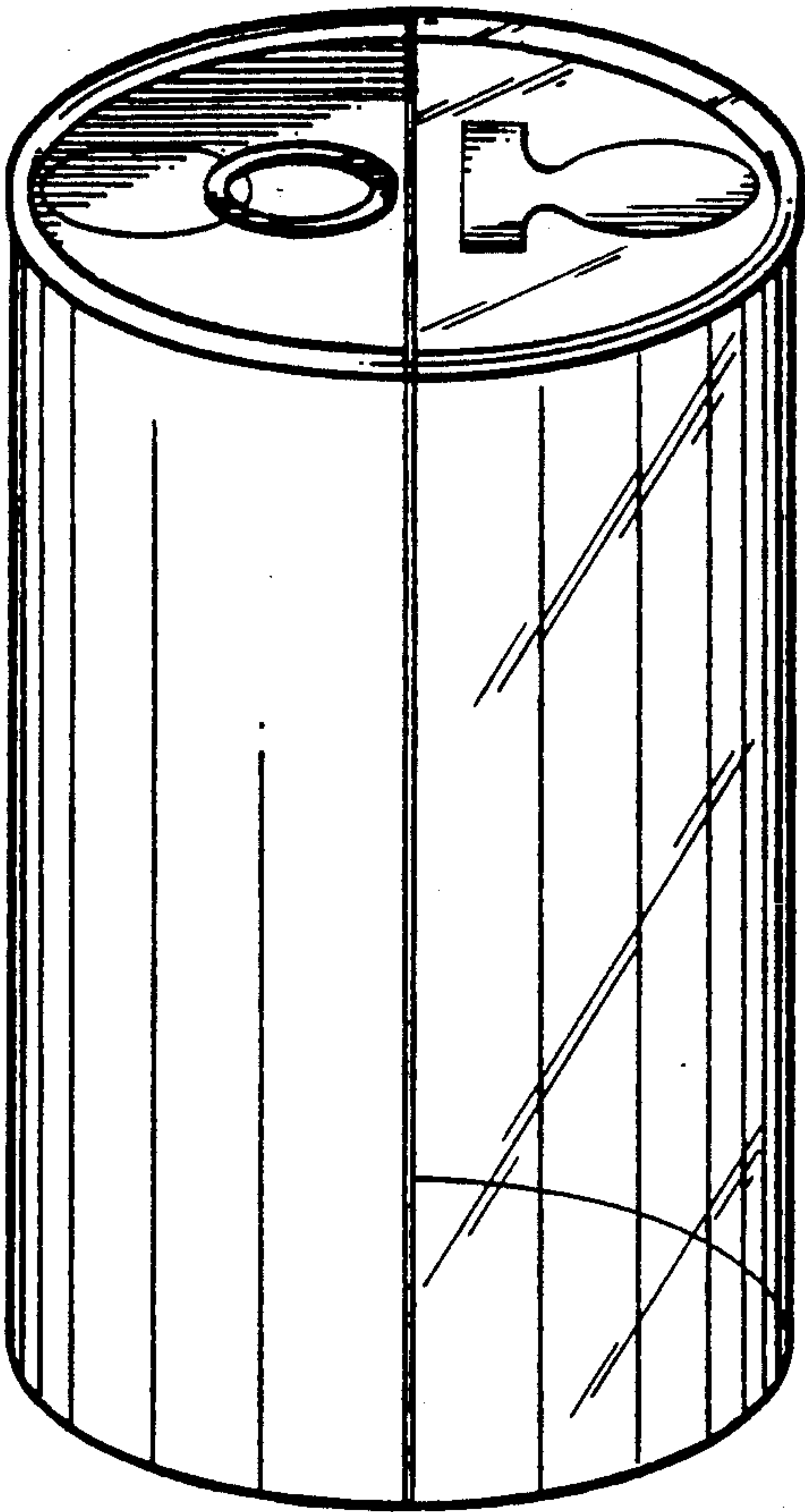

FIG. 6 is a left side elevation thereof.



