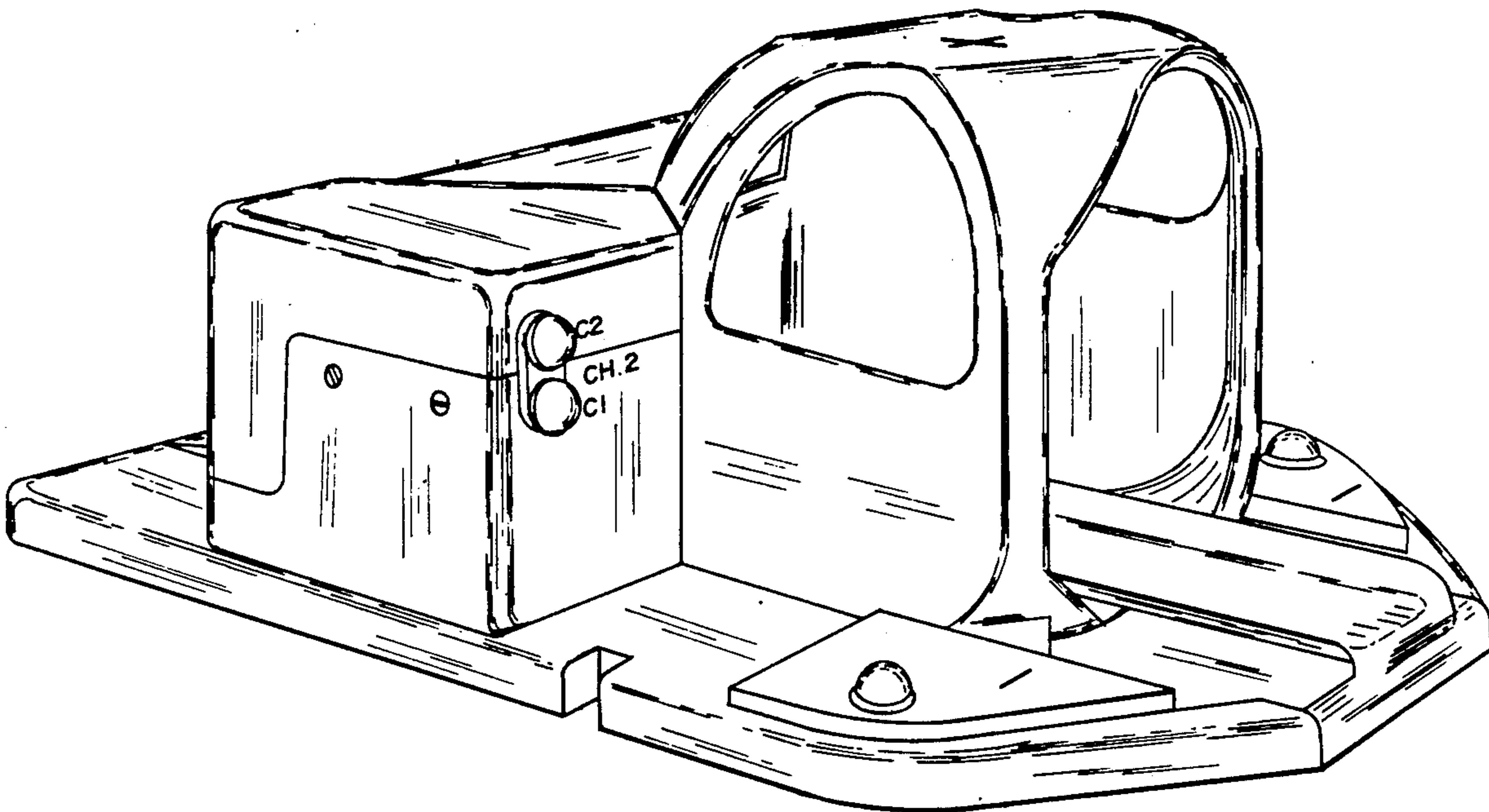
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