

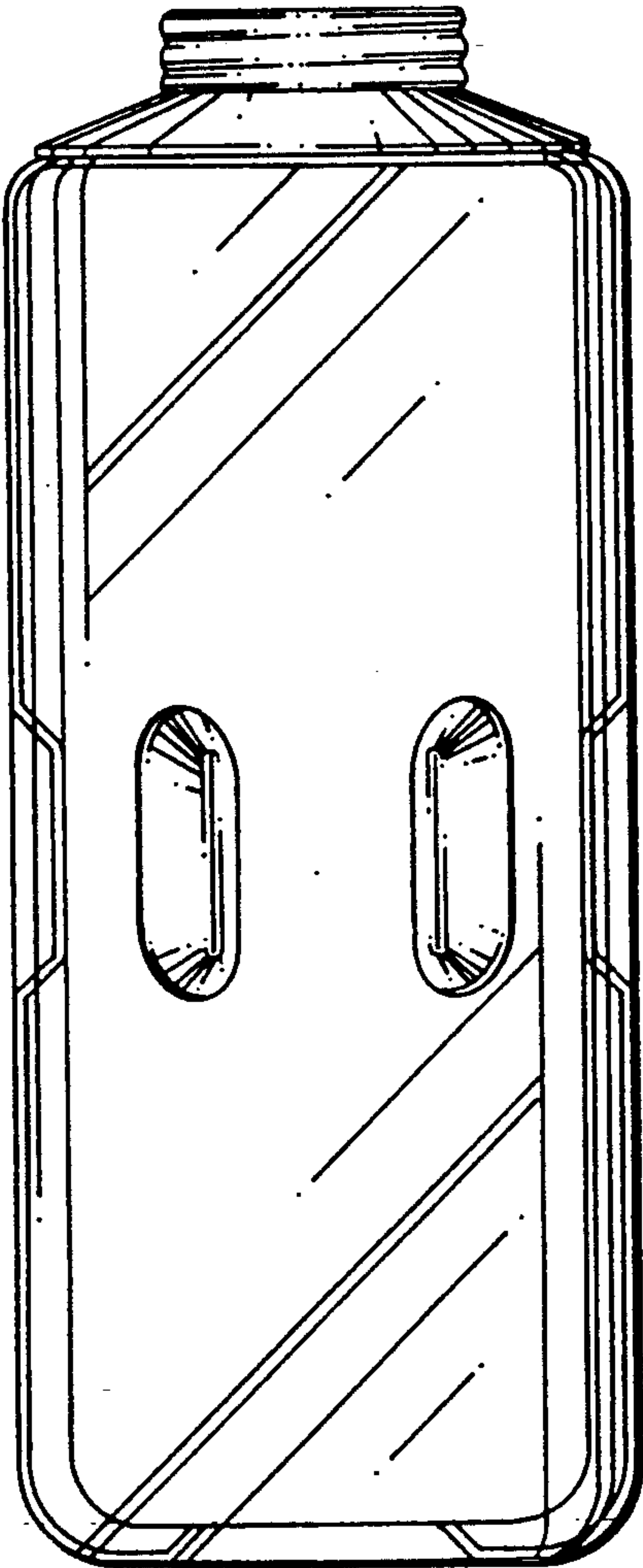

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above of a bottle
showing my new design in an exploded condition;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the bottle in an assembled
condition, the rear view is identical;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the bottle shown on an
enlarged scale; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the bottle shown on an
enlarged scale.



