DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a teacup or similar
article showing my new design, the side opposite is a
mirror image;
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view taken from the left
side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view taken from the right
side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along
lines 6—6 of FIG. 4.

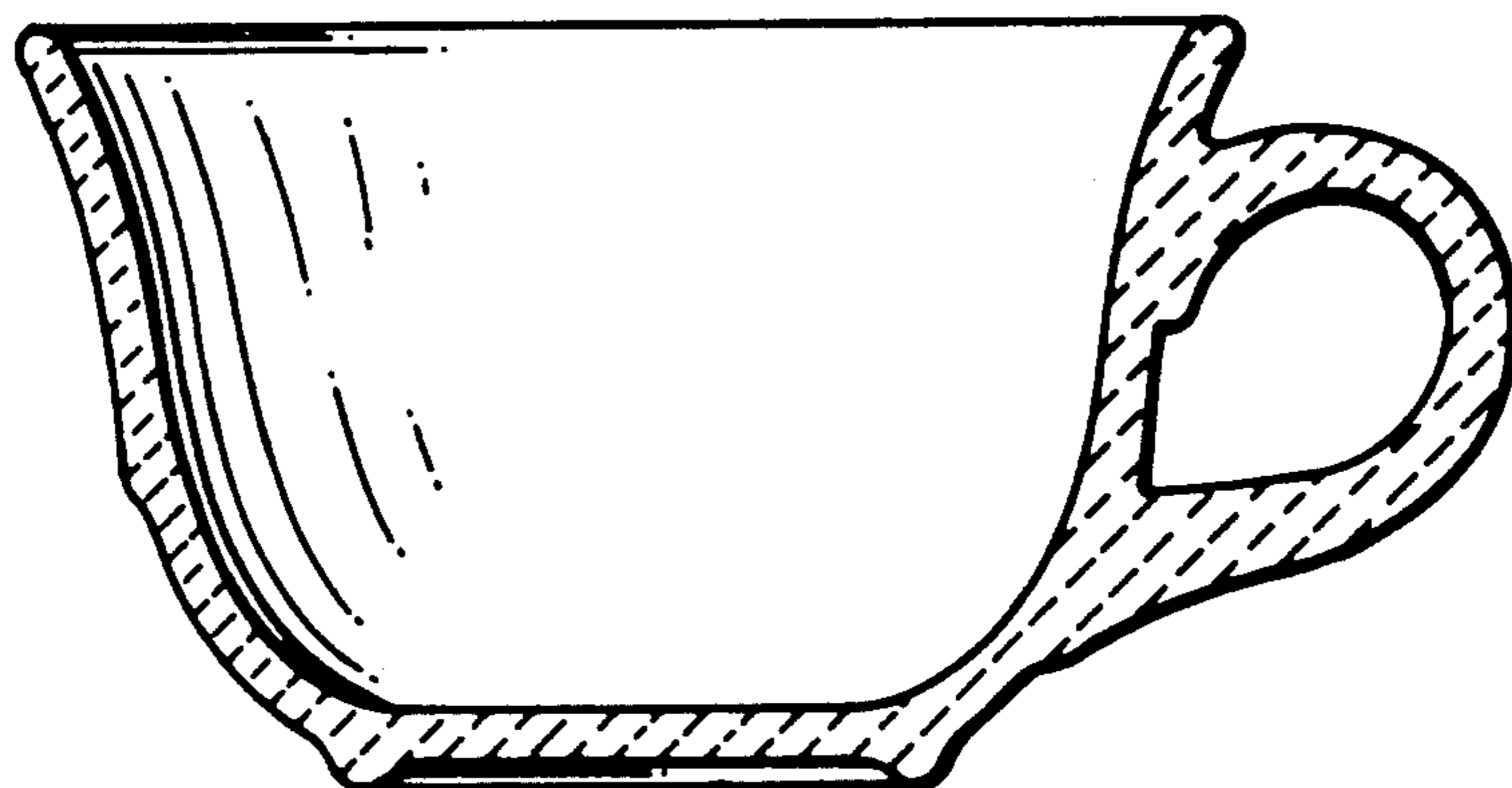
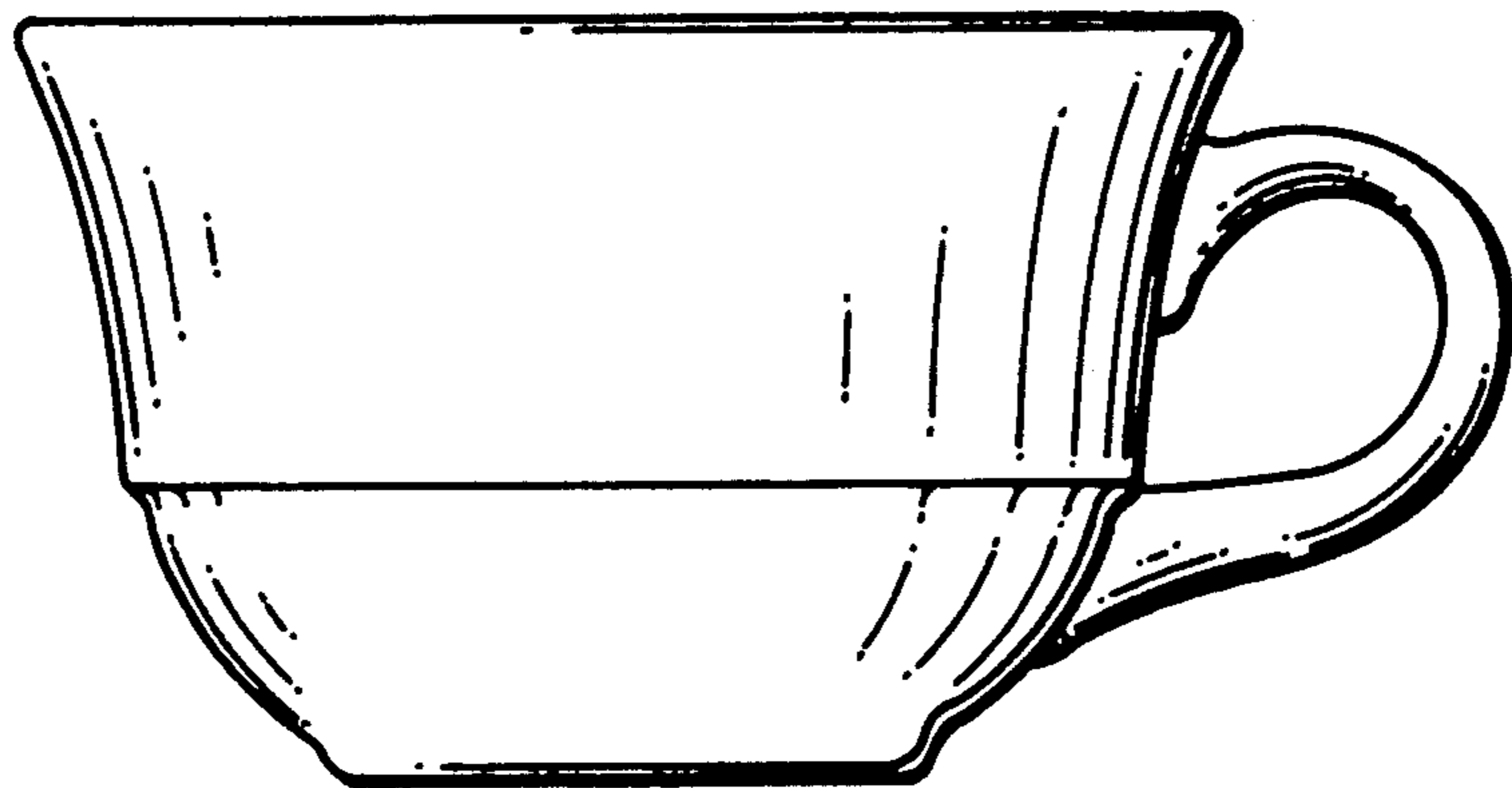

