DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right-side perspective view of a combined tape player and radio tuner, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top, front, and right-side perspective view thereof, shown with tape cassette door in the opened position;

FIG. 3 is a top, front, and right-side perspective view thereof, shown with antenna in the partially raised position;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof; and


FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof.


