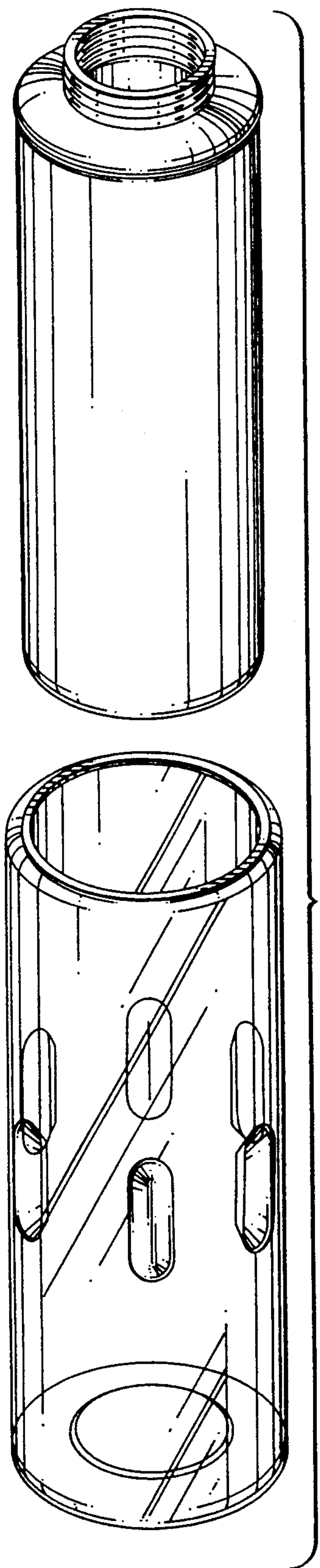

