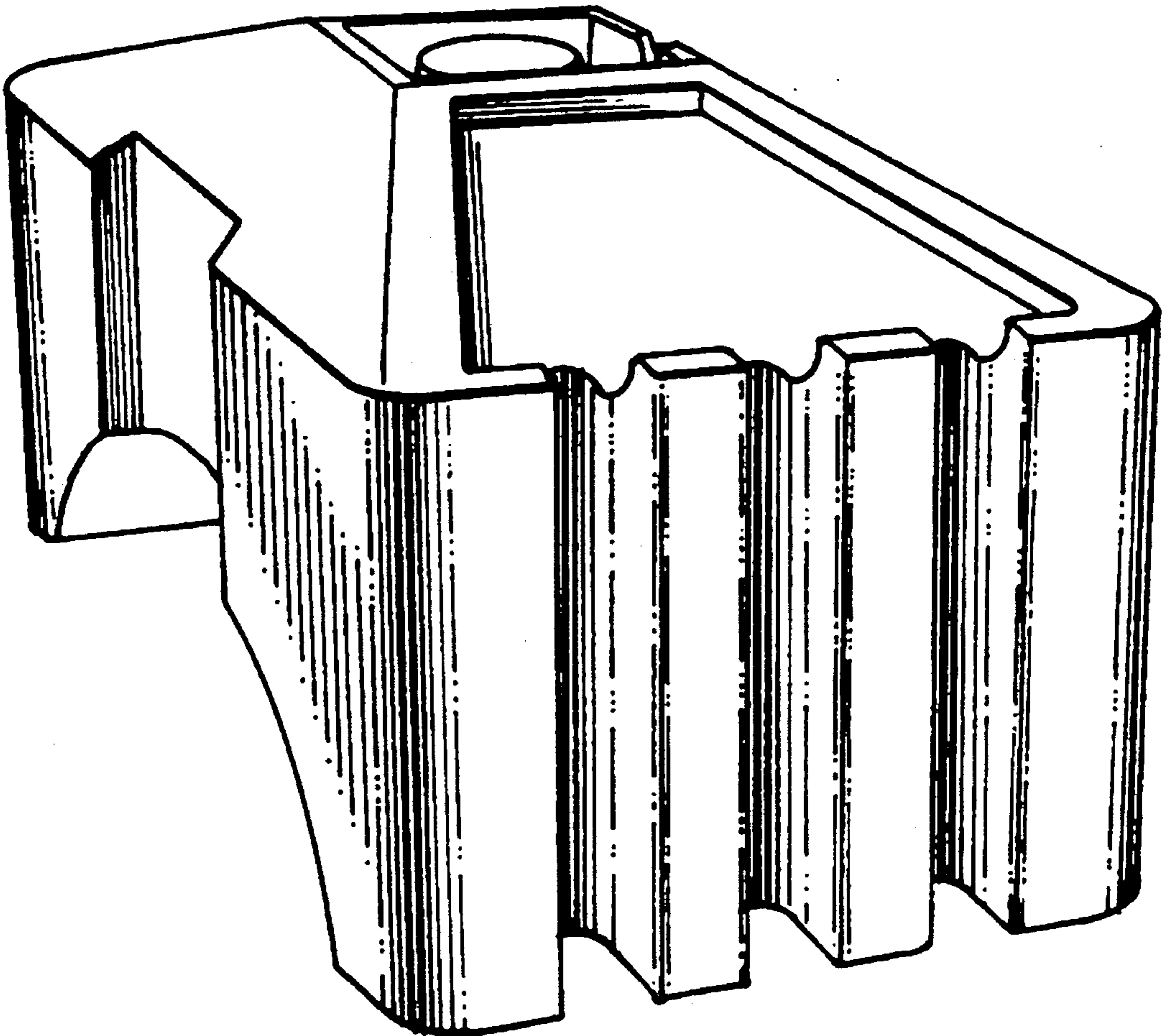
DESCRIPTION

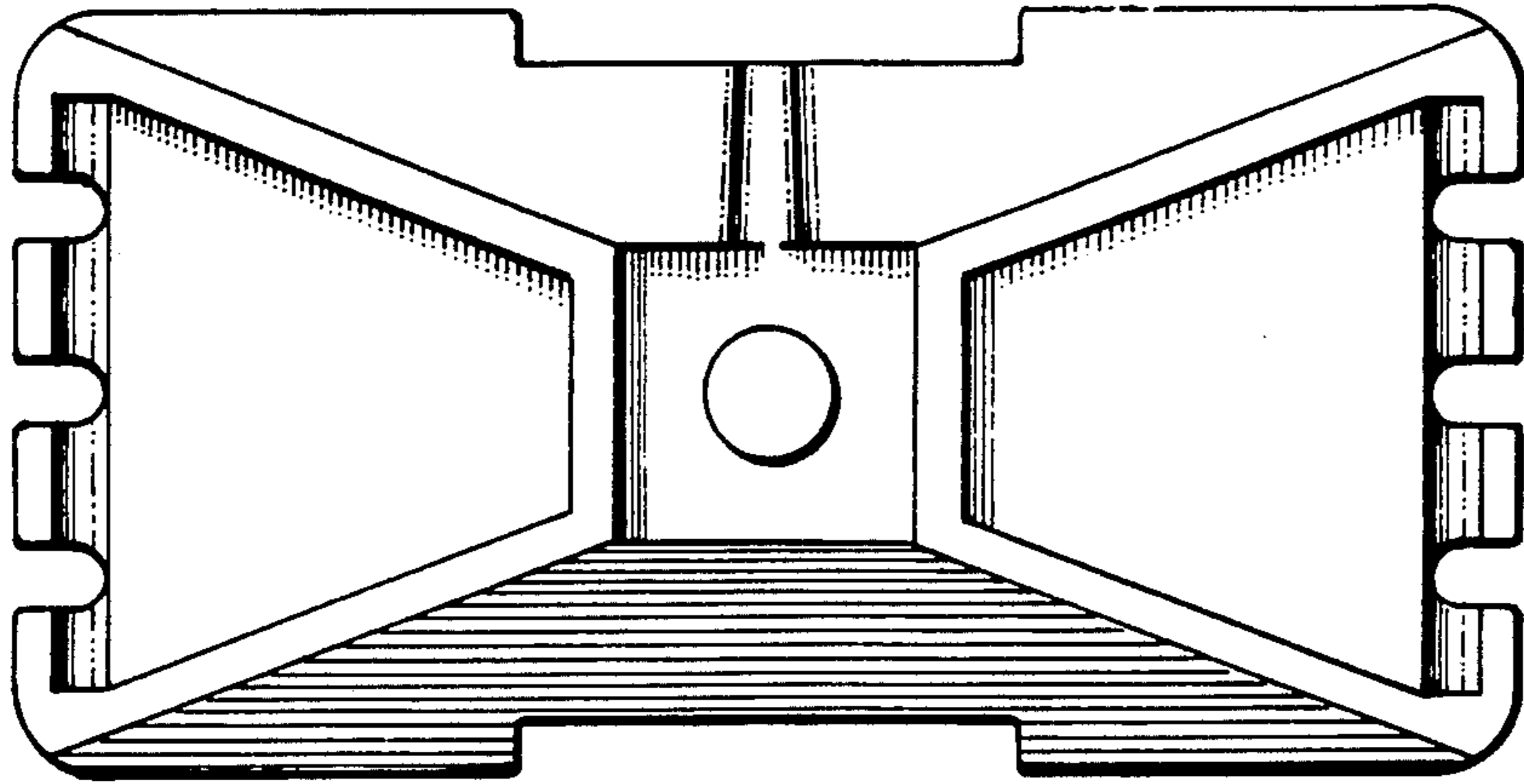

