

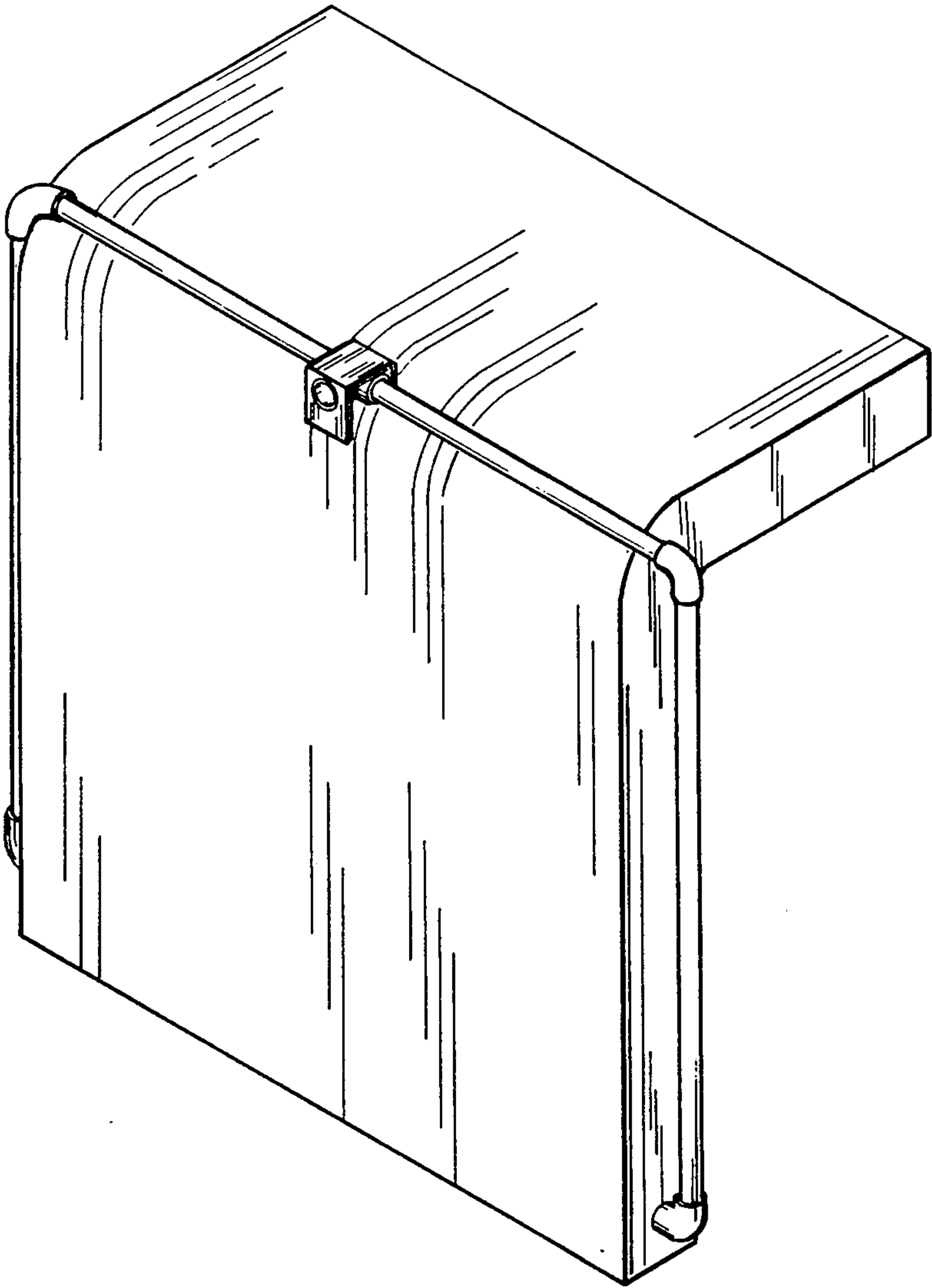

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of combined air supply line and manifold for aerating a pond or lake on fish farms showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a top rear perspective view thereof, on an enlarged scale.



