CLAIM

The ornamental design for a rhinoceros-shaped pasta, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of rhinoceros-shaped pasta showing our new design, the undisclosed rear being a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

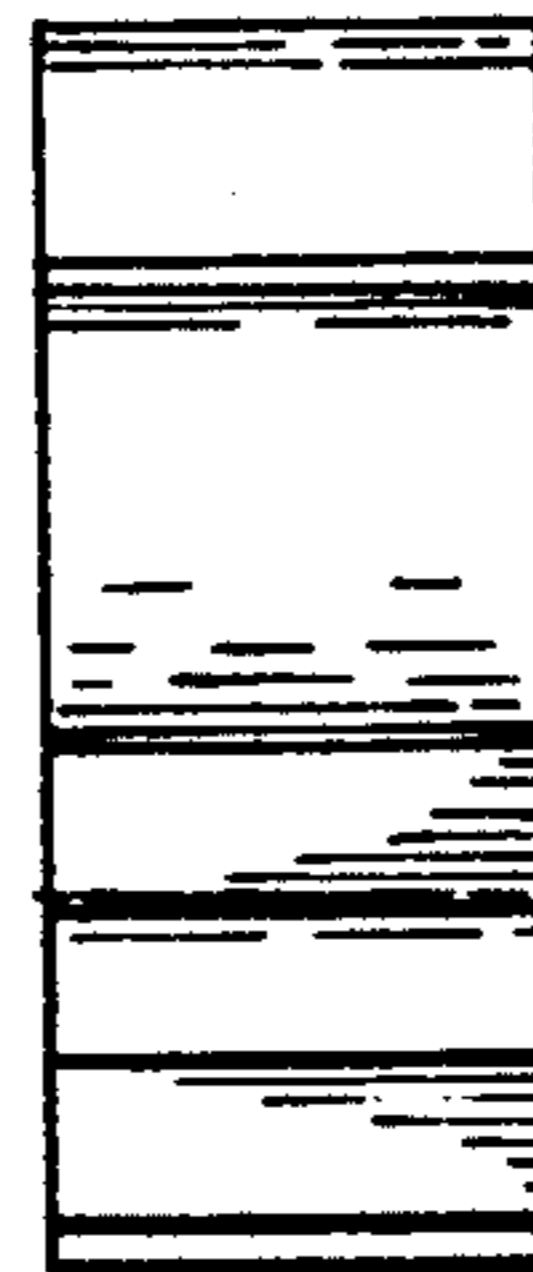
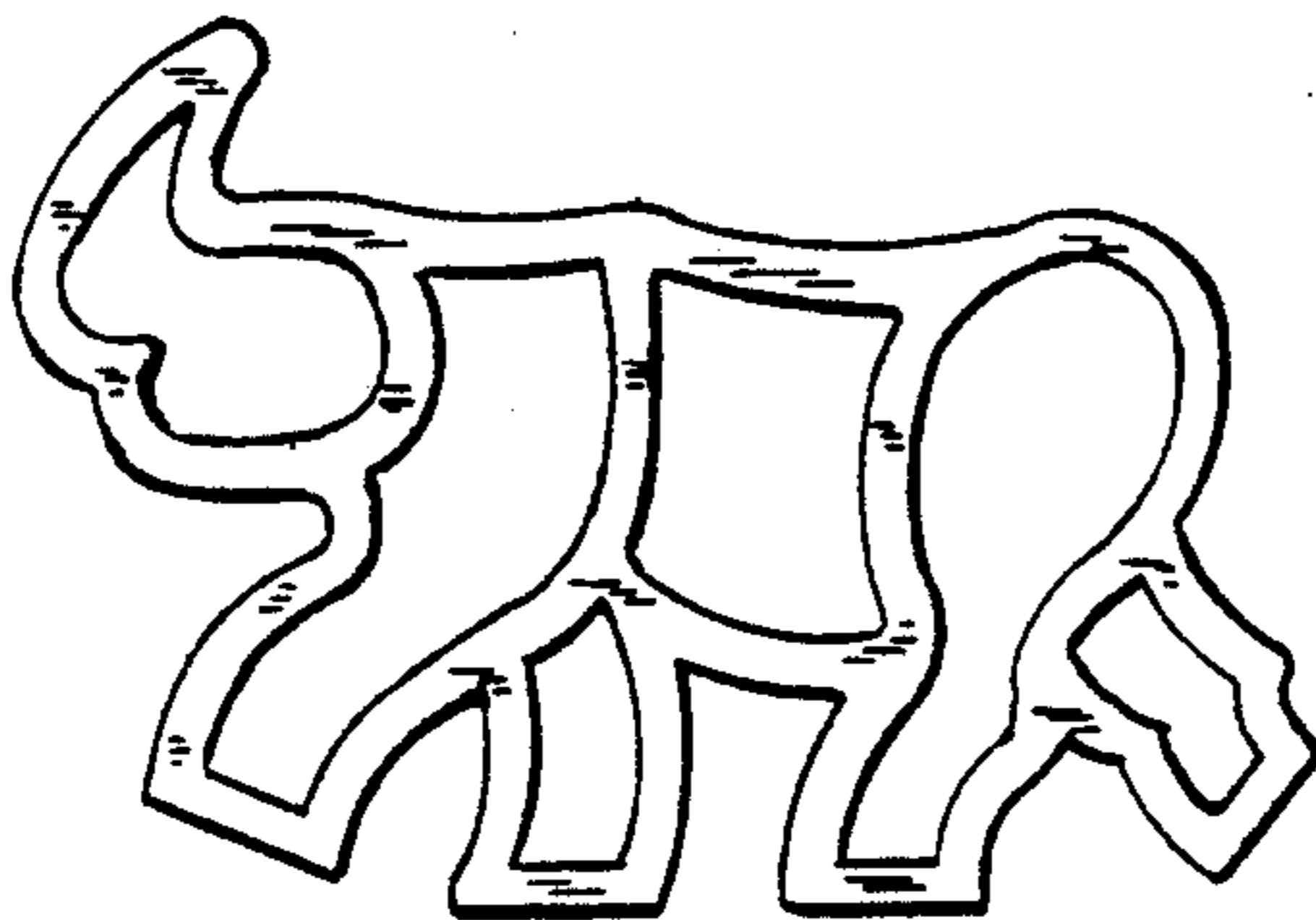