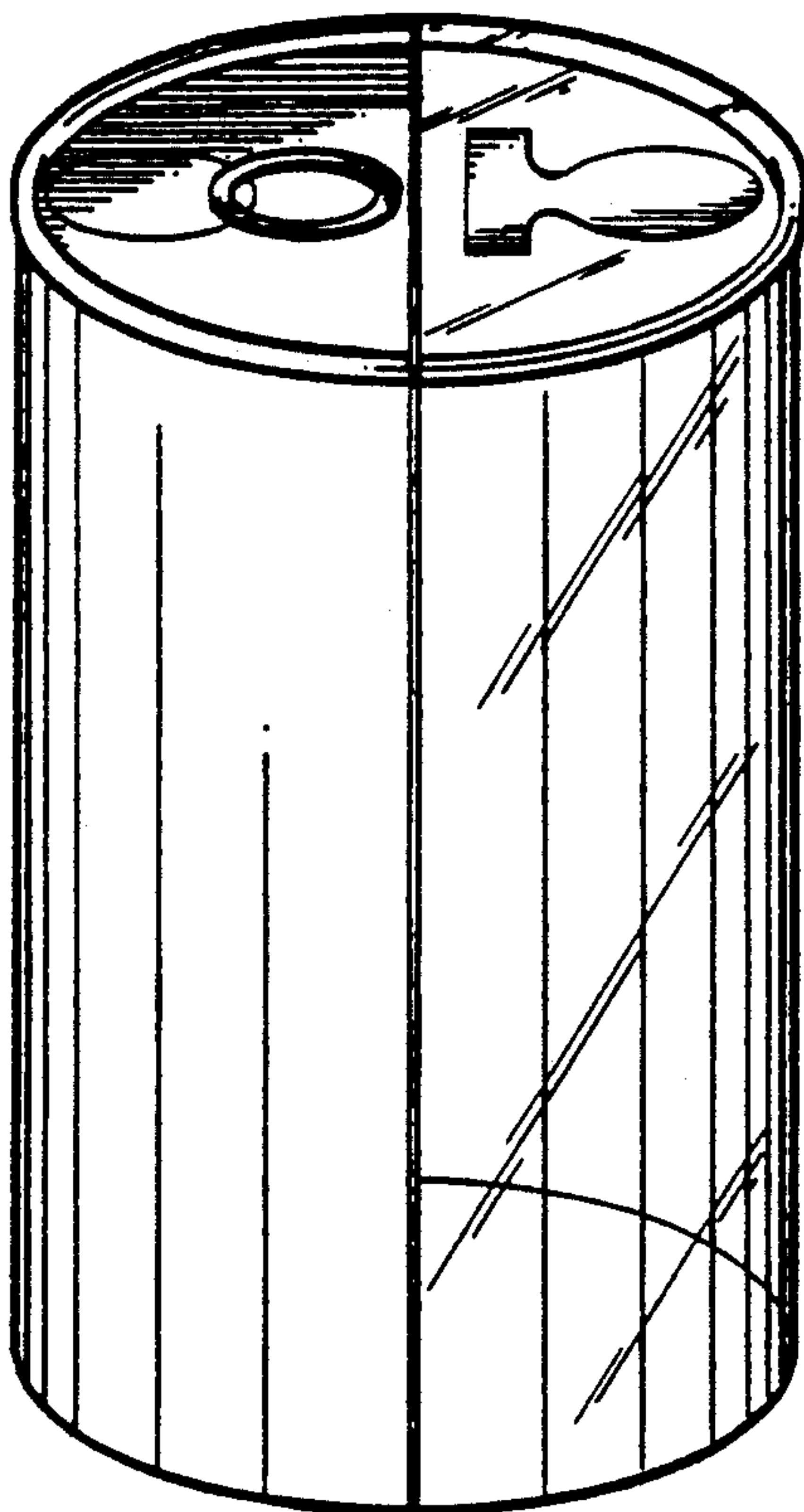

