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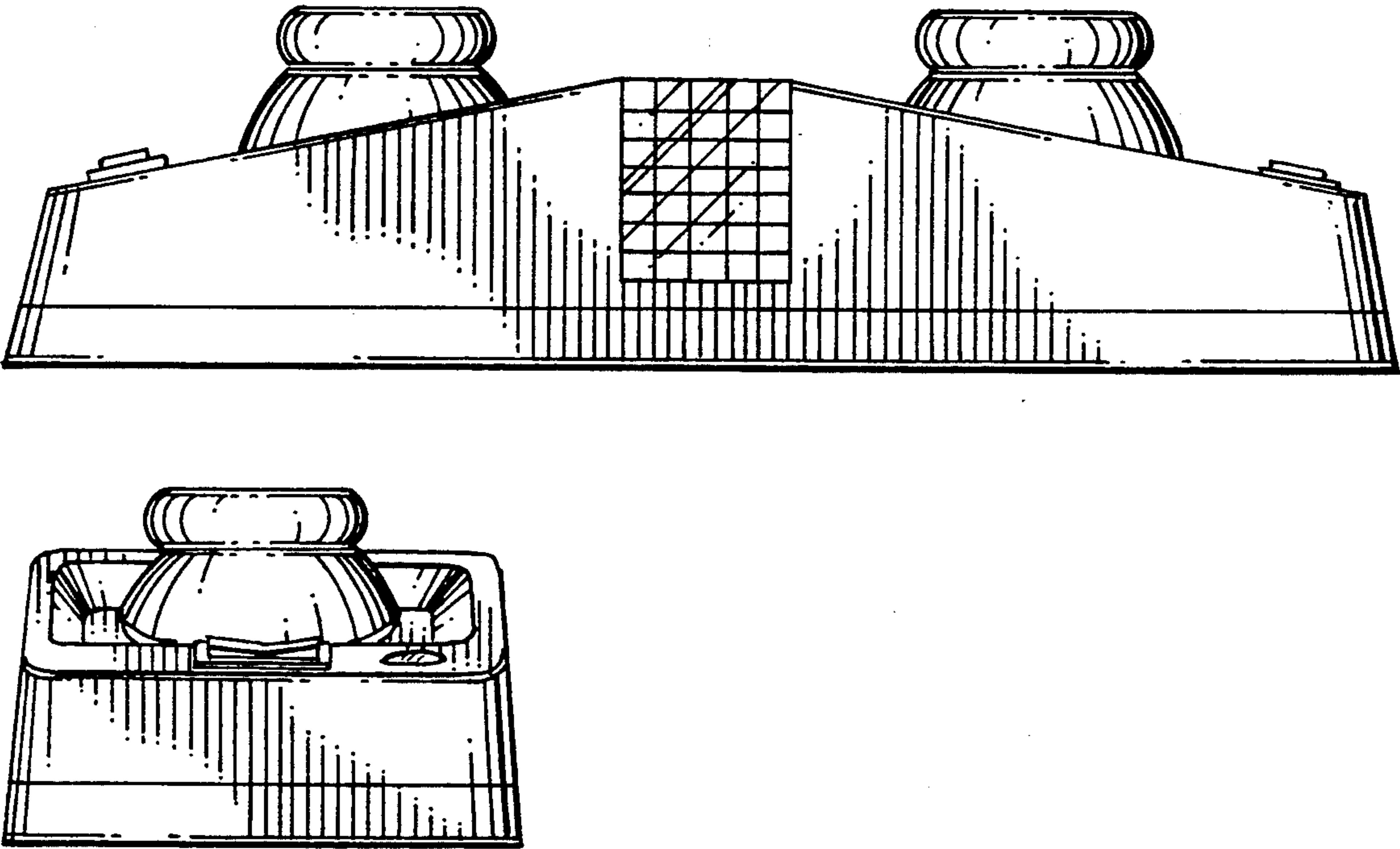

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom view of a combined courtesy and adjustable reading light for vehicles showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image.



