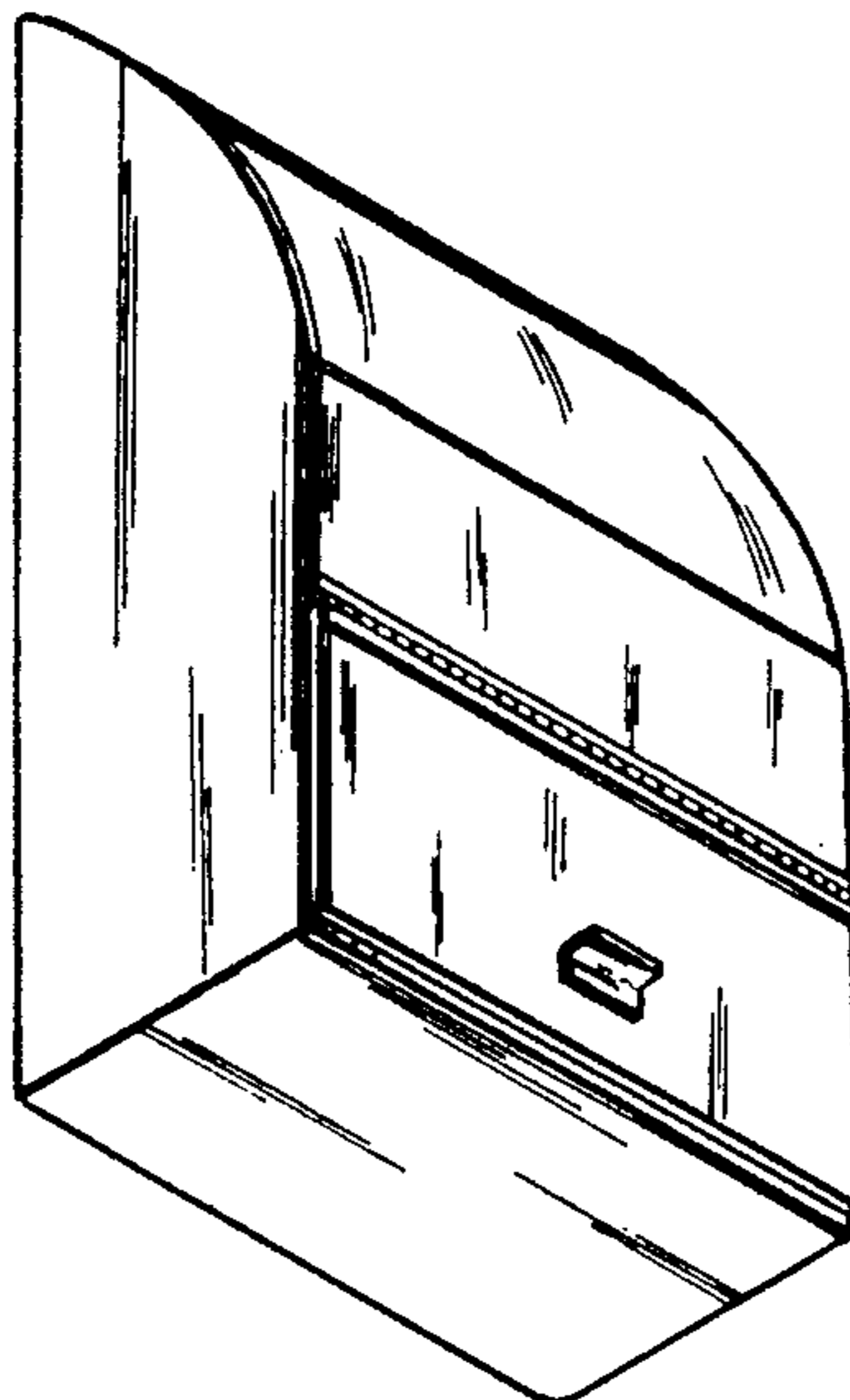
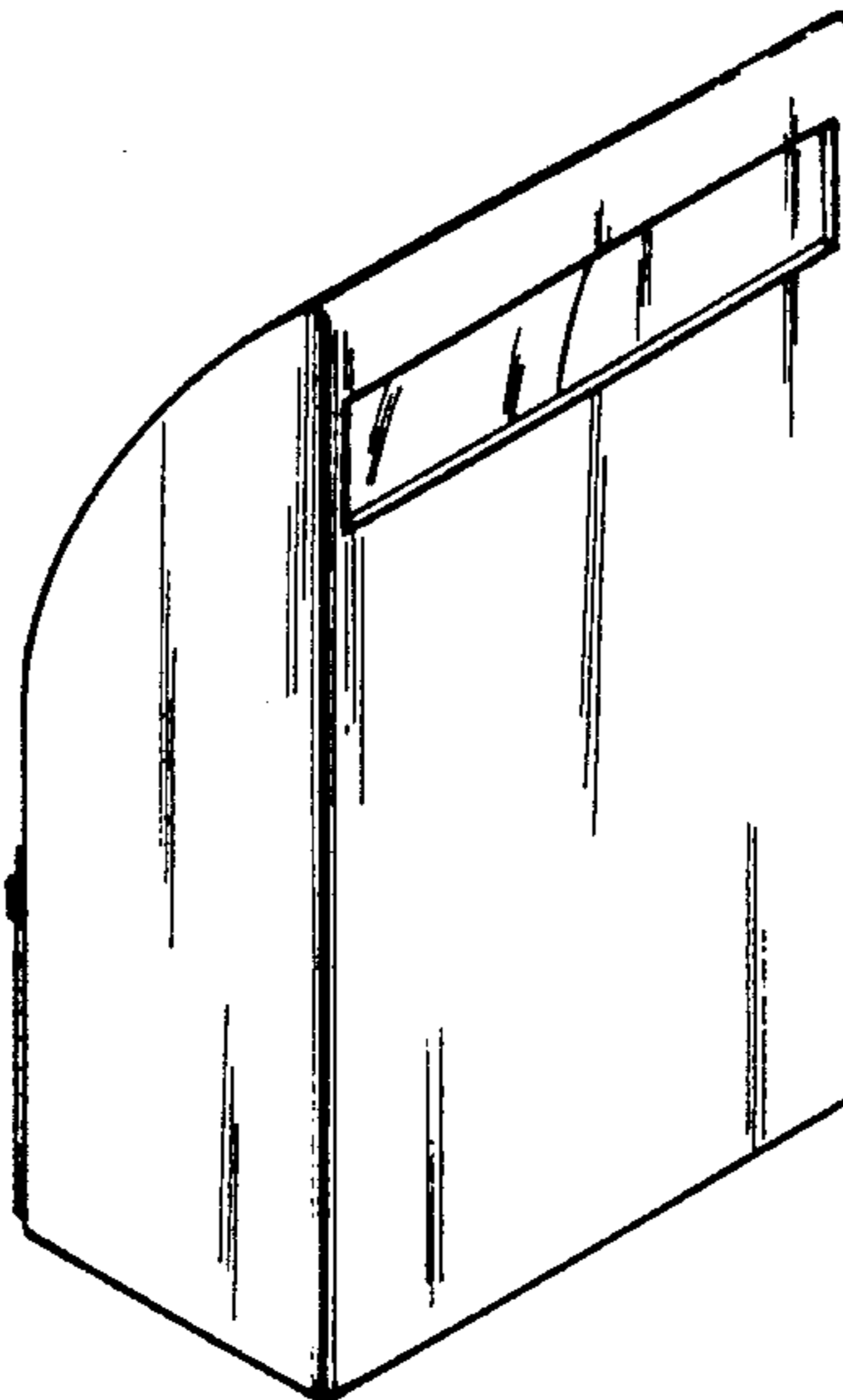
[57] CLAIM

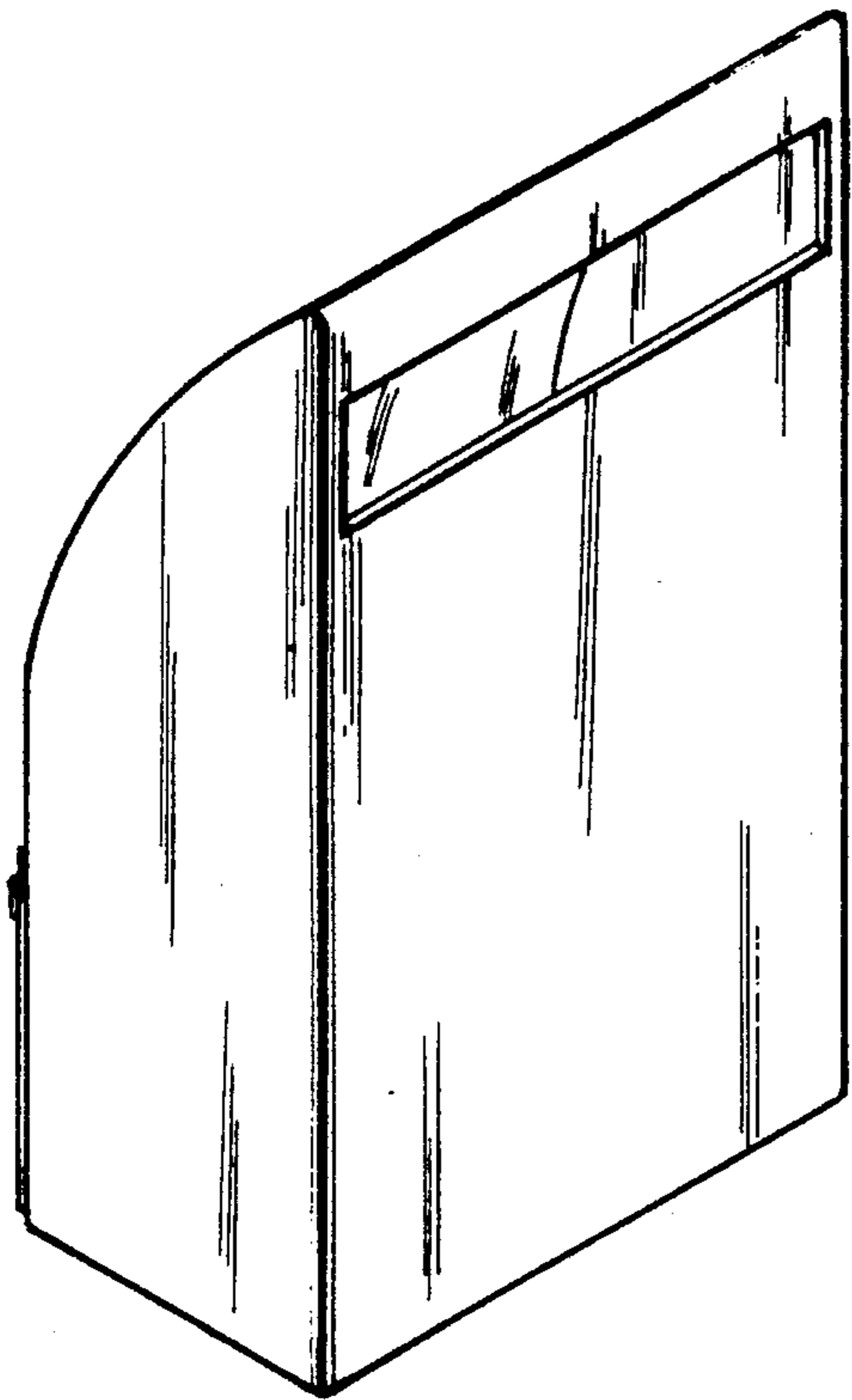