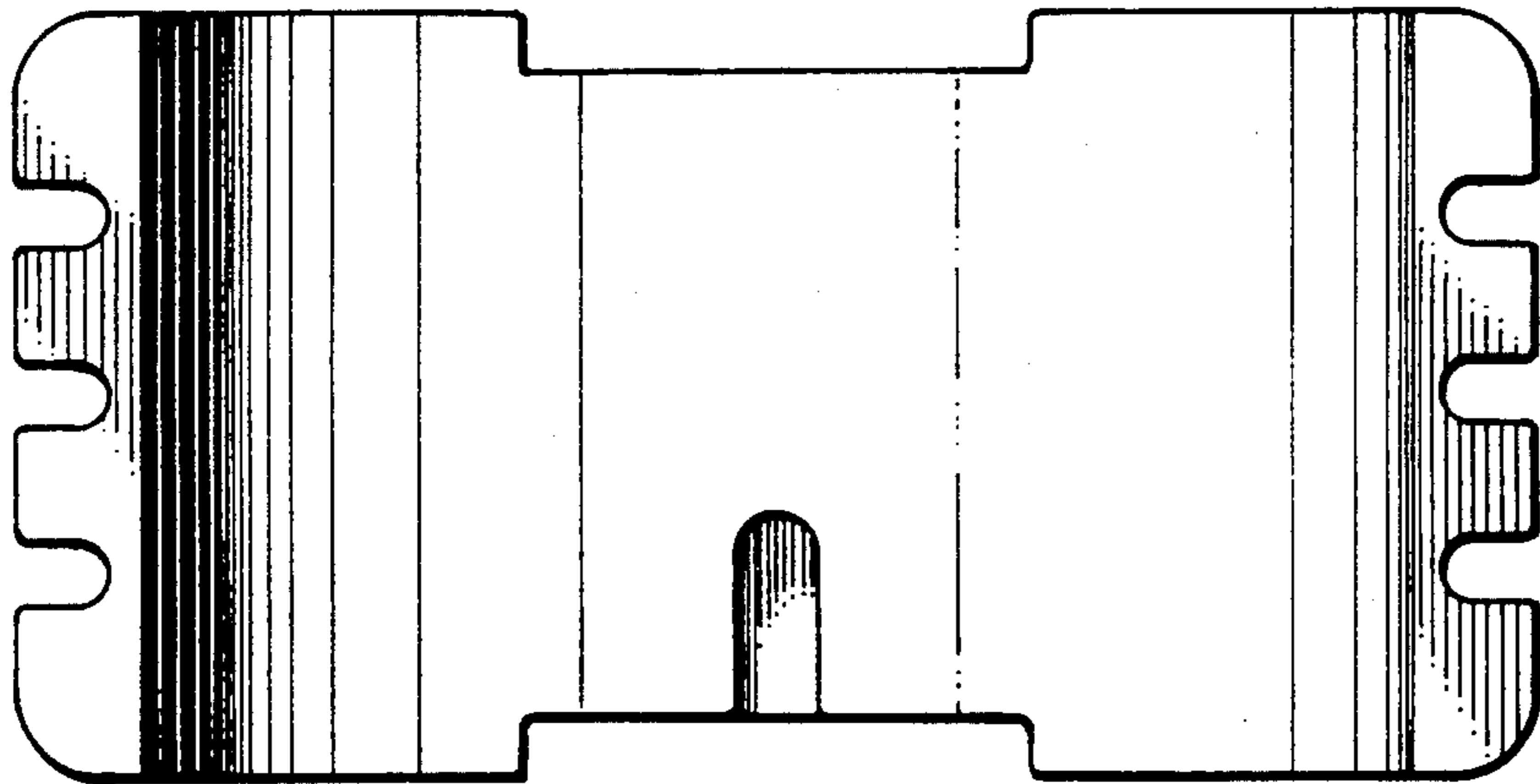

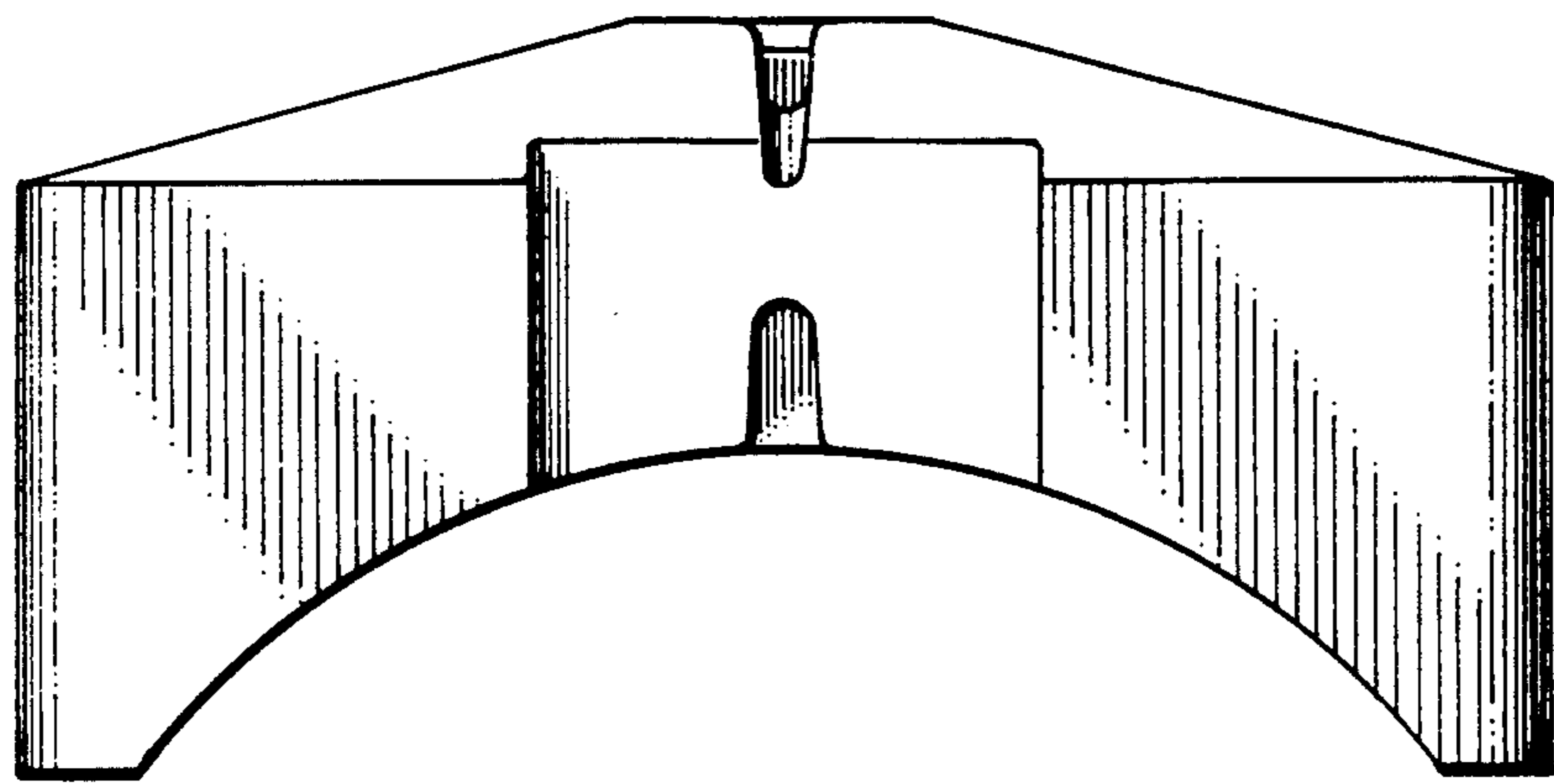

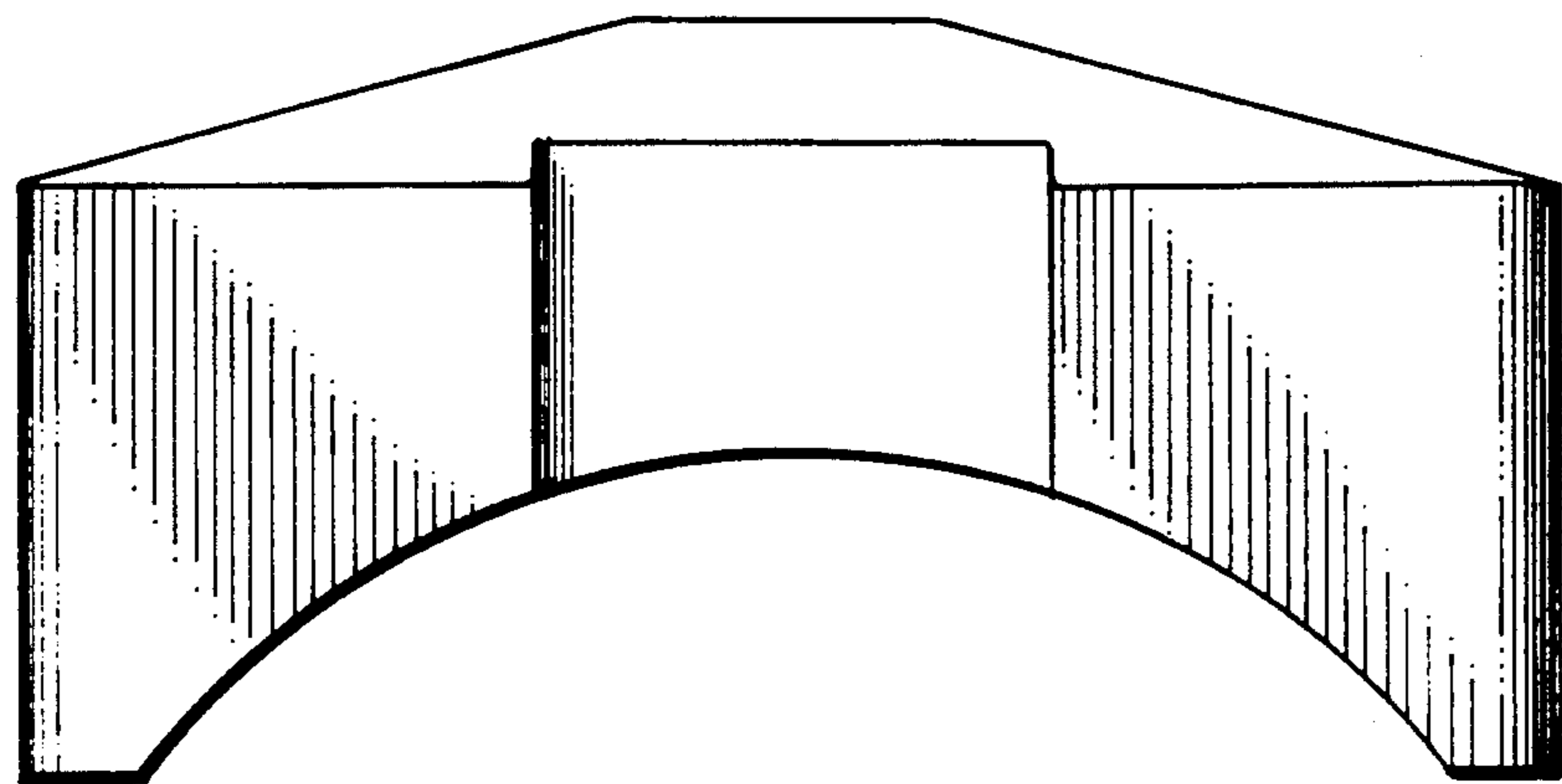