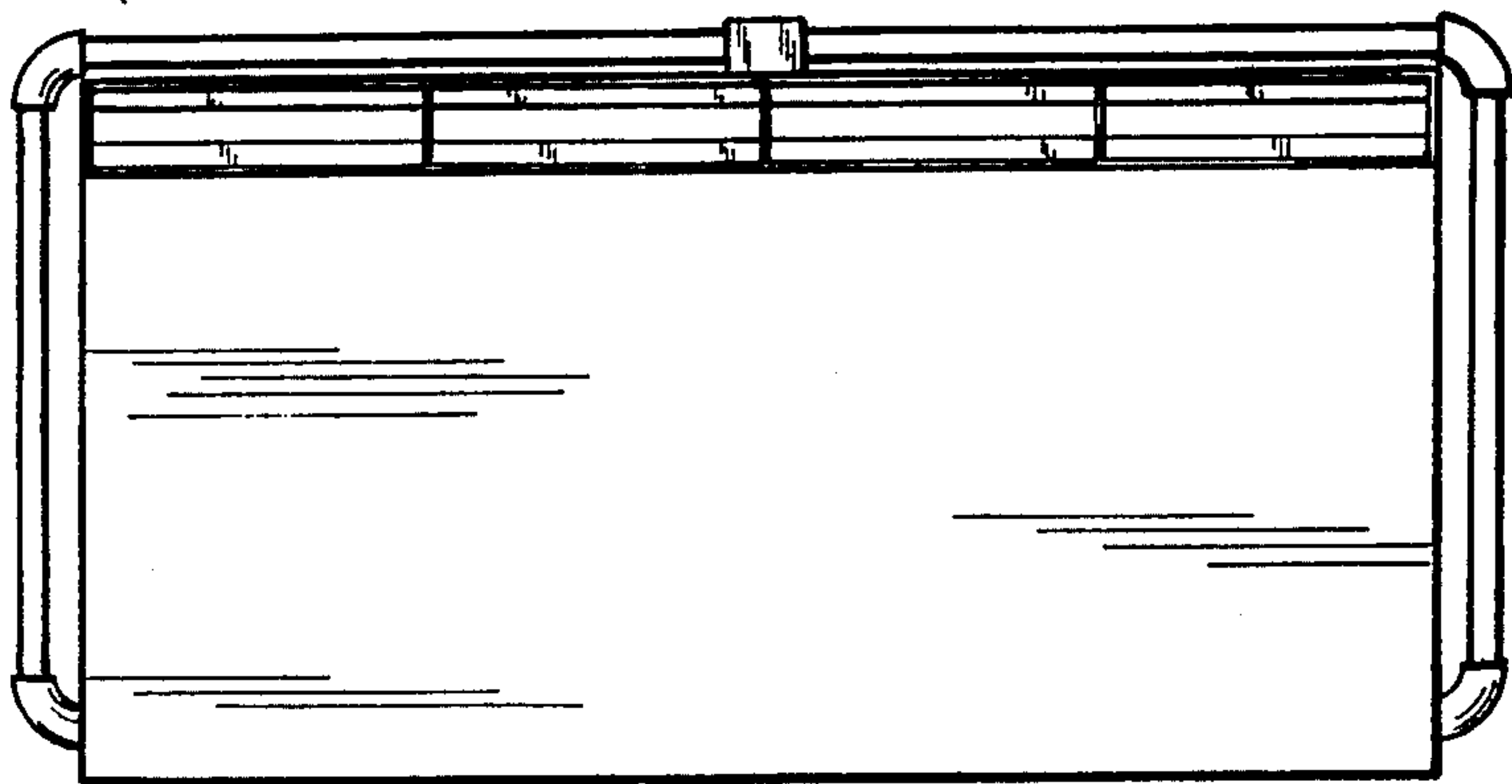