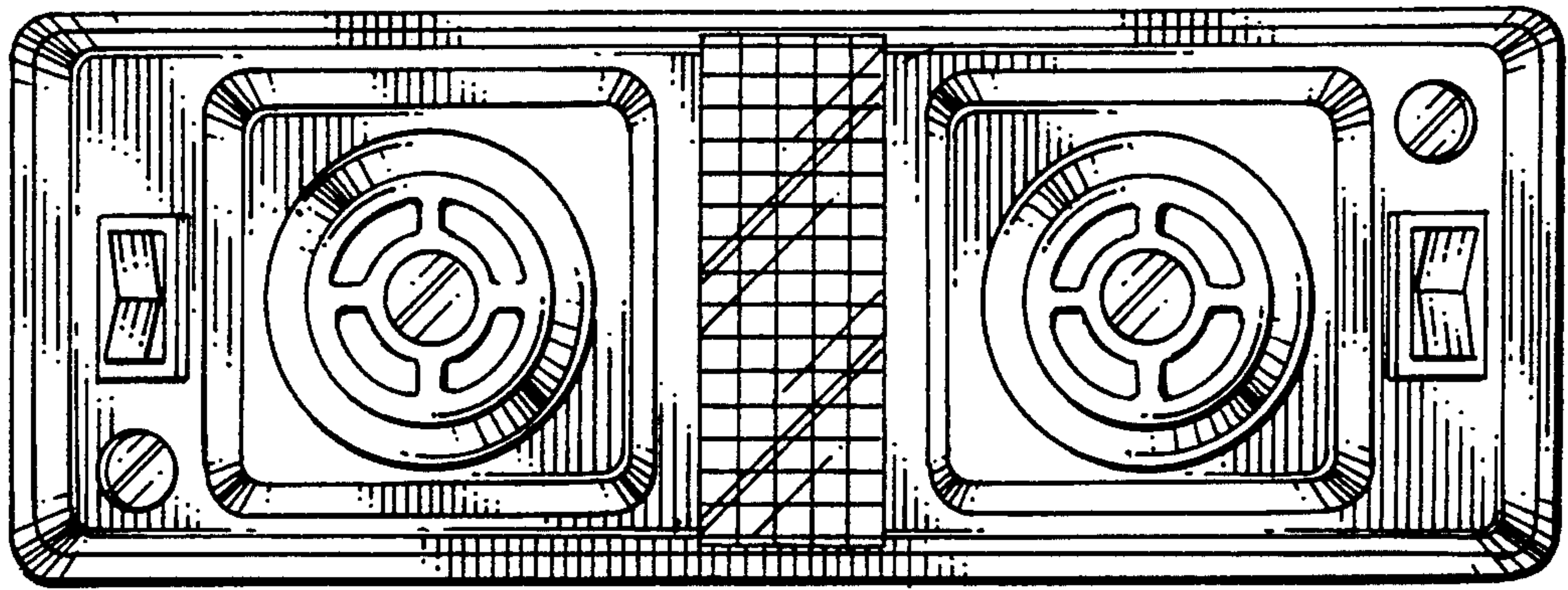