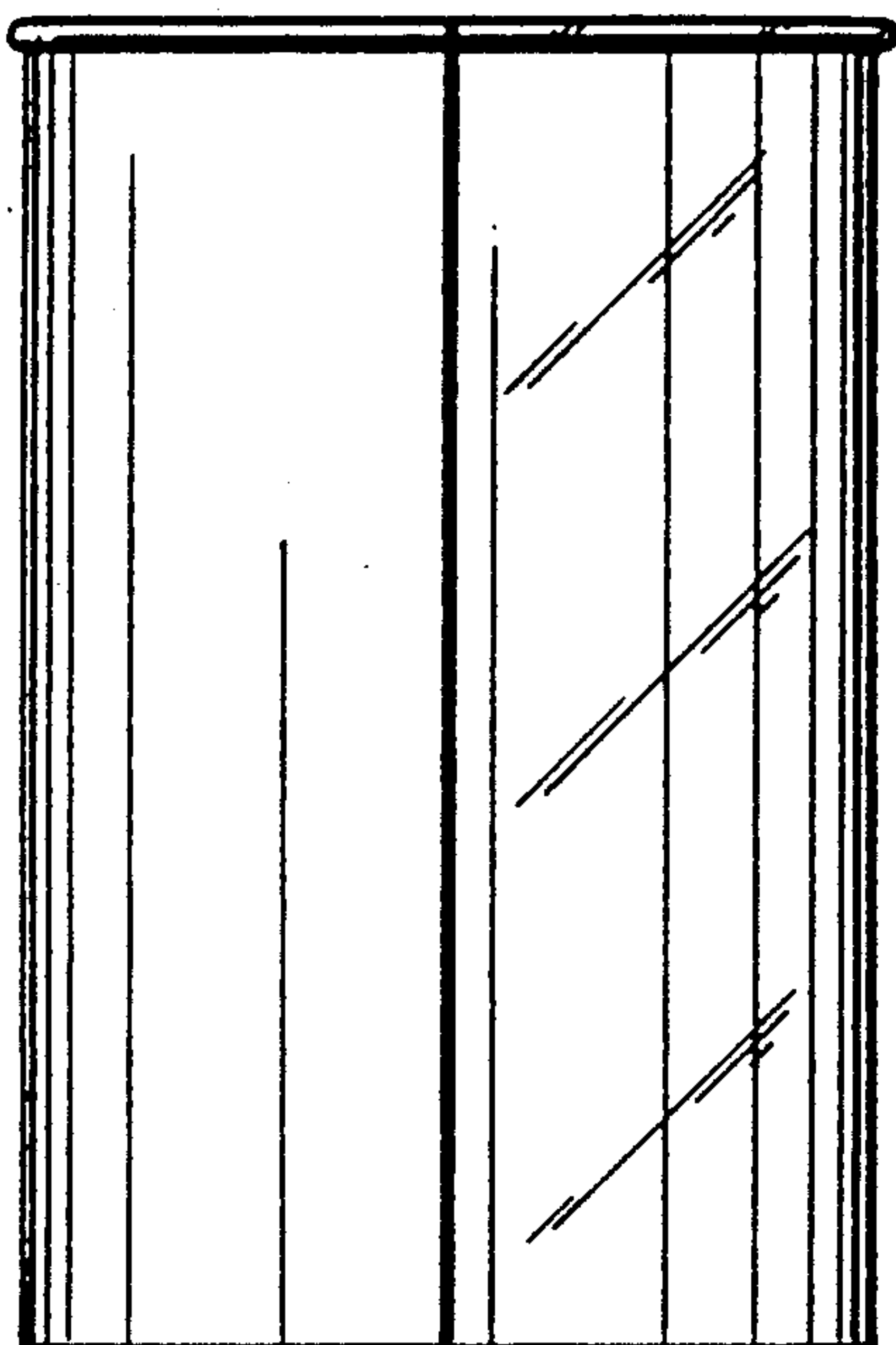