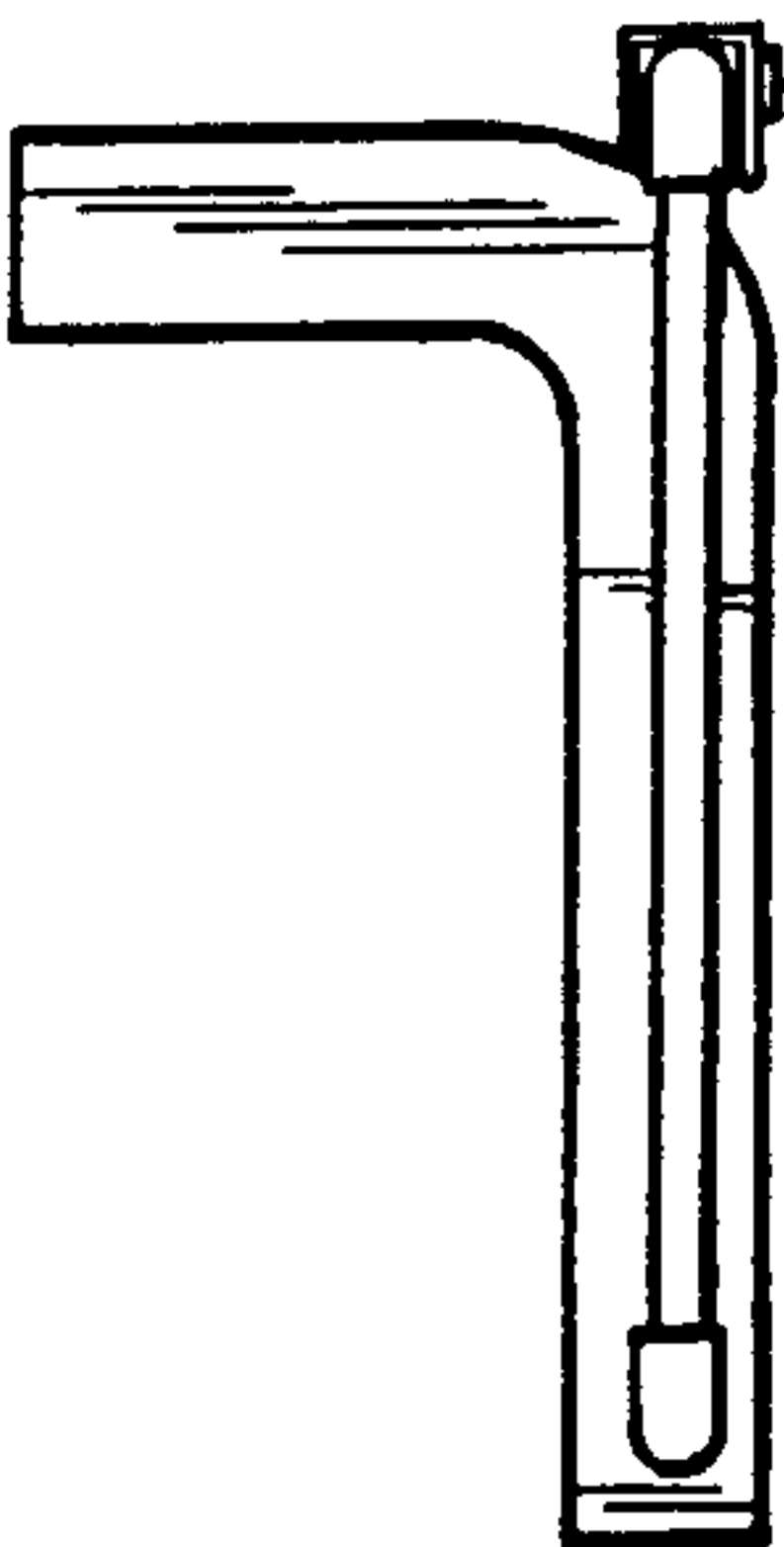

