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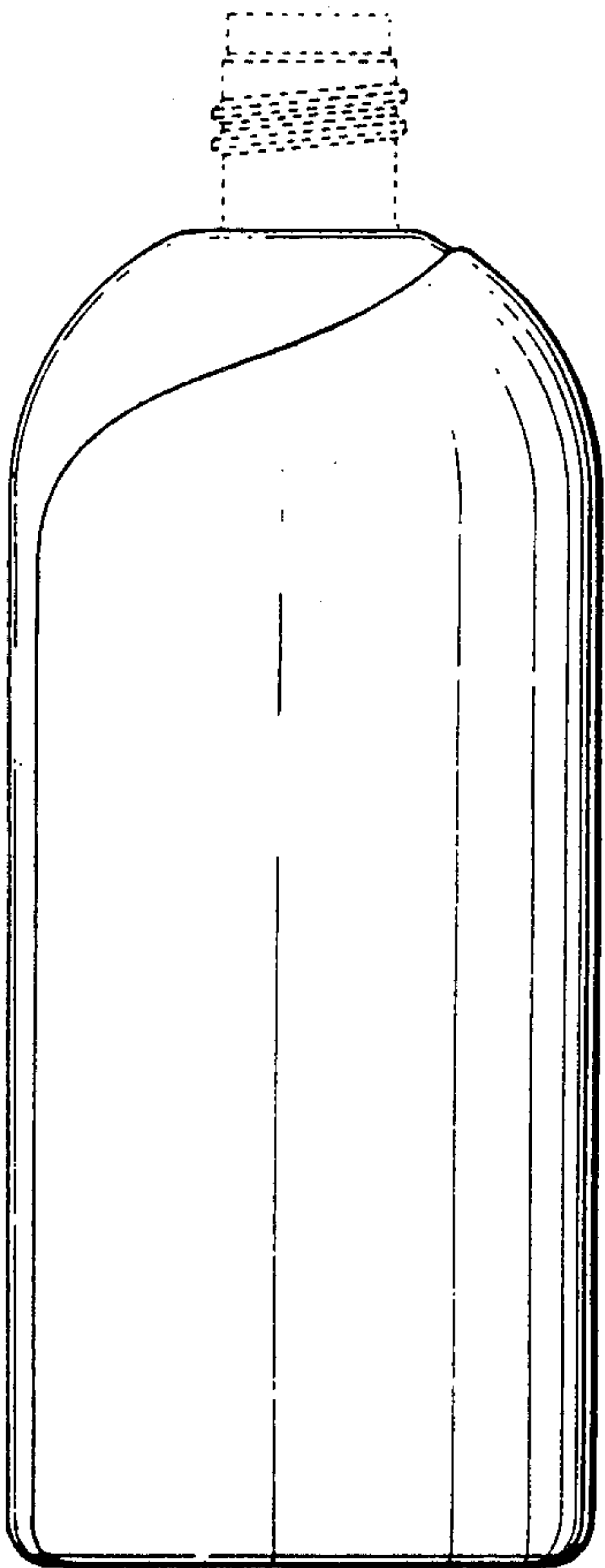