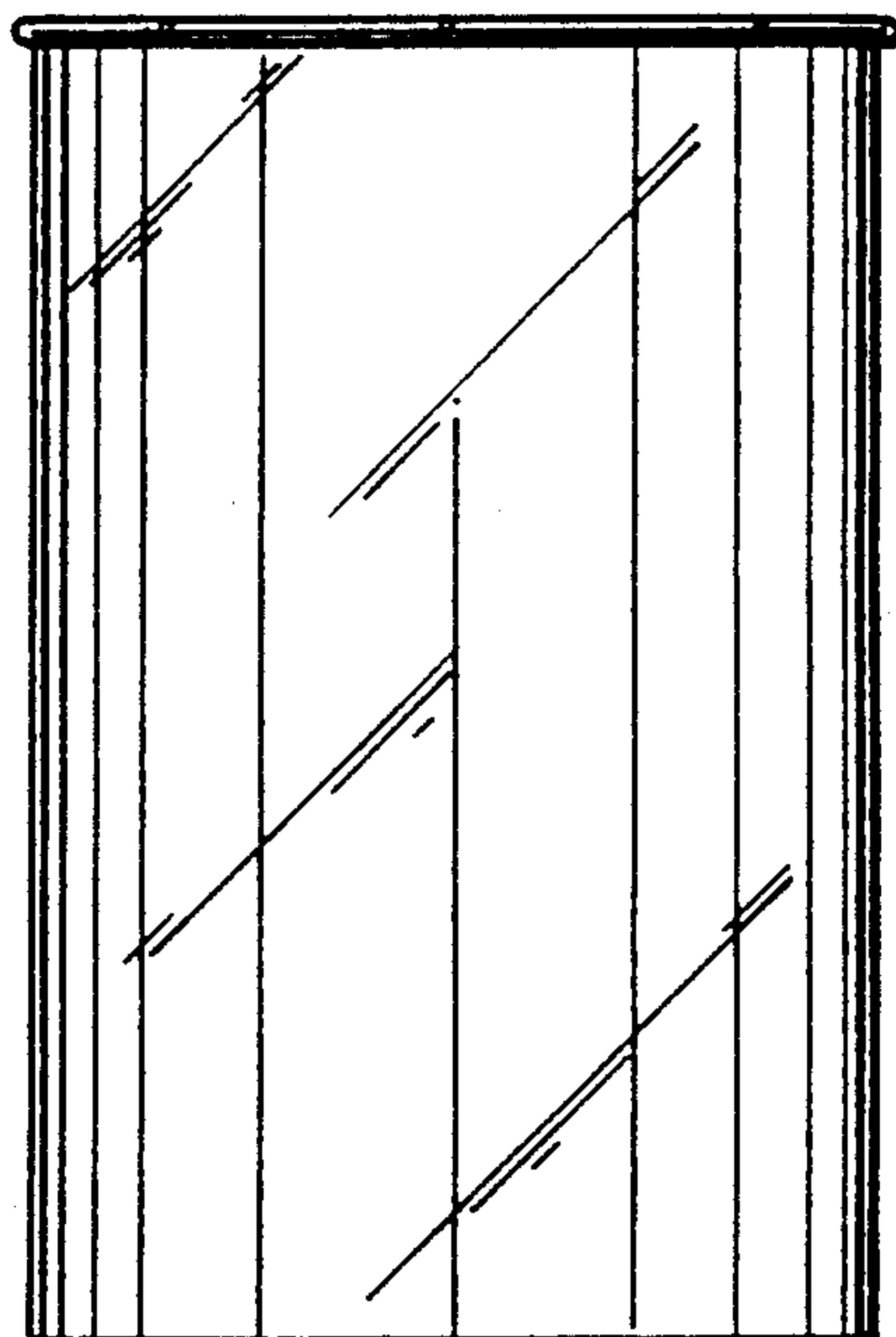

