FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a brush handle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

The broken line showing of bristles is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

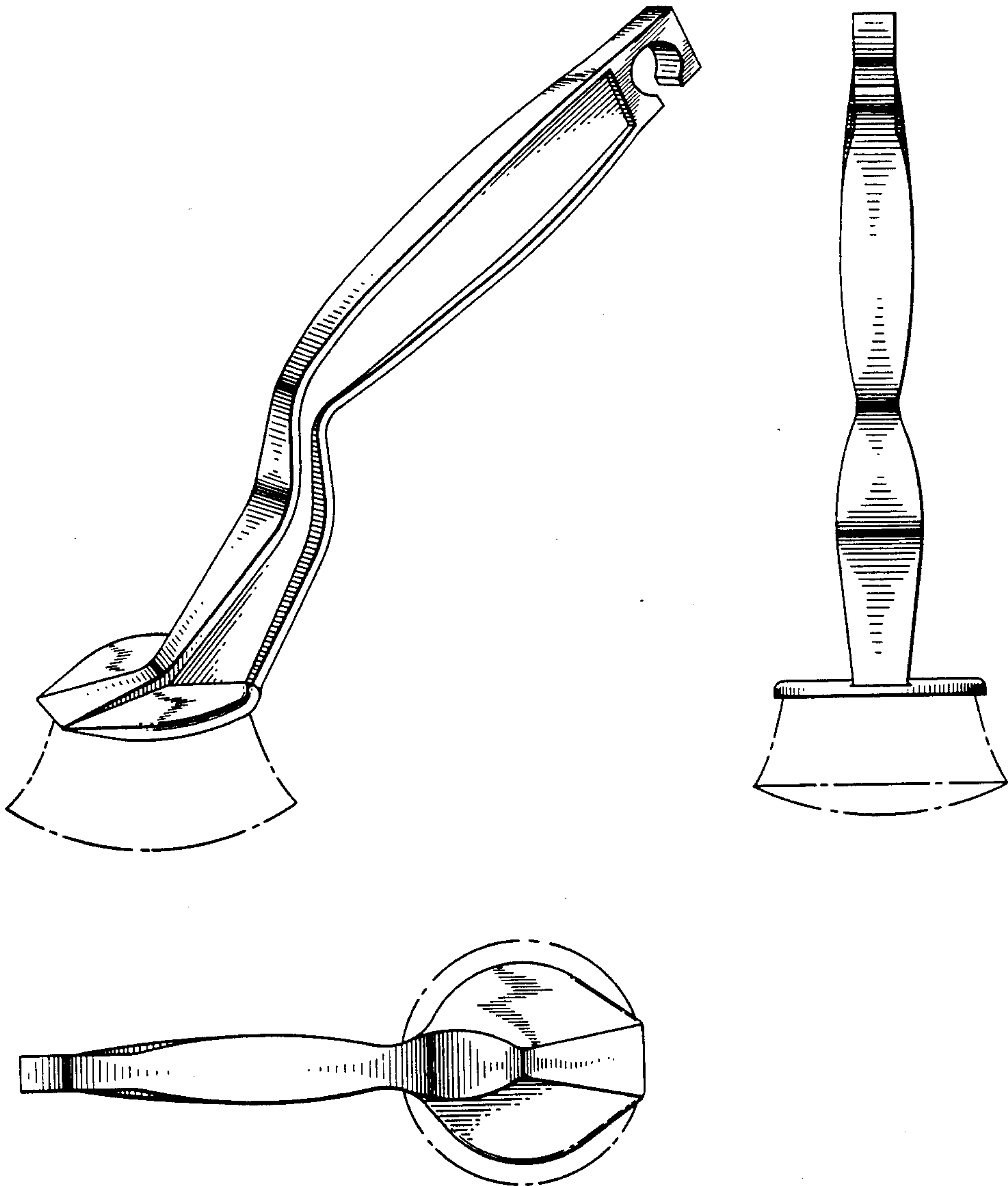
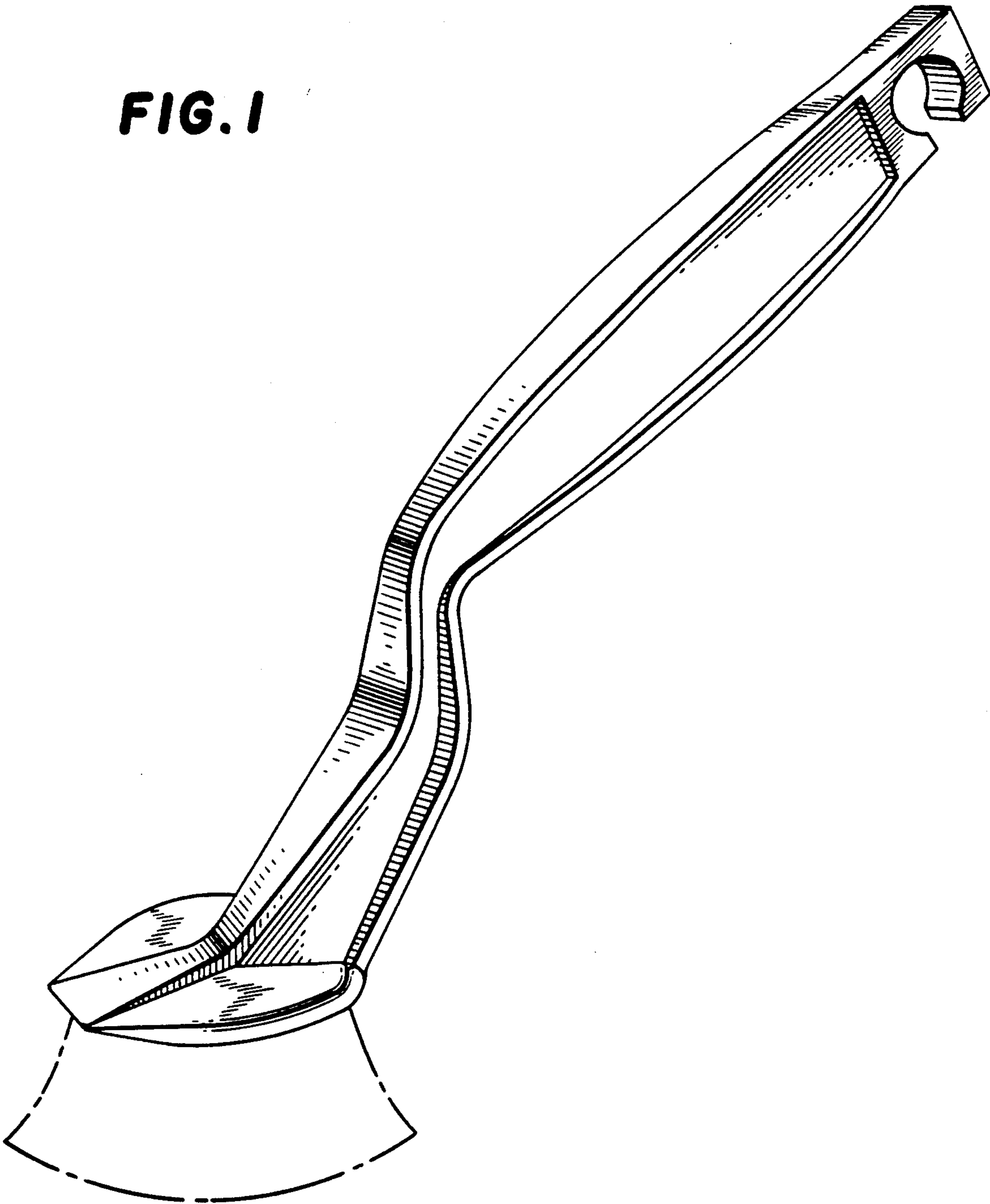