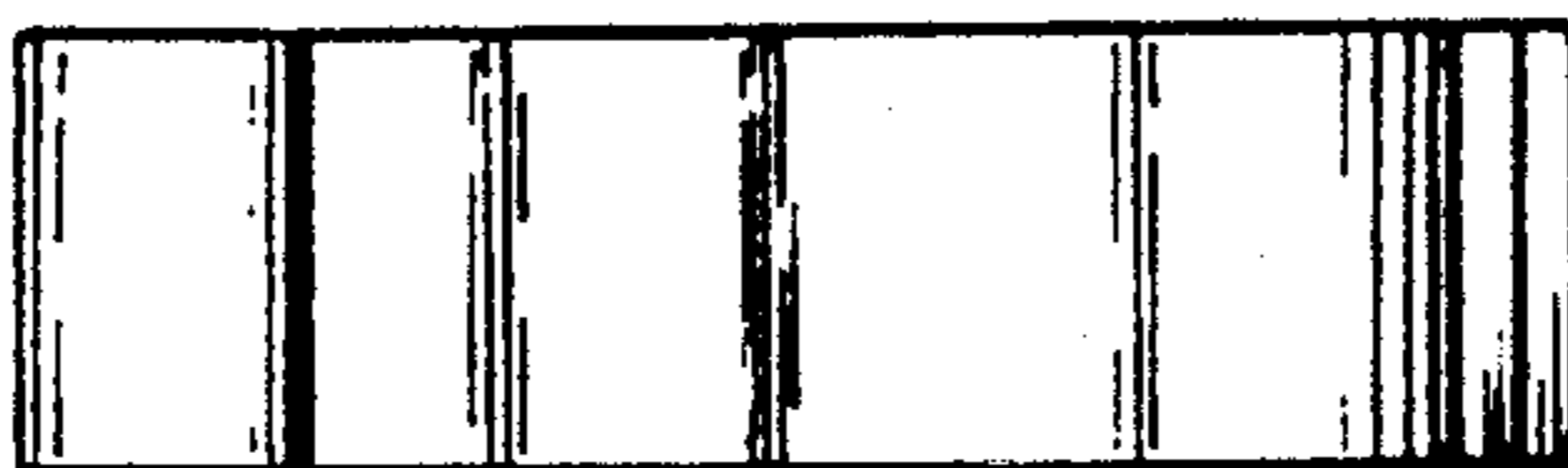