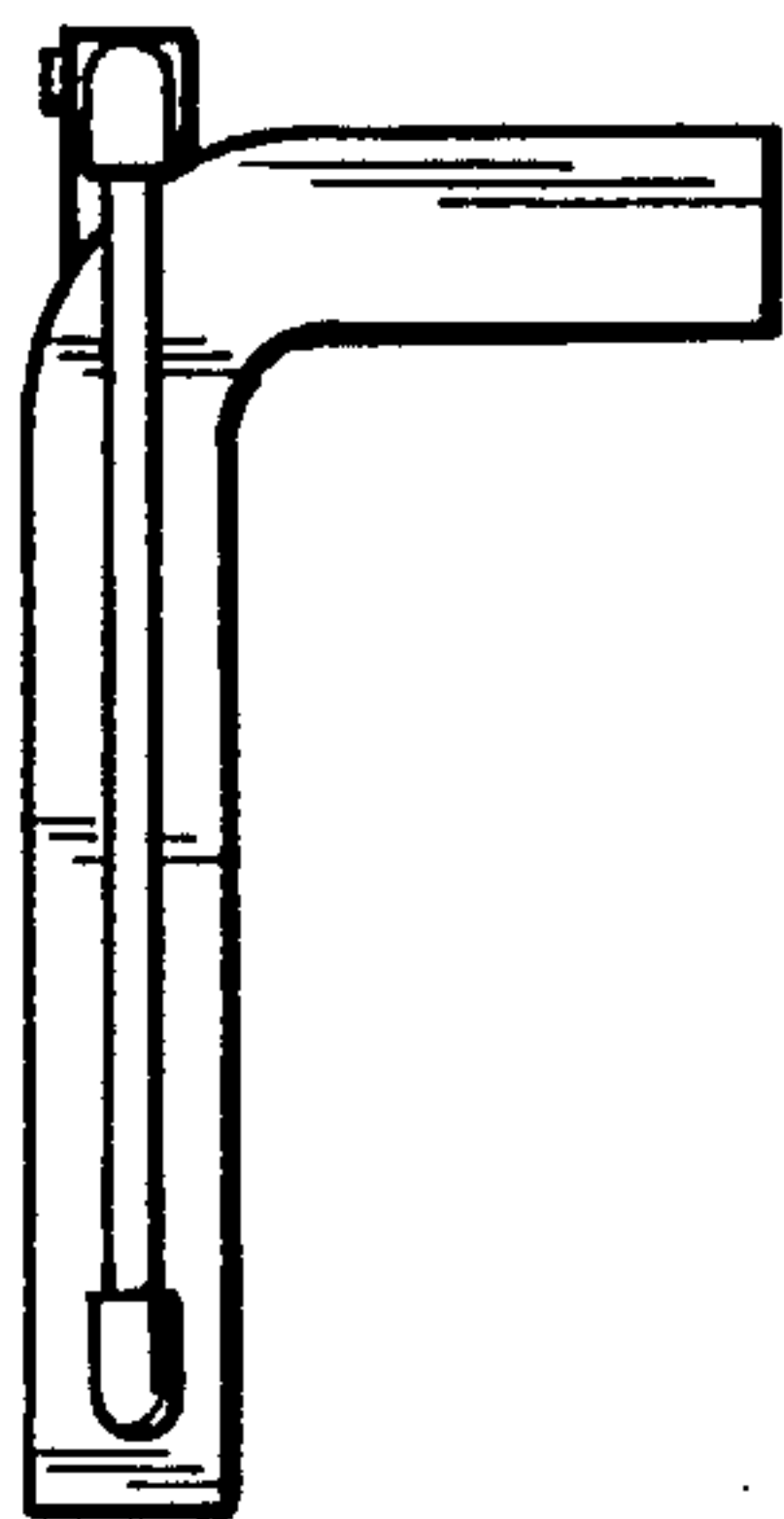