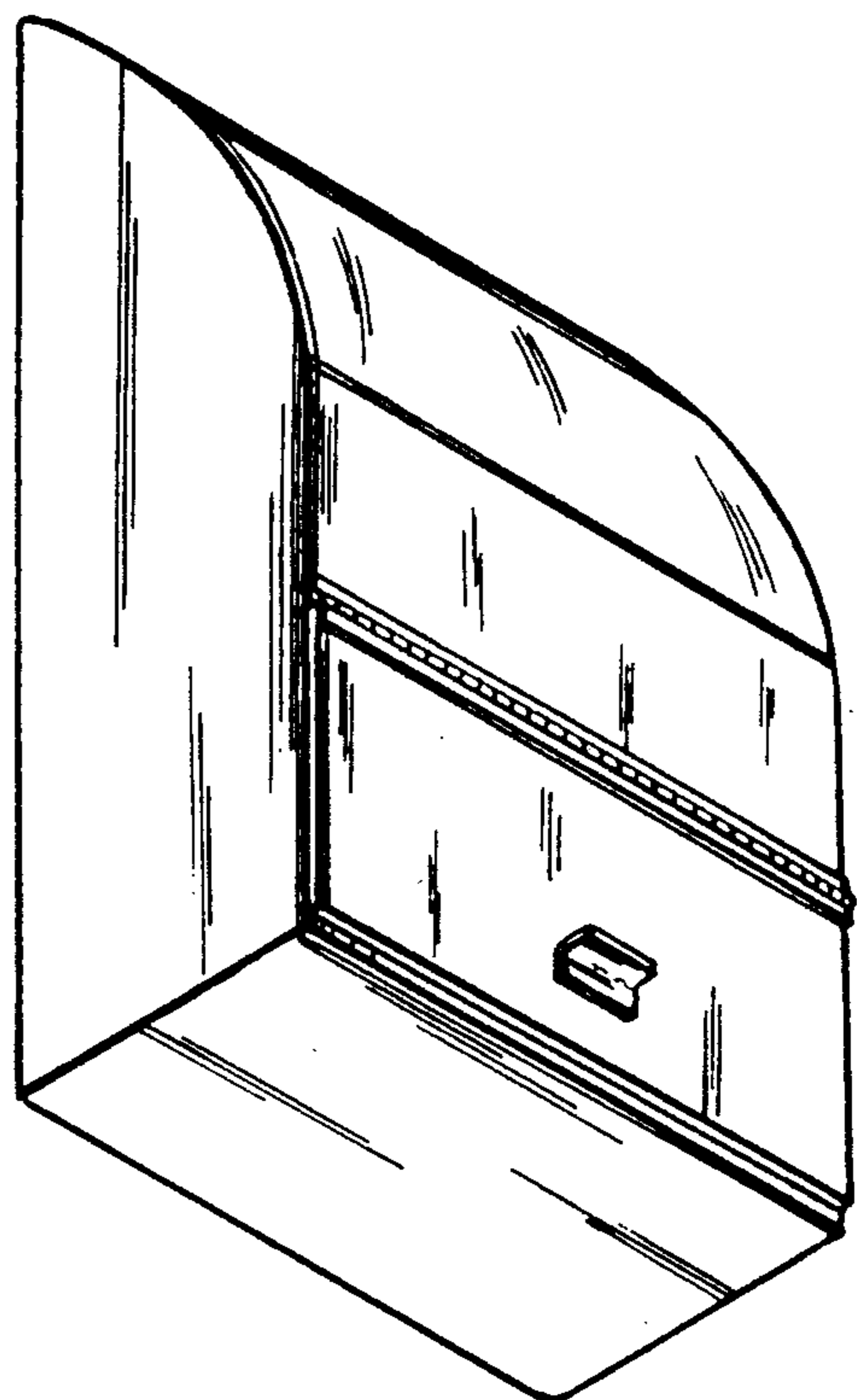
