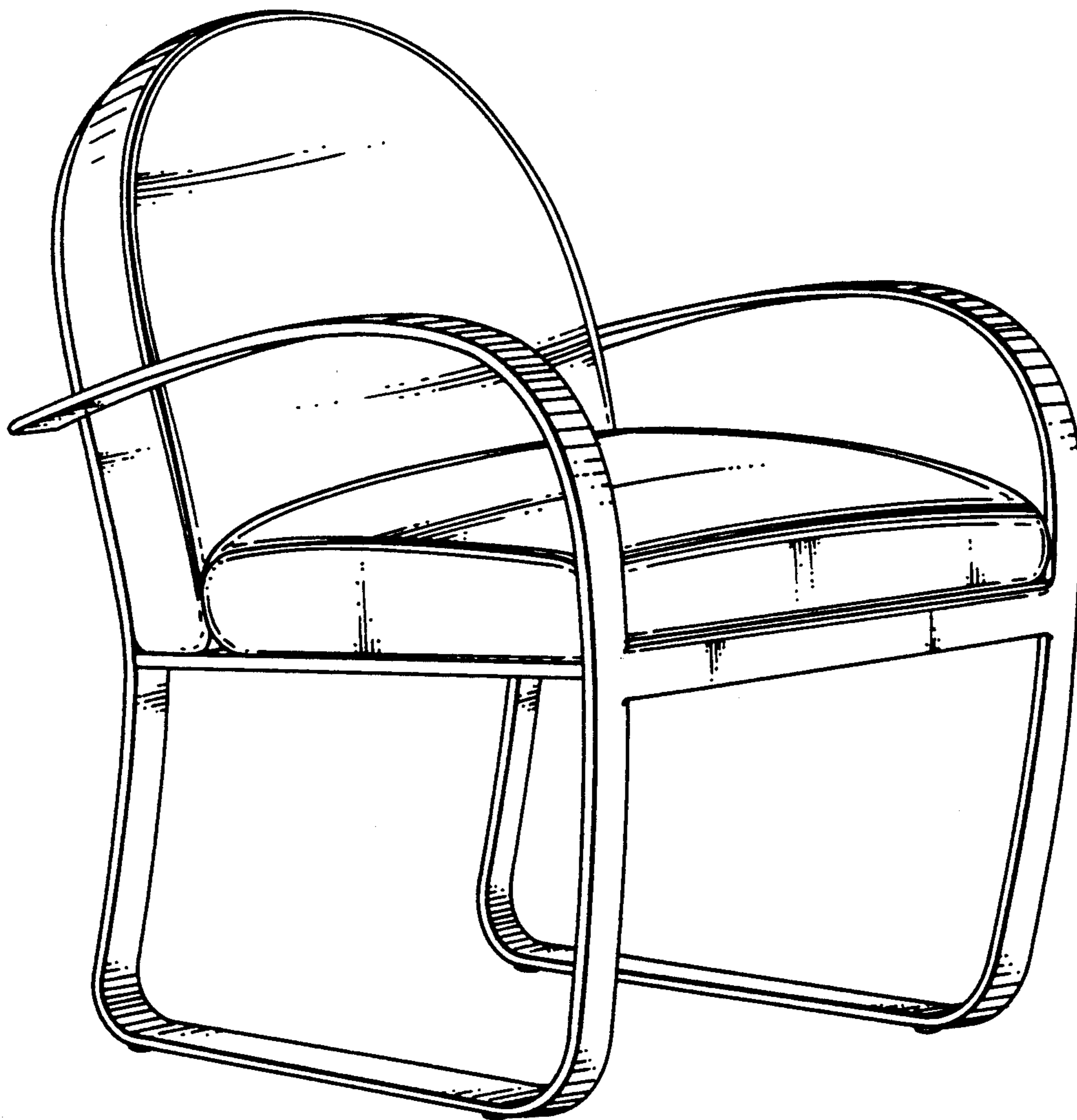

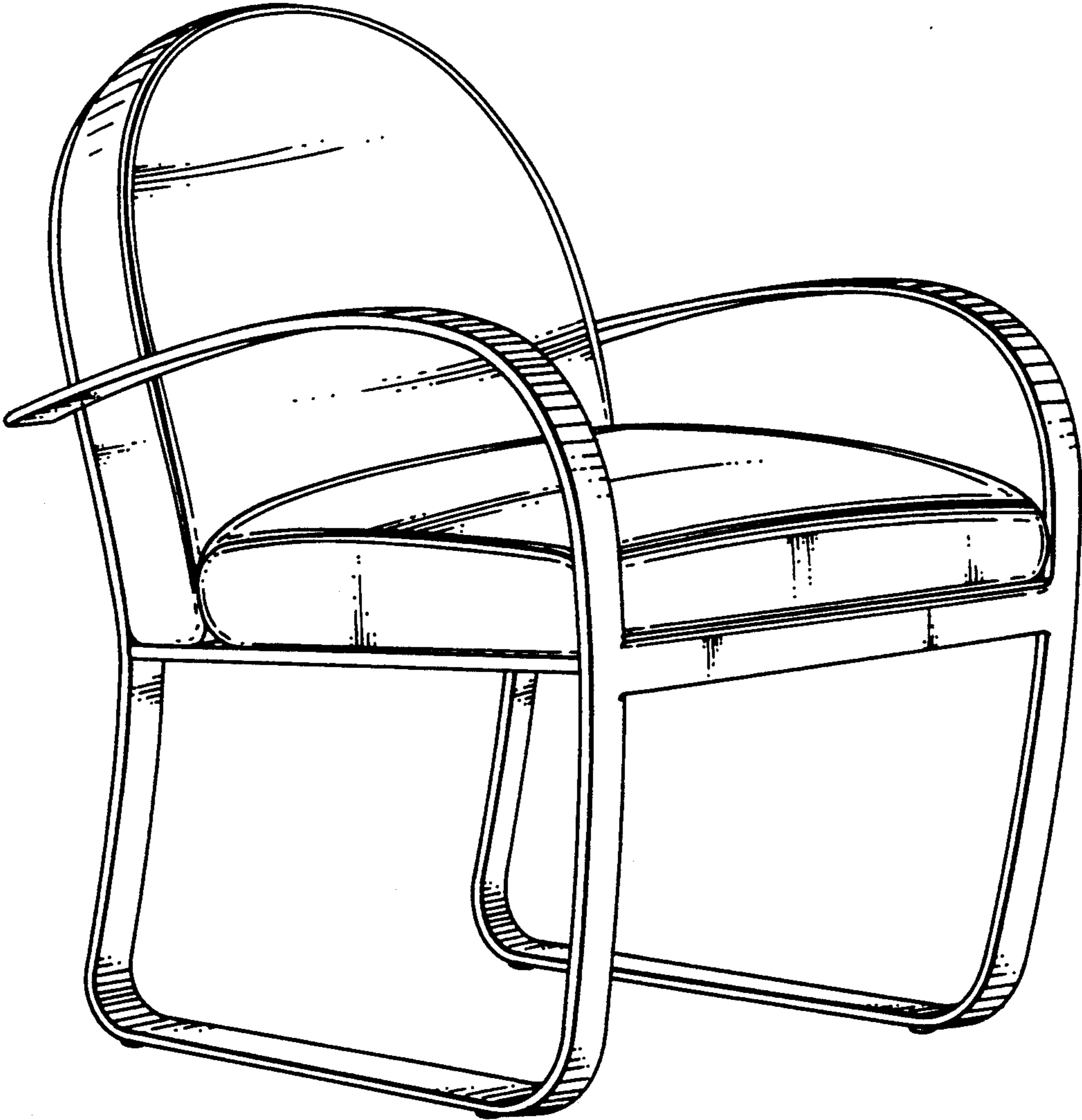