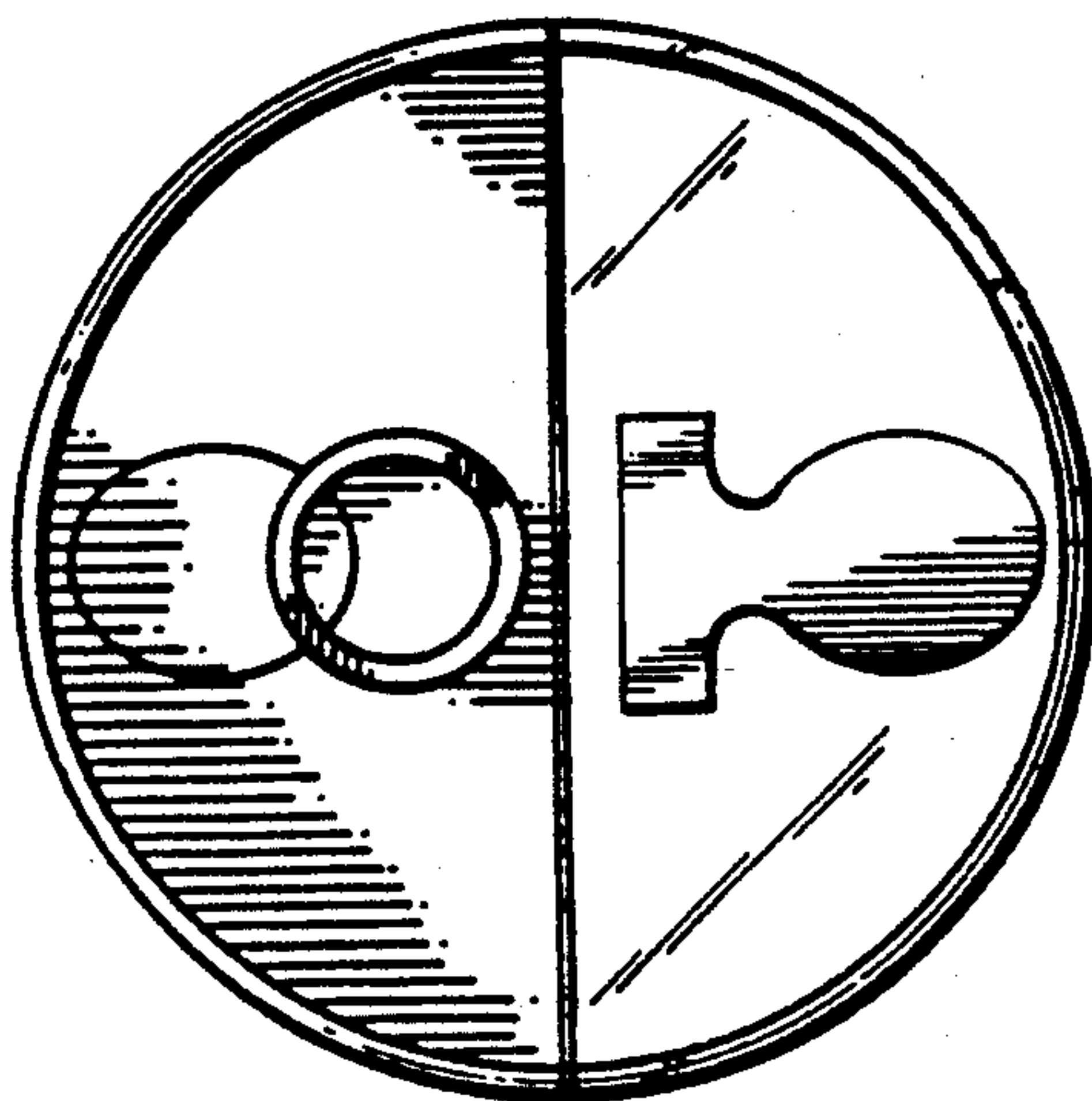

