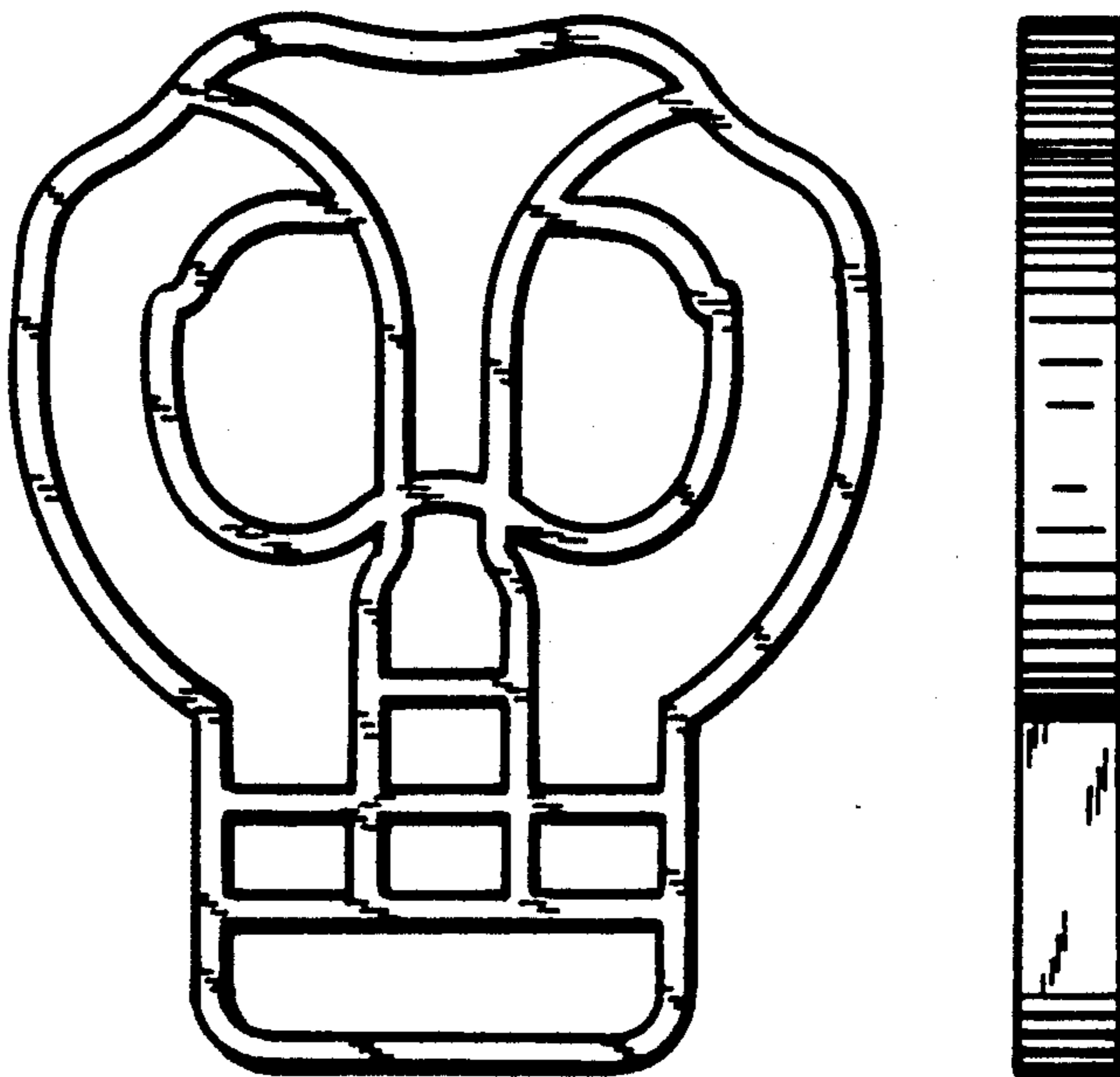

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for skull-shaped pasta, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of skull-shaped pasta showing our new design, the undisclosed rear being a mirror image;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed side being a mirror image;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



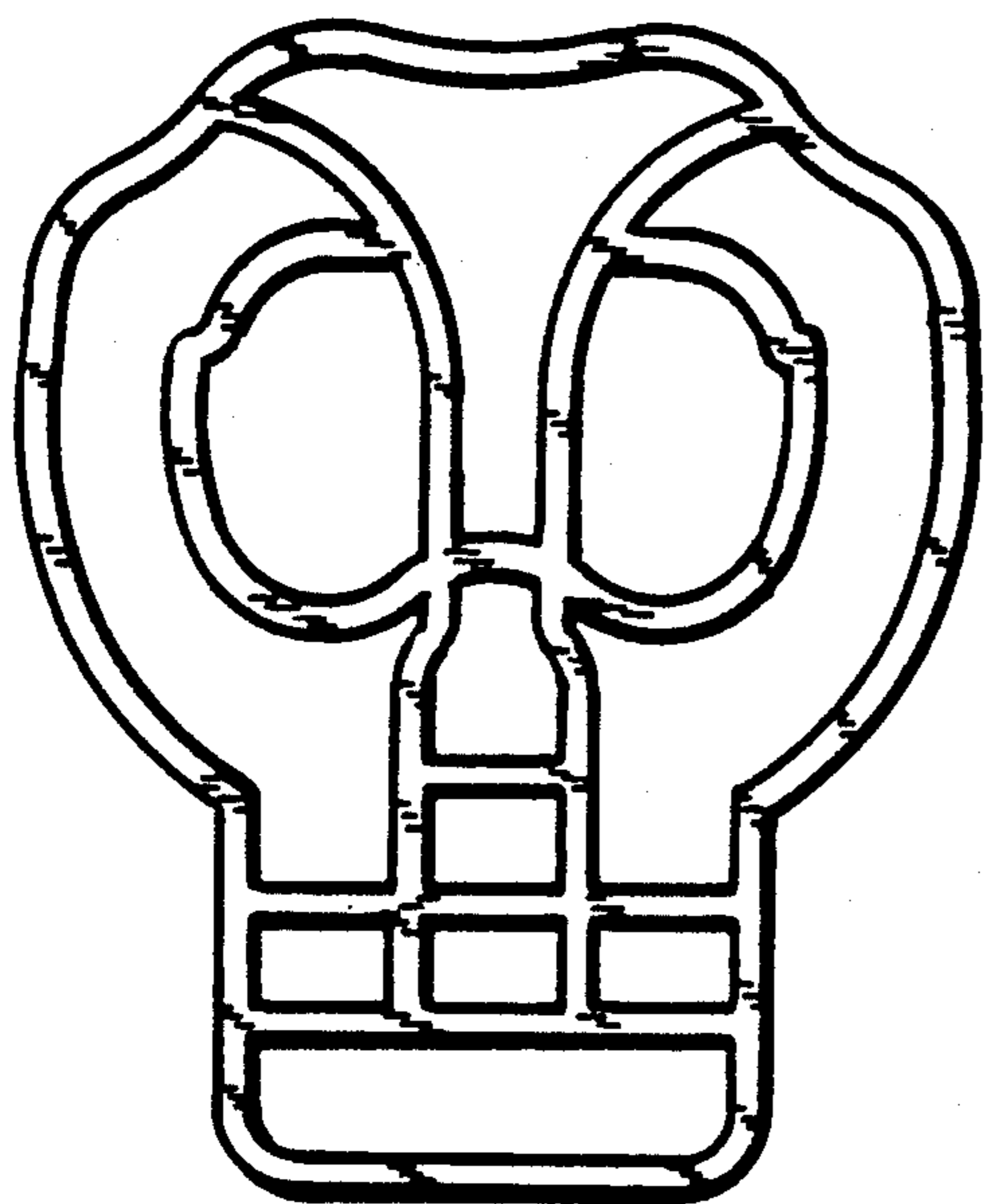