The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

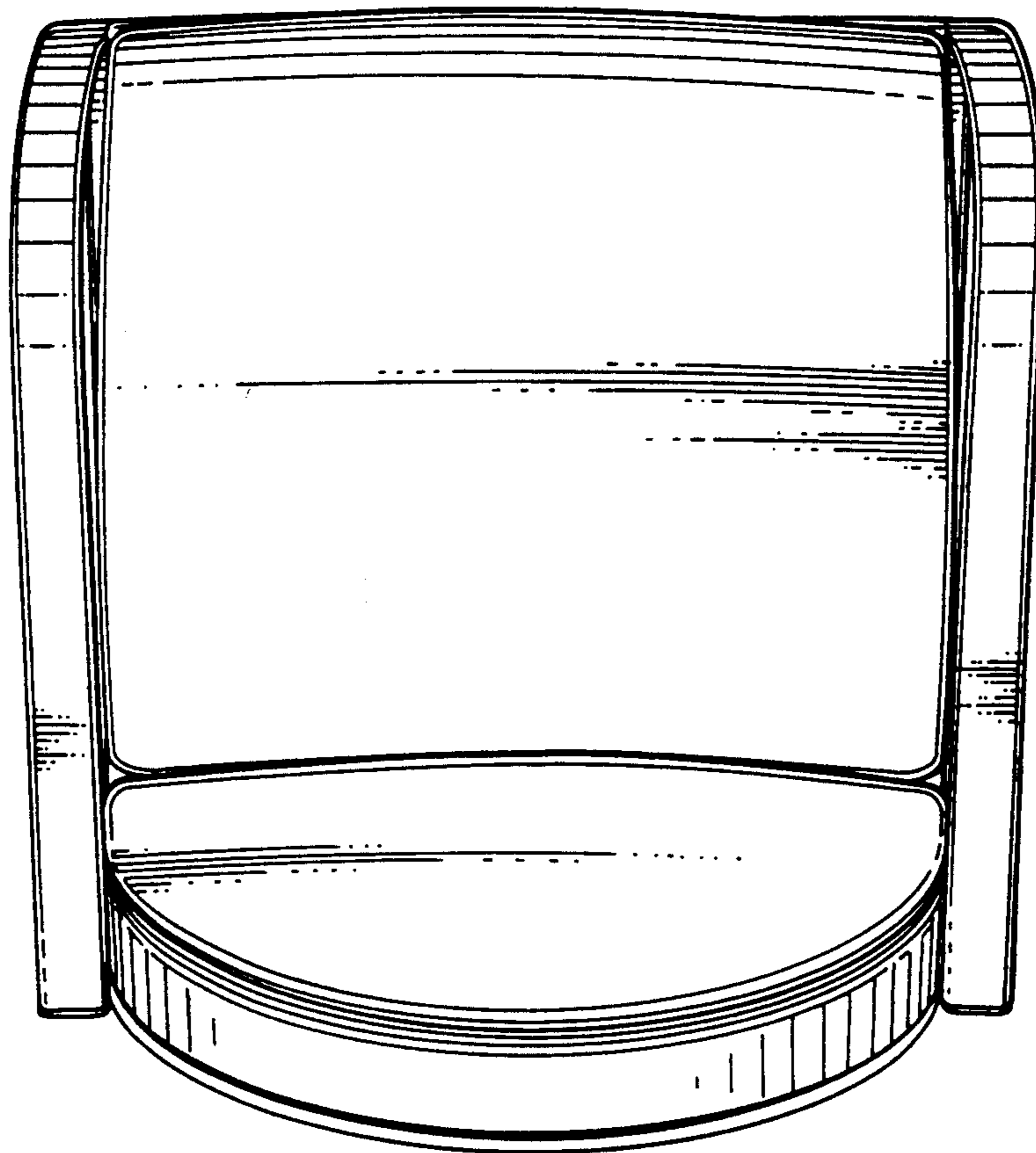
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.