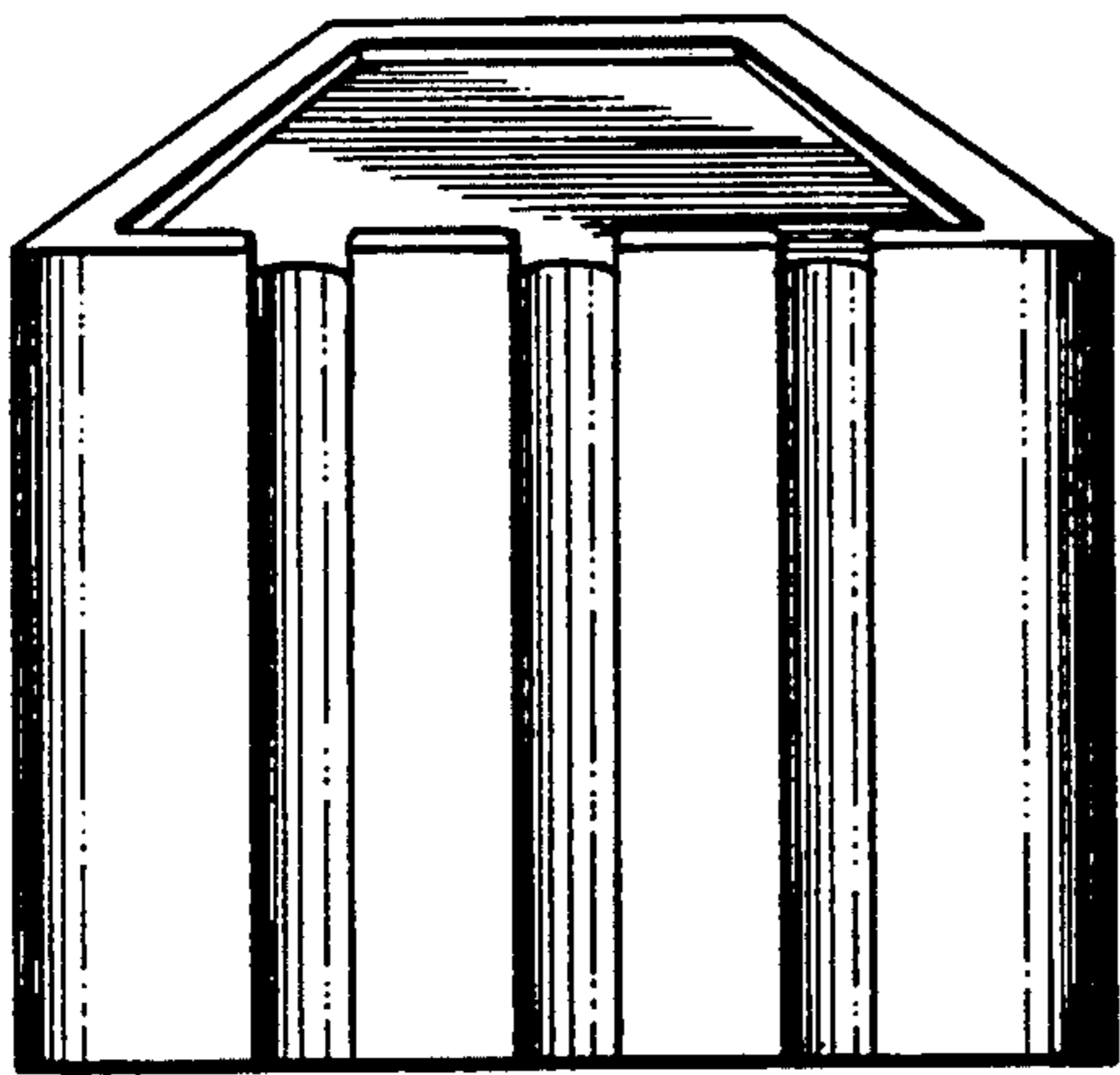