a head imaging coil for magnetic resonance imaging apparatus, showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



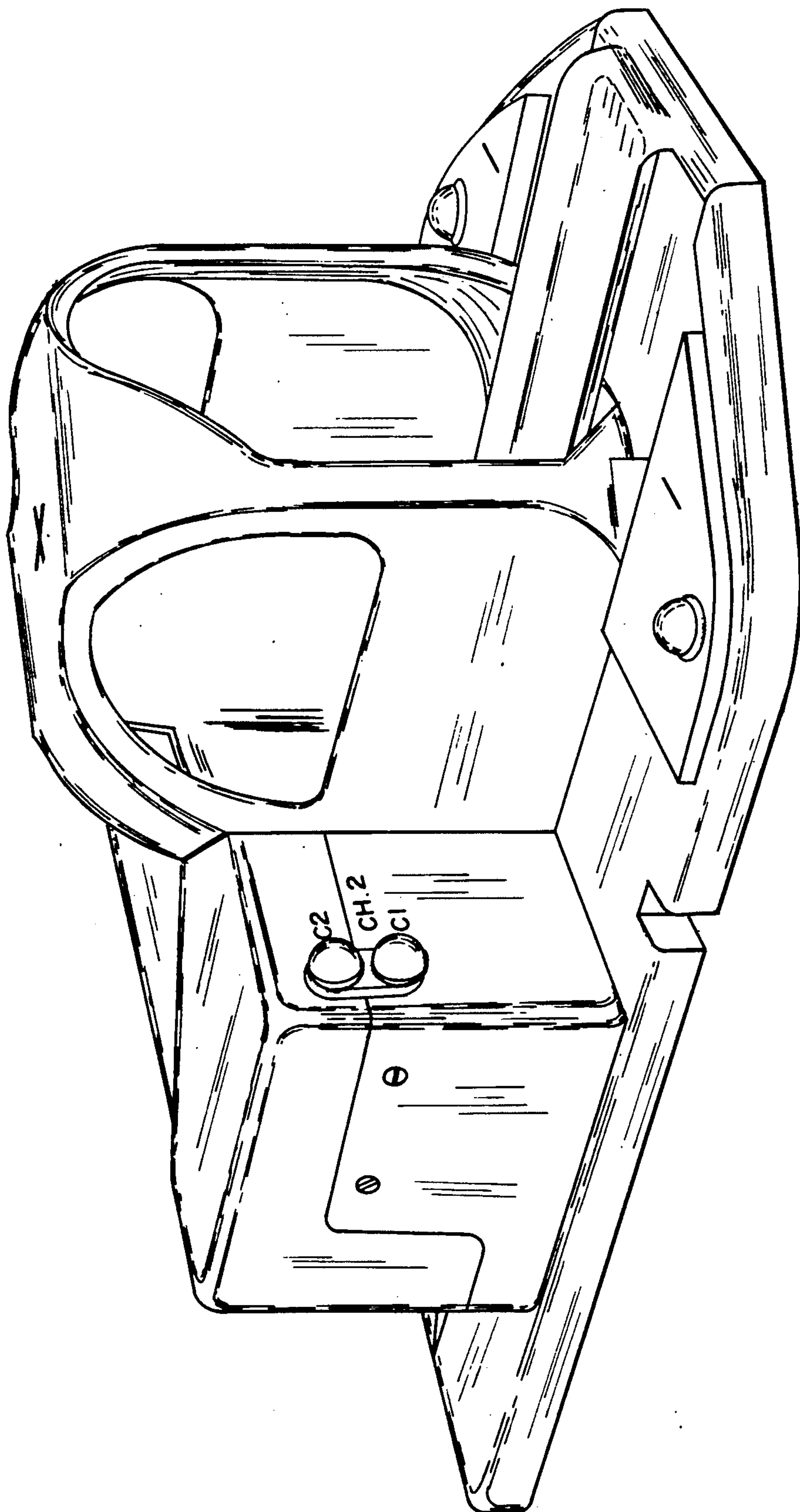

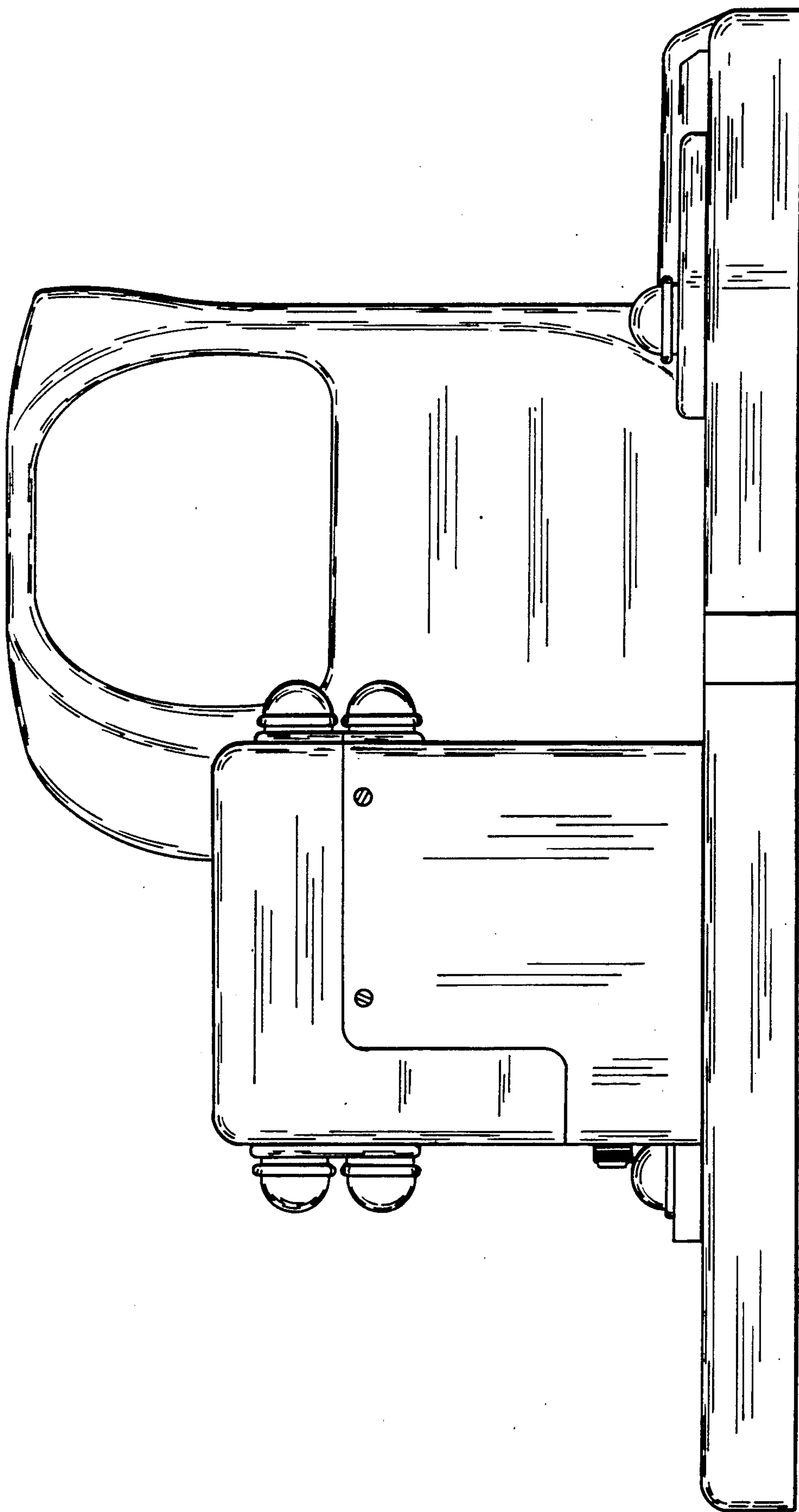