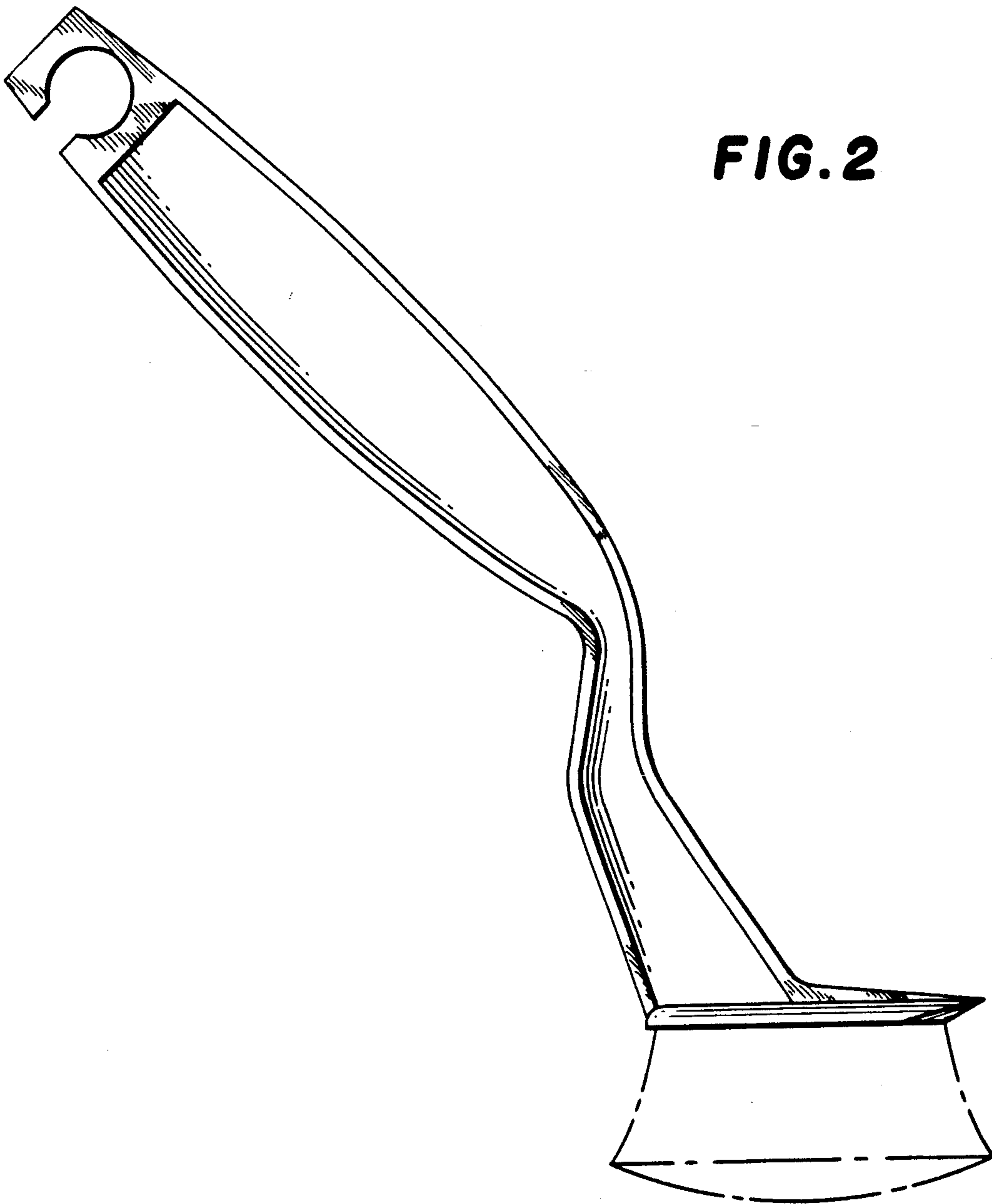

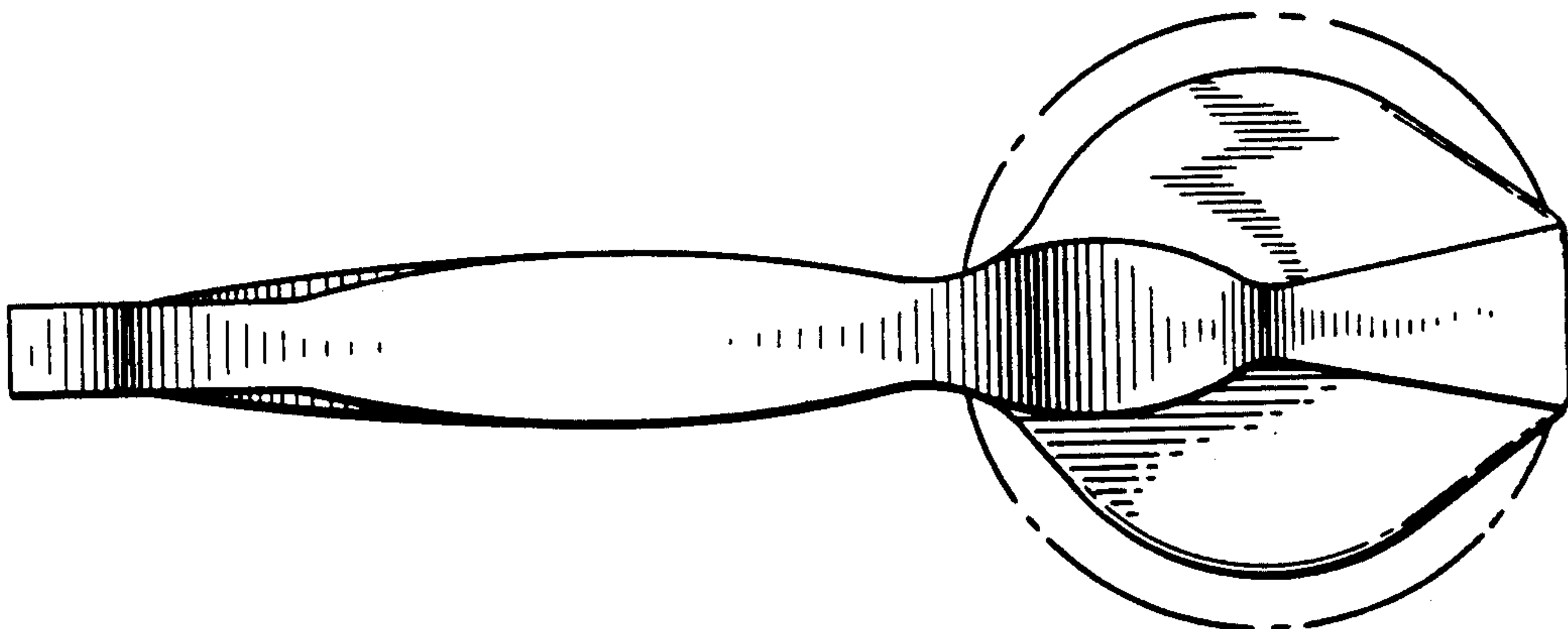

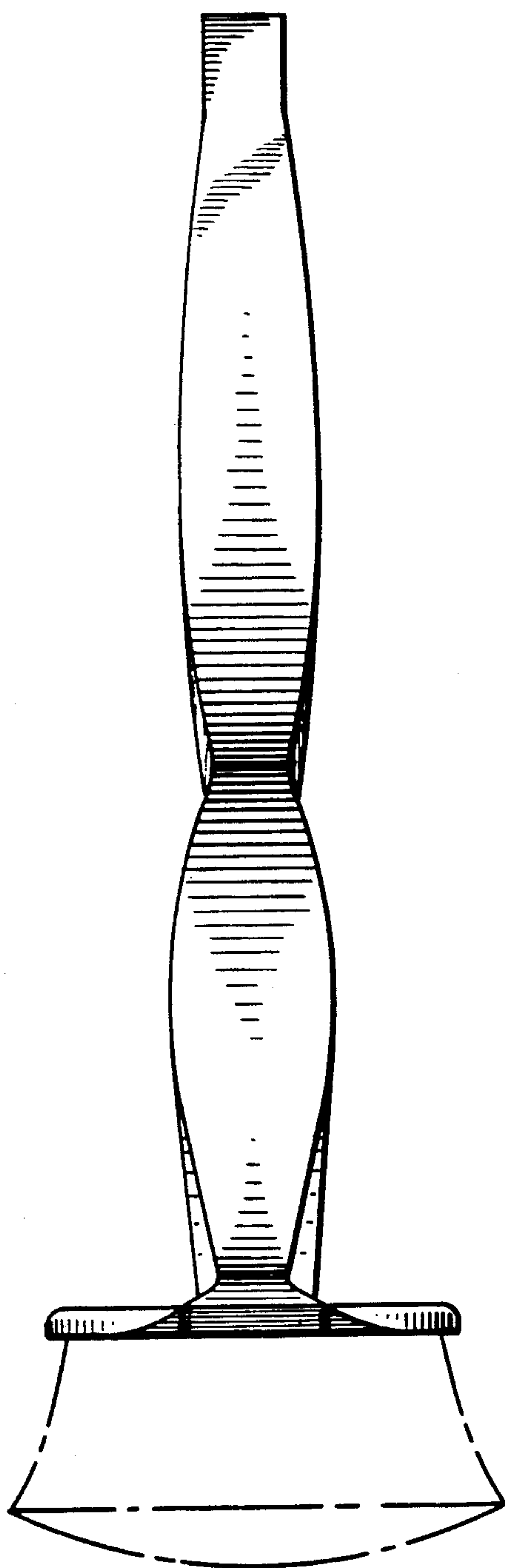