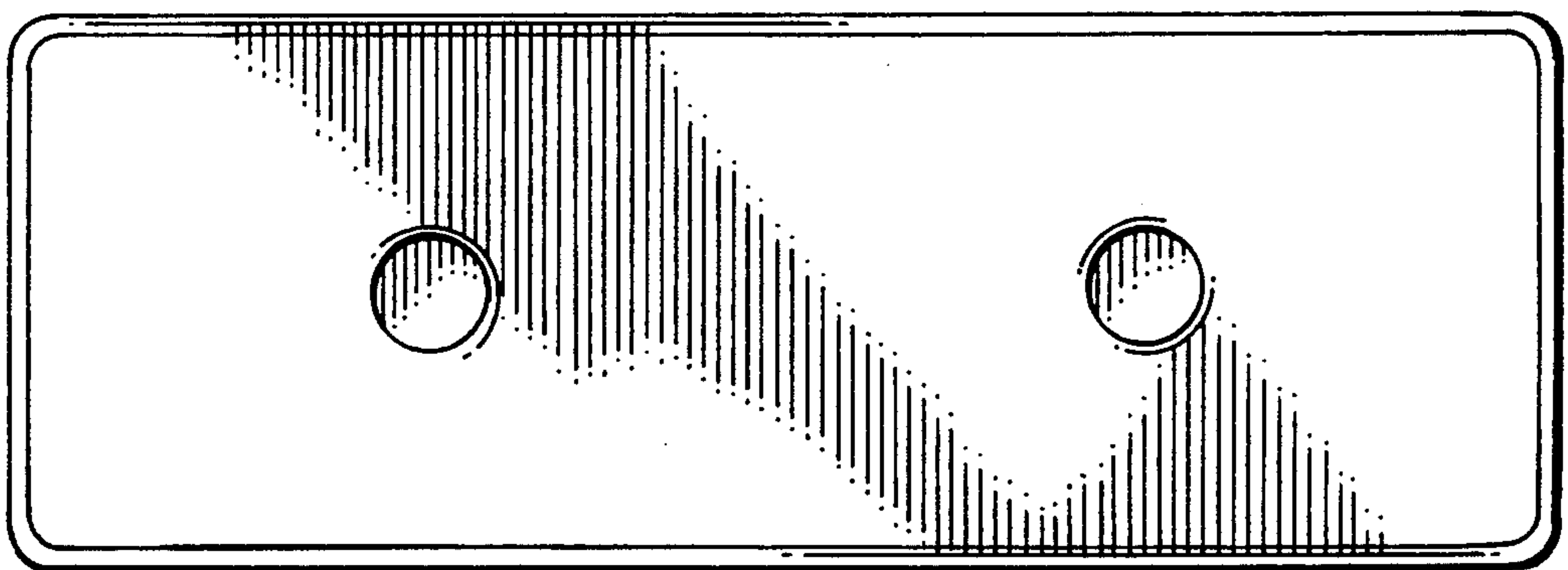

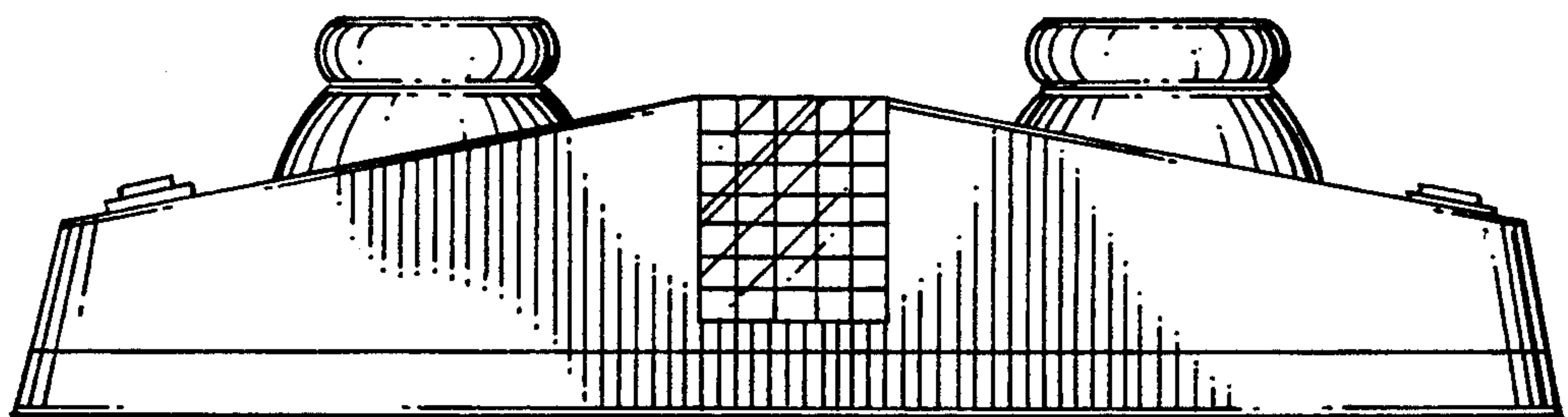