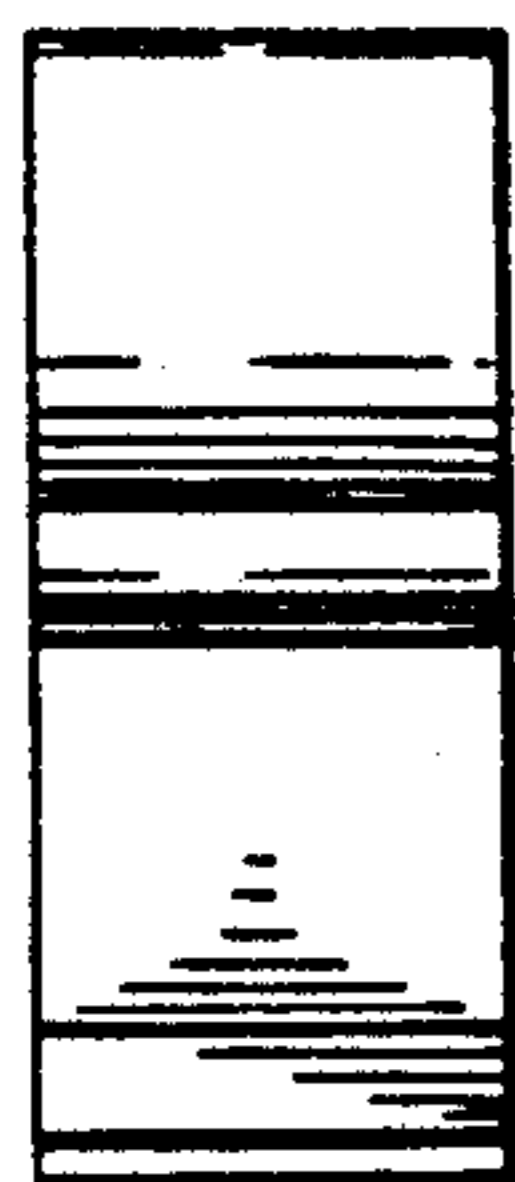

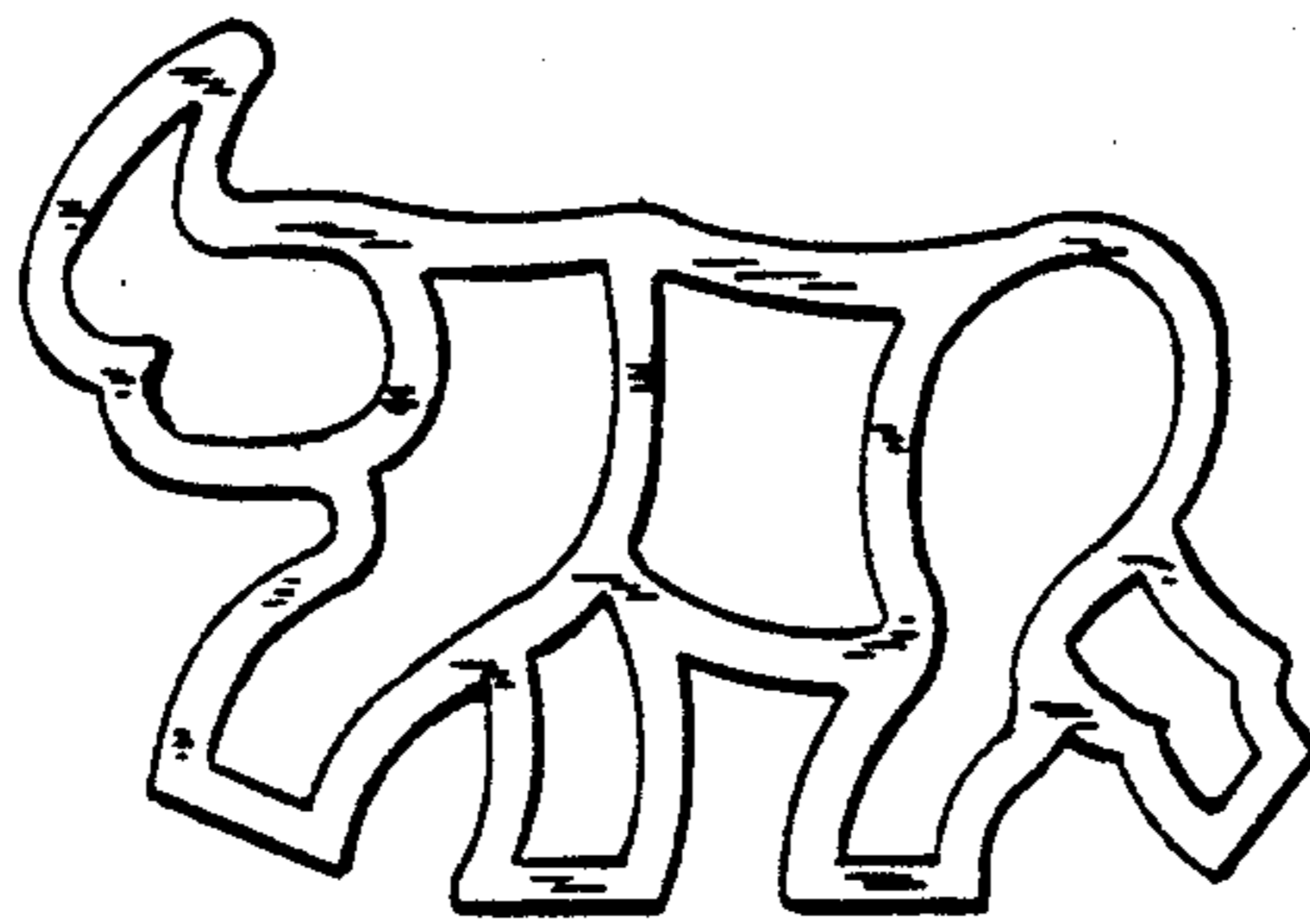