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear and left side perspective view from above of a bottle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a bottle neck is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



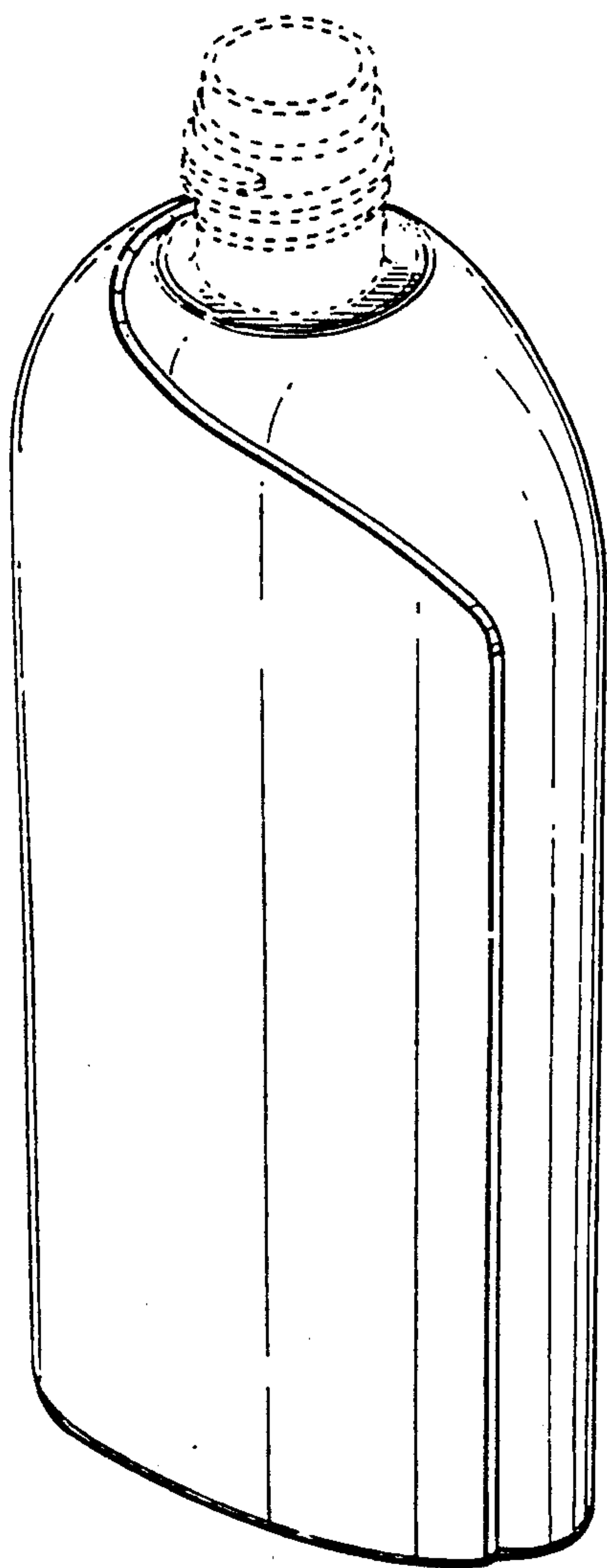

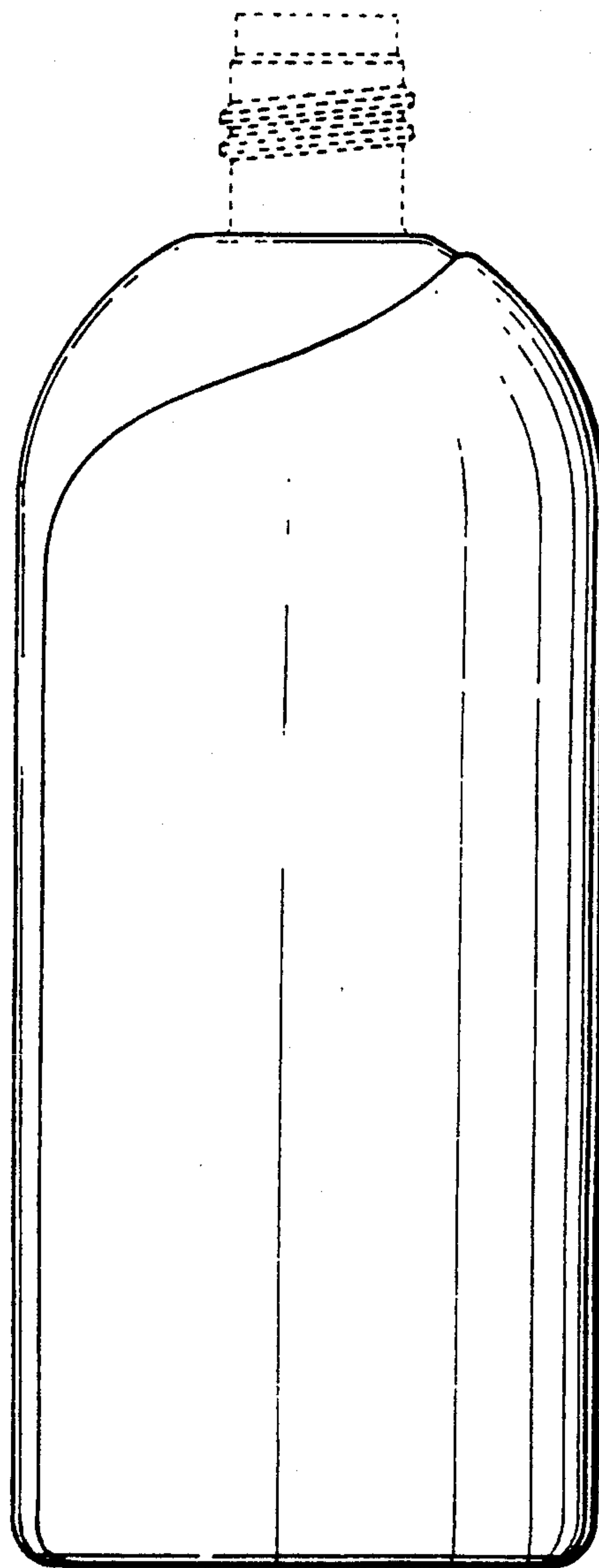