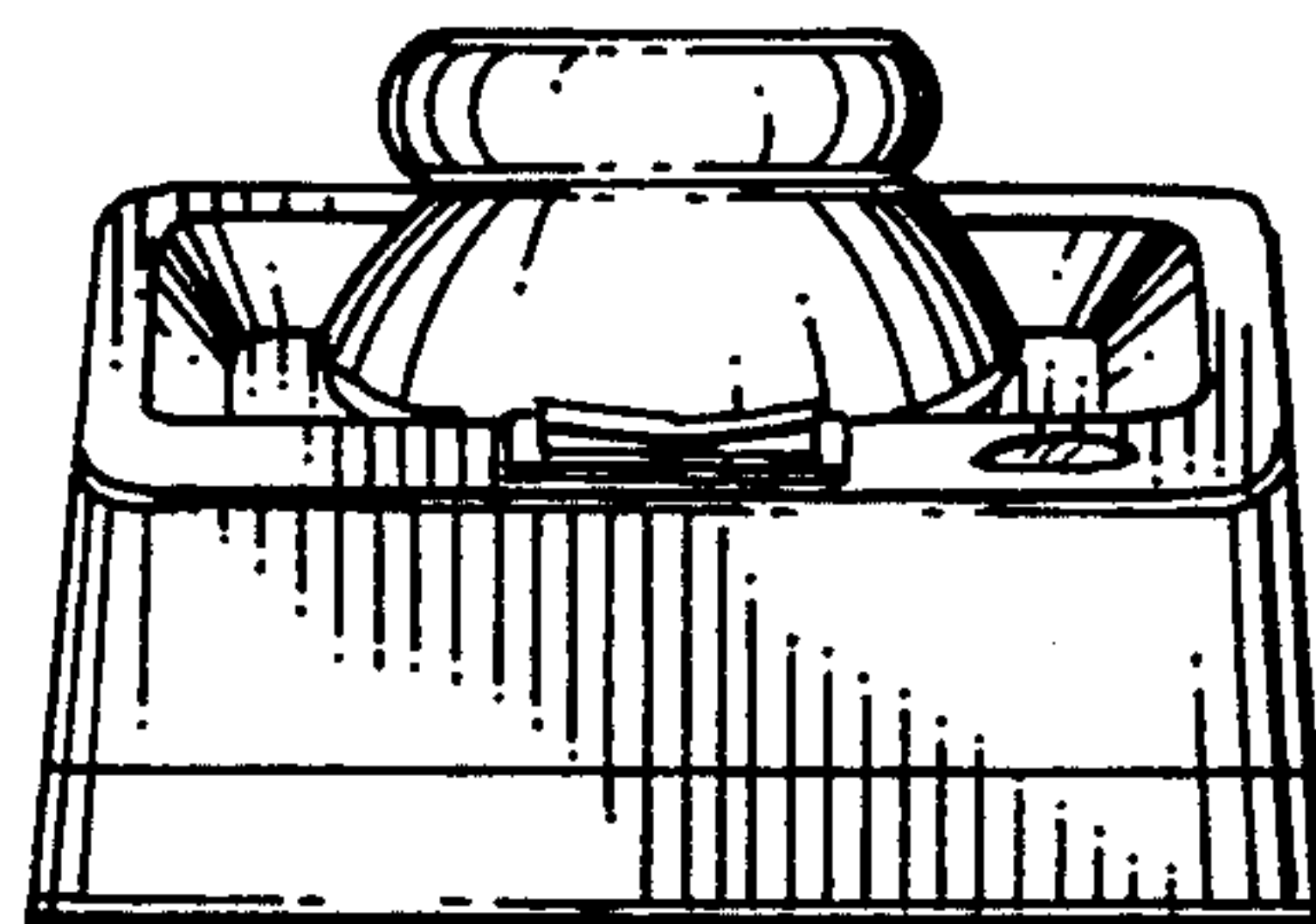