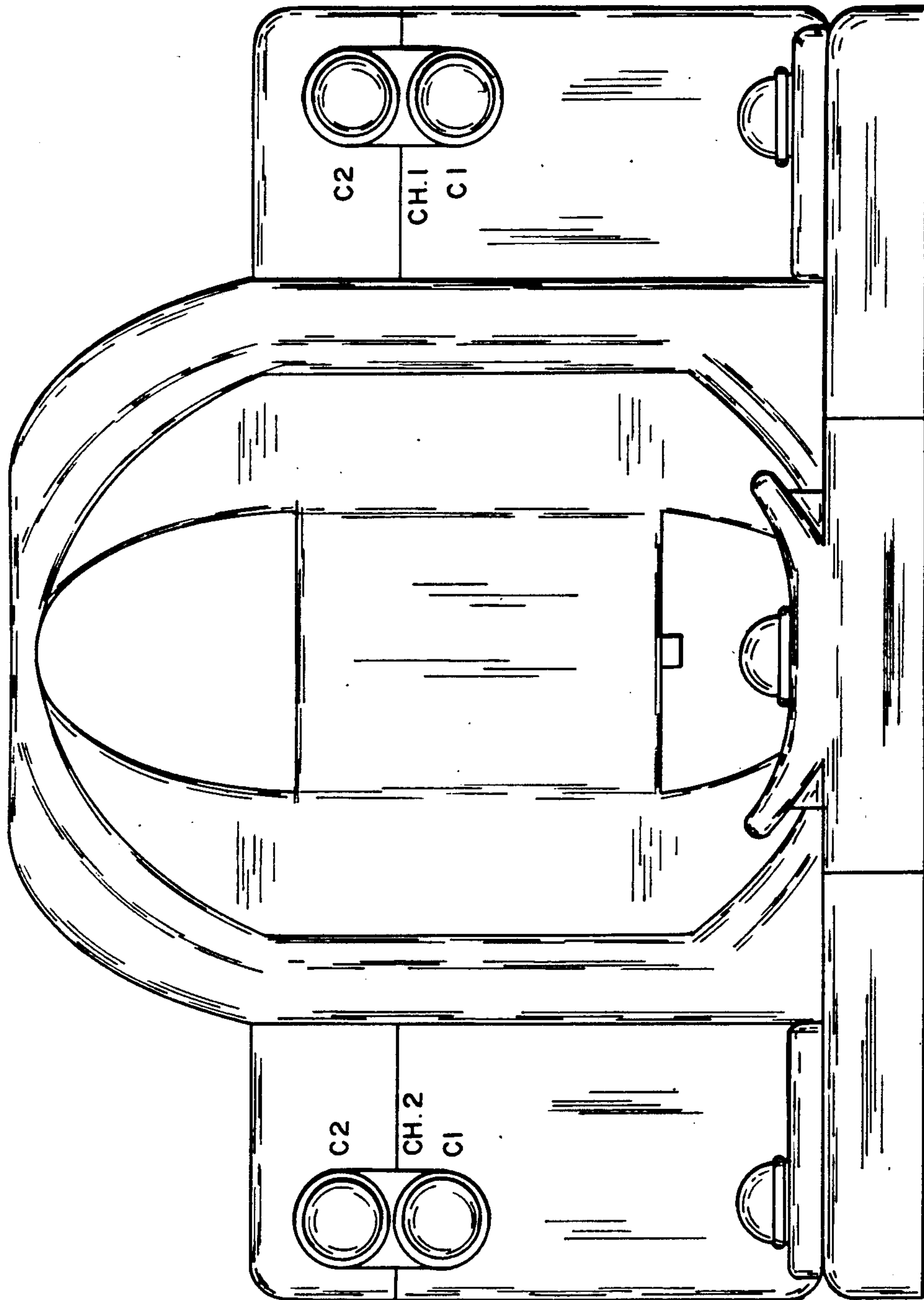