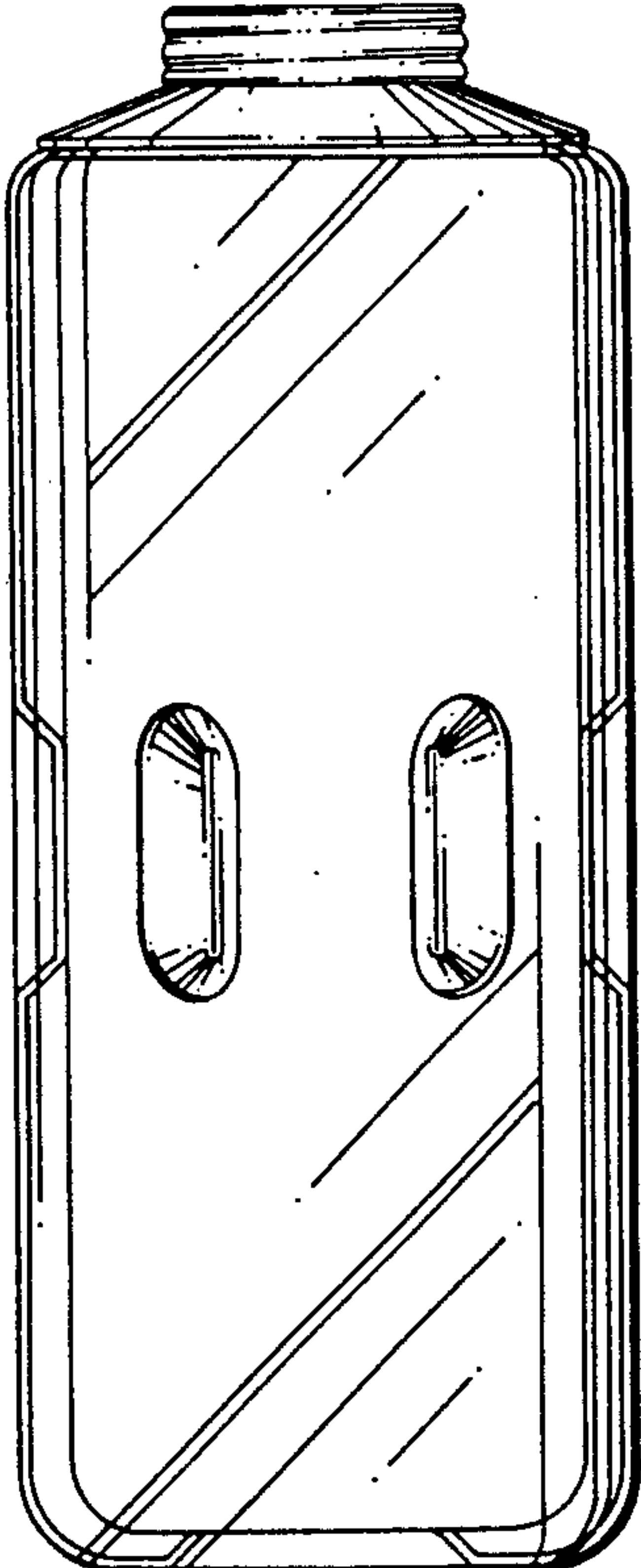

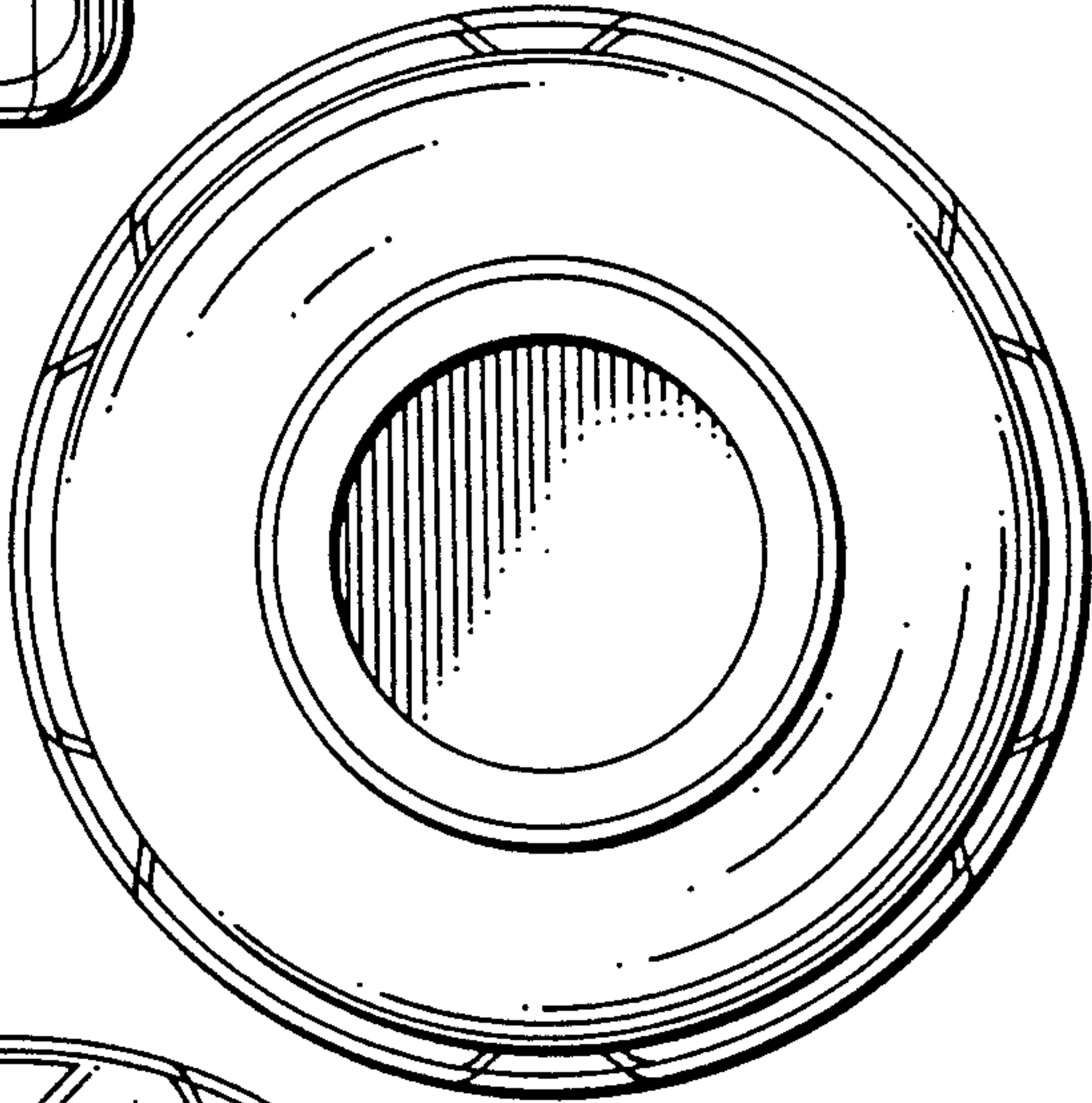