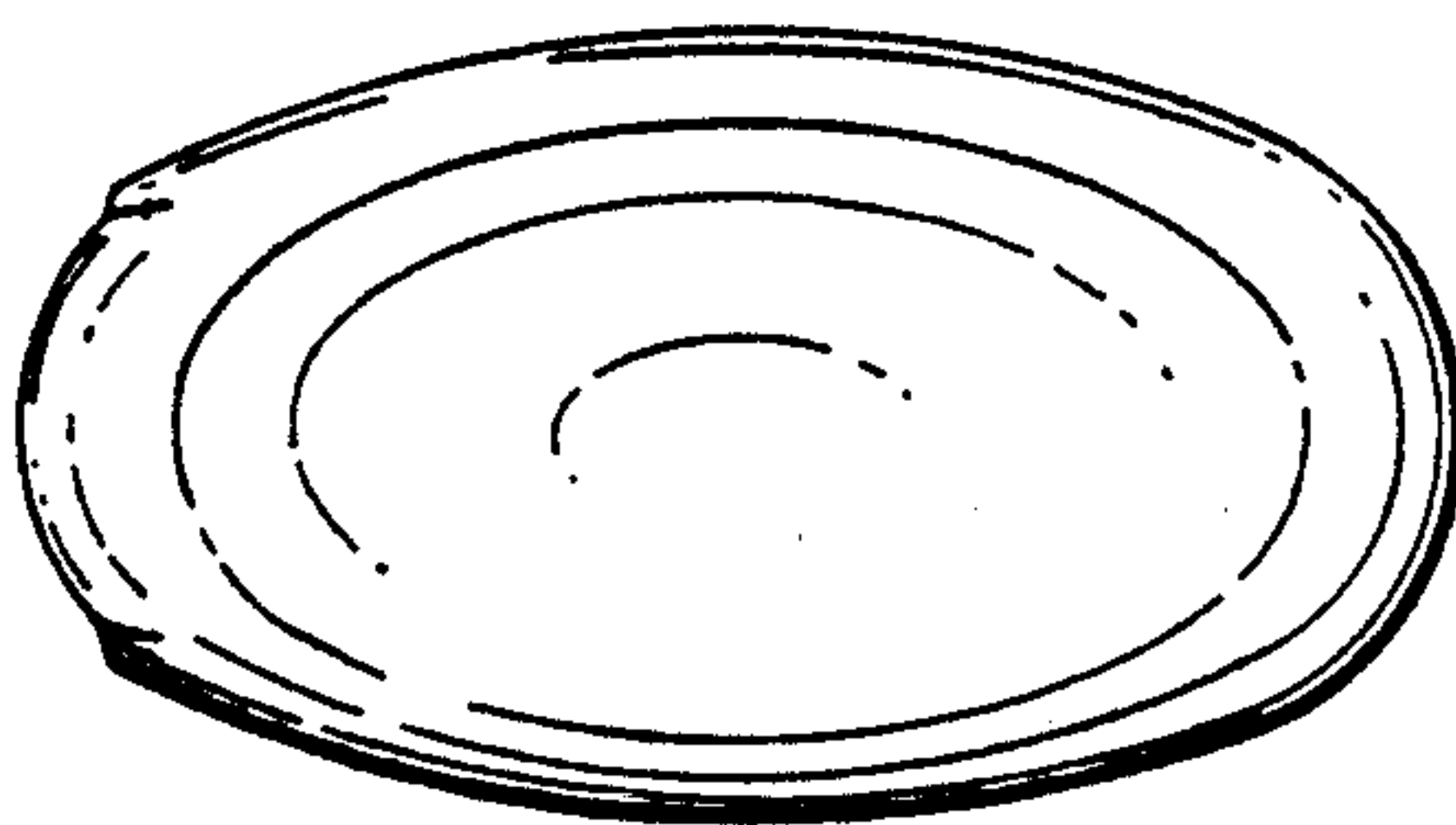

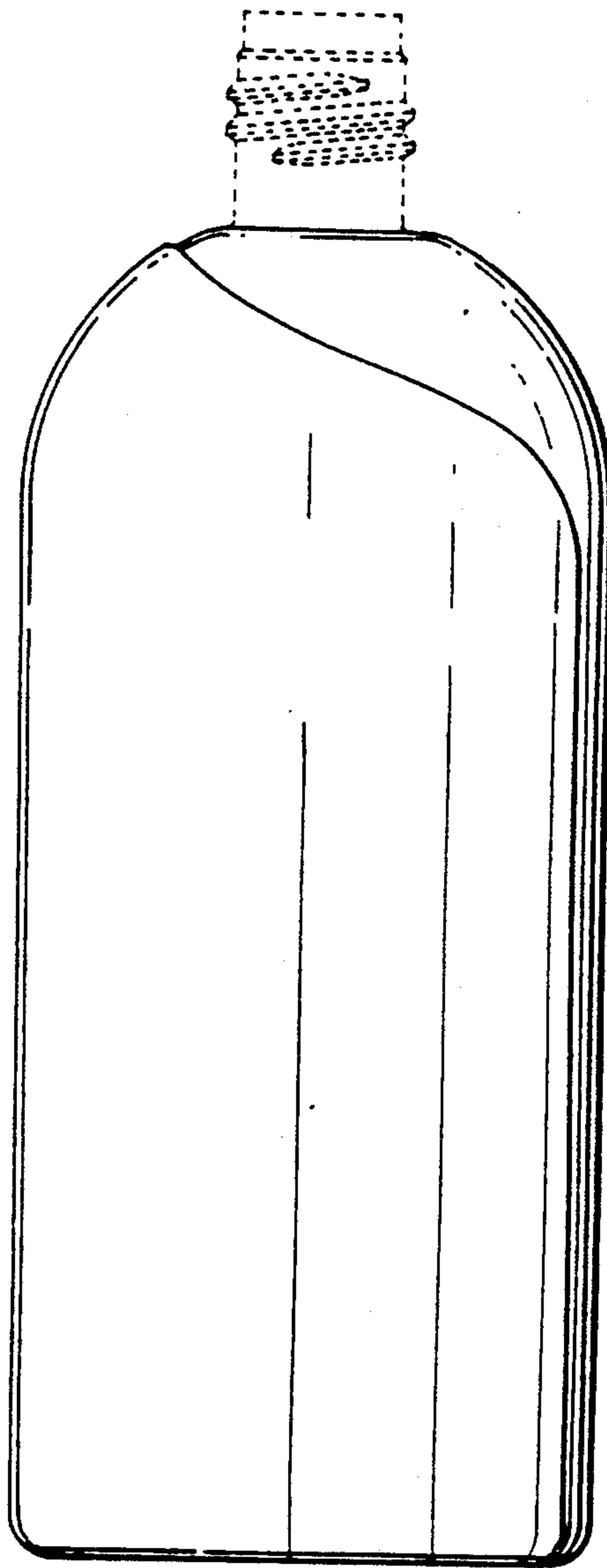

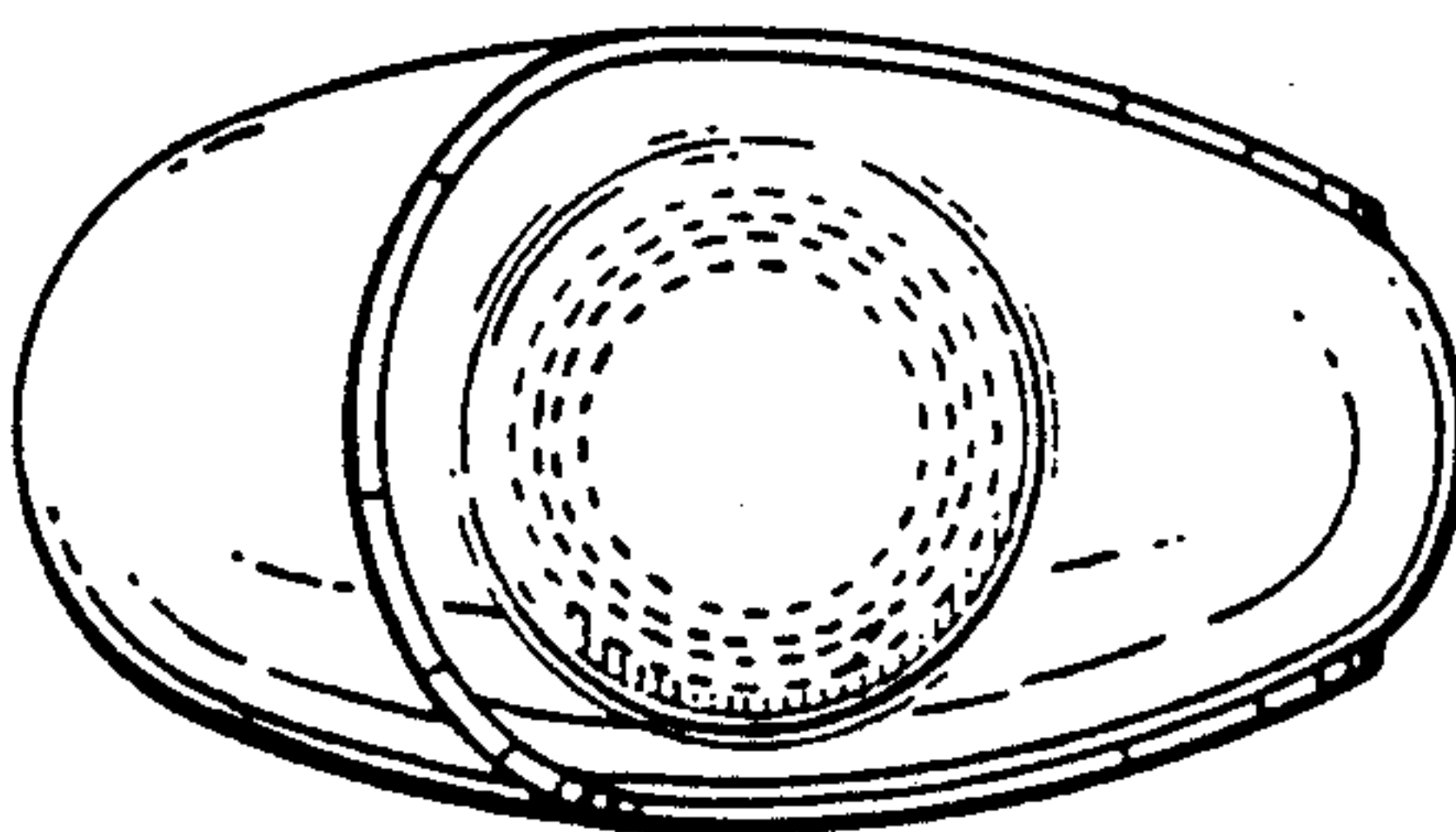