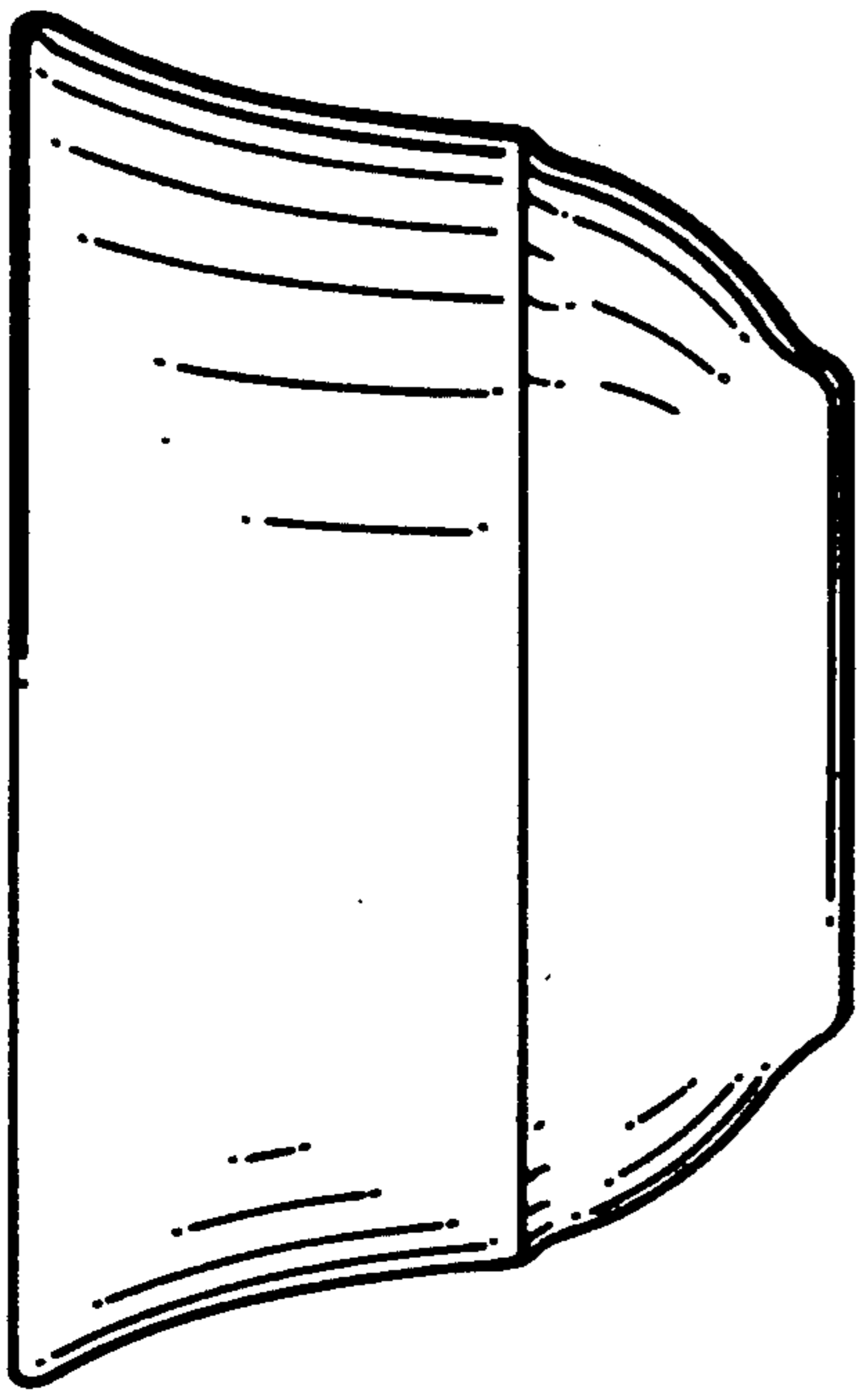

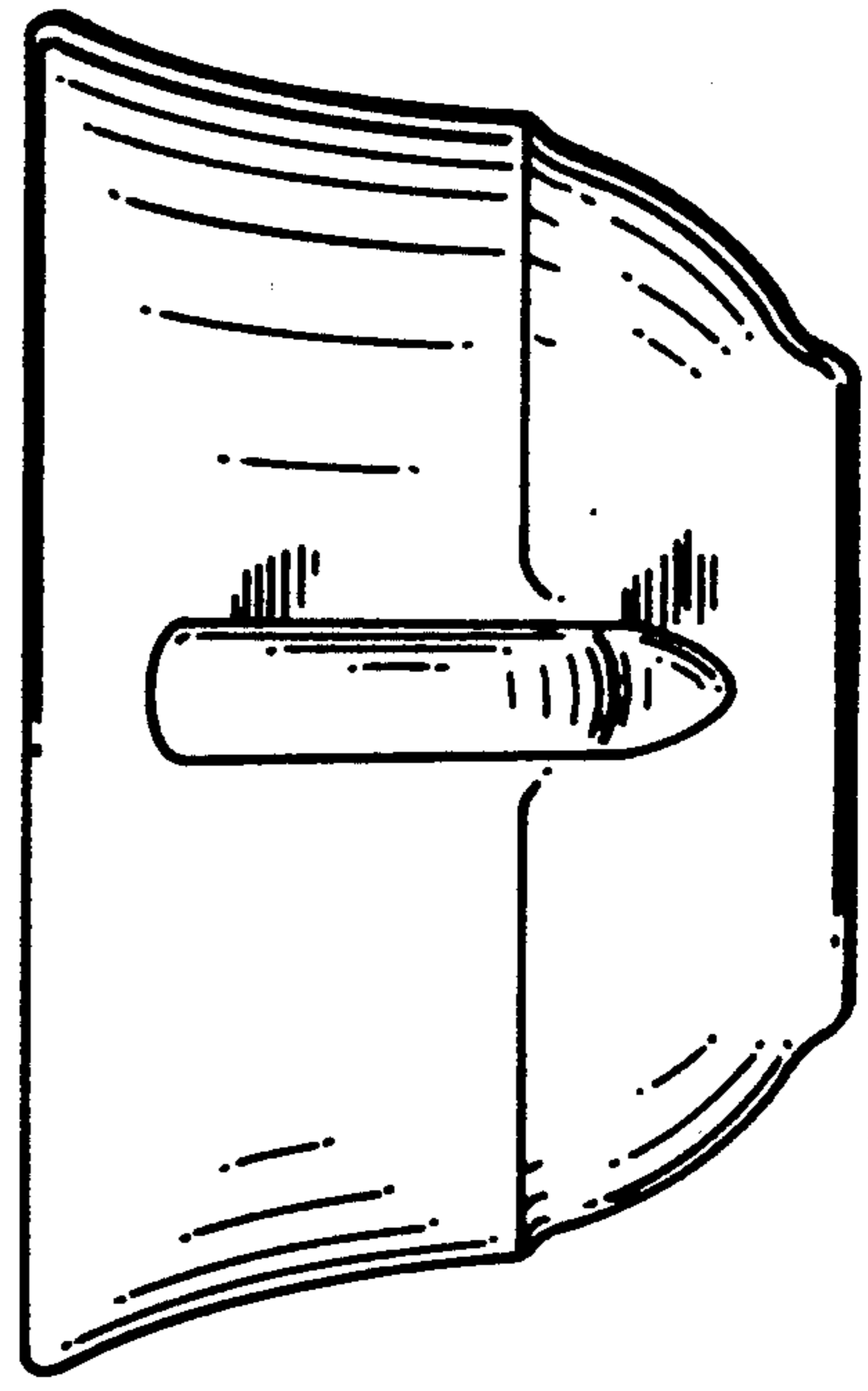

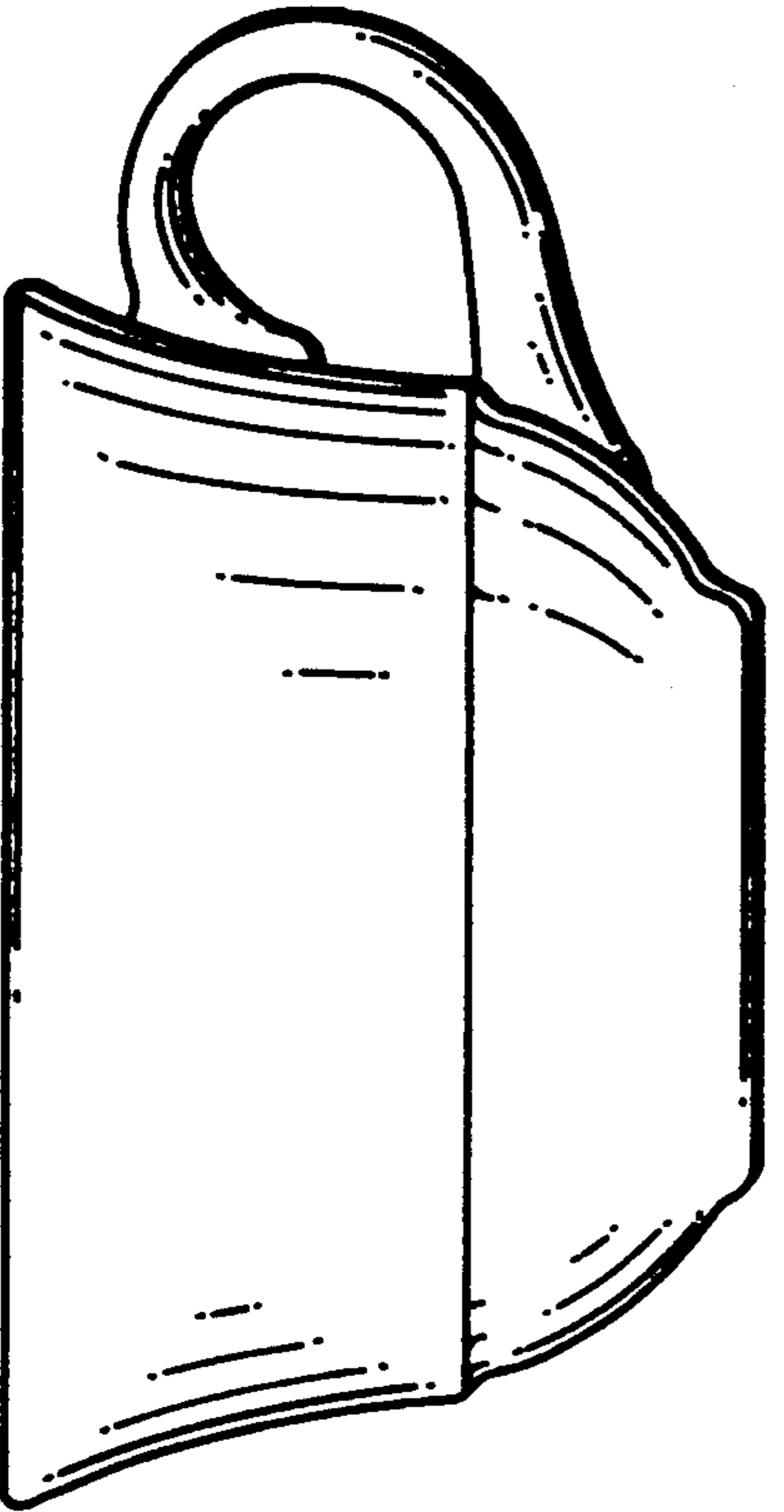