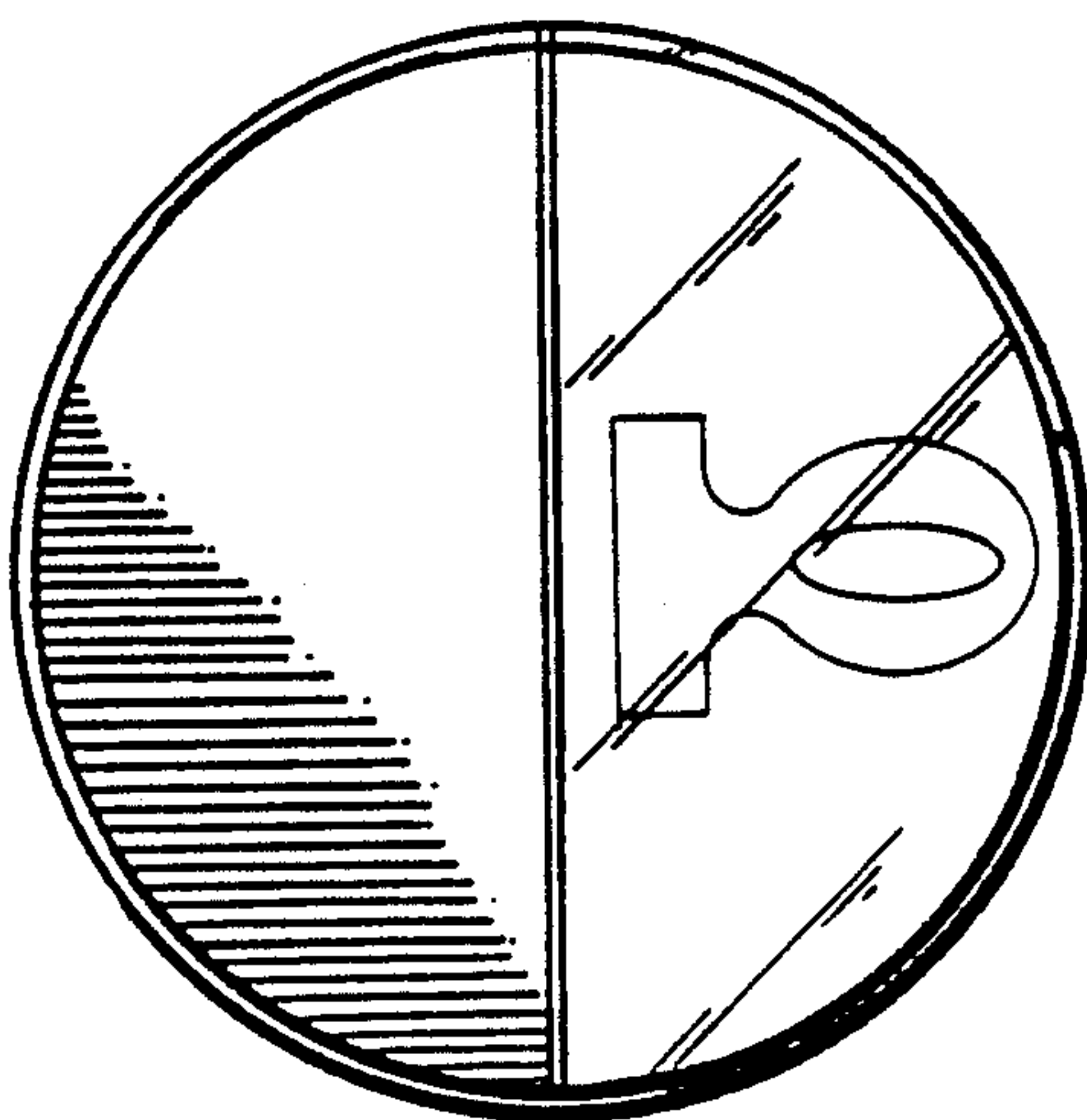