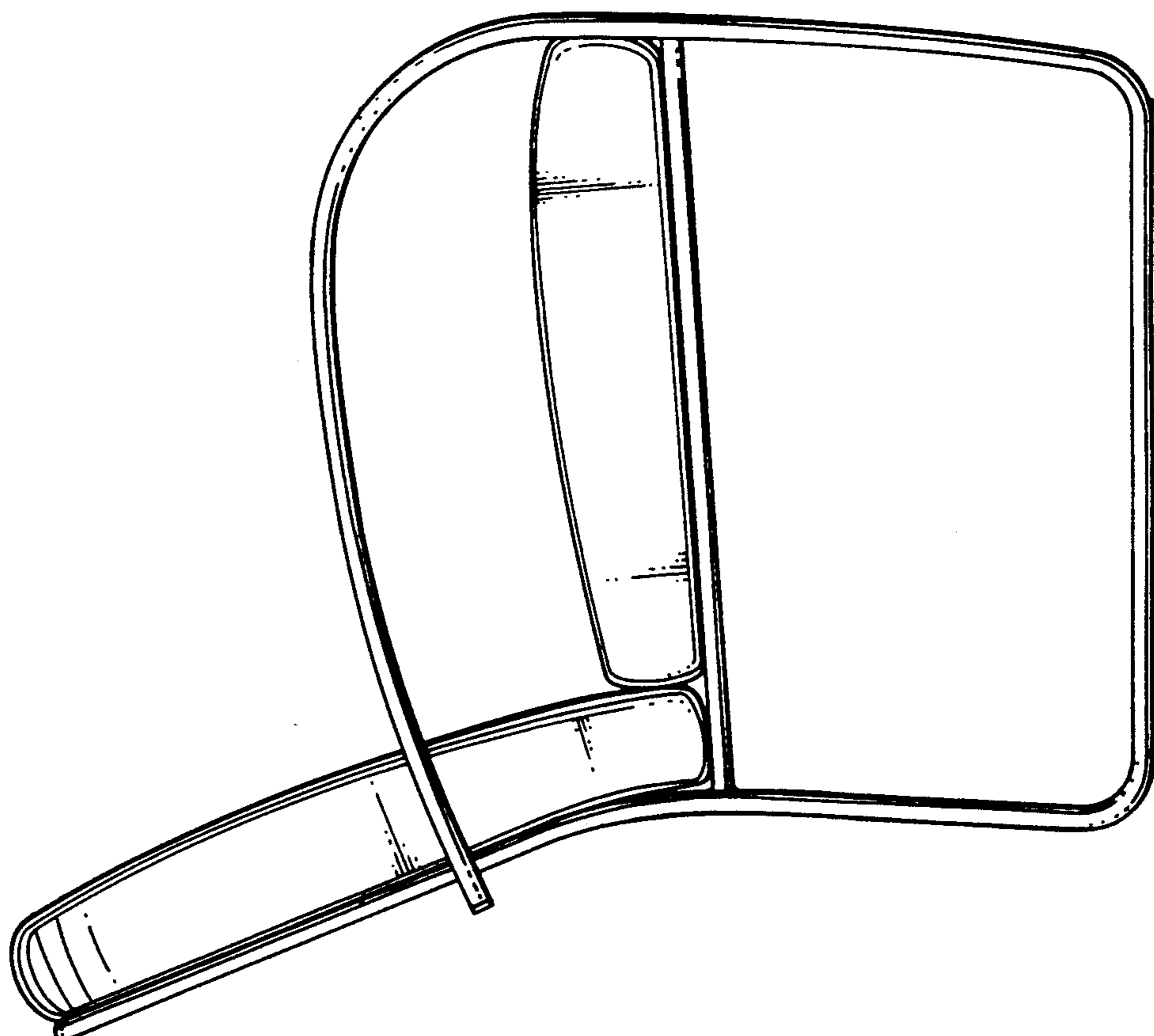