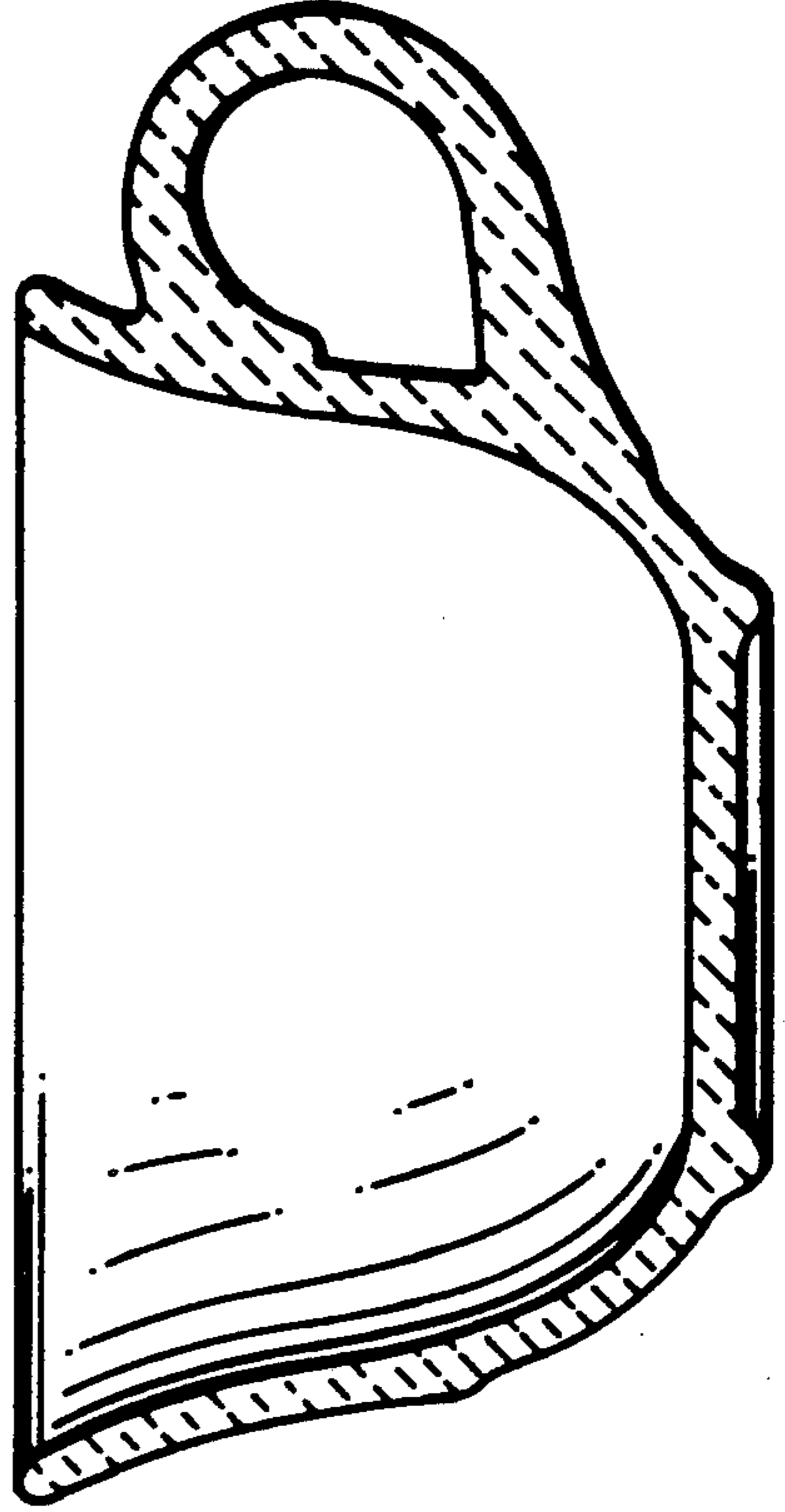

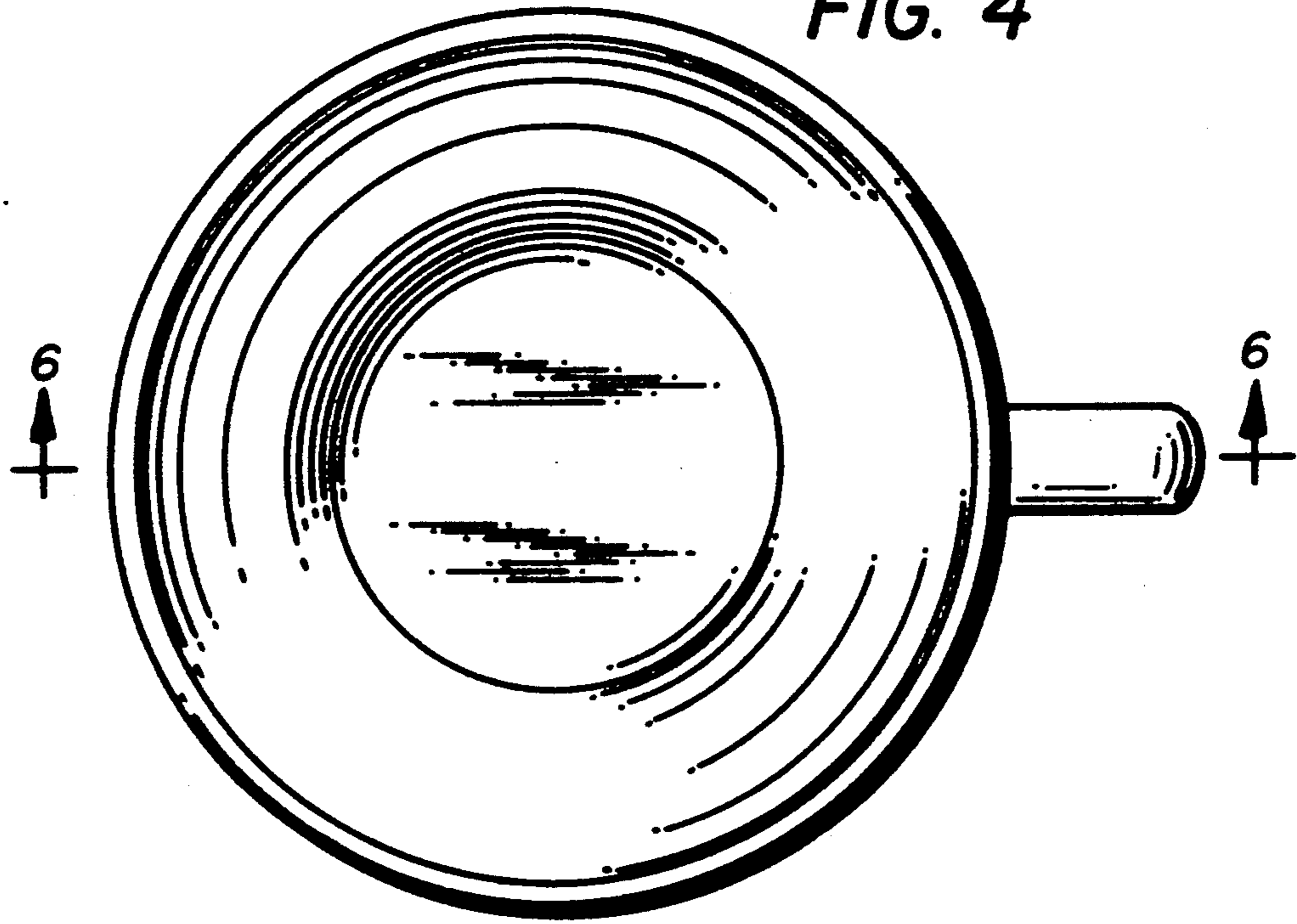
