DESCRIPTION

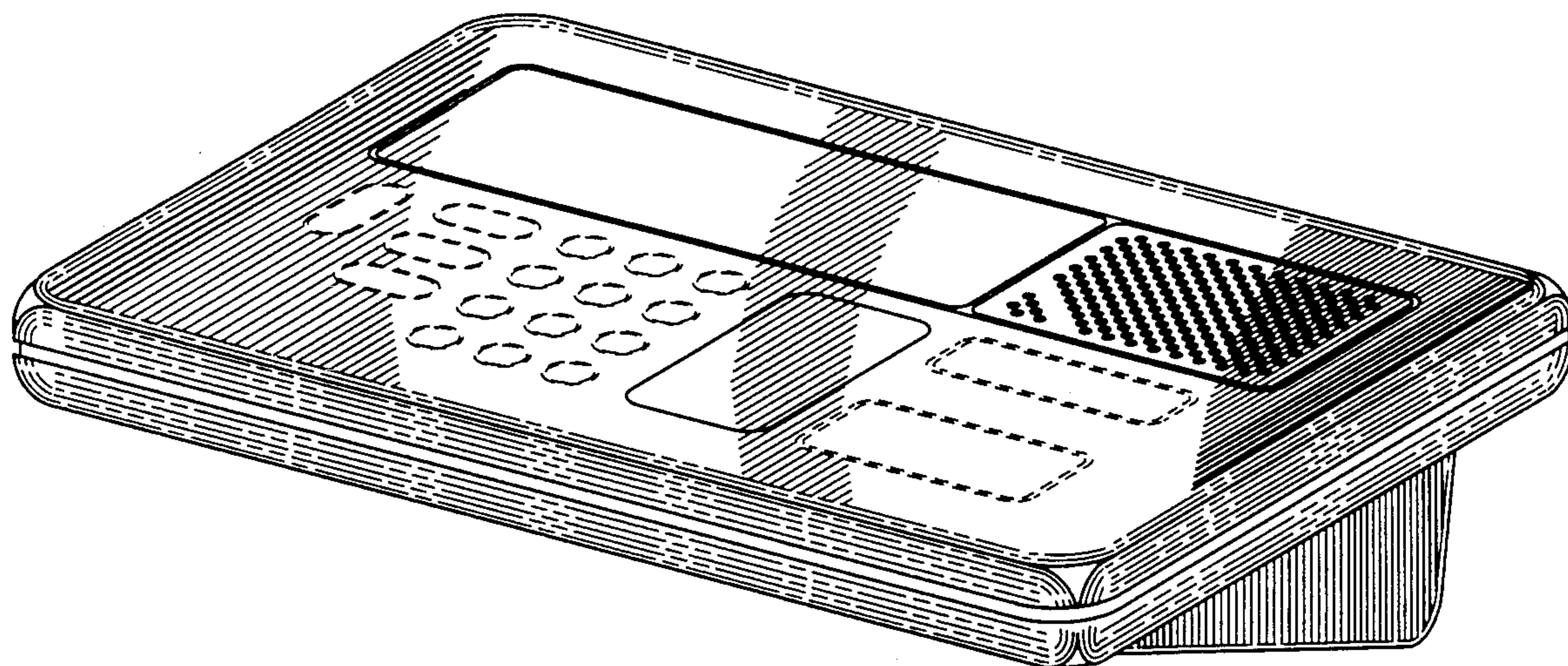
FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a desk-top communications radio unit or similar article showing my new design;

The broken line showing in FIGS. 1 and 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



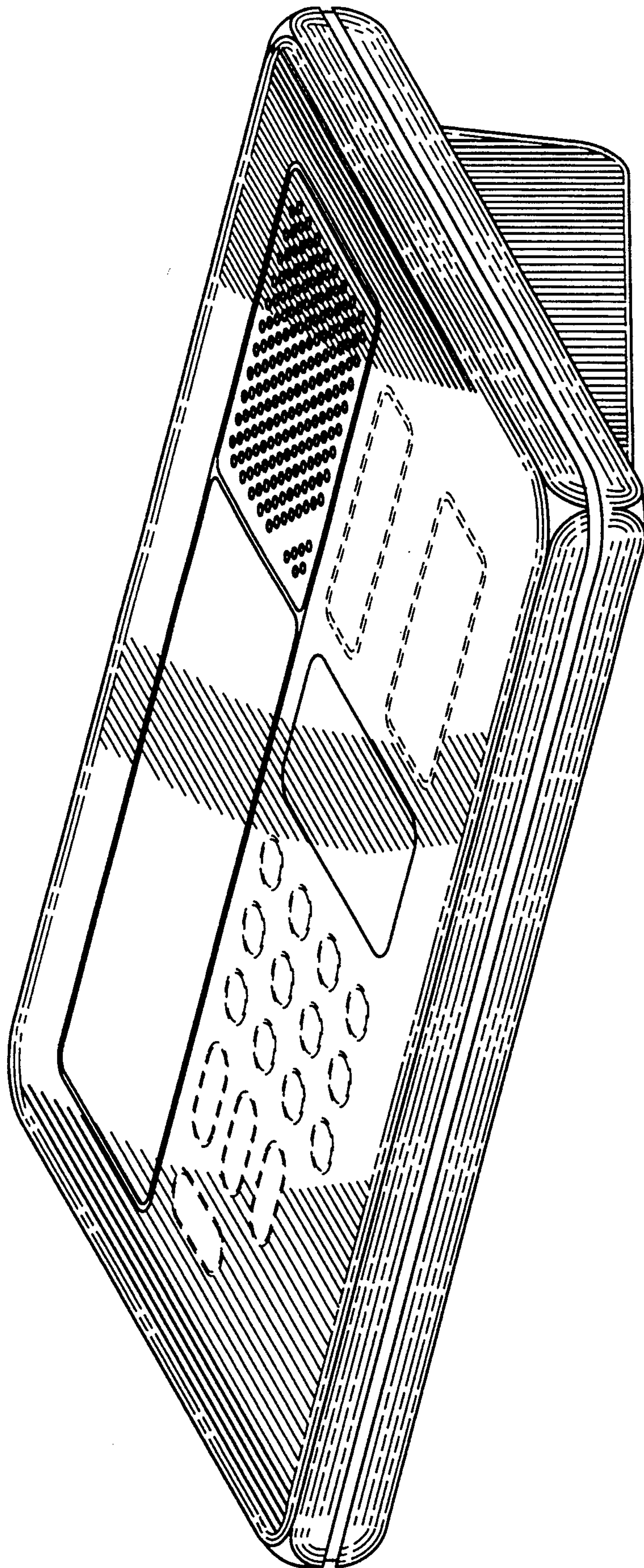

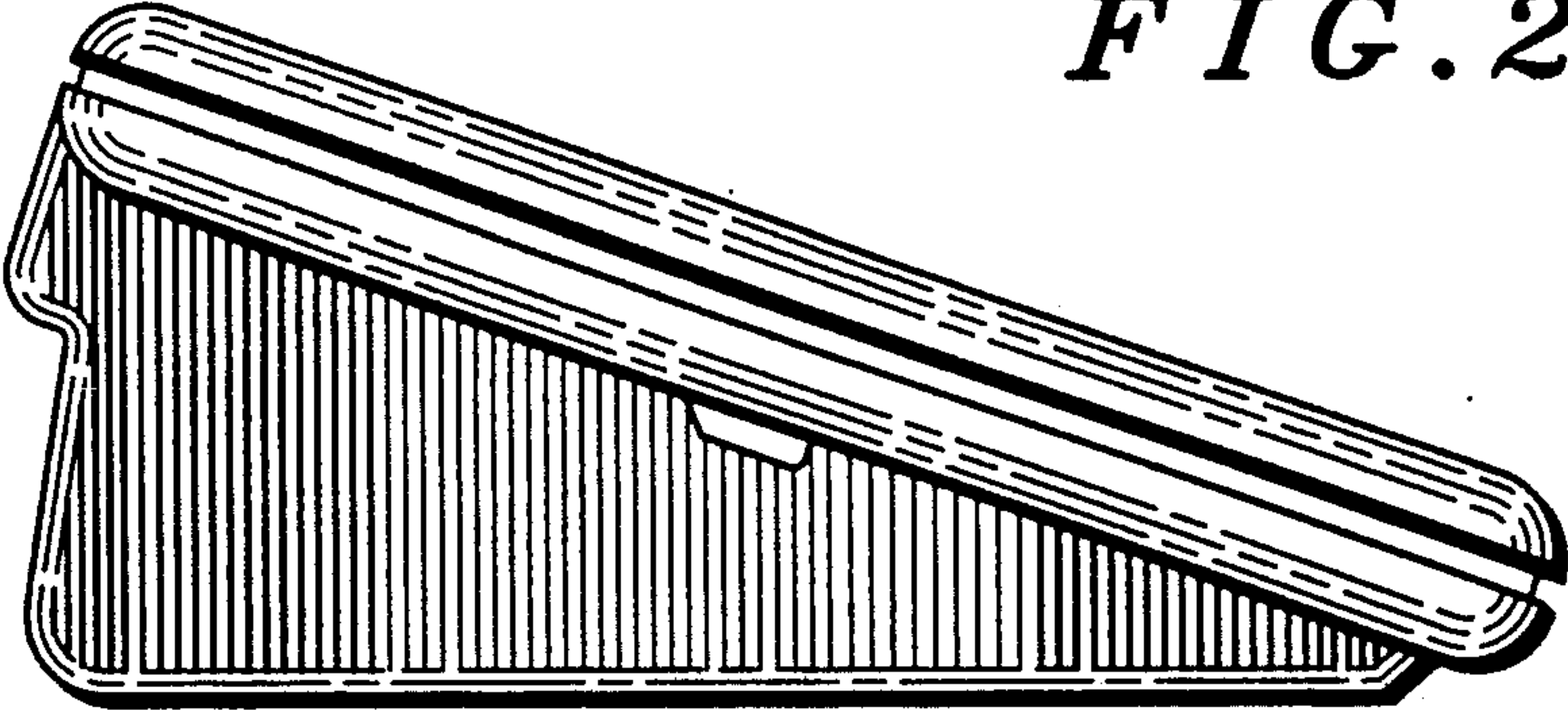
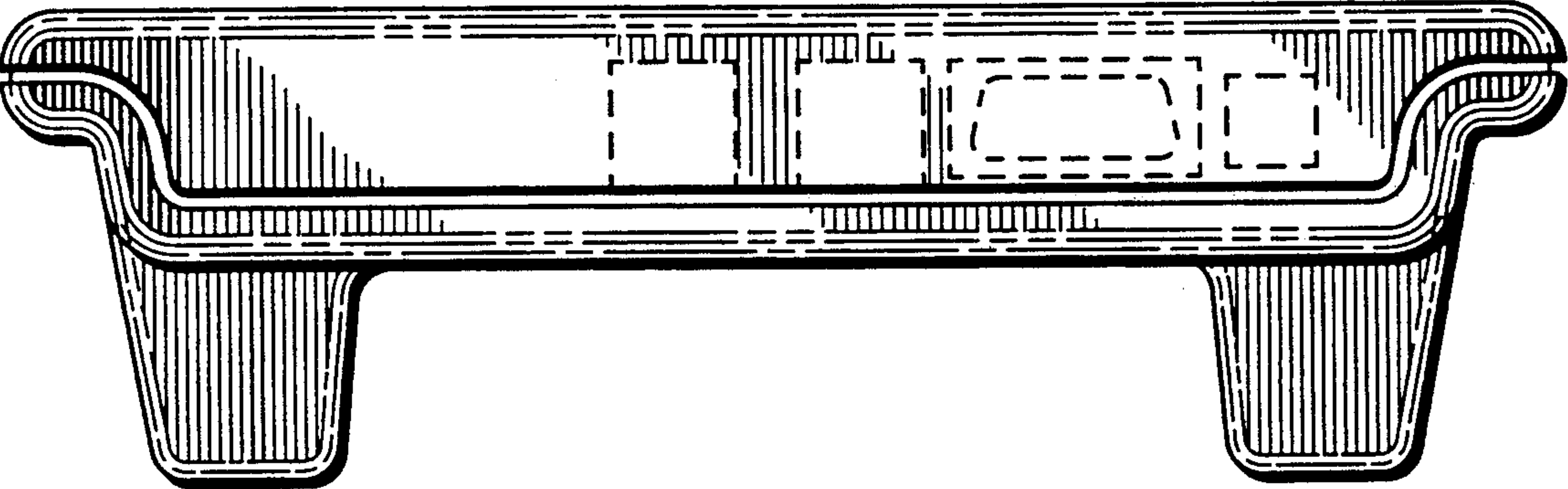

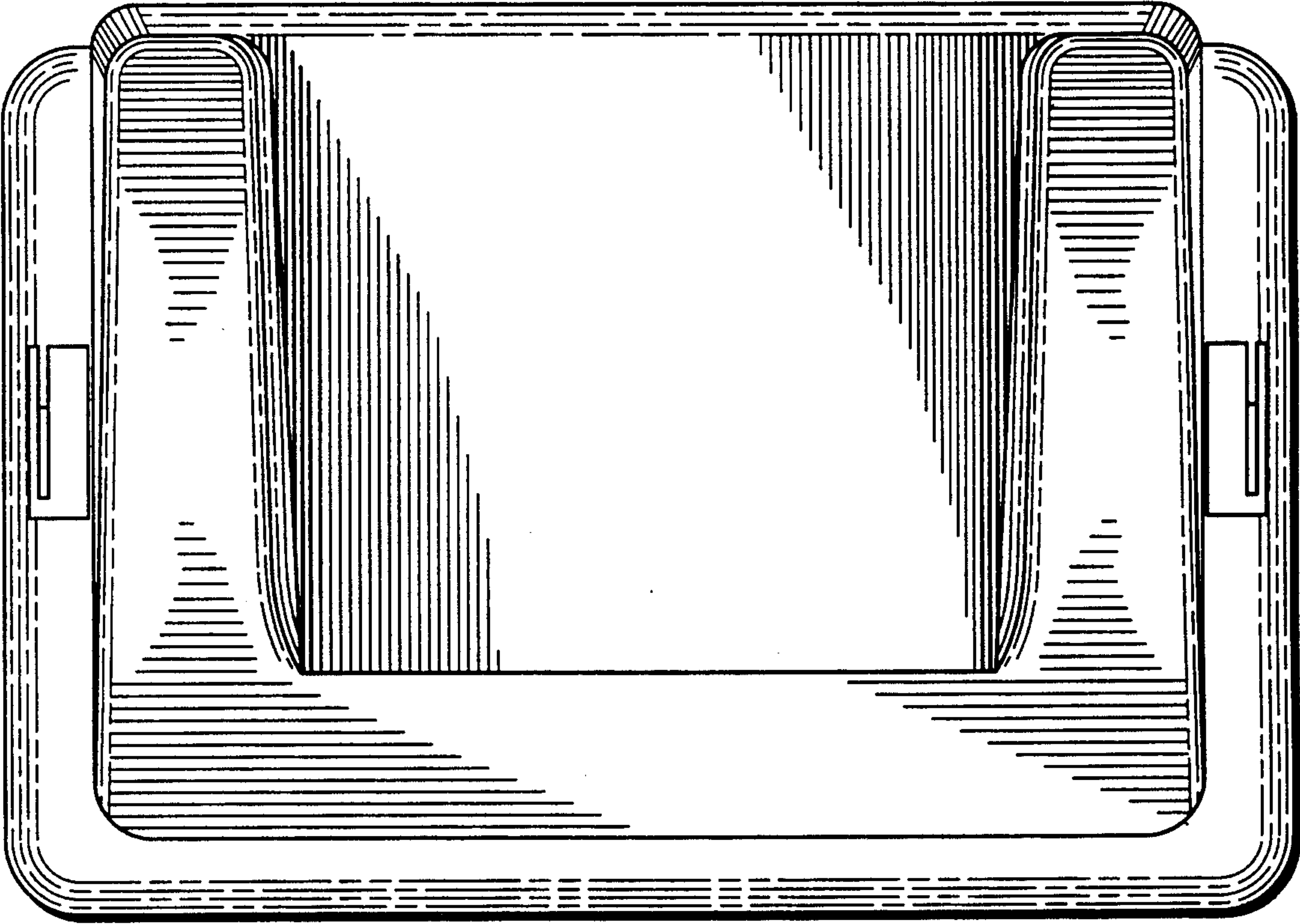