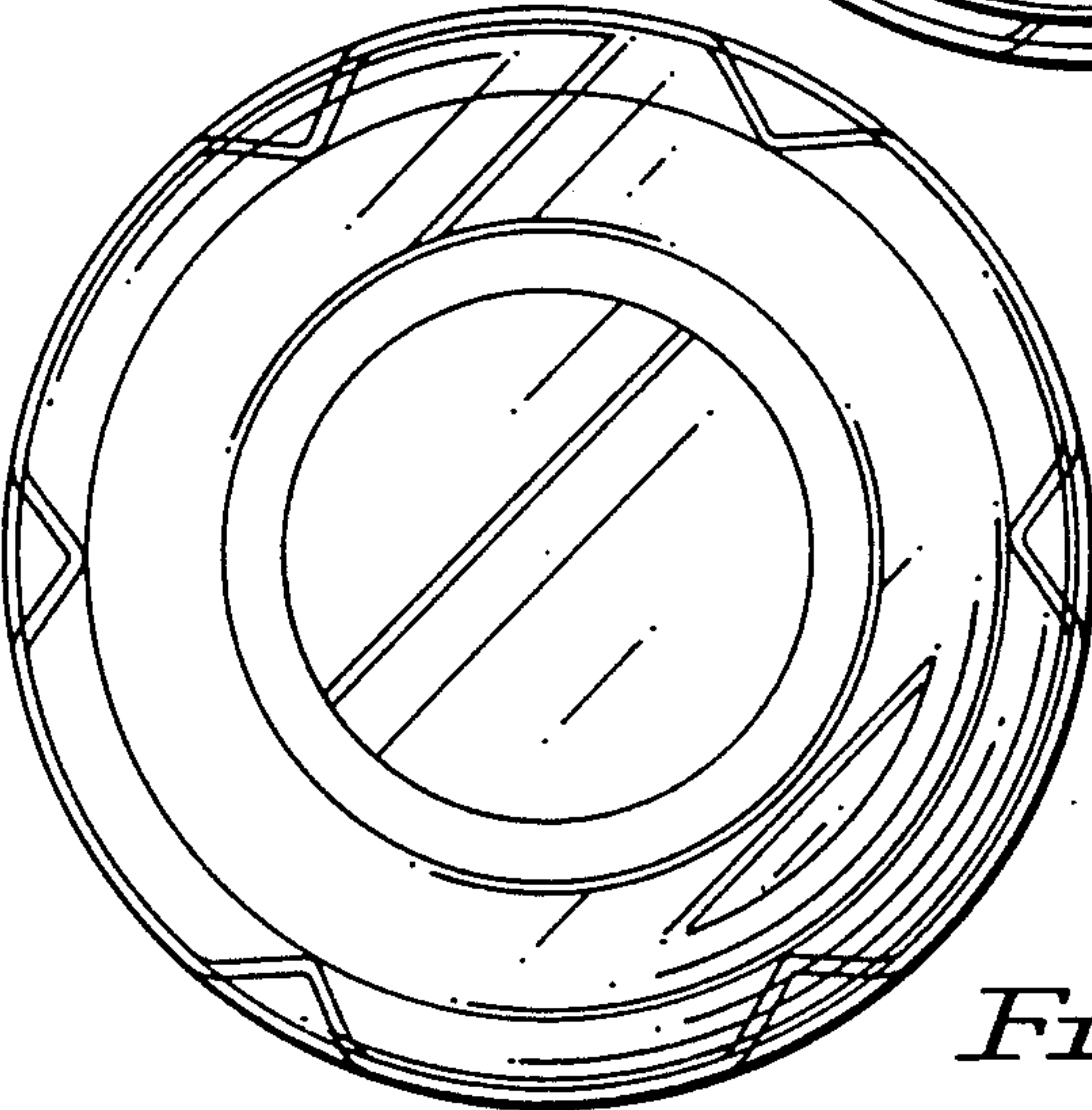
