The ornamental design for a birthing-assistance vacuum bell, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a birthing-assistance vacuum bell, showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the vacuum bell; the right side elevational view is substantially a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; the bottom plan view is substantially identical.