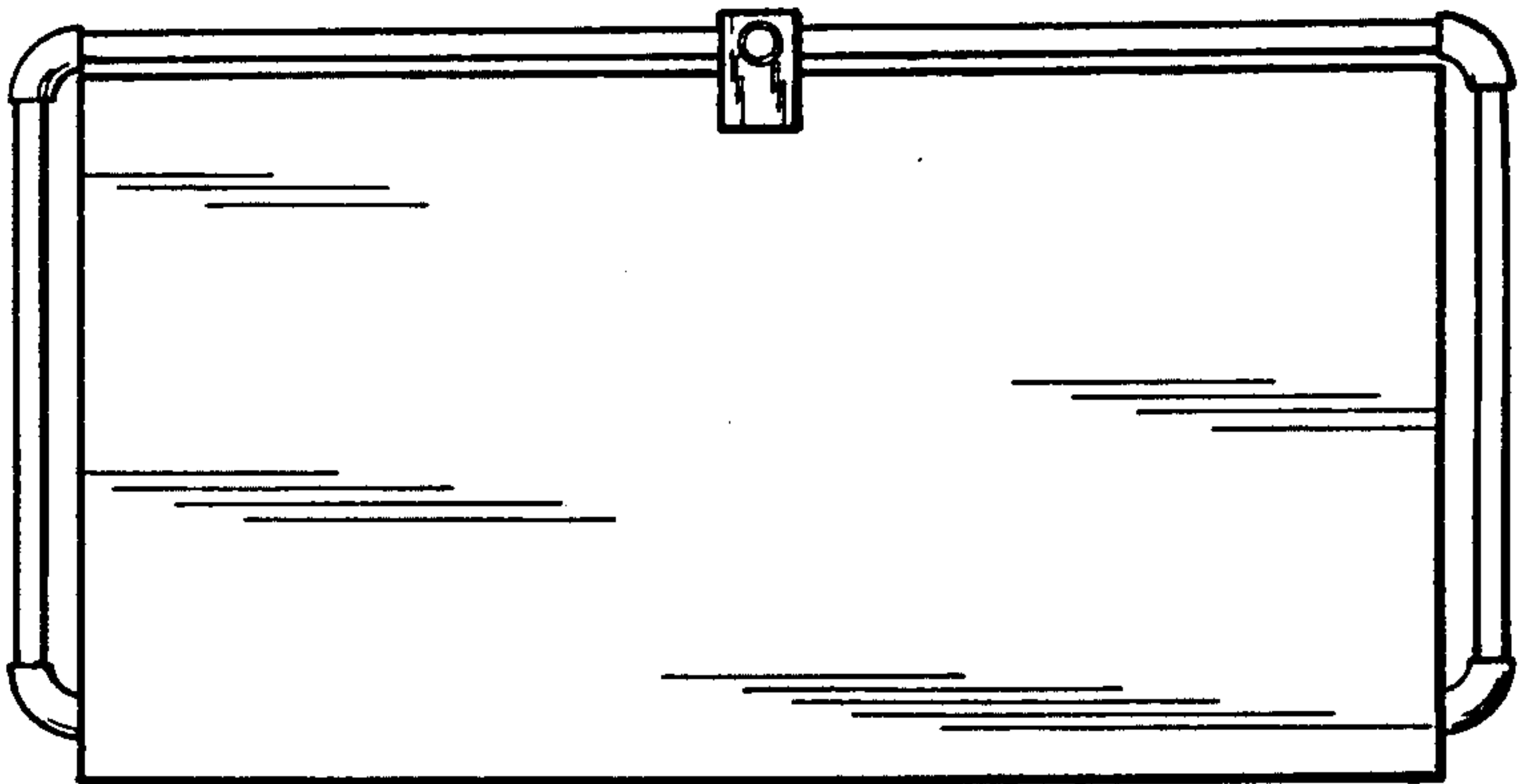

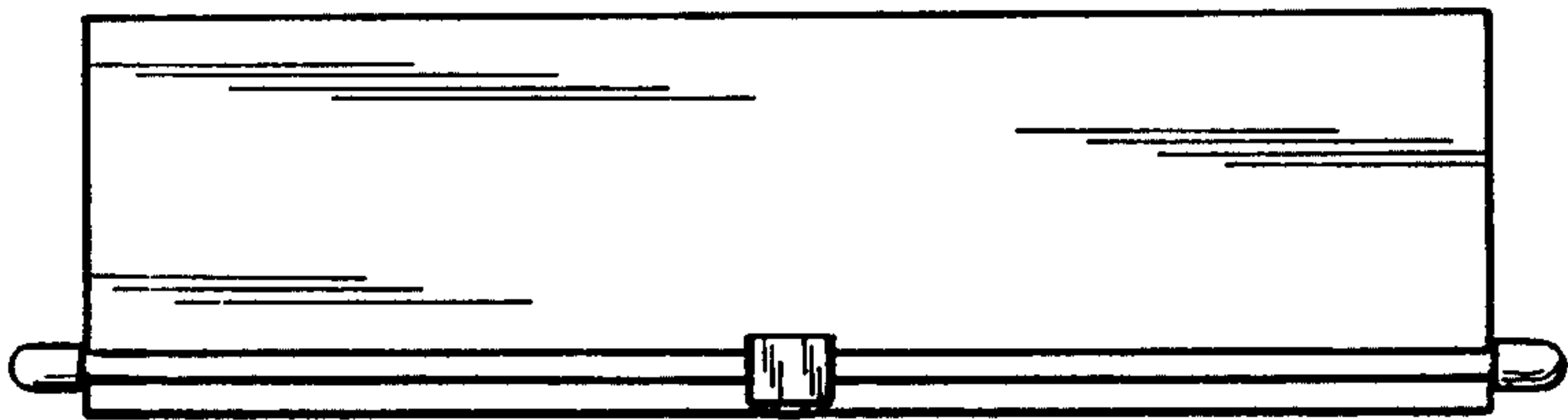

