[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a balancing toy or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a balancing toy or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof, without the tray;
and
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, without the tray.
The broken lines showing of glasses and mugs in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purpose and forms no part of the claim. FIGS. 3 and 4 are shown without the tray for clarity of illustration.

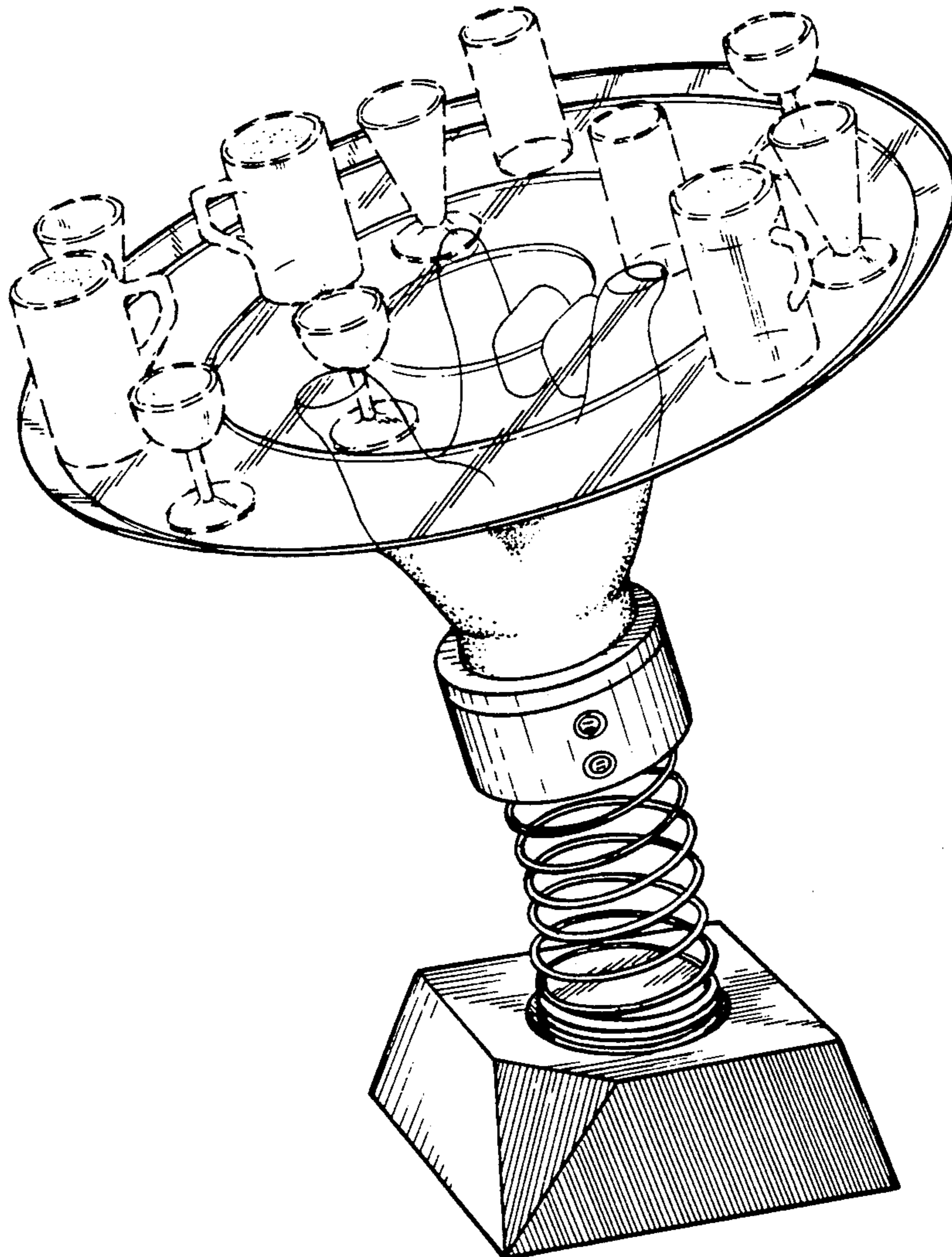

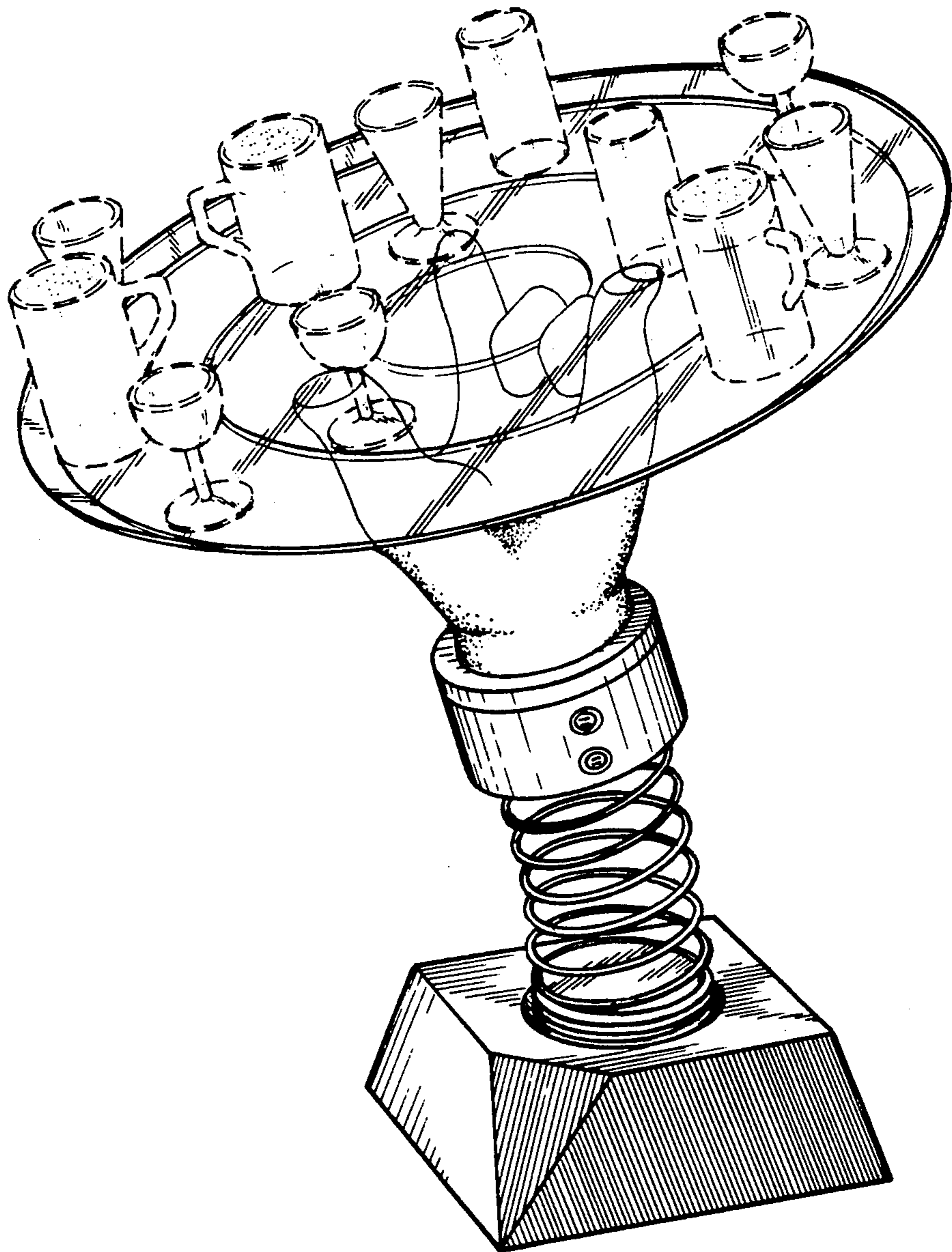

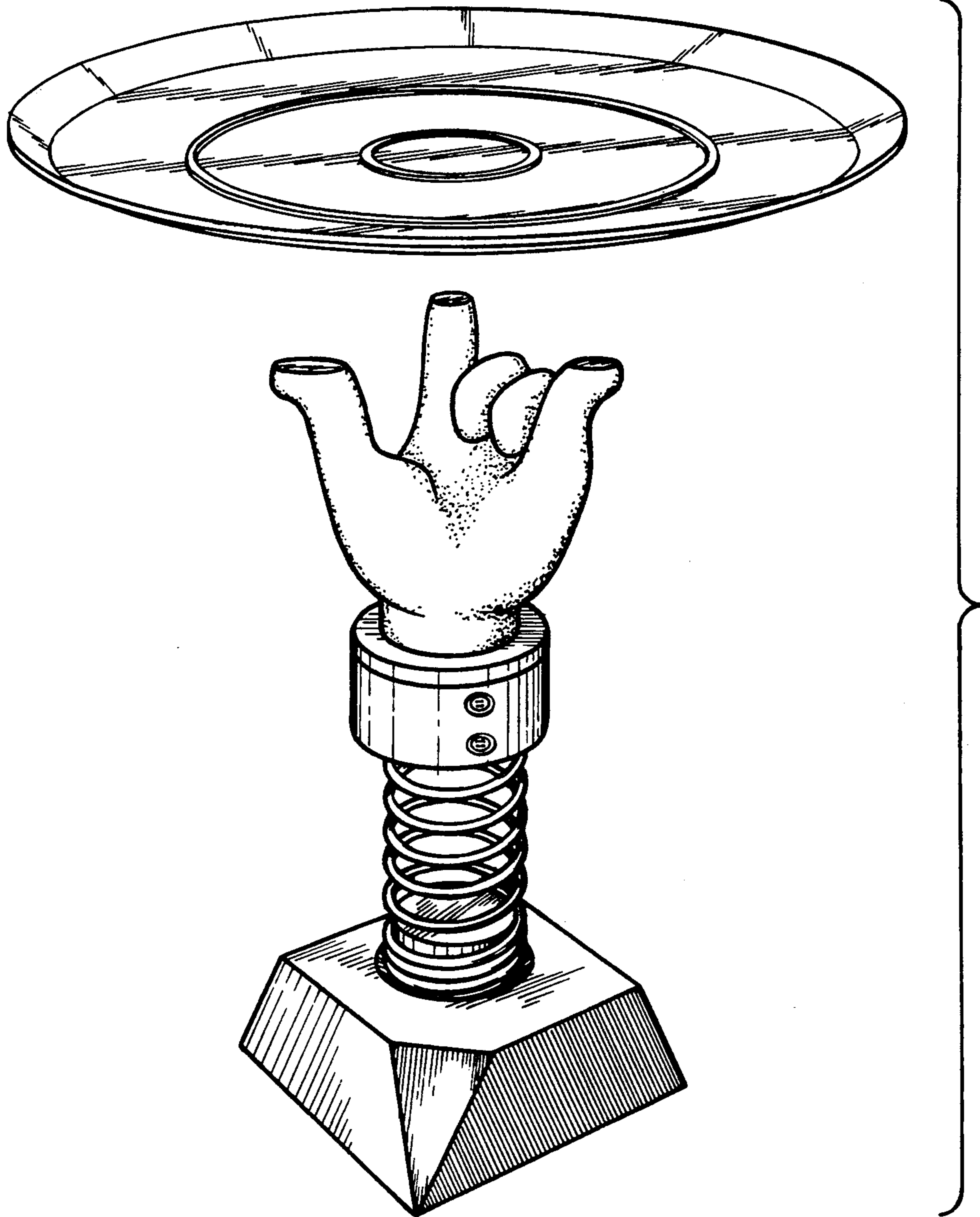

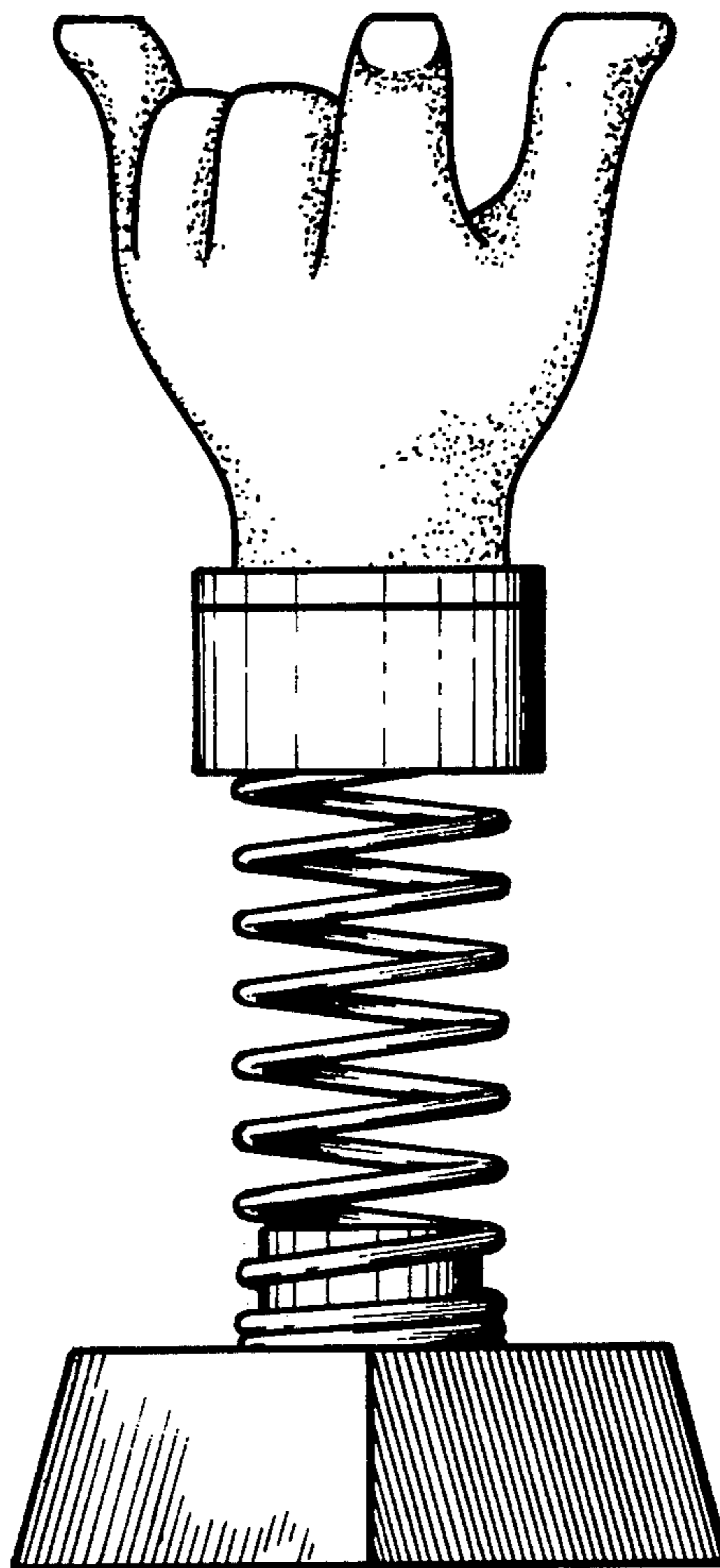