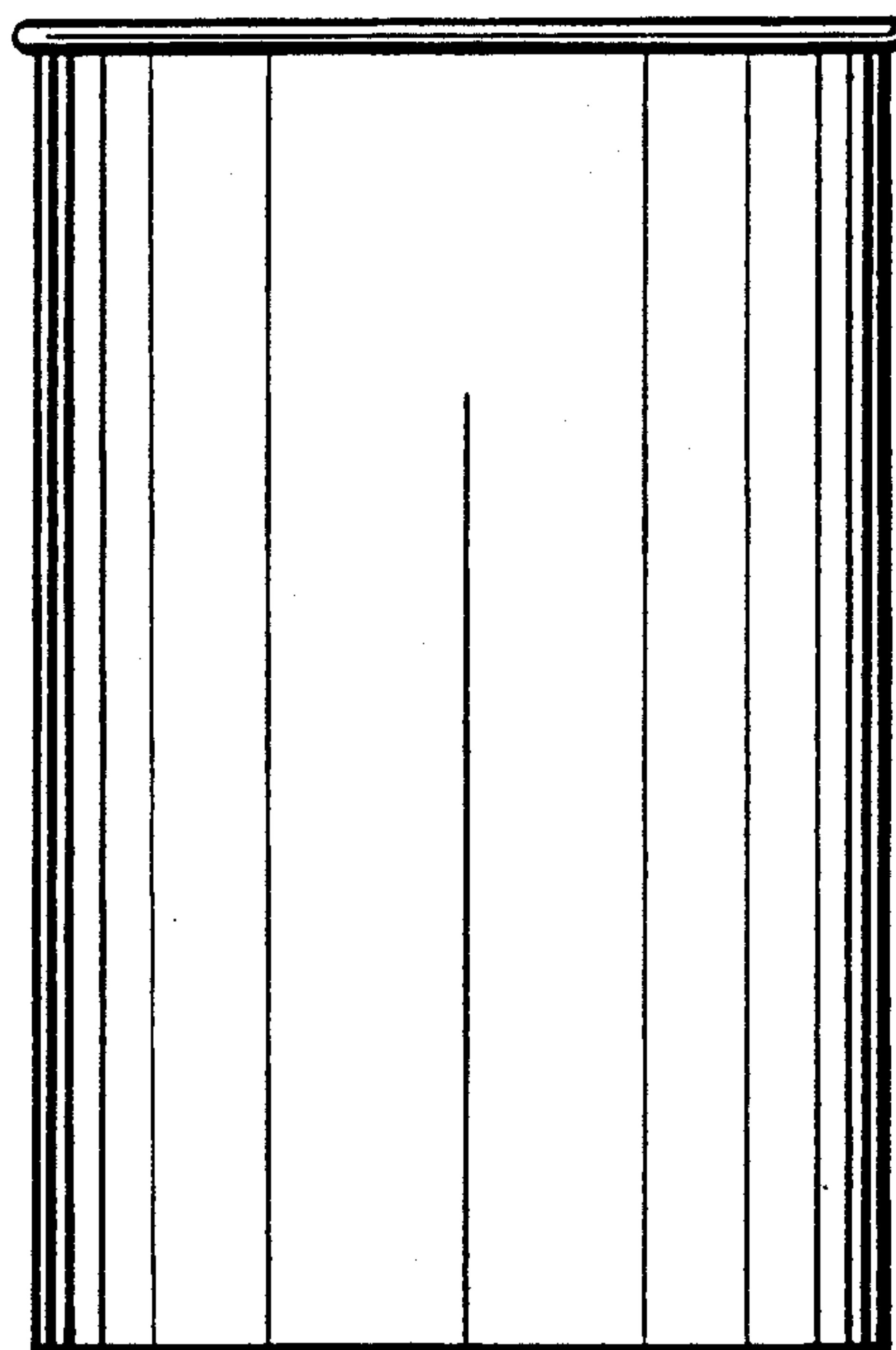