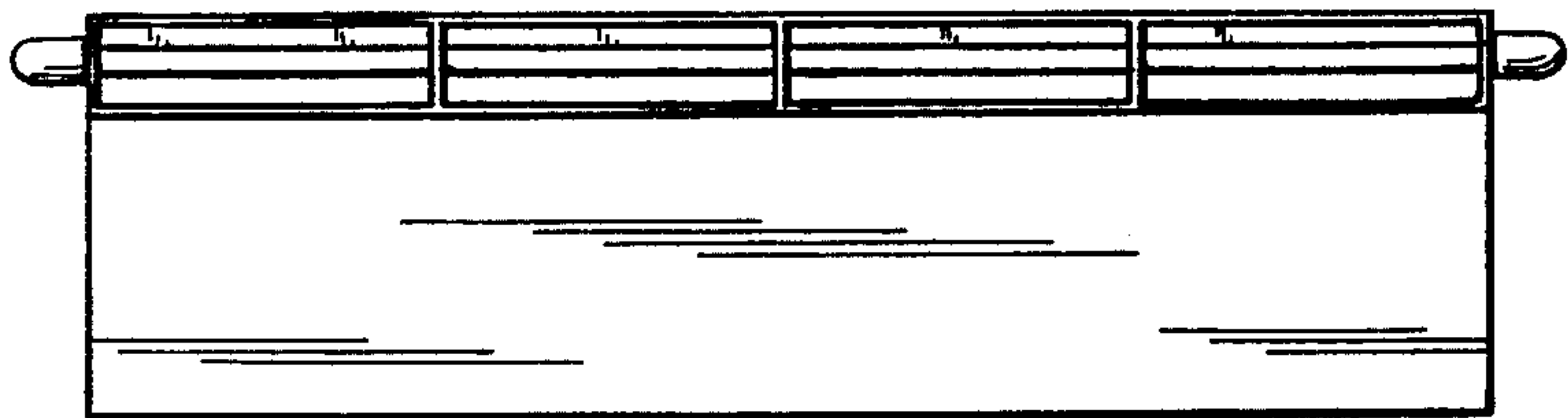