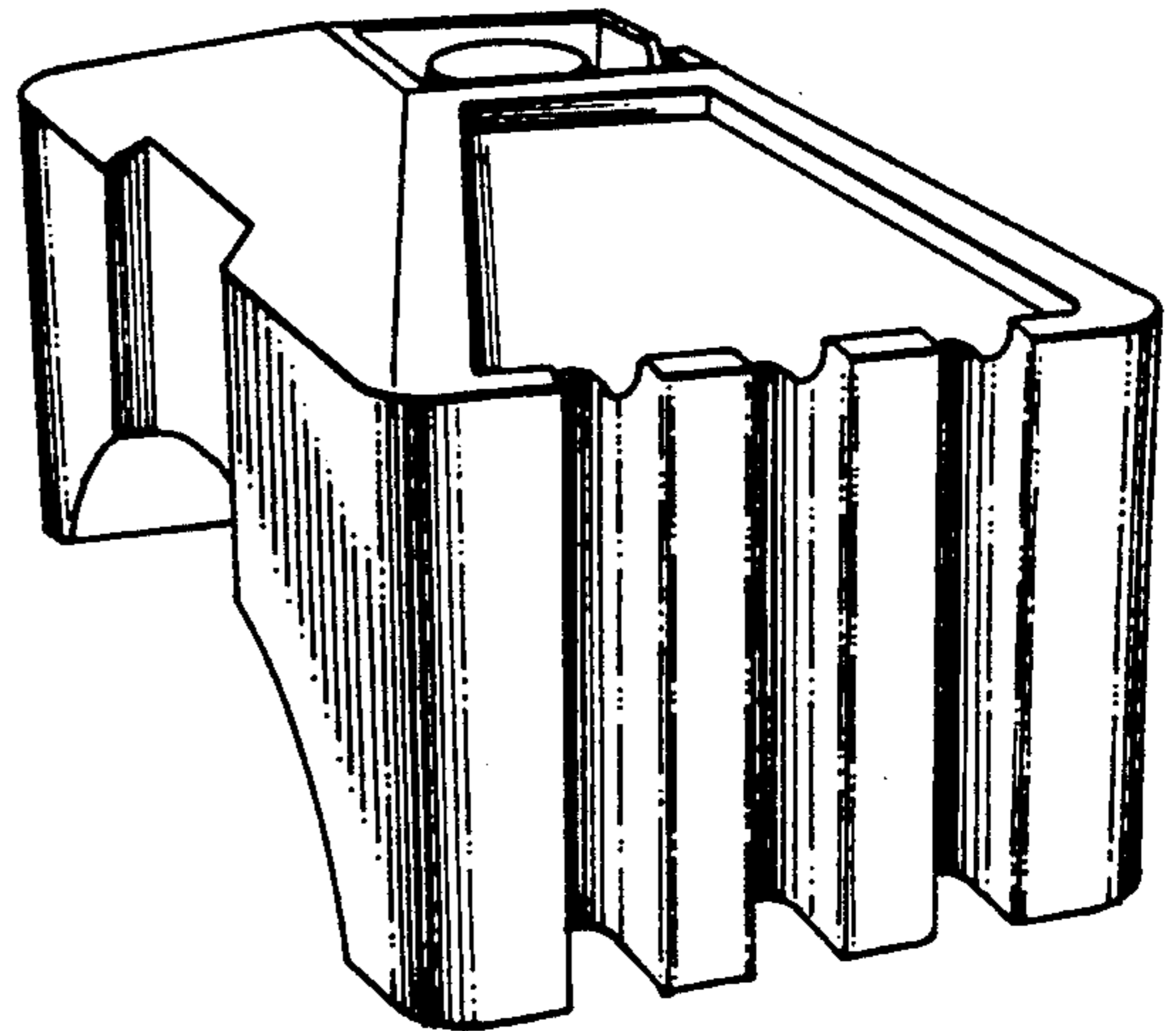