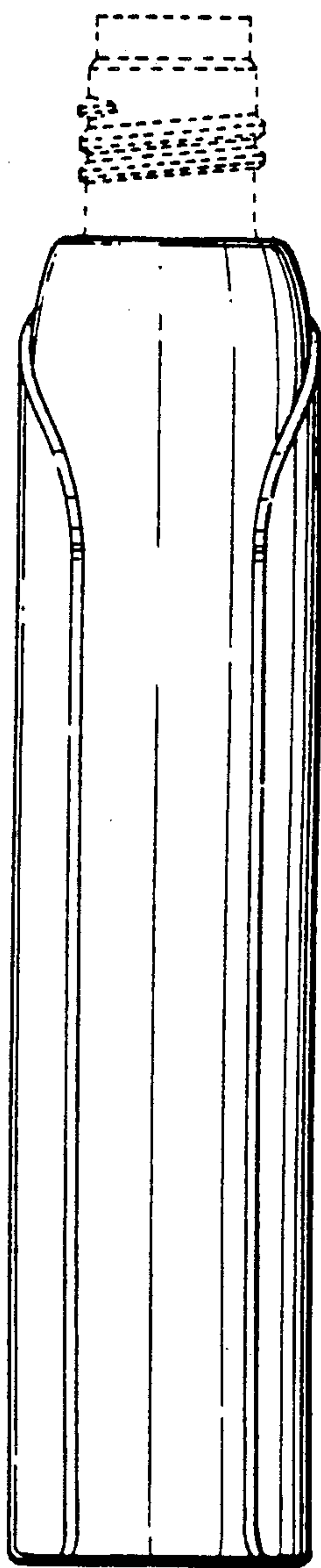

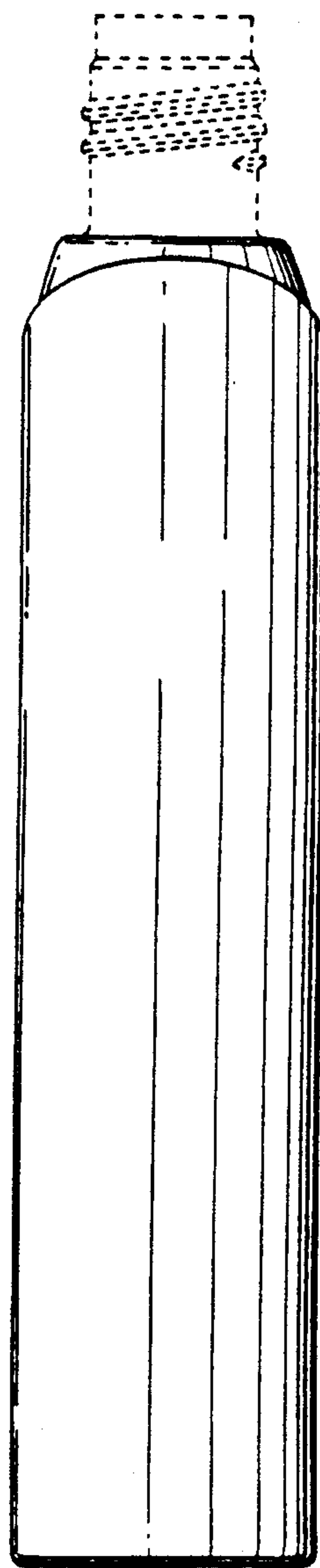