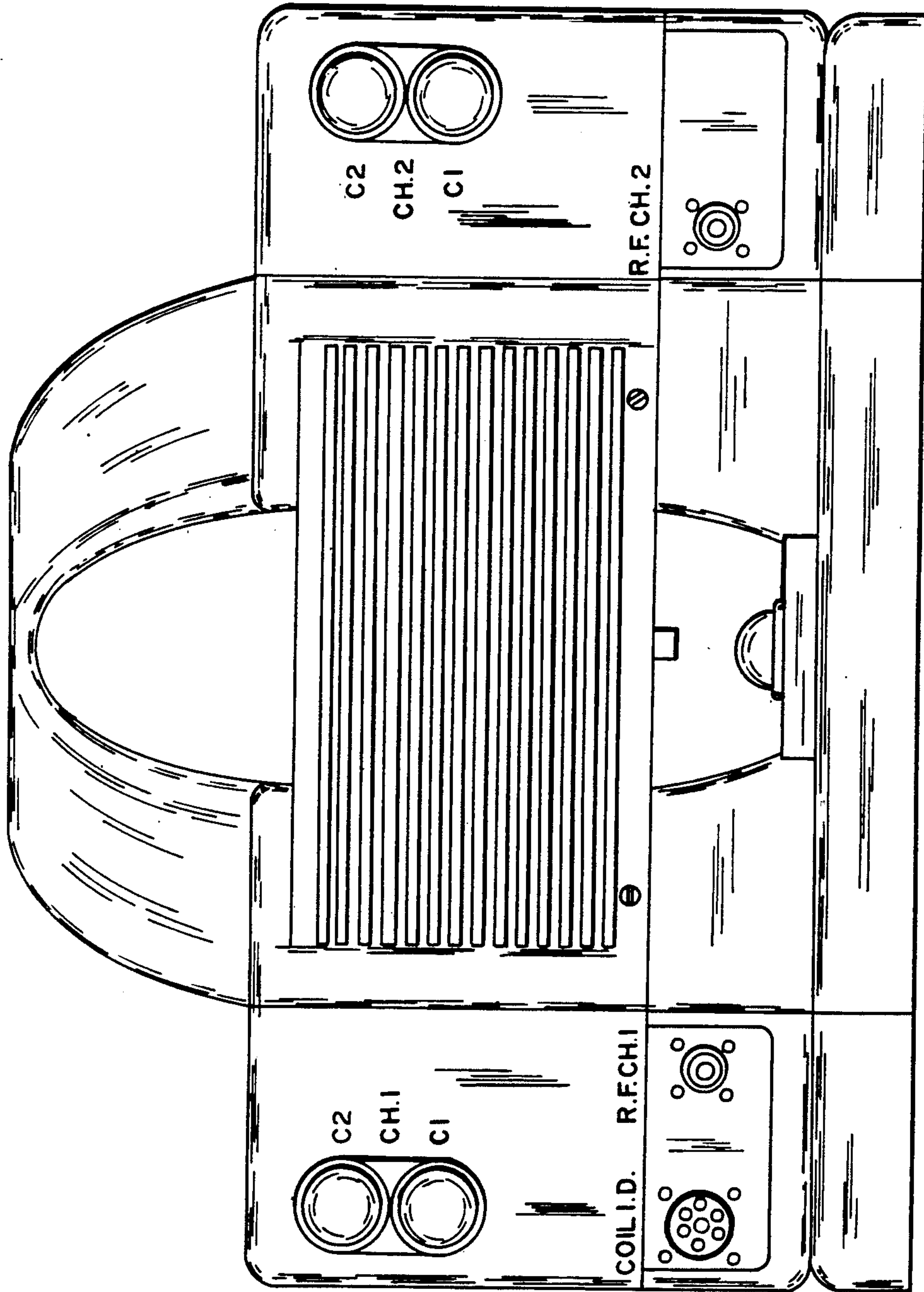

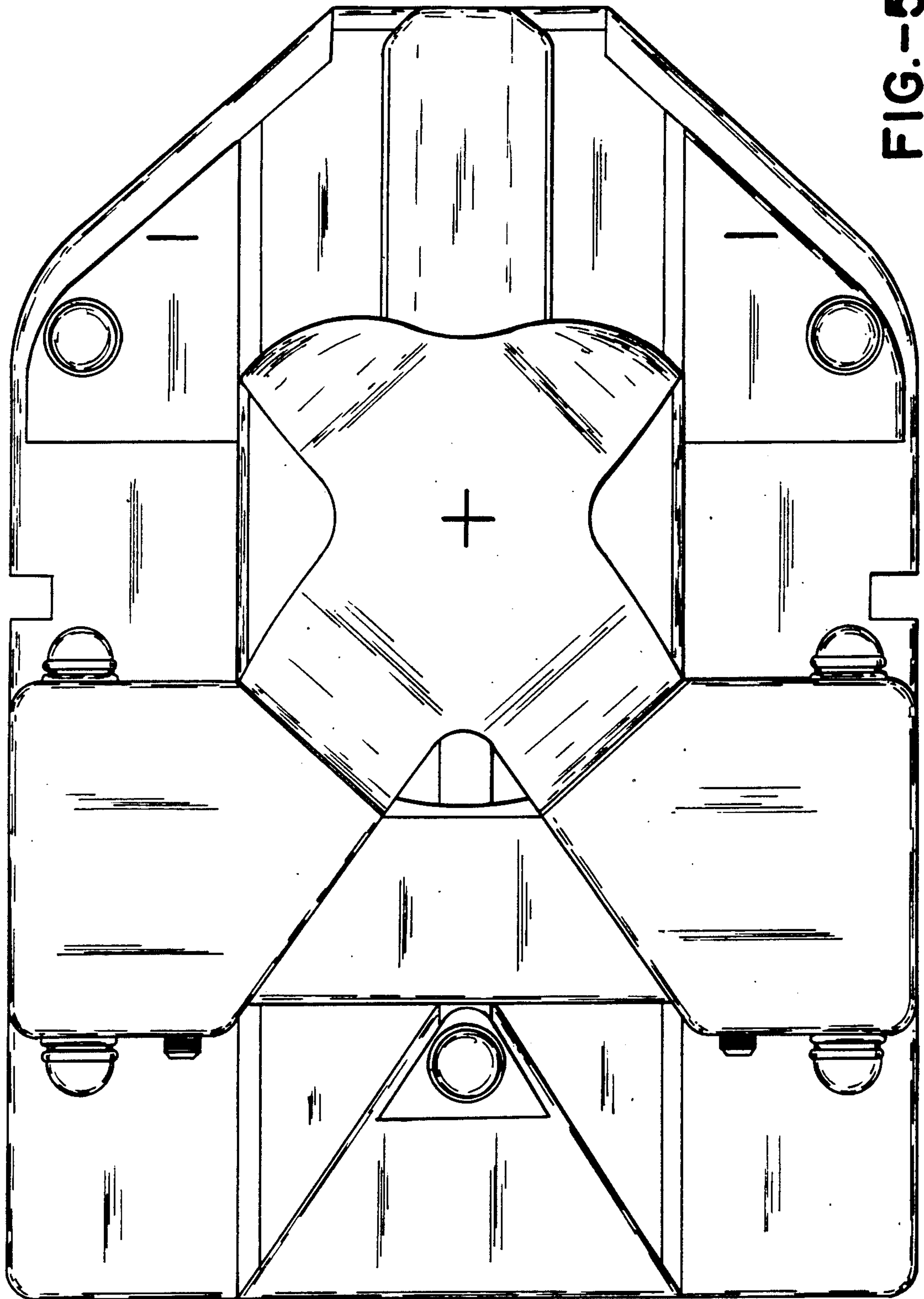