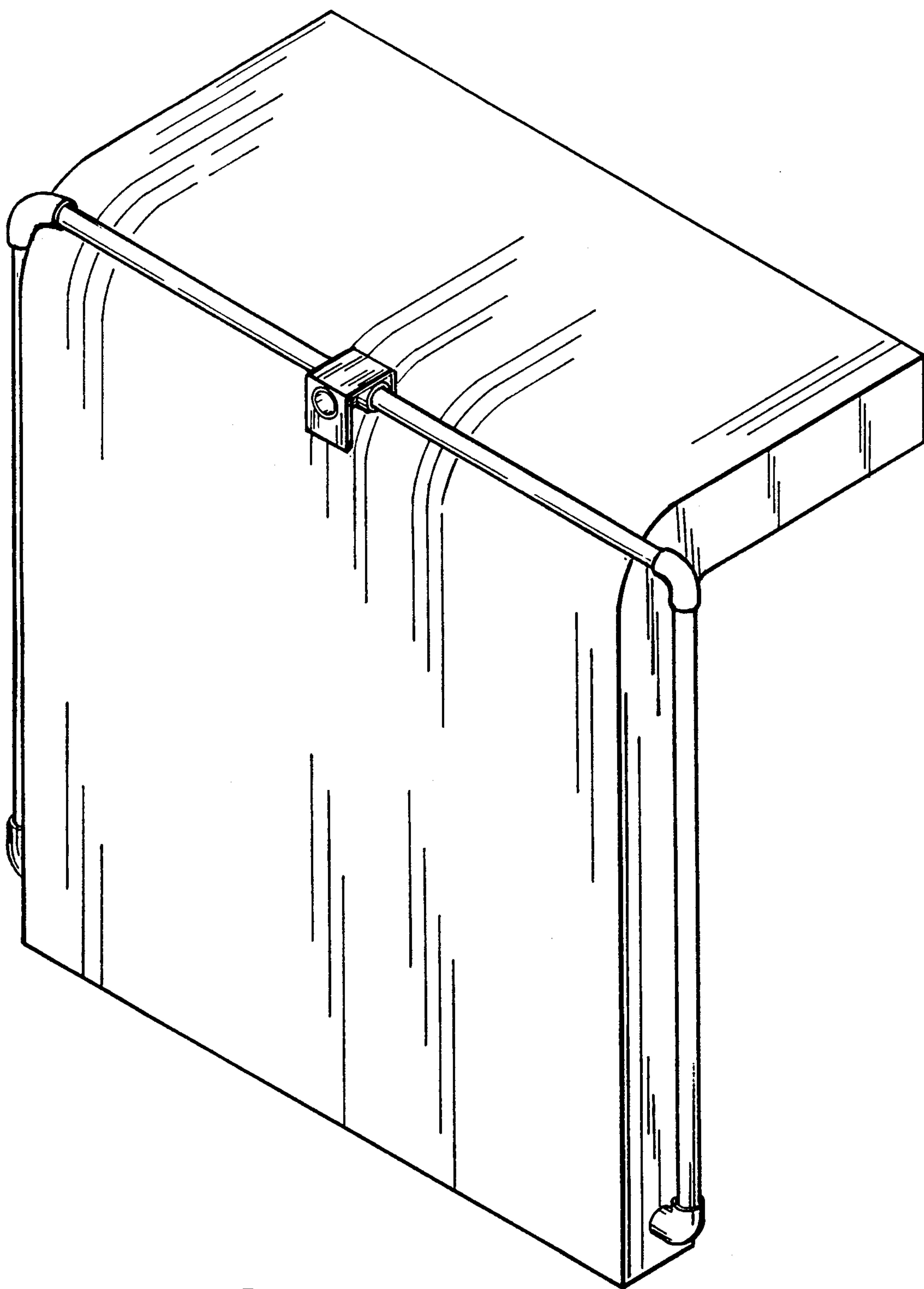