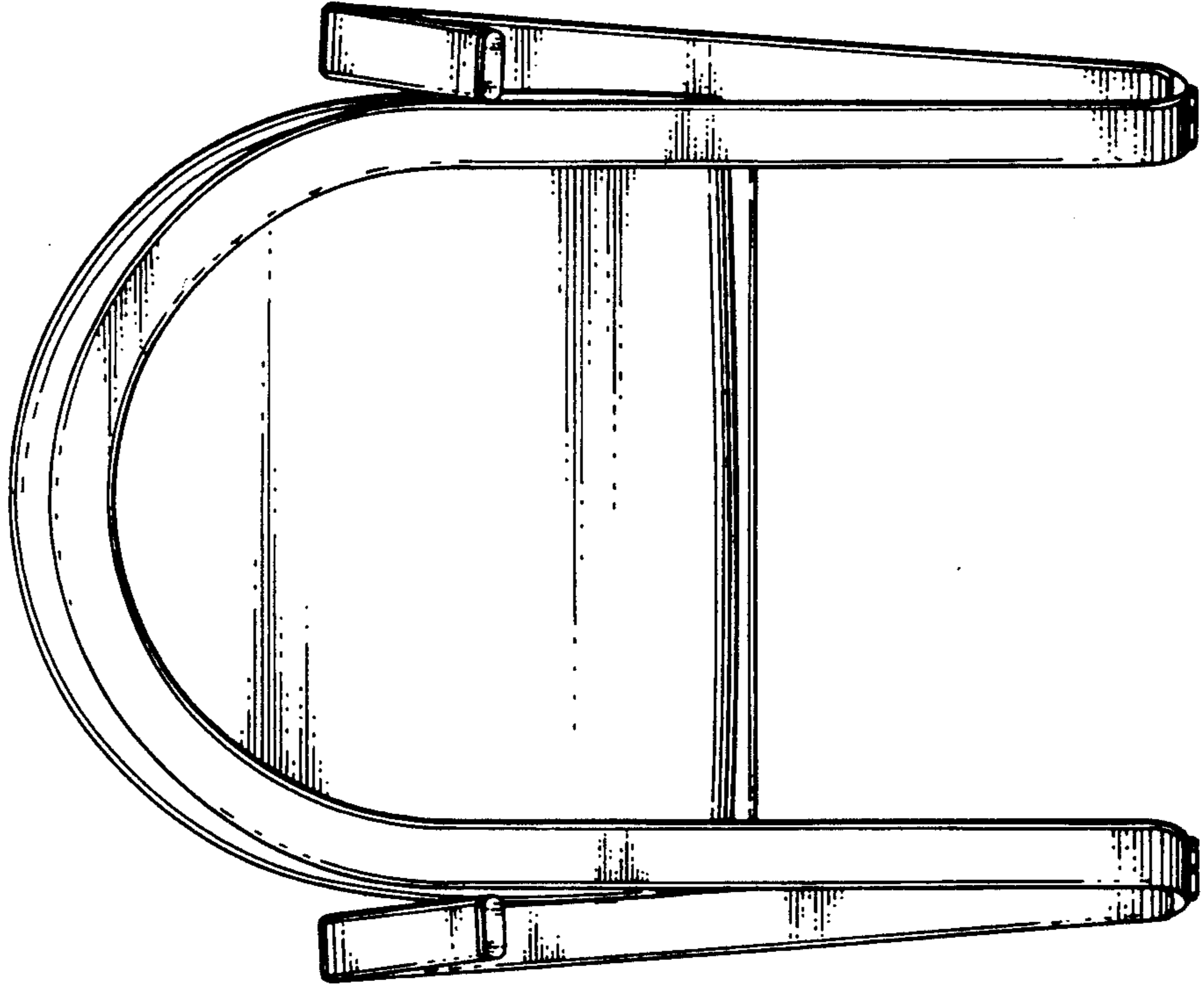
